LOS ANGELES ANGELS (12-23) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (17-19)

May 7, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #37/HOME #17

LHP PATRICK SANDOVAL (1-5, 5.91 ERA) vs. RHP QUINN PRIESTER (0-2, 3.31 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...opened their three-game series with the Angels with a 4-1 win last night...Have won three straight games for the first time since 4/6-8...Began the year 9-2 before losing 17 of 22 games between 4/9 and 5/3...Have gone 14-1 when scoring at least four runs in a game this season (their only loss came on April 25 against Milwaukee)... Have gone 4-0 in extra innings this season, which is tied for the second-wins in extra frames in MLB (Cleveland leads with five)... It is Pittsburgh's longest win streak in extra-innings games to begin a season since 2012 (also 4-0)...The last start to a season with a longer streak was 1960 (7-0).

GO THE DISTANCE: Mitch Keller threw a career-high 109 pitches while tossing the second complete game of his career last night against the Angels...Prior to last night, Keller's other complete game came on May 8, 2023, against the Rockies at PNC Park...Keller is now one of seven pitchers in MLB to toss a complete game this season.

FAST TIMES AT PNC PARK: Last night's 5-1 win was completed in 1 hour and 55 minutes, which was the fastest time of game this year for the Pirates and the third-fastest for a nine inning game in MLB this year...The only two times this season in MLB that a game was completed faster came on April 17 when the Guardians and Red Sox wrapped up in 1 hour and 49 minutes, and on April 23 when the Marlins and Braves played a 1 hour and 54 minute game...Pittsburgh's average 9.0 inning game time this season at PNC Park is 2 hours and 28 minutes...Special thanks to the Elias Sports Bureau.

ON Q: Quinn Priester will make his fourth start of the season tonight after being promoted from Triple-A Indianapolis on April 19...The 23-year-old Priester went 1-1 with a 3.95 ERA (13.2ip/6er), .20 strikeouts and .226 batting average against in three starts this season with Indianapolis...He entered this season rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh's No. 8 prospect... The Pirates drafted Priester out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School with the 18th overall selection in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft...He made his big league debut last year on July 17 against Cleveland and suffered the loss before winning each of his next two starts.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Quinn Priester was charged with his second loss of the season in his last start Wednesday at Oakland after the Pirates were shut out 4-0 by the Athletics...The Pirates have not scored a run when Priester has been in the game in each of his first three starts... Priester allowed five runs in 4.1 innings in his season debut with the Bucs on April 19 against the Red Sox...Since then he has given up a total of three runs in 12.0 innings in his last two starts.

LET'S GO REYNOLDS: Bryan Reynolds has recorded back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since September 9-10 of last season against the Braves...Reynolds is also hitting at a .364 clip with a 1.042 OPS against left-handed pitchers this season...His .364 average against southpaws is tied for the fifth-highest among all players in the National League.

A GRAND OLD TIME: Edward Olivares hit the first grand slam of his career with his 424-foot blast off Angels starter Tyler Anderson last night...It was Pittsburgh's second slam of the season (also Jack Suwinski on April 14), which matched the team's total from 2023.

EASY AS 1,2,3: The Pirates have won three straight games for the first time since April 6-8 (also three games)...Pittsburgh opened the 2024 campaign by winning each of their first five games, which marked the first time the team began a season 5-0 since 1983.

CALL TO THE PEN: Pittsburgh's bullpen has recorded a 1.98 ERA (50.0ip/11er), 56 strikeouts and .190 batting average against dating back to April 20...The bullpen's 1.98 ERA in that time is the third-lowest in all of MLB behind the Dodgers (1.35) and Yankees (1.58)...Pittsburgh's .192 batting average against in that time is also the seventh-lowest in MLB among all bullpens.

CLOSING IN ON OROSCO: Aroldis Chapman comes into today with 1168 career strikeouts, which is just one shy of tying Jesse Orosco for the second-most all-time among left-handed relievers (Billy Wagner leads with 1196)...Chapman also enters today with the third-lowest batting average against (.132) among NL relievers behind Erik Miller (.127) and Kyle Finnegan (.128).

David Bednar struck out the side in the bottom of the ninth inning to earn his fourth save of the season.
