SNAKEBITES

ALMOST 2.4 MILLION: The D-backs’ season home attendance of 2,393,773 is back-to-back seasons of 2.3+ million as well as the largest home attendance since 2008, fourth largest since 2003 and ninth all-time: 1998 (3,604,237), 2002 (3,198,975), 1999 (3,015,948), 2000 (2,942,251), 2003 (2,805,542), 2001 (2,735,821), 2004 (2,519,560) and 2008 (2,509,058).

RACE AGAINST CANCER 5K THIS SUNDAY: The D-backs’ 12th annual Race Against Cancer 5K presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute and benefiting cancer research and patient care is this Sunday at Chase Field.

NL WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs — who trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race on August 1 — are in fifth place, 2.0 games behind the third-place Mets and 1.0 game behind the fourth-place Reds.

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs are 8-5 in their last 13 games.

- Zac Gallen** tossed 6.0 with 1 unearned run (5 H, 1 BB, 9 K) in a 6-3 win @ Padres on July 7...in his last 6 starts vs. Padres since 2023 (team is 6-0), is 4-0 with a 2.92 ERA (11 R-9 ER in 37.2 IP), an opponent .197 AVG (27-for-137)/.568 OPS, 8 walks and 40 strikeouts.
- Geraldo Perdomo’s** 14-game on-base streak is the third-longest streak of his career behind a pair of 15-gamers (April 3-19, 2025; July 29-Aug. 14, 2025)... during his current 14-gamer, is hitting .373 (19-for-51)/1.108 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 7 RBI, 10 walks (7 K) and 3 hit by pitches.
- Corbin Carroll** has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 games at a .333 clip (13-for-39)/.952 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 8 RBI, 6 walks and 4 stolen bases.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 8-0 vs. Dodgers.

- Ketel Marte** had a double, the team’s lone extra-base hit.
- Blaze Alexander** had a single and a walk.
- Austin Pope** made his Major League debut with 2.0 scoreless innings (2 H, 1 BB, 1 K).
- Taylor Rashi** tossed 3.0 shutout frames with 6 strikeouts (1 H, 1 BB).

HOME WRAP-UP: The D-backs’ 43-38 (.531) home record tied for the fourth-best mark since 2017 [not including 2020] with 2023, behind 2017 (52-29, .642), 2019 (44-37, .543), 2024 (44-37, .543).

- The team has had winning seasons at home in 6 of 9 seasons since 2017.

STIFF COMPETITION: The D-backs’ last 26 games (16-10) have included all 3 NL division winners (@ Brewers, @ Dodgers, vs. Phillies, vs. Dodgers), an AL Wild Card candidate (vs. Red Sox) and 2 teams in the thick of the Wild Card Race at the time (vs. Rangers, @ Giants, vs. Giants).

START ME UP: The D-backs starting rotation is among the best in the Majors since Aug. 27 ranking tied for first with 17 quality starts, tied for third with 12 starter wins, fourth with a 2.86 ERA, fifth with 51 runs allowed and 148.0 innings and sixth with an opponent .648 OPS.

VS. PADRES: The D-backs are 5-5 vs. Padres (2-2 on road).

- Geraldo Perdomo** has hit safely in 5 straight vs. Padres (.316 AVG, 6-for-19, 1.066 OPS, 3 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI, 4 BB).
- Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 6 straight vs. Padres (.370 OBP, 5 H, 5 BB).
- Corbin Carroll** has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 games vs. Padres (.286 AVG, 8-for-28, .955 OPS, 2 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, 2 BB).

1-2-3-WHEEEEEEE: Over the last 9 games, since Sept. 15, **Geraldo Perdomo**, **Ketel Marte** and **Corbin Carroll** are hitting a combined .336 (37-for-110)/.940 OPS with 12 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 16 RBI, 10 walks (18 K), 3 hit by pitches and 4 stolen bases..Carroll and Perdomo have hit safely in 8 of 9 games and Marte has hit safely in 7 of 9 games.

CUATRO’S STRONG FINISH: **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 games at a .361 clip (13-for-36)/.962 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 home run, 5 RBI and 1 hit by pitch.

