Rubber Match Pitching

The Braves enter their 10th rubber match of the season this afternoon with a 7-2 record in such games.

Today's starter, Chris Sale, has pitched in three series-deciding games this season. The left-hander has gone a perfect 3-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER/18.0 IP).

Atlanta's rotation has combined for a 1.18 ERA (7 ER/53.1 IP) in rubber games, while the entire pitching staff owns a 1.69 mark (15 ER/80.0 IP). Both of those marks stand as the best in Major League Baseball.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Red Sox today conclude a three-game midweek set and the season series with the last of six games between the clubs this season...The two will have played all six games in a span of just 14 days, as Atlanta hosted Boston for three games at Truist Park from May 15-17.

A Atlanta bookended the first set with a pair of wins to take the series, including a walk-off double from Mike Yastrzemski in Game 1.

A Atlanta went an even 3-3 in six games versus Boston last season, with each club winning a series in the visiting ballpark...The Braves and Red Sox are playing for the seventh consecutive season, and Atlanta is 18-15 (.545) against Boston in 33 total games since 2020.

A The Braves are the only visiting team in MLB with a winning record at Fenway Park, playing to a 29-23 all-time record (.558).

A Since the advent of Interleague Play in 1997, Atlanta has played Boston far more than any other American League team...The two clubs have met 105 times in that span, with the Braves going 50-55 (.476)...The Braves have not played any other AL team more than 70 times (Toronto).

A LHP Payton Tolle is set to face Atlanta for the second time in his last three starts...He pitched against the Braves on May 16 at Truist Park, the second game of that series, and gave up a pair of runs across 8.0 innings, earning the win...In 13 career appearances (9 starts), Tolle has booked a 2-2 record and a 3.57 ERA (21 ER/53.0 IP)...The southpaw has allowed three runs-or-fewer in each of his last seven starts, dating to September 10 of last season.

CHRIS SALE: Takes the ball for his 11th start of the season and ranks top-5 in Major League Baseball in various categories, including opponent batting average (2nd, .181), wins (T3rd, 7), WHIP (4th, 0.87) and ERA (5th, 1.89).

A The last starting pitcher with a better ERA through 10 games, Sale's age or older, was A.J. Burnett, who had a 1.81 ERA (13 ER/64.2 IP) for the Pittsburgh Pirates to start the 2015 season...Since 1985, only four total starters have met those qualifications: Kenny Rogers (TEX, 2005), Roger Clemens (HOU, 2005), Burnett and Sale.

A A veteran of 16 major-league seasons, including six with these Red Sox, Sale has pitched 12 career games (7 starts) against his former club...Against Boston he owns a 4-1 record and a 1.89 ERA (11 ER/52.1 IP)...At Fenway Park specifically, Sale is 21-11 with a 3.28 ERA (119 ER/326.1 IP).

A Since 1968, only three pitchers have maintained a sub-3.00 career ERA while making at least 300 starts: Pedro Martínez (2.93 ERA, 409 starts), Clayton Kershaw (2.53 ERA, 451 starts) and Chris Sale (2.98 ERA, 322 starts).

THE SERIES: The Braves play the Red Sox today to decide this set...A win would also clinch the season series...Since 2020, Atlanta is 3-1-3 in series here at Fenway Park, with all three series splits coming in two-game sets.

A The club is looking to avoid losing its third series of the year, and just its second on the road...Atlanta's other series losses occurred in Seattle (May 4-6) and versus Washington (May 22-24) at Truist Park.

A Entering play, the Braves are the only team with fewer than five series losses...Los Angeles-NL, New York-AL and Milwaukee have each lost five sets apiece.

A Atlanta's seven wins and .778 winning percentage (7-2) in rubber games are each the best marks in MLB this season.

A The Braves have pitched to a 1.69 ERA (15 ER/80.0 IP) in rubber matches, by far the best mark in Major League Baseball...The Toronto Blue Jays rank second with a 2.29 ERA (16 ER/63.0 IP).

A Atlanta has averaged 6.11 runs per game in rubber matches, the most in the National League and second-most in MLB behind Baltimore (6.17).

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Payton Tolle this afternoon...They faced lefties in each of their last three games as well, constituting a four-game streak of the Braves facing a left-handed starter.

A It's the second time this season that Atlanta has seen at least four straight lefties, after facing five in a row from April 29-May 3 in games against Detroit and Colorado.

A The team enters play 17-6 (.739) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins in such games in the majors this year.

A Dating even further to 2019, no team in baseball has been better against lefties...The Braves have gone 183-105 (.635) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .626 (204-122).

A Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 13 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 10-3 record in those games.

AT FENWAY: Although interleague play didn't begin until 1997, the Braves have played 141 games at Fenway park, beginning in 1913...The team owns a 29-23 (.558) record against the Red Sox inside this venue, and a 59-27 (.686) record when facing non-Boston teams here (including playoffs).

A The current Atlanta Braves played their home games at Fenway Park during the 1914 World Series, and began the 1915 regular season here...The Braves clinched that World Series at this park, beating the Philadelphia Athletics, 3-1.

A The Braves have more all-time wins (87) at Fenway Park than two current members of the AL: the Seattle Mariners (84) and Houston Astros (26).

