UNDER REVIEW: Orioles manager Brandon Hyde challenged the call of SS Wander Franco safe at home in the top of the 13th inning...Upon further review, the call on the field was overturned.

ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles defeated the Rays by a score of 8-6 in 13 innings, improving to 16-24 and 11-10 at home... **2B Rougned Odor** hit a two-run, walk-off home run...Baltimore won consecutive games via walk-off homer for the first time since August 14-15, 2015, vs. Oakland (Manny Machado, 2-run in the 13th inning on 8/14; Chris Davis, solo in the 9th inning on 8/15)...The O's walked off their opponent in back-to-back games for the first time since June 6-7, 2017, vs. Pittsburgh (Mark Trumbo, 1B on 6/6; Trey Mancini, HR on 6/7)...Have won six of their last 10 games at Oriole Park...Snapped a 15-game losing streak against Tampa Bay...Are 4-1 in games tied after the seventh inning...Marked the ninth time this season at least three Orioles have recorded multiple hits in a game...Improve to 3-0 in extra innings this season.
- RHP Tyler Wells received a no decision...Pitched 4.2 innings and gave up three runs on two hits with a pair of walks...Matched a season-high with four strikeouts (3x, last: 5/2 vs. MIN)...Snapped a streak of five consecutive games without allowing a walk...Threw 79 pitches, 44 strikes.
- LHP Nick Vespi made his MLB debut in the 12th inning and earned the win; pitched 2.0 innings and struck out three with one intentional walk...Marked the fourth time in franchise history (since 1954) an Orioles pitcher has debuted in the 12th inning or later; second time at home and first at Oriole Park.
- **2B Rougned Odor** (1-for-2, HR, 2 RBI, R) hit his third career walk-off home run and first since August 3, 2019, vs. Detroit while with the Texas Rangers...Marked his sixth career walk-off plate appearance.
- DH Trey Mancini (2-for-4, RBI, BB) extended his season-long on-base streak to 14 games since May 8 (G1) vs. Kansas City; is batting .370 (20-for-54) with two home runs and six RBI during that span.
- CF Cedric Mullins (2-for-5, R, BB) recorded his 10th multi-hit game of the season...Is batting .313 (26-for-83) with three home runs and eight RBI since April 30; entering play today his 24 hits ranked sixth in MLB over that span...His single in the fifth inning was his 300th career hit.

RAYS NOTES

- The Rays fell to the Orioles by a score of 8-6, dropping to 23-16 and 10-7 on the road...Were walked off for the second time this season (also: 5/8 at SEA)...Had their 15-game win streak against Baltimore snapped; was the longest winning streak against a single opponent in club history...Have lost four of their last five road games.
- LHP Jalen Beeks did not factor in the decision...Pitched 2.0 scoreless innings with one hit, one walk, and one strikeout...Made his first start since August 14, 2019, at San Diego...Nine of his 10 outings this year have been scoreless...Threw 19 pitches, 13 strikes.
- C Mike Zunino (1-for-3, HR, 3 RBI, R) hit his first home run since May 5 at Seattle...Six of his last 10 hits since April 29 have been for extra bases (2-2B, 4 HR).
- LF Randy Arozarena (4-for-5, R, BB) matched a career-high with four hits (4x, last: 5/6/22 at SEA)...Reached base five times for the second time in his career (also: 10/2/21 at NYY)...Is batting .404 (36-for-89) with nine home runs and 22 RBI in 22 career games against Baltimore.
- CF Kevin Kiermaier (3-for-6, 2B, RBI) matched a season-high with three hits (also: 5/17 vs. DET).
