**RAYS REPORT**—The Rays continue their final road trip before the All-Star break today at Comerica Park, going 1-2 so far against the Twins (1-2), Tigers (3G) and Red Sox (4G)...have lost six of their last nine games, but have still won 13 of 22, 19 of 31, 28 of 43 and 40 of their last 67 following a 9-14 start...are 3-4-1 in their last eight series after going 7-1-1 in their previous nine (May 9–June 8)...have the third-best record in the majors since May 20 (28-15), trailing the Astros (30-13) and Blue Jays (30-14)...are fourth in the AL/sixth in MLB in run differential (+69)...are tied for second in the AL East, 3.0 GB the first-place Blue Jays...spent 19 days within 2.5 games from June 16–July 4, including three within a half-game, but never claimed first...have been in second or third for the last 44 days...on the season, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 28 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays salvaged their three-game series in Minnesota with a 7-5, 10-inning win yesterday afternoon...after being recalled from Triple-A Durham prior to the game, **Joe Boyle** did not allow an earned run over five innings of relief.
- ★ **Brandon Lowe** departed in the 3rd inning (left side soreness) after 1 AB, ending his hitting streak at 20 games, tied with **Yandy Diaz** (June 7-28, 2024) for longest in club history...he was making his first career start on his birthday.
- ★ Over their last 14 games, the Rays rotation has recorded a 3.19 ERA (73.1IP, 26ER) while the bullpen has a 7.46 ERA (50.2IP, 42ER)...the pen has yielded multiple runs in four straight and seven of the last nine games.
- ★ The Rays have dropped three consecutive series for the first time since Aug. 23–Sept. 1, 2024...they have not lost four in a row since June 18–July 4, 2024 (six straight).
- ★ The Rays are 20-16 (.568) on the road, second in the majors behind the Tigers (27-20/.574)...having played the most home games (53) and fewest road games (37) to this point, 14 of 20, 26 of 35 and 32 of their next 46 games will come on the road.
- ★ Tampa Bay has lost three straight series openers on the heels of a 10-game winning streak...the club's 17-12 record in openers ranks third in the AL behind the Tigers (23-6) and Astros (18-11).

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Earlier today, the Rays recalled **RHP Mason Englert** from Triple-A Durham and optioned **LHP Mason Montgomery** to Durham...this marks Englert's third stint with the Rays, joining Opening Day–May 9 and June 10-16...the right-hander began his major league career with the Tigers from 2023-24 after they selected him in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft from the Rangers.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR**—Yesterday, **Jonathan Aranda** and **Brandon Lowe** were named the Rays representatives at the 2025 MLB All-Star Game in Atlanta...this marks Aranda's first career selection—he is the fourth Rays first basemen to earn an All-Star nod, joining **Yandy Diaz** (2023), **Carlos Peña** (2009) and **Fred McGriff** (1999)...Lowe is headed to the Midsummer Classic for the second time, joining 2019...he is the only second baseman in franchise history to make the All-Star Game and is the eighth Ray to earn multiple selections with the club, joining **Carl Crawford** (4), **David Price** (4), **Evan Longoria** (3), **Chris Archer** (2), **Scott Kazmir** (2), **Shane McClellan** (2) and **Ben Zobrist** (2)...Crawford, Longoria, Zobrist and Lowe are the only position players in that group...Lowe is one of seven active second basemen (min. 50% of games at 2B) with multiple career All-Star nods, joining **HOU Jose Altuve** (9), **ATL Ozzie Albies** (3), **NY Yankees DJ LeMahieu** (3), **AZ Ketel Marte** (3), **TEX Marcus Semien** (3) and **Jake Cronenworth** (2).

- ★ This is the first time the Rays have had a first and second basemen named to the Midsummer Classic in the same season...it marks the third time they have had multiple infielders earn selections, joining 2023 (Diaz, **Wander Franco**) and 2009 (Peña, **Jason Bartlett**, **Evan Longoria**).