- Last season, reached base safely in 9 of his final 10 games, from Sept. 19-29 (.324 AVG, 11-for-34, 1.213 OPS, 2 2B, 4 HR, 8 RBI, 9 BB-6 K.
- In 2023, reached base safely in 8 of his final 10 games, from Sept. 17-30 (.333 AVG, 11-for-33, 1.075 OPS, 1 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI, 7 BB-7 K).

VETERAN LEADERSHIP: **James McCann** has hit safely in 6 of his last 8 games (.310 AVG, 9-for-29, .920 OPS, 2 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 1 HBP).

- Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 road games (.308 AVG, 8-for-26, .731 OPS, 1 HR, 6 RBI).
- From Sept. 2-20, hit safely in 10 of 11 games (.343 AVG, 12-for-35, .780 OPS, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 1 BB).

BACKSTOPS: **Gabriel Moreno** had a career-high 13 game on-base streak from Sept. 7 through Wednesday, hitting .354 (17-for-48)/.978 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 10 walks (6 K).

- Backstops **Gabriel Moreno** (88 PA), **James McCann** (38 PA) and **Adrian Del Castillo** (3 PA), in the last 31 games since Aug. 22, are hitting .328 (38-for-116)/.917 OPS with 6 doubles, 6 homers, 27 RBI, 10 walks (23 K), 1 hit by pitch and 6 stolen bases (1 CS).

YEAR OF THE SNAKE: **Geraldo Perdomo’s** 6.7 bWAR (Baseball-Reference.com) leads NL position players and is fifth in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (9.2), Cal Raleigh/SEA (7.2), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (7.0) and Julio Rodríguez/SEA (6.8) behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (7.3) and ahead of Trea Turner/PHI (6.7) and Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.5).

- Perdomo’s** 6.9 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (7.3) and ahead of Trea Turner/PHI (6.7) and Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.5).

1 OF 1: **Corbin Carroll** (.886 OPS, 107 R, 146 H, 32 2B, 17 3B, 31 HR, 84 RBI, 65 BB, 32 SB) is the only player in Major League history with a season with an .850+ OPS, 100+ runs scored, 140+ hits, 30+ doubles, 15+ triples, 30+ home runs, 80+ RBI, 60+ walks and 30+ stolen bases.

- Lowering the qualifiers to 10+ triples, Carroll is 1 of 2 players all-time to reach those marks with Ken Williams/St. Louis Browns (1922).

1 OF 10: **Corbin Carroll** (32 2B, 17 3B, 31 HR) is the 10th player (12th time) in Major League history to reach 30+ doubles, 15+ triples and 30+ homers in a season:

Babe Ruth (1921), Lou Gehrig (1927), Jim Bottomley (1928), Lou Gehrig (1930), Al Simmons (1930), Lou Gehrig (1931), Chuck Klein (1932), Hank Greenberg (1935), Joe DiMaggio (1937), Stan Musial (1948), Jimmy Rollins (2007), **Corbin Carroll (2025)**

EXTRA BASES: **Corbin Carroll’s** 80 extra-base hits are tied for second most in a season in club history with Luis Gonzalez (2000), behind Gonzalez in 2001 (100 XBH).

THE RESURGENCE: Since August 1, the D-backs’ 29-21 (.580) record is third in the NL and sixth in the Majors: Mariners (32-17, .653), Phillies (33-18, .647), Brewers (32-19, .627), Guardians (32-19, .627), Yankees (31-19, .620), **D-backs (29-21, .580).**

- The D-backs’ 12-9 record in September is tied for seventh in the Majors with the Athletics behind the Mariners (17-5), Guardians (18-6), Yankees (15-7), Phillies (15-7), Orioles (14-8) and Braves (13-9).
- The D-backs’ 17-12 mark in August was fourth in the Majors to the Brewers (21-9), Phillies (18-11) and Red Sox (17-11).

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (9-8, 4.91)

- In his last start, tossed 6.0 scoreless innings (6 H, 3 BB, 5 K) in a 9-2 win vs. Phillies on Sept. 21.
- In his last 2 road starts, both wins, has tossed 12.1 shutout frames (6 H, 6 BB, 10 K)...in his last 5 road starts (3 quality), is 4-1 with a 2.70 ERA (8 ER in 26.2 IP).
- Fourth career start vs. Padres (1-1, 2.30 ERA).

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: Seventh season with the D-backs.