Today's Game

- Makes his 11th start of the season this afternoon in the finale of a three-game series against the Red Sox at Fenway Park, his first turn since defeating Miami on May 20.
- In rubber games since joining Atlanta, the left-hander is 3-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER/18.0 IP) in three series-deciding starts in 2026, and is 7-3 with a 2.47 ERA (15 ER/54.2 IP) over 10 such outings dating to 2024.
- Owens a 4-1 record with a 1.89 ERA (11 ER/52.1 IP) and 63 strikeouts in 12 career appearances (seven starts) against Boston...Beat the Red Sox most recently on May 16, 2025, allowing one run on five hits over 7.0 innings with two walks and eight punchouts in Atlanta's 4-2 win at Truist Park.
- Sale is 7-3 with a 1.89 ERA (13 ER/62.0 IP) and 72 strikeouts across his first 10 starts.
- His nine quality starts are tied for the most in the Major Leagues, even with Philadelphia's Christopher Sánchez and Kansas City's Michael Wacha...Has turned in a quality start in nine of his 10 outings in 2026, with the lone exception coming April 6 at Los Angeles (AL).
- Has held opponents to a .181 batting average this season, the second-lowest mark among qualified MLB pitchers behind only Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (.152).
- His seven victories are tied for the second-most among MLB starters, behind only Cleveland's Gavin Williams (8).
- Owens a 4-1 record with a 0.60 ERA (2 ER/30.0 IP) over five home starts in 2026, compared to 3-2 with a 3.09 ERA (11 ER/32.0 IP) over five road outings.
- Enters play ranked third among qualified MLB starters in strike percentage at 68.2%, trailing only New York's (AL) Cam Schlichter (68.8%) and Cincinnati's Graham Ashcraft (68.7%).
- His 38.0% chase rate ranks second among MLB qualifiers, behind only Chicago's (NL) Shota Imanaga.
- Owens a 2.36 ERA (96 ER/365.1 IP) since joining the Braves in 2024, third among qualified MLB starters over that span, trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.13) and Detroit's Tarik Skubal (2.34)...The southpaw has compiled 462 strikeouts in 60 appearances (59 starts) across his time in Atlanta.
- Since 1968, only three pitchers have maintained a sub-3.00 career ERA while making at least 300 starts: Pedro Martínez (2.93 ERA, 409 starts), Clayton Kershaw (2.53 ERA, 451 starts) and Sale (2.98 ERA, 322 starts).
- His 11.12 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (2,651 SO/2,146.0 IP) are the most in MLB history (since 1901) among pitchers with at least 1,500.0 career innings.
- Sale's 403 career appearances rank third among active primary starters since his 2010 debut, behind only Detroit's Justin Verlander and Toronto's Max Scherzer.

2026

- Earned his seventh victory May 20 at loanDepot park, allowing one run on four hits over 7.0 innings with no walks and eight strikeouts on 96 pitches in the 9-1 win...Recorded his first career victory against Miami, having entered 0-2 in three prior starts against the Marlins...Notched his ninth quality start in 10 outings.
- Took the loss in his ninth start May 14 against the Cubs, allowing one unearned run on five hits over 6.0 innings with eight strikeouts and two walks on 100 pitches in the 2-0 defeat at Truist Park.
- Took the loss in his eighth start May 8 at Dodger Stadium, surrendering three runs (two earned) on five hits over 7.0 innings with seven strikeouts and no walks on 102 pitches in the 3-1 defeat at Los Angeles (NL).
- Earned his sixth victory of the season May 2 at Coors Field, allowing one run on three hits over 7.0 innings with three walks and 11 strikeouts on 102 pitches in the 9-1 win...Recorded the second-most strikeouts in a start of his Atlanta tenure... Reached 2,628 career strikeouts.
- Picked up his fifth victory April 26 against Philadelphia, allowing no runs on one hit over 6.0 innings with two walks and nine strikeouts on 100 pitches in the 6-2 win...Reached 150 career wins, becoming the 265th pitcher in MLB history to do so...Passed Chuck Finley (2,610) on the all-time strikeout list during the outing, slotting into 28th and seventh among left-handers in MLB history.
- Improved to 4-1 on April 18 at Citizens Bank Park, allowing one run on five hits over 7.0 innings with one walk and seven punchouts on 101 pitches in the 3-1 victory over the Phillies...Passed Tom Glavine (2,607) for 29th on the all-time strikeout list.
- Reached 400 career strikeouts with the Braves in the loss April 6, the 13th pitcher in franchise history to reach the plateau.
- Won his seventh career Opening Day start March 27, holding Kansas City to three hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts in the 6-0 victory...Became the first Atlanta starter to throw 6.0-or-more innings on Opening Day since Michael Soroka (6.0 IP, July 24, 2020).
- Is the first Braves lefty to toss 6.0-plus scoreless innings while allowing three or fewer hits in the season opener since Tom Glavine on April 7, 1992 at Houston.
- His seven Opening Day starts are tied for the second-most among active pitchers with Toronto's Max Scherzer...Trails only Detroit's Justin Verlander (12)...Is the 11th pitcher in MLB history to make multiple Opening Day starts for three different teams.

- Awards:** NL Cy Young (2024), Rawlings Gold Glove (2024), NL Comeback Player of the Year (2024), AL All-Star (7x, 2012-18), NL All-Star (2024-25), and World Series Champion (2018).
- In his 16th major league season, Sale was selected to seven consecutive AL All-Star teams from 2012-2018, was selected to the NL All-Star team in 2024 & 2025, and has eight career Top 10 finishes in Cy Young voting, winning the award with Atlanta in 2024.
- In his first year with Atlanta and 14th major league season, Sale was named the National League Cy Young Award winner, a Rawlings Gold Glove Award recipient, a National League All-Star, a First-Team All-MLB Nomination and the National League Comeback Player of the Year, going 18-3 with a 2.38 ERA (47 ER/177.2 IP) and 225 strikeouts.
- Led the National League in wins, strikeouts and ERA...Became the first pitcher in Braves franchise history to win the triple crown and first in the National League since Clayton Kershaw with Los Angeles in 2011.
