JOE GARAGIOLA JR. TO BE INDUCTED INTO AZ SPORTS HALL OF FAME:

Joe Garagiola Jr., the D-backs' first general manager who helped lead the franchise to its first World Series in 2001, will be officially inducted as a member of the 2024-25 Arizona Sports Hall of Fame class at Chateau Luxe in Phoenix on April 10.

- 8-member class: Arizona Diamondbacks' former GM and current Senior Director of Special Projects **Joe Garagiola Jr.**, Arizona Cardinals owner Michael Bidwill, former Olympic and Arizona State swimmer Melissa Belote Ripley, former University of Arizona and NBA basketball player Mike Bibby, former U.S. Women's National Team soccer player and Mesa native Julie Ertz, former University of Arizona football standout Ricky Hunley, former MLB player and Scottsdale Chaparral alum Paul Konerko, and the late Matt Shott, former Sr. Director of Amateur Hockey Development for Arizona Coyotes.

GENO BOBBLE SATURDAY: The D-backs will give away the **Eugenio Suárez** Bobble, courtesy of Chase, to the first 20,000 fans @ Chase Field on Saturday, April 12.

EXCITING FRIDAY NIGHT: Friday, April 11 will be the second installment of Postgame Fireworks presented by Seat-Geek themed to boy-band music in conjunction with the Special Event Boy Band Tee Ticket Pack, which includes an exclusive tee featuring **Ketel Marte**, **Corbin Carroll**, **Gabriel Moreno**, **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** and **Geraldo Perdomo**.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 5-1 last night vs. Orioles in the series opener.

- Corbin Carroll** went 1-for-4 with his fourth double.
- Josh Naylor** (2-for-4, 2B) notched his team-leading fourth multi-hit performance.
- Ryan Thompson** worked 1.1 scoreless innings for his third scoreless outing in 4 appearances.
- Ryne Nelson** (0 ER in 3.0 IP) made his second consecutive scoreless appearance of 2.0+ innings, facing the minimum.

BULLPEN PICK UP: In the last 5 games, the D-backs' bullpen has allowed just 1 run over 17.2 innings (0.51 ERA) and owns a 0.74 WHIP, opponent .133 AVG., with 5 walks and 19 strikeouts.

TEAM OFFENSE: Among all teams, the D-backs are tied for second with 25 doubles (behind 26 Red Sox), fourth with 39 extra-base hits (behind 47 Yankees, 43 Cubs, 42 Dodgers), fifth with 45 walks (behind 69 Cubs, 49 Red Sox, 47 Mariners, 46 Cardinals) and sixth with 59 runs (behind Cubs 84, Yankees 78, Cardinals 66, Red Sox 65, Dodgers 61).

OFFENSE VS. RELIEVERS: The D-backs' offense vs. relievers ranks among the league in AVG (1st, .289), OBP (2nd, .381), OPS (3rd, .830), SLG (4th, .450), doubles (T-4th, 10 with Blue Jays and Nationals), hits (5th, 43) and runs (6th, 32).

LATE-INNING PRODUCTION: The D-backs' 28 runs in the seventh-ninth innings lead the Majors, ahead of the Cardinals (26), Phillies (23), Yankees (21) and Red Sox (19).

- In addition, Arizona leads the Majors in hits (41) and total bases (63).

CARROLL AT THE TOP: **Corbin Carroll** ranks among the NL in the leadoff spot (min. 20 PA) in SLG (1st, .778, ahead of S. Ohtani-LAD/.644), OPS (1st, 1.123, ahead of S. Ohtani-LAD/1.081), isolated (raw) power [*SLG-minus-AVG*] (1st, .481, ahead of K. Schwarber-PHI/.346) and extra-base hits (T-1st, 6, with S. Ohtani-LAD).

PERDOMO AMONG SHORTSTOPS: **Geraldo Perdomo** ranks among all qualified shortstops in RBI (T-1st, 12, with A. Volpe-NYY), fewest strikeouts (T-1st, 2, with J. Wilson-ATH), hits (3rd, 12, behind J. Wilson-ATH/15 and B. Bichette-TOR/13).