- D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona BBWAA the last 3 seasons (2022-24) and 4 of the last 5 seasons (2020, '22-'24).
- 2023 NL All-Star starting pitcher.
- Finished in Top 5 in NL Cy Young Voting in 2023 (3rd) and 2022 (5th).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Has quality starts in 8 of his last 10 starts, going 6-2 with a 2.82 ERA (19 ER in 60.2 IP), opponent .197 AVG (44-for-223)/.599 OPS, 16 walks and 51 strikeouts.

- Among NL starting pitchers since July 1, his 90.2 innings are tied for third with Nick Pivetta/SD, behind Cristopher Sánchez/PHI (102.2 IP) and Shota Imanaga/CHC (95.0).
- Has tossed 6.0+ innings in a career-high-tying 7 straight starts (also: July 20-Aug. 22, 2023), 11 of his last 12 starts and 13 of his last 15 starts.
- His 65 wins are third in franchise history, ahead of Merrill Kelly (62) and behind Brandon Webb (87) and Randy Johnson (118).

LAST START: Tossed his second straight quality start on Sept. 20 vs. Philies, allowing 3 runs on 4 hits and 2 walks with 9 strikeouts over 7.0 innings.

- His 9 strikeouts were his most in a game since 9 on July 7 @ Padres.
- His 9 strikeouts tied for this third most in a game this season with 9 strikeouts on July 7 @ Padres, behind 10 strikeouts on July 1 vs. Giants and 13 strikeouts on April 2 @ Yankees.
- Eclipsed 1000.0 career innings after the fourth inning...became the fourth starting pitcher who debuted in 2019 to reach 1,000.0+ career innings, joining Logan Webb/SF, Dylan Cease/SD and Merrill Kelly/AZ-TEX.

VS. PADRES: 15th career start, seventh @ Petco Park.

- Has won 4 of his last 5 starts, going 4-0 with a 1.42 ERA (6 R-5 ER in 31.2 IP), opponent .179 AVG (20-for-112), 0.85 WHIP, 7 walks and 37 strikeouts.

1,000TH K AS A D-BACK: Became the third D-backs pitcher to reach 1,000 strikeouts...his 1,014 strikeouts currently rank third in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (2,077) and Brandon Webb (1,065).

- Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on July 21 vs. Astros in the fourth inning (Brice Matthews swinging).
- Second pitcher to debut in 2019 and reach 1,000+ career strikeouts, joining Dylan Cease (source: Elias Sports Bureau).
- Among all pitchers since 2019, his 1,057 strikeouts are 11th...Top 3 are Zack Wheeler/PHI (1,289), Aaron Nola/PHI (1,270) and Gerritt Cole/NYY (1,241)...teammate Corbin Burnes/AZ (1,079) is 10th.

10+ WINS: Is 1 of 4 D-backs to have 4+ consecutive 10+-win seasons with Randy Johnson (1999-2002), Brandon Webb (2005-08) and Zack Greinke (2016-19).

5.0+ INNINGS: Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 29 straight starts (since April 13), the second-longest active streak in the Majors this season, behind Bryan Woo/SEA (30 games) and ahead of Jacob deGrom/TEX (27).

- The 29 games are tied with Merrill Kelly (29 games from April 6-Sept. 30, 2023) for the sixth-longest streak in franchise history.
- The franchise record is 35 straight games by Randy Johnson (4x - April 5-Sept. 30, 1999, April 3-Oct. 2, 2001, April 1-Sept. 26, 2002 and April 6-Oct. 2, 2004) and Curt Schilling (April 2-Sept. 5, 2022) followed by Brandon Webb with 34 games (April 2-Sept. 28, 2007), 33 games (April 6-Oct. 2, 2005) and 32 games (April 3-Sept. 26, 2006) and Joe Saunders with 31 games (April 16-Sept. 28, 2011).

VS. NL WEST: Has won 6 of his last 7 starts vs. NL West opponents...in those starts, has a 3.16 ERA (17 R-15 ER in 42.2 IP) with 12 walks and 47 strikeouts.

- In 10 starts in 2025, has gone 6-2 (team is 7-3) with a 4.37 ERA (31 R-29 ER in 59.2 IP) and 63 strikeouts.
- In 30 starts from 2022-24 vs. NL West went 13-4 with a 3.37 ERA (69 R-66 ER in 176.1 IP), an opponent .212 AVG (137-for-645)/.630 OPS, 50 walks and 201 strikeouts.

