RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates wrap up a three-game weekend series with this afternoon's finale at PNC Park ... This series in Pittsburgh is the Cardinals 2nd-straight road trip of only three games and third since August 9 ... After tomorrow's off day, the Cardinals open a six-day, seven-game homestand vs. Milwaukee (2G) and Cincinnati (5G), continuing a stretch of playing 17 of 23 home games (Aug. 26-Sept. 18).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals are in first place in the NL Central, 8.0 games in front of Milwaukee (74-66) ... St. Louis currently holds the No. 3 seed in the NL postseason standings, 6.5 games behind the Mets (No. 2) ... The Cardinals +127 run differential ranks 4th in the NL behind the Mets (+134), Braves (+160), and Dodgers (+301).

A WINNING TRADITION: Last night clinched the Cardinals' 15th consecutive winning season (2008-22), their 22nd in the last 23 seasons, and the 82nd in franchise history ... The 15 consecutive winning seasons matches a franchise-record previously established from 1939-53 when the Cardinals won three of four World Series (1942, 1944, 1946) ... Only the Yankees (30 seasons) sport a longer active consecutive winning season streak in MLB.

AUGUST AND EVERYTHING AFTER: Since August 1, the Cardinals have posted the best record (28-10, .737) in MLB with the Dodgers trailing (27-10, .730).

QUEST FOR 700: Last night's game-tying, two-run blast in the 6th inning was **Albert Pujols'** 696th career home run, tying **Álex Rodríguez** for 4th all-time in Major League history ... The Machine needs four home runs over the remaining 22 games to become just the 4th player to reach the 700-homer career plateau, joining **Barry Bonds** (762), **Hank Aaron** (755), and **Babe Ruth** (714).

PNC PUNISHER: **Albert Pujols** has hit 33 homers at PNC Park, 14th-most in stadium history, most all-time among visiting players, most among active Pirates, and his most at any ballpark (Minute Maid Park) ... Pujols ranks 1st in PNC Park history (2001-present) in batting (.375), OBP (.448), slugging (.724), and OPS (1.172), while leading all visiting players in hits (144), doubles (33), homers, RBI (95), runs scored (87), extra-base hits (67), and total bases (278).

ROAD WARRIORS: Winners of nine of its last 13 road games (August 19-present), St. Louis is 35-34 (.507) away from Busch Stadium this season and one of 12 MLB teams with a winning road record ... The last time the Cardinals had a losing record away from St. Louis was 2017 (39-42, .481).

AHOY, MATEY!: With a win today, St. Louis will have won the season series over Pittsburgh for the 9th straight season (2014-22) and 20th time in the last 23 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013). ... St. Louis is 28-6 (.824) in its last 34 games in the city of Pittsburgh since May 26, 2018, and its .592 overall win pct (109-75) at PNC Park over that timespan is 3rd-best among annual NL visitors behind the Dodgers (.622, 46-28) and Padres (.618, 42-26).

TOMMY BOY: **Tommy Edman** is hitting .413/.438/.826 (19-46) over his career-high-tying 12-game hitting streak, longest active in MLB ... The switch-hitter has excelled in September with 107 hits and 59 runs since his 2019 debut, ranking 2nd and 6th over that period.

CORE' VALUES: Hitting safely in 16 of his last 19 games (.423/.431/.606, 30-71) with eight multiple-hit efforts, **Corey Dickerson** is batting .404 (40-99) since the All-Star Break, highest in MLB this season and currently the 8th-best single-season mark after the Break in MLB single-season history (1957 Red Sox **Ted Williams** is 1st at .453).

AFTER THE BREAK: The Cardinals lead MLB in most homers (78) since the All-Star Break break while also allowing the fewest long balls in MLB (36) ... **Paul Goldschmidt** is 2nd in MLB (15), while **Albert Pujols** ranks T-10th (11), and **Nolan Arenado** ranks T14th (10).

GOLDY NOMINATED FOR 2022 ROBERTO CLEMENTE AWARD: For the seventh time in his career, **Paul Goldschmidt** has been named his team's nominee for the prestigious Roberto Clemente Award, the most-prominent individual player award bestowed by MLB and annual recognition of a player who best represents the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field ... Previous Cardinals to win the Roberto Clemente Award include **Adam Wainwright** (2020), **Yadier Molina** (2018), **Carlos Beltrán** (2013), **Albert Pujols** (2008), **Ozzie Smith** (1995), and **Lou Brock** (1975), the most of any MLB Club.

A PAIR BEYOND COMPARE: On Thursday, Sept. 8, **Adam Wainwright** and **Yadier Molina** tied the all-time MLB record of 324 starts as batterymates last Thursday, previously established by the Detroit Tigers duo of **Mickey Lolich** and **Bill Freehan** (1963-75) who made their 324th and final start together exactly 47 years prior on Sept. 8, 1975 vs. New York Yankees ... Waino and Yadi are projected to break the record with their next start on Wednesday vs. Milwaukee.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004 at PNC Park), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), and **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park) made MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Andrew Knizner's uncle, **Matt Knizner**, was a quarterback at Penn State Univ. and was on the 1986 National Championship Nittany Lion squad.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (A).

Corey Dickerson played parts of two seasons in Pittsburgh (2018-19) ... Won a 2018 Rawlings Gold Glove award in left field.

Mike Maddux signed with Pittsburgh in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before released in May.

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale, Ill... caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956... played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

José Quintana signed with Pittsburgh before the season, while **Chris Stratton** pitched parts of four seasons with the Pirates (2019-22)...the duo was traded to St. Louis for **Malcom Nunez** and **Johan Oviedo** (Aug. 2, 2022).

Tyler Heineman played in 21 games for Memphis (AAA) last season.

Johan Oviedo signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22)
