TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants are looking for a win today to avoid being swept by the Rockies for the first time since losing a three game set to Colorado from September 3-5, 2018 at Coors Field.

- ► San Francisco enters today 47-52, 11.0 games back of the NL West-leading Dodgers, and 4.0 games back of the third Wild Card spot.
- ▶ The Giants currently have 16.5% odds odds of making the Postseason according to FanGraphs.
- ▶ Per Elias, SF entered the second half of the season with the second-easiest remaining schedule in terms of opponent winning percentage (.479) behind only the Angels (.469).

SECOND HALF STRUGGLES: The Giants have not fared well coming out of the All-Star break in recent seasons.

- ▶ After starting off last season's second-half with a threegame sweep of Pittsburgh followed by two wins at Cincinnati, SF would go on to lose the final two against the Reds, get swept by Washington and lose a one-gamer in Detroit to go 5-6 with a -14 run differential (41-55).
- ▶ In 2022, SF came out of the break with a winless road trip and a -25 run differential (19-44), going 0-4 at Los Angeles-NL and 0-3 at Arizona.

ON THE ROCKY MOUND: RHP Hayden Birdsong will make his fifth Major League start today...he has allowed three runs or fewer in all four of his big league starts while also logging at least 4.2 innings in all four outings.

- ▶ Opponents are just 1-for-33 (.030) over his first 30 pitches of a game, compared to a .359 average (14-for-39) on his pitches 31-75.
- ▶ Is holding opponents to a .154 average (2-for-15) with his slider, compared to opponents hitting .467 (7-for-15) off his changeup.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: SF is 5-3 against the Rockies thus far in 2024, going 2-3 here at Coors and 3-0 at Oracle Park.

Since the start of the 2021 season, SF is 20-11 against the Rockies at Coors Field, outscoring them 194-149 (+45).

LET'S FIND SOME SHADE: The Giants dropped to 6-8 in the month of July and have slashed .217/.289/.388 with a .677 OPS this month...San Francisco has also struck out 139 times during that stretch.

▶ The .217 batting average is the lowest in the NL and third-lowest in the Majors ahead of the Angels (.212) and Mariners (.210)

LA ESTRELLA DE MAUNABO: Since being called up on May 8, All-Star **OF Heliot Ramos** is tied for the most RBI (46) in the NL and ranks among the top in home runs (14, T-4th), SLG% (.519, 9th) batting average (.296, 10th), and OPS (.880, 7th).

- ► The 24-year-old has started 61 of SF's 62 games since being recalled and has started in 60 consecutive games.
- ▶ Ramos leads SF with 14 homers and 46 RBI...his 2.4 fWAR is tied with IF Matt Chapman for second-most among Giants position players behind the 3.5 fWAR by C Patrick Bailey.

I LOVE IT HERE: OF Mike Yastrezmski has a .992 OPS in 39 career games at Coors Field...since 2019, the .992 OPS is the fourth-best among players with at least 35 games...he has 10 career homers here, but hasn't homered in 2022.

- ▶ Since July 11, Yastrezmski is hitting .500 (10-for-20) with three doubles, two triples, home run and three RBI in six games.
- ➤ Yastrezmski hit his sixth triple of the season last night, which is tied for the most triples in the NL...his six triples are the most by a Giant in a single season since 2016 (IF Brandon Crawford 11, IF Brandon Belt 8 and IF Joe Panik 7).

JET SETTERS: Following today's game at Coors Field, the Giants will travel to Los Angeles to play a four-game series against the Dodgers.

- ▶ The Giants are 3-6 with a -13 run differential in nine games against the Dodgers this year, however, they have won three of their last four contests.
- San Francisco has struggled at Dodger Stadium over the past few years, dropping each of their last five games and 14 of their last 19 contests since 2022.

A QUICK LOOK AT NEXT YEAR: The San Francisco Giants released their 2025 regular season schedule on Thursday.

- ▶ The Giants will open the season on Thursday, March 27, at the Reds before finishing the opening road trip at Houston.
- ▶ Following the road trip, the Giants will head back to San Francisco to host the Mariners and Reds, holding their home opener on Friday, April 4 vs. Seattle.
- ▶ SF is on the road for all the major holidays in 2025, including Mother's Day (Sunday, May 11 at Minnesota), Memorial Day (Monday, May 26 at Detroit), Father's Day (Sunday, June 15 at Los Angeles-NL), Fourth of July (Friday, July 4 at Athletics) and Labor Day (Monday, September 1 at Colorado).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Will make his fifth Major League start today...had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 26...Birdsong has spent parts of three seasons in the Giants system after being selected in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Illinois University (Charleston, IL).

LAST TIME OUT: Last start came Saturday, July 13 vs. Minnesota and threw 5.0 innings, allowing just two runs (one earned) on two hits with three walks and three strikeouts...did not factor into the decision in SF's 4-2 loss.

LAST TIME OUT: Has allowed three runs or fewer in all four of his big league starts while also logging at least 4.2 innings in all four outings.

WITH THE SQUIRRELS: Birdsong entered the season ranked as the Giants #6 prospect according to *Baseball America*...he began the year at Double-A Richmond and posted a 4-2 record with a 2.05 ERA (11er, 48.1ip) with 61 strikeouts in 11 starts for Double-A Richmond before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on June 11.

WITH THE RIVER CATS: Made two starts for Sacramento after the promotion and posted a 5.00 ERA (5er, 9.0) with 14 strikeouts...his last Triple-A start came on June 21 vs. Round Rock when he threw 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits with seven strikeouts.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: With the prospect graduation of **LHP Kyle Harrison**, Birdsong is currently the Giants' second-ranked pitching prospect, No. 4 overall, according to *MLB.com...*he also enters today's start as #98 on MLB.com's Top-100 prospects...Birdsong was the last of six consecutive pitchers the Giants selected during the 2022 draft, which is a group that included **LHPs Reggie Crawford** and **Carson Whisenhunt**.

EARLY ARRIVAL: Birdsong became the second Giant from the 2022 draft to reach the Majors, joining **OF Wade Meckler** (eighth round), who did so last year...there are just three players from the first round of that 2022 draft that have reached the Majors overall (IF Jackson Holliday with Baltimore, IF Zach Neto with the Angels and OF Jordan Beck with Colorado)...at the time of his debut, there were just 12 players selected ahead of Birdsong (6th round, 30th pick) in that 2022 draft that had made their debuts.

LIKE, REAL EARLY: According to Grant Brisbee of *The Athletic* Birdsong's 169.2 minor league innings were the fewest thrown by a Giant before their Major League debut since **RHP Tim Lincecum** debuted in 2007 with only 62.2 minor league innings under his belt.

- ▶ Is 17-for-21 in save opportunities...since June 2, he's posted a 6.91 ERA (11er, 14.1ip) with a 1.95 WHIP and is 8-for-11 in save opportunities.
- ▶ Has issued 24 BBs in 37.0ip...his 14.0% BB rate is bottom 3% of league.
- ▶ Doval's hard-hit rate of 46.9% this year is in the bottom 5% of the league...had a hard-hit rate of 41.3% in 2023.
- ▶ Righties are just 15-for-74 (.203) with six extra-base hits off him, while lefties are 21-for-71 (.296) with eight extra-base hits.