ON THE ROAD: The D-backs are 3-1 in his last 4 road starts (2 quality)...is 2-1 with a 3.80 ERA (10 ER in 23.2 IP), opponent .233 AVG (21-for-90), 8 walks and 15 strikeouts.

VS. RIGHTIES: In his last 11 starts, is holding righties to a .187 AVG (23-for-123)/.580 OPS with 9 walks and 32 strikeouts.

VS. LEFTIES: In his last 7 starts, is holding lefties to a .157 AVG (13-for-83)/.511 OPS with 7 walks and 22 strikeouts.

INNING BREAKDOWN: In his last 8 starts, in innings 3-6, has a 2.31 ERA (9 ER in 35.0 IP) with an opponent .154 AVG (19-for-123)/.519 OPS, 5 walks and 28 strikeouts.

RUNNERS ON BASE: In his last 7 starts with runners on base, has held opponents to a .133 AVG (6-for-45)/.500 OPS with 5 walks and 17 strikeouts.

AUGUST RECAP: In August, the D-backs went 4-2 in his 6 starts (5 quality), going 3-1 with a 2.57 ERA (10 ER in 35.0 IP), an opponent .220 AVG (29-for-132)/.626 OPS, 9 walks and 28 strikeouts.

- Selected from Triple-A Reno on Sept. 18.
- Went 3-2 with 7 saves, a 3.07 ERA (27 R-20 ER in 58.2 IP), opponent .216 AVG (46-for-213), 16 walks and 70 strikeouts over 53 games between Triple-A Reno (8 G), Double-A Amarillo (34 G) and High-A Hillsboro (11 G).
- First call-up from the D-backs’ 2023 draft class...signed as a sixth-round selection in 2023 out of the University of Florida.

- Earned a win in relief on Aug. 22 and made the start for the D-backs on Aug. 23, marking the second time in franchise history that a relief pitcher earned a win and made a start in consecutive games (last: Joe Mantipty, June 30-July 2).
- Is scoreless in 18 of his last 22 outings, going 3-2 with a 1.86 ERA (4 ER in 19.1 IP), an opponent .169 AVG (11-for-65) and 0.83 WHIP (11 H, 5 BB) and 11 strikeouts.
- Vs. lefties since Aug. 1, is holding opponents to a .235 AVG (4-for-17) with 0 walks and 2 strikeouts.
- Has allowed just 2 home runs in his last 23 games (79 BF).
- His 48.4 ground ball percentage ranks seventh by a D-backs relievers in a season since 2021 (min. 50 G).

- Has held opponent scoreless in 13 of his last 20 games, since Aug. 1, with a 3.24 ERA (11 R-9 ER in 25.0 IP), an opponent .163 AVG (14-for-86), 3 walks and 17 strikeouts.
- On Sept. 20 vs. Phillies, became the 17th different D-backs player to record a save in 2025, extending their MLB record.
- Has just 5 walks in his last 29 games (138 BF).
- In his last 19 games vs. righties (with a plate appearance), has an opponent .190 AVG (8-for-42) with 1 walk and 7 strikeouts.
- Made his 100th career relief outing on Aug. 3 @ Athletics (0 ER in 1.0 IP)...has 5 career starts (3 in 2020 and 2 in 2021).
- Made his D-backs debut on June 29 vs. Marlins (0 ER in 1.1 IP, 6 P)...was his first MLB appearance since Aug. 1, 2024 with the Rockies.

Prev. Homestand: 5 G; 1 R-0 ER/5.0 IP, 6 K

- In his last 9 games (41 BF), has a 1.74 ERA (4 R-2 ER in 10.1 IP) with 2 walks and 13 strikeouts.
- His 99.8 mph sinker to Willy Adames in the fifth inning on Sept. 8 @ Giants was the hardest thrown pitch by a D-backs left-hander since detailed data started being recorded in 2008...prior to Garcia, the hardest thrown pitch recorded by a lefty was a 98.7 mph four-seamer from Robbie Ray on Sept. 7, 2016.
- Set career highs in innings (2.2) and strikeouts (3) in his scoreless appearance on Aug. 31 @ Dodgers.
- Recalled from Triple-A Reno on Aug. 29...in 6 outings, was 1-1 with a 3.27 ERA (5 R-4 ER in 11.0 IP).