**PLAYING UP...AND PLAYING DOWN**—The Rays are 24-17 against teams that currently have a .500 or better record, second in the majors behind the Astros (28-19)...they are undefeated in their last seven sets against teams that entered at .500 or better, going 6-0-1, and are 9-2-1 in their last 12 since losing each of their first four to open the season...meanwhile, their 25-24 mark against sub-.500 teams is 24th in the majors...they have dropped three straight series against teams that entered below .500 and are 1-4-1 in their last six.

- ★ On the season, they are 9-6-1 against teams that were .500 or better at the start of the series and 6-5-1 against those with a losing record.
- ★ This marks the Rays third series vs. a club that entered with the best record in the majors...they won each of the previous two, sweeping the Mets from June 13-15 in New York before taking two of three from the Tigers from June 20-22 in Tampa.

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**—Five of the Rays last six games have been decided in the final at-bat, including each of their last three, after they went 18 straight games without a last at-bat win or loss from June 10-29...their last four losses have come in the last at-bat, tied for the second-longest streak in club history (4x, last: Aug. 3-8, 2018) behind a five-loss streak from July 3-7, 2002 (Stats Perform)...it also ties the Rangers (June 27–July 4) for the longest streak in MLB this season...all three games last series in Minnesota saw the winning run scored in the last at-bat, their first such series since June 18-20, 2024, which was also against the Twins, albeit at Tropicana Field...each of the Rays last six games have had a margin of two runs or fewer after they went 15 straight games decided by three runs or more from June 14-29.

- ★ Of the Rays 90 games, 22 have been decided in the final at-bat, tied with the Rangers and Red Sox for third most in MLB behind the Blue Jays (27G) and Mariners (24G).
- ★ Their 46 games decided by two runs or fewer are tied for third in the AL behind the Astros (50G) and Red Sox (47G)...the Rays are 23-23 in such games.

**20-20 VISION**—With 19 doubles and 21 homers, **Junior Caminero** needs one double to become the first player in franchise history to record 20 doubles and 20 homers before the All-Star break...only six players in the majors have accomplished the feat so far this season, including three AL hitters: **NY Yankees Aaron Judge** (21 2B, 33HR), **DET Riley Greene** (21/22) and **LAA Taylor Ward** (20/20)...since 1901, five have turned the trick at age 22 or younger: **ATL Ozzie Albies** in 2018 (29/20), **WSH Bryce Harper** in 2015 (21/26), **LAA Mike Trout** in 2014 (26/22), **STL Albert Pujols** in 2002 (25/21) and **CIN Jonny Bench** in 1970 (23/28).

- ★ **Brandon Lowe** is 1 HR shy of reaching 20 HR, which would mark the first time in team history the Rays have had multiple players hit 20 HR before the All-Star break.

**SIMPLE CHAN**—**Chandler Simpson** is batting .387 (12-for-31) with 1 3B, 3 RBI and an .880 OPS over a 10-game hitting streak, second longest of his career behind May 11-26 (11G) and three games shy of **Rocco Baldelli**'s club-rookie-record 13-game streak, set from March 31–April 16, 2003...Simpson has not struck out in his last 42 PA, the longest active streak in the majors and third longest by a rookie in Tampa Bay history (see table to the right)...his 24 SB are tied with **KC Bobby Witt Jr.** for second most in the AL behind teammate **José Caballero** (31SB) and are three shy of the Rays rookie record for a full season, also set by Baldelli in 2003 (27SB)...he has accomplished this despite appearing in only 47 of the Rays 90 games.

**TIGER TOWN**—The Rays and Tigers meet for the second time this season after the Rays took two of three games from June 20-22 at Steinbrenner Field in a series that featured a combined 45 runs (TB - 25, DET - 20), Tampa Bay's second most in any series this year behind June 26-28 at BAL (50)...the clubs will complete their six-game season series over a span of 20 days June 20–July 9...last season, the Rays dropped five of six matchups, their first season series loss to the Tigers since 2021 (4-3)...they have won five of the last seven season sets between the clubs dating back to 2017, going 29-19 in that span...the Rays are 5-2-0 in their last seven series against the Tigers and 8-3-1 in their last 12...they were swept at Comerica Park last season from Sept. 24-26, 2024, but have won two of their last three series here...the Rays are 9-14-1 in this venue since its gates opened in 2000.

