FLIGHT PATTERN: After going 7-1 over its recent eight-game road trip through Cincinnati (3-1) and Pittsburgh (4-0), the Cardinals return home to Busch Stadium tonight to open a six-game homestand against the Houston Astros (July 26-28) and Chicago Cubs (July 30-August 1)...Over the next 11 games, the Cardinals face off against opponents with combined records of 77 games over .500, all of which currently either share a division lead or hold a wild card spot. Each opponent sports a win percentage in the top 11 in MLB this season: Astros (.635, 3rd); Cubs (.539, 11th); Athletics (.558, 7th); Dodgers (.644, 2nd).

RED-HOT REDBIRDS: Winners of five in a row, eight out of nine, 11 of 13, and 15 of their last 21, the Cardinals enter today tied with Chicago for 1st place in the National League Central, sharing the division lead for the first time since the morning of May 7... St. Louis is eight games over .500 entering play today for first time since May 3 (20-12 record)...Since the All-Star break (July 11-present), St. Louis and San Francisco co-lead MLB with 11 wins.

SOARING: The Cardinals five-game win streak (July 21-present) is the longest active in MLB and ties their season-best streak for the fourth time (April 7-11, April 20-24, & April 27-May 1). The last time St. Louis won six in a row was part of an eight-game win streak last season (August 7-15).

REJUVENATING JULY: St. Louis (14-6, .700) trails only San Francisco (16-4, .800) among NL teams in July win pct. and wins. The Cardinals' .700 win pct. is currently their 8th-best in July in club history and best since the 2004 squad (20-5, .800) that reached the World Series.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: St. Louis is 187-181 all-time in Interleague play, with a .508 win pct. that trails only New York (.510) among National League clubs...The Cardinals are 6-7 vs. the American League this season, and have finished with a winning Interleague record 13 times in 22 seasons (since 1997).

CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL: The Cardinals have homered in a season-high nine straight games (July 17-present), with 20 home runs hit by 10 different Cardinals, (five by both **Paul Goldschmidt** and **Paul DeJong**). The last time St. Louis went yard in 10 in a row was during a 16-game homer streak last season (August 7-24).

GOLD RUSH: **Paul Goldschmidt** hit his team-leading 22nd home run of the season yesterday and has gone yard in a career-high four straight games. The last Cardinal to homer in five consecutive was **Matt Carpenter**, who homered in six straight (July 14-21, 2018) to tie the franchise record held by **Mark McGwire** (Sept. 27, 1997-April 4, 1998). In 21 games this month (20 with an at-bat), Goldschmidt has established new July career highs in homers (8), RBI (22, leads NL), slugging (.671) and OPS (1.026).

CARPENTER UPDATE: **Matt Carpenter's** 20-day injury rehabilitation assignment (back spasms and right foot contusion) moves from the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) to the Springfield Cardinals (AA) tonight. In two games with Memphis (July 23-24), the three-time NL All-Star has gone 0-for-6 with three strikeouts, one walk and one run scored, while appearing defensively in 13.0 innings at third base.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (July 26, 2004): The MV3 trio of **Albert Pujols**, **Jim Edmonds**, and **Scott Rolen** all homer as the Cardinals erase an early 3-0 deficit and defeat the Reds 9-6 in 11 innings at Great American Ball Park.

HOUSTON CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt graduated from The Woodlands (Tex.) High School...grew up a fan of the Astros' **Jeff Bagwell** and **Craig Biggio**...as a high school senior, was seated in the center field upper deck at Minute Maid Park when **Albert Pujols** hit the famous home run off Astros closer **Brad Lidge** in Game 5 of the 2005 NLCS...played college baseball at Texas State University (2007-09) in San Marcos, Tex. where he left as the school's all-time leader in home runs (36) and RBI (178)...his No. 37 was retired in Feb. 2015, becoming the first TSU baseball player to have his jersey retired.

Paul Goldschmidt and **Andrew Miller** were teammates with **Alex Bregman** on the gold-winning USA squad in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Giovanni Gallegos made his Major League debut (with the Yankees) against Houston on May 12, 2017 at Yankee Stadium...his first strikeout victim was Houston's Brian McCann (swinging) on May 14, 2017.

Daniel Ponce de Leon pitched his junior season (2013) at the University of Houston...selected by the Cubs in the MLB 2013 Draft, but failed his physical due to concerns about the ulnar nerve placement in his right elbow...later ruled ineligible by the NCAA to return to Houston and transferred to Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in Daytona Beach, Fla. for his senior season (2014).

Dexter Fowler played in 116 games with Houston in 2014...became an Astro via trade with Colorado, exchanged for outfielder **Brandon Barnes** and pitcher **Jordan Lyles** (Dec. 3, 2013).

