



# Los Angeles Dodgers (28-15) vs. San Francisco Giants (19-24)

RHP Gavin Stone (3-1, 3.55) vs. RHP Keaton Winn (3-5, 5.63)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants are looking to even the three-game series with a win tonight after falling 6-4 in extra innings last night.

- ▶ SF is 4-3 in its last seven games but is also 5-9 in its last 14 games dating to April 30.

**I'VE GOT THE MAGIC IN ME:** SF will don its City Connect jerseys tonight after not having the ability to wear them the first two Tuesdays of the year (a 5-3 loss to the Nationals on April 9 and a 5-1 win vs. the Mets on April 23).

- ▶ Since the jerseys were introduced in July of 2021, the Giants are 26-10 with a +53 run differential in games where they wear the creamsicle jerseys...of the 26 wins, five have been walkoffs.
- ▶ Last season the Giants were 9-4 in 13 City Connect games with two of the nine wins being walkoffs...SF lost its final two City Connect games in 2023.

**TOUGH SLEDDING:** It's been a tough go vs. LA at home since 2018 with the Giants going 17-30 in 47 games against the Dodgers here at Oracle Park...SF has a -103 run differential in that time.

- ▶ SF did not win a home series vs. LAD in 2024, going 2-4 overall...since August 1, 2022, SF is 2-12 vs. the Dodgers here at Oracle Park, being outscored 78-36 in that stretch.
- ▶ The Giants have lost their last five games overall (regardless of venue) to the Dodgers dating to the final game of the 2023 season...since 2018, SF is 40-63 (.388) against their Southern California rivals.

**STILL GRINDING:** The Giants are slashing .224/.291/.340 over their last 18 games dating to April 24...they are averaging 3.22 runs/game in that span, scoring 58 runs.

- ▶ SF's 3.22 runs/game in that time is third-worst in the Majors ahead of only the Reds (3.11 runs/game) and Pirates (3.11).
- ▶ However, the Giants have scored at least four runs in three straight games entering play tonight...it's only the third time SF has scored four or more in three straight this year.
- ▶ If the Giants score four or more tonight they'll match their longest streak of the season, which was the first four games of the year in San Diego from March 28-31.

**INNINGS FEST:** SF's bullpen covered 5.0 more innings last night and has covered 61.1 of the 121.0 innings the Giants have played in their last 14 games since April 30.

- ▶ In those 14 games, Giants starters have finished at least 6.0 innings just twice...one came from **LHP Kyle Harrison** on May 7 in Colorado (7.0ip) and the other came from **RHP Logan Webb** last Friday vs. Cincinnati (7.0ip).
- ▶ The Giants bullpen has a 3.52 ERA (24er, 61.1ip) in this 14-game stretch with 77 strikeouts.
- ▶ The 77 punchouts lead all MLB bullpens in this stretch (since April 30) while the bullpen's 11.30 K/9ip ratio is second-best in MLB in that time to the Angels' 'pen (12.10 K/9ip).

**BUT TONIGHT I BOUNCE BACK...:** RHP Keaton Winn takes the hill tonight looking to put his last two rocky trips to the hill behind him.

- ▶ Last time out in the unfriendly confines of Coors Field, Winn allowed seven runs on eight hits (one homer) in 3.2 innings as the Giants fell to the Rockies 9-1.
- ▶ Winn breezed through the first 3.0 innings of that outing, giving up just one hit, before being tagged for all seven runs on seven hits in a 4th inning he could not escape.
- ▶ Over his last two starts, he's allowed 12 runs (all earned) on 12 hits in 4.1 innings...in four starts leading into this tough stretch he allowed five runs in 23.0 innings (1.96 ERA).
- ▶ The righty has been better here at home in his three starts this year, logging a 3.00 ERA (6er, 18.0ip) and has given up two runs in his last two starts here (12.0ip).

**WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** has reached base in 14 consecutive games entering play today and has a .491 OBP with seven RBI in that span...the 14-game on-base streak is the tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors behind MIL's William Contreras (21 games), SD's Luis Arraez (20 games) and TEX's Leody Taveras (16 games).