- ★ **Matt Thaiss** is batting .351 (13-for-37) with 2 HR and 12 RBI in 15 games against the Tigers, his highest average (min. 15AB) and most RBI vs. any opponent in his career.
- ★ **Yandy Diaz** went 7-for-14 (.500) with 1 2B and 2 HR against the Tigers at Steinbrenner Field from June 20-22...he is batting .412 (14-for-34) with 2 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBI and a 1.180 OPS over his last eight games vs. Detroit dating back to Aug. 6, 2023.

**DOWN ON THE FARM**—Class-A Bowling Green **1B Blake Robertson** was named South Atlantic League Player of the Week for June 30–July 6 after going 7-for-14 (.500) with 1 2B, 3 RBI, 8 BB and a 1.267 OPS over five games against Rome, reaching base in 15 of his 23 trips to the plate (.696 OBP), a 2022 Rays draftee (7th round), Robertson is hitting .391 (18-for-46) with 4 XBH, 6 RBI and 18 BB against 13 SO over 16 games since the beginning of June...it marks the 20th weekly award claimed by a Rays farmhand, second most behind the Giants (20).

**TONIGHT’S START**—Shane Baz will toe the rubber for his 18th start of the season and eighth on the road in tonight’s series opener...marks his 41st career start and 21st as a visitor...has gone 7.0 IP or more in consecutive starts, pitching to a 1.80 ERA (15.0IP, 3ER)...the Rays have won seven of his last eight starts and are 12-5 in his outings overall (7-1 on the road)...has a personal five-decision winning streak, the longest single-season streak of his career...was originally acquired from the Pirates as a player to be named later (Aug. 14, 2018) along with RHP Tyler Glasnow and OF Austin Meadows for RHP Chris Archer on July 31, 2018.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Despite tying a career high with 11 SO (also: April 14 vs. BOS) and working his third quality start in his last four outings, Baz settled for a no-decision in a 4-3 loss to the Athletics on July 1 at Steinbrenner Field (ND, 7.0IP, 7H, 3ER, BB, 11SO, 2HR)...allowed only two baserunners through the first three innings on a leadoff single and a 2nd-inning walk...had a runner on second with two outs in the 4th and allowed a game-tying two-run homer to **Max Muncy**, the first of three straight hits by the Athletics (HR, 2B, 1B)...after a perfect 5th, allowed a go-ahead homer to **Shea Langeliers** on the first pitch of the 6th...following the blast, retired six of his final seven batters faced before departing...**Danny Jansen** helped Baz avoid the loss with a game-tying homer in the 7th, but the Athletics scored the automatic runner in the 10th to claim a 4-3 win.

- ✦ He recorded a career-high 20 swings-and-misses, most by a Rays pitcher since **Taj Bradley** (21) on Sept. 5, 2024 vs. MIN...a career-high 14 of those came on his four-seamer, tying **Ryan Pepiot** (June 10 at BOS) for the most by a Ray this season
- ✦ Baz has struck out nine batters or more in consecutive starts for the first time in his career...the last Ray to accomplish the feat in three straight starts was **Tyler Glasnow** from Aug. 25–Sept. 6, 2020.

**EYE OF THE TIGER**—Baz earned the win in his first career start opposite the Tigers on June 20 at Steinbrenner Field, a 14-8 Rays victory (W, 5.1IP, 4H, 5ER, 4BB, 6SO)...he received nine runs of support in the win, tied for the second most in any start of his career...his five runs allowed were the most in a winning decision in his career—he became the third Rays pitcher since 2019 to earn a win despite yielding five runs or more, joining **Zach Eflin** on July 4, 2024 at KC (6R) and **Jacob Lopez** on Oct. 1, 2023 at TOR (6R).

