AROUND THE HORN

VOTE D-BACKS: Phase 1 voting is open on the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot for the MLB All-Star Game thru June 25 (9:00 a.m. AZ) exclusively online and via mobile devices at dbacks.com/vote, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App.

INTER-TRIBAL TOURNAMENT: Continuing today through Thursday, the 26th Annual D-backs Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament presented by Talking Stick Resort and generously supported by Resolution Copper and Nike will host 84 teams and nearly 1,500 participants from more than 20 tribes across six states — Arizona, New Mexico, California, Oklahoma, Texas and Mississippi — for athletes ages 9-18 in 3 baseball divisions and 1 softball division, making it the largest all-Native American youth baseball and softball tournament in the country.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since May 9, the D-backs' 17 wins are tied for fifth in the Majors with the White Sox, behind the Brewers (21), Braves (19), Phillies (19) and Dodgers (18).

• **Zac Gallen**, in 2 starts @ Marlins, is 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER in 13.0 IP), opponent .156 AVG (7-for-45), 0.54 WHIP, 0 walks and 12 strikeouts.

• His 1,060 strikeouts as a D-back are 5 away from tying Brandon Webb (1,065) for second most in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson's 2,077.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-1 vs. Nationals Sunday.

• **Michael Soroka** (W, 1 ER in 7.0 IP, 6 K) posted his NL-best-tying eighth win in his first start of 7.0+ innings with 1 or fewer runs allowed since Aug. 10, 2019.

• **Taylor Clarke** (0 ER in 1.0 IP) made his 16th consecutive scoreless appearance.

• **Kevin Ginkel** (0 ER in 1.0 IP) made his fourth consecutive scoreless appearance.

• **Corbin Carroll** homered (10) in the first inning.

• **Gabriel Moreno** homered (4) in the fifth inning to pad their 4-1 lead.

MINOR LEAGUE SPOTLIGHT: Yesterday, Triple-A Reno INF/OF **Tim Tawa** (PCL) and Single-A Visalia RHP **Junior Ciprian** (CAL) were named Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Week (June 1-7).

• Tawa hit .476 (10-for-21)/1.637 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers and 7 RBI in 5 games

• Ciprian tossed 6.0 innings of 1-run, 2-hit ball with 1 walk and 6 strikeouts on June 6 @ Rancho Cucamonga.

D-BACKS AGREE TO TERMS WITH MAX KEPLER: On Sunday, the D-backs agreed to terms with OF **Max Kepler** on a 1-year contract, who remains on the restricted list.

• Has played 11 seasons and 1,199 career games with the Twins (2015-24) and Phillies (2025).

PAVIN POWER IN MIAMI: Jupiter native **Pavin Smith**, in his last 12 games @ Marlins, is hitting .378 (14-for-37)/1.226 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers and 9 RBI... he homered in each of his last 2 games on April 16-17, 2025 and has 3 straight 2+-hit games.

FISH TIES: **Zac Gallen** made his MLB debut with the Marlins in 2019...was traded by the Cardinals in Dec. 2017 with LHP David Castano, OF Magneuris Sierra and RHP Sandy Alcantara for OF Marcell Ozuna.

• **Adrian Del Castillo**, a Miami native and University of Miami alum (2019-21), hit his first career grand slam on Aug. 19, 2024 @ Marlins.

• Bullpen coach **Wellington "Beef" Cepeda** served as Marlins bullpen coach from 2020-24.

LOVULLO 2 SHY OF 700: **Torey Lovullo** is 2 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure to become the 106th MLB manager to reach the feat.

TRIPLE THREAT: **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.

ALL-STAR CALIBER: **Ketel Marte** ranks among NL second basemen in homers (2nd, 11), RBI (2nd, 37) and extra-base hits (3rd, 24)...defensively, ranks atop in fielding pct (1.000) and errors (0).

• **Corbin Carroll** ranks among NL outfielders in extra-base hits (1st, 33), triples (1st, 8), SLG (2nd, .553), OPS (2nd, .928), doubles (T-2nd, 15), OBP (3rd, .375) and total bases (4th, 126).

• **Nolan Arenado** ranks among NL third basemen in OPS (2nd, .773), SLG (2nd, .437), doubles (2nd, 12), homers (T-3rd, 8), OBP (3rd, .336) and extra-base hits (3rd, 20)...defensively, is tied for the third fewest errors (3) with Max Muncy/LAD, behind Ke'Bryan Hayes/CIN and Manny Machado/SD (2).

DEFENSE! DEFENSE!: Since May 1, the D-backs' .994 fielding pct. and 7 errors (2 throwing, 4 fielding) rank best in the Majors, ahead of the Phillies (.991, 11 E).

THE BULLPEN: The D-backs' bullpen, since May 1, boasts a 2.94 ERA (36 R-31 ER in 95.0 IP), opponent .225 AVG (78-for-346), 36 walks and 83 strikeouts.

• The D-backs bullpen since May 1 ranks among MLB in fewest earned runs (1st, 31), fewest hits (1st, 78), fewest homers (T-1st, 6), extra-base hits (2nd, 25) and ERA (6th, 2.94).

• Since May 1, the D-backs bullpen's 17.4 (8 IS/46 IR) inherited runners allowed pct. is second in MLB, behind the Marlins' 12.5 pct. (5 IS/40 IR).

CLARKE'S STREAK: **Taylor Clarke**, since April 28, is scoreless in his last 16 games (13.1 IP), tied for the longest active reliever scoreless streak with Aroldis Chapman/BOS (16)...is 1-0 with an opponent .114 AVG (5-for-44)/.280 OPS, 0.60 WHIP, 3 walks and 8 strikeouts.

VS. MARLINS: The D-backs swept their last 3-game series @ Marlins from April 15-17, 2025 and split the season series 3-3.

• The D-backs are 10-2 in their last 12 games at loanDepot Park and have taken 3 of the last 4 series, all via 3-0 sweeps.