- In addition, Perdomo's 21.1 chase pct. ranks second to Dansby Swanson/CHC (18.8%), while his 15 swings out of the zone also rank second to Trey Sweeney/DET (12).

TRENDING BATS:

- Corbin Carroll** has reached base in each of his 11 games this season (12 H, 5 BB, 2 HBP) and is slashing .279/.380/.628/1.008.
- Alek Thomas**, in 6 games, is hitting .381 (8-for-21)/.963 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 7 RBI, including 3 multi-hits...has recorded 1+ RBI in 5 games.
- Pavin Smith**, in 10 games, is hitting .348 (8-for-23)/.923 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 RBI and 4 walks.
- Josh Naylor** has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 games (.333; 6-for-18, 2 2B, RBI, 2 BB).

2023 ROYs REVISITED: This 3-game series features **Corbin Carroll** and **Gunnar Henderson**, who won the 2023 Rookie of the Year Awards in their respective leagues... both were also named Rookie of the Month for June that same season.

GENO CHASING 30: With a homer vs. Orioles, **Eugenio Suárez** will have homered against every MLB team in his 12-year career...he would become the second D-back on the current roster to homer vs. all teams, joining **Randal Grichuk**.

VS. THE O's: The D-backs are 16-12 all-time against the Orioles (10-6 at home).

- Josh Naylor**, in his last 13 games since May 30, 2023, is hitting .395 (17-for-43)/1.132 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers and 16 RBI.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** is batting .300 (6-for-20)/.868 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 1 walk in his last 5 games.
- Eugenio Suárez** has reached base in 17 of his 18 career games since 2017 (16 H, 8 BB, HBP)/.325 OBP.

NEXT STARTER: BRANDON PFAADT (1-1, 5.25)

- Will make his second home start this season (third overall)...earned the win in his last start on April 4 @ Nationals (W; 4 ER in 6.0 IP, 0 BB, 4 K).
- Has tossed 6.0 innings in each of his first 2 bids.
- Made his lone start vs. Orioles @ Oriole Park at Camden Yards on May 10, 2024 (L; 3 ER in 6.0 IP).

- ◆ Is in his first season with the D-backs (seventh in the Majors)...acquired from the Guardians for RHP Slade Cecconi and a Competitive Balance Round B draft pick in December.
- ◆ Has reached safely in 9 of his 11 games (.391 OBP) and 18 times overall (12 H, 6 BB) including 4 multi-hit efforts.
- ◆ Since 2023, his 209 RBI are third among all first basemen, behind Matt Olson/ATL (242) and Pete Alonso/NYM (217)...is tied for eighth overall (also: Marcell Ozuna/ATL).
- ◆ Since 2023, his 19 stolen bases are third among all first basemen, behind Freddie Freeman/LAD (32) and Paul Goldschmidt/NYY (22).
- ◆ In 2024, hit .243 (137-for-563).776 OPS with 27 doubles, 31 homers, 108 RBI and 58 walks over 152 games with Cleveland...set career highs in games, runs (84), homers, RBI and walks.
- ◆ Named a 2024 AL All-Star (first time in the Mid-Summer Classic).

- ◆ Is in his fifth season with Arizona (ninth in the organization) and made his third Opening Day start.
- ◆ Hit his second career grand slam on April 3 @ Yankees (also: June 7, 2022 @ Reds)...became the fourth D-back shortstop with 2 career grand slams (also: Nick Ahmed, Jay Bell and Tony Womack).
- ◆ Has reached base safely in 10 of his first 11 games, batting .308 (12-for-39) with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 12 RBI and 3 walks.
- ◆ Became the second D-backs shortstop ever to record a hit in the team's first 5 games of the season (also: Willie Bloomquist in 2011).
- ◆ In February, agreed with the D-backs to a 4-year contract extension through 2029 (beginning in 2026) with a club option for 2030.
- ◆ His 5 errors in 2024 tied for the second fewest among all shortstops [min. 800.0 inn.], and his .987 fielding pct. was the fourth lowest.