- ▶ Wade's 14-game on-base streak is the third-longest of his career behind a 15-gamer from September 1-20, 2023 and a 19-gamer from April 20-May 23, 2023.
- ▶ His .472 on-base percentage and 20.5% walk rate are both tops in MLB (min. 110 PA), while his .330 average is eighth-best.

**AGE IS BUT A NUMBER:** The Giants have gotten considerably younger in the last week with the amount of call-ups to replace injured position players.

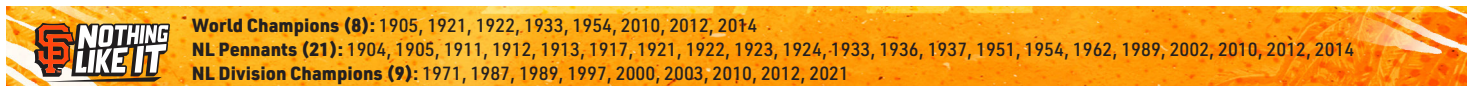
- ▶ The average batter age of SF's players (weighted by ABs plus games played) is 29.8, third-oldest in MLB behind the Mets (30.2) and Dodgers (30.4).
- ▶ However, SF's pitching staff has the second-youngest average pitcher's age (weighted by 3\*GS+G+SV) at 27.1 years...only the Marlins have been younger (26.7).
- ▶ Looking at it by innings, SF has had 173.1 innings thrown by pitchers 26 or younger, fourth-most in MLB behind Miami (253.0), Cleveland (196.0) and Arizona (181.2).

**THE ATTENDANCE IS IN...:** Through 20 home games, SF has eclipsed 30,000 fans 14 times (70%)...last season, the Giants were above 30,000 in 46 of their 81 home games (56.8%).

# KEATON WINN **RHP** #67

**IT'S IOWA:** The rookie made his first career Opening Day roster and is slated to face the Dodgers for the third time in his young career... Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Iowa Western Community College and made his debut last season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Had another tough outing last Thursday at Colorado, suffering the loss for a second consecutive start...had given up just one hit through 3.0 innings before surrendering seven runs on seven hits in the 4th...worked just 3.2 innings with one strikeout.

**VS. LOS ANGELES-NL:** Has faced the Dodgers twice in his career and suffered the loss both times...Winn has a 7.84 ERA (9er, 10.1ip) in the two starts and has struck out 11 batters over 10.1 innings... his last start against LA came earlier this year when he spun 5.0 innings on April 1 at Dodger Stadium...the right-hander held Dodgers batters to just four hits and struck out six in the start.

**HOME, SWEET HOME:** Winn is 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (6er, 18.0ip) in three starts at Oracle Park this season...the right-hander has held opponents to a .169 (10x59) clip and allowed just three extra-base hits (.288 SLG) in those outings...in contrast, Winn is 1-4 with a 7.97 ERA and .309 opposing average in five starts on the road.

**IN THE FAST LANE:** Batters are just 4-for-28 (.143) with 10 strikeouts off his four-seam fastball this season...Winn's .143 opposing average with the four-seamer is seventh-lowest in the NL among starters who've thrown at least 100 four-seamers.

**BANANA SPLIT:** Winn's trademark is his splitter, which he's been using 42.4% of the time this season...13 of his 29 strikeouts this season have come off the pitch and he's limiting opponents to a .234 clip with just four extra-base hits (.375 SLG)...Winn's 42.4% splitter usage this season is the highest of any starting pitcher in MLB.

**KEEP THEM GROUNDED:** Winn has been successful at inducing ground balls early in his career...his 58.0% ground ball rate this season is seventh-best in MLB among pitchers with at least 30.0 innings this season and just behind teammate **RHP Logan Webb** (59.2%, 6th).

**UNDERLYING DATA:** Batters have been hitting the ball hard off Winn this year...his average exit velocity this season is 92.5 mph, the 10th-highest figure among qualified pitchers...his 48.2% hard hit rate also ranks in the bottom 6% of the league.

**TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT:** Lefties are 11-for-62 (.177) off him this season with 17 strikeouts and a .290 slugging percentage.

**DYNAMIC DUO:** Winn has a 2.12 ERA in three starts this season with **C Patrick Bailey** behind the plate...he has a 8.43 ERA in his other five starts.