Adam Wainwright's first MLB start was April 6, 2007 at Houston, earning a 4-2 win (7.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 3 BB, 4 K).

Hitting Coach **Jeff Albert** worked six seasons in the Astros organization (2013-18), serving as a Roving Hitting Instructor (2013), Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2014-17) and Houston's Second Hitting Coach (2018).

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** pitched in 21 games during his final professional season with the Astros in 2000...coached three seasons as the pitching coach for Houston's AA-Round Rock (2000-02)...Round Rock made the Texas League playoffs all three seasons in which he was pitching coach and won the 2000 league championship (2000).

First Base Coach **Stubby Clapp** worked five seasons (2007-12) in the Astros organization, serving as hitting coach for A-Lexington for three seasons (2007-09), one season as hitting coach for Double-A Corpus Christi (2010), and taking on his first managerial role with short-season Tri-City for two seasons (2011-12)...played college baseball at Texas Tech University.

Aledmys Díaz signed with the Cardinals as a free agent and played two seasons with St. Louis (2016-17)...in 2016, became the first Cardinals rookie to make the All-Star team since **Albert Pujols** (2001)...traded by St. Louis to Toronto for outfielder **J.B. Woodman** (Dec. 1, 2017).

Astros Pitching Coach **Brent Strom** spent six seasons (2008-13) with the Cardinals organization, serving as minor league pitching instructor (2008-11) and pitching coordinator (2012-13).

Astros bench coach **Joe Espada** played in eight games for the Triple-A Memphis Redbirds in 2003.

Astros President of Baseball Operations and GM **Jeff Luhnow** spent eight seasons with the Cardinals as VP of Baseball Development (2003-05), VP of Player Procurement (2005), and VP of Scouting and Player Development (2006-11). During his time with the Cardinals, oversaw scouting, international, and player development that brought in many players instrumental to the 2011 World Series victory, the 2012 NLCS team and 2013 World Series team...of the 25 players on the Cardinals' 2013 World Series roster, 16 were drafted while he oversaw player development and scouting.

Astros owner **Jim Crane** was born in St. Louis and grew up a Cardinals fan in nearby Dellwood...caddied for members of the Cardinals team at local golf clubs and parked cars for patrons at Cardinals games...graduated from Lutheran High School North in St. Louis County (1972)...played college baseball at Central Missouri State University (1973-76)...inducted in the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame (2017) and St. Louis Sports Hall of Fame (2018)...received the Jack Buck Award from the Missouri Athletic Club in St. Louis (2018).

Astros Special Assistant to the GM, People Operations & Major League Translator **Oz Ocampo** began his career with the Cardinals in 2005 as their Dominican academy administrator and coordinator of Latin American scouting.

Astros Manager, Baseball Administration **Alexandra Nobao** worked two seasons as a Cardinals Spanish Interpreter (2016-17).

Astros Community Outreach Executive **José Cruz** played five seasons with St. Louis (1970-74), where he made his MLB debut...purchased by the Astros (Oct. 24, 1974).

- Makes his 21st start of the season and his 54th career start (55th appearance).
- Has allowed just 2 runs on 11 hits (1 HR) in last three starts covering 18.1 IP (0.98 ERA).
- Since April 22, ranks 5th among National League starting pitchers in average against (.198) and 6th in Hits/9 IP (6.42).
- Has not had a winning decision over his last 11 starts (since May 14 at Atlanta) and has lost a career-high 3-straight decisions.
- Last win at Busch Stadium came on April 28 vs. CIN. Is winless in last six home starts.
- Has received two runs of support or less in 13 of 20 starts this season. His 3.99 run support average is the 7th lowest in the National League.
- Is 1-2, 5.59 ERA (37.0 IP/23 ER) in 7 career Interleague games, allowing .819 OPS.

- Threw 86 pitches, striking out seven in 4.1 IP last Sun. (7/21) at CIN. Was pulled in the 5th with the bases loaded and took ND in the Cardinals 3-1 win.

- In final game before All-Star break (7/7), carried a no-hitter for 6.1 IP before allowing Evan Longoria one out solo HR in the 7th that was game's only tally in 1-0 loss at San Francisco. In a game that lasted just 2:19, Flaherty allowed only two hits and one walk.
- Surrendered 9 of his season total 20 home runs in June, co-leading NL pitchers (Robbie Ray) during the month and most in June by a Cardinal since Lance Lynn (9, 2017).
- Pitching with heavy heart following the loss of friend Tyler Skaggs, made his first career appearance against the Mariners and at T-Mobile Park on 7/2. Allowed four runs in 4.2 innings in a 5-4 Cardinals loss. Threw 39 of his 103 pitches in the second inning.
- Matched his season high with 7.0 IP vs. MIA (6/18) allowing three runs, but took the loss (6-0), marking the 4th game this season he received zero runs of support.
