TODAY'S STARTER: #48 - RHP COLIN REA [3gs, 2-0, 2.70]

REA AT A GLANCE: Colin Rea. 33. will be making his fourth start of the season.....Rea last started last Sunday at Baltimore and received no decision in the Brewers' 6-4 loss (5.2ip, 5h, 3r, 3er, 1bb, 6k, 2hr, 1hbp, 87 pitches).....the team is 2-1 in his starts.....has has made 1 quality start....opponents are batting .254 (17-for-67, 2hr).....Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025.....name is pronounced "RAY."

LAST SEASON: Rea went 6-6 with a 4.55 ERA in 26 games/22 starts during five stints with Milwaukee last season....the team went 14-8 in his starts.....he had 4 guality starts....opponents batted .235.....he set career highs in wins (6), games (26), starts (22), innings pitched (124.2) and strikeouts (110).

CAREER: Is 16-14 with a 4.63 ERA in 65 games/52 starts (295.2ip, 152er)....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24).....is 14-13 with a 4.72 ERA as a starter (269ip, 141er) and 2-1 with a 3.71 ERA as a reliever (26.2ip, 11er).....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University.....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season.....Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: IS 3-4 with a 4.52 ERA in 16 games/13 starts (71.2ip, 36er).....is 1-0 with a 1.50 ERA in 1 start this season (6ip, 1er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 8-6 with a 4.70 ERA in 29 games/21 starts (130.1p, 68er).....is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA in 2 starts this season (10.2ip, 4er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Is 1-3 with a 5.19 ERA in 7 games/5 starts (26ip, 15er), including 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA in 2 relief appearances last season (5.2ip, 1er)....his last start against the Cardinals came as a member of the Cubs on 9/5/20 at Busch Stadium in a 5-1 loss (2ip, 5h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 3k, 2hr).