- ✦ Baz has allowed five runs or more in three of his four career starts opposite AL Central teams, pitching to a 7.17 ERA (21.1IP, 17ER)...however, he threw a career-high eight scoreless frames in his last outing against the division on June 26 at KC and has earned the win in back-to-back starts vs. AL Central clubs.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN**—The Rays have won seven of Baz’s eight starts awy from home, with the right-hander going 3-1 with a 2.91 ERA (43.1IP, 14ER) in those games...he has an active 14.2 scoreless inning streak on the road entering tonight’s game...Baz has allowed three runs or fewer in six of seven road starts, turning in three scoreless outings...tonight, he looks to earn the win in three straight road starts for the first time in his career.

- ✦ Baz is the first Ray to record back-to-back scoreless starts of 6.0 IP or more on the road since **Taj Bradley** from July 20-25, 2024...only one Tampa Bay hurler has turned the trick in three straight road starts: **Rolando Arrojo** from April 19-May 6, 1998.
- ✦ He has allowed three runs or fewer in 13 of his last 15 starts on the road dating back to July 5, 2024, going 5-3 with a 2.89 ERA (87.1IP, 28ER), sixth in the AL over that span (min. 75.0IP).

**ALL I DO IS WIN**—The Rays have won seven of Baz’s last eight starts, outscoring opponents, 61-28 (+33), in those games while backing him with 6.66 runs of support per 9.0 IP...this includes a stretch of seven straight wins in his starts from May 24–June 26...he has received three runs of support or more in each of his last eight starts, the longest streak of his career...the Rays are 10-2 when providing Baz with three runs of support or more and 2-3 with two runs or fewer.

- ✦ When Baz receives three runs of support or more in his career, he is 13-1 with a 3.11 ERA (124.1IP, 43ER), and the Rays are 19-4 (10-2 in 2025)...in 17 starts with two runs or fewer, he is 2-7 with a 4.74 ERA (93.0IP, 48ER), and Tampa Bay has gone 5-12 (2-3 in 2025).

**CUT IT OUT**—Baz fully introduced a cutter to his arsenal on June 15 and has held opponents to a 5-for-23 (.217) clip with 8 SO on the offering...opponents were 2-for-17 before the Athletics went 3-for-6 against the pitch in his last outing...the cutter has been his second-most utilized pitch over his last four starts since June 15, throwing it 28.6 pct. of the time (114 of 398 pitches), trailing only his four-seam fastball (37.7%/150 of 398)...he has recorded a 2.67 ERA (27.0IP, 8ER) and held opponents to a .179/.264/.305 (17-for-95) line in his last four starts since fully integrating the cutter into his arsenal.

**RUNNING OUT OF GAS**—Over the first three innings, Baz has pitched to a 2.12 ERA (51.0IP, 12ER), 0.96 WHIP and .191 (35-for-183) opp. average...he has held opponents scoreless in the opening frame in 16 of his 17 starts this season and 34 of his 40 career starts...Baz has not permitted a run in the first two innings since April 19 vs. NYY, going 13 starts since...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 6.75 ERA (46.2IP, 35ER), 1.56 WHIP and .282 (51-for-181) opp. average...35 of his 47 runs allowed (74.5%) have come from the 4th inning on.

TOMORROW’S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP RYAN PEPIOT [6-6, 3.34]

**LAST START**—Opened July with his 11th quality start of the year on July 2 vs. ATH, stretching his winning streak to three games (W, 6.0IP, 4H, 2ER, 3BB, 9SO, 2HR)...has held opponents to five hits or fewer in eight straight starts, recording a .182 (29-for-159) opp. average in that span.

**vs. TIGERS**—Pepiot has yielded a total of five runs over four career appearances (4GS) against Detroit, going 1-1 with a 2.05 ERA (22.0IP, 5ER)...he has made one previous start at Comerica Park, taking the loss in a 2-1 setback despite throwing five innings of two-run ball (L, 5.0IP, 3H, 2ER, 4BB, 6SO).
