HEY FELLERS: The Giants look to win this series, and their season series, over the Colorado Rockies with a win in today's finale...SF is 8-8 in rubber games this season.

- ▶ The Giants are 3-5 through the first eight games of this season-long nine-game homestand.
- ▶ Since the All-Star break, SF's 10-17 (.370) record is tied for the fourth-worst in MLB over that span, ahead of only the Pirates (10-18, .357), Guardians (9-18, .333) and A's (7-20, .259).
- ▶ Yesterday's win snapped a streak of three straight home day game losses for SF, moving the Giants up to a 14-13 (.519) record in home day games this season.

LU-LU-LU, I'VE GOT SOME APPLES: RHP Blade Tidwell will make his first career start vs. Colorado...the rookie has made two starts since being recalled following the trade deadline, posting a 2.53 ERA (3er, 10.2ip), nine strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP in the two outings.

- ▶ In his last start, August 10 vs. Houston, Astros batters went 1-for-8 with four strikeouts vs. Tidwell's sweeper (38.1% usage rate this season).
- ▶ Despite never facing Colorado in the Majors, Tidwell has faced a few Rockies in the minors...TJ Rumfield is 4-for-13 (.308) with two homers vs. Tidwell, Zac Veen is 1-for-5 (.200) with two strikeouts and Jordan Beck is 2-for-4 (.500) with a double and a homer.

WHEN YOUR ENEMY IS NICE TO YOU, YOU JUST BE NICE RIGHT BACK: The Giants are 6-6 in 12 games so far this season against the Rockies (4-2 here at home and 2-4 at Coors Field)...today's game decides the season series winner.

- ▶ SF has won five straight season series vs. the Rockies dating to the 2021 season, last losing its season series vs. Colorado in 2020 (4-6)...dating back to 2019, SF has won six of the seven completed season series vs. COL.
- ▶ The Giants have won each of their last eight completed home series vs. COL dating to Sept. 2022 and have won 12 of their last 13 home series vs. COL since the start of 2021.
- ▶ SF's eight home series win streak is its longest against the Rockies in their matchup history...it's tied for SF's longest active streak versus any team (also the Phillies) and tied for its longest against a divisional opponent all-time (two eight home series win streaks vs. San Diego from 1970-73 and 2011-2014) (Stats, LLC).

HOW CAN THY GROUND THAT WHICH IS UNGROUNDABLE: With seven runs scored in yesterday's win, SF eclipsed five runs in a game for the first time this month, last scoring 6+ on July 29 (16-3 win over Milwaukee)...the 14-game streak without scoring 6+ runs in a game was tied for the fourth-longest streak in the Majors in 2026.

- ▶ SF scored six of its seven runs in the 4th inning yesterday...it marked the third time this season in which the Giants scored six or more runs in a single inning at home.

OH, HAMBURGERS: OF Jung Hoo Lee had two hits in the 4th inning yesterday, marking the third time this season he had two hits in an inning (also May 31 at COL and June 4 at MIL).

- ▶ Lee became the first player in the Majors with three instances of two hits in a single inning in a season since CHC's Dansby Swanson did so in 2023...he is the first Giants batter with three instances of two hits in a single inning in one season since at least 1974 (Stats, LLC).

HE'S MY BEST FRIEND IN THE WHOLE WORLD: OF Drew Gilbert homered among three-hits yesterday...he is batting .319 (15x47) with 11 runs, a triple, two homers and seven RBI over his last 18 games dating to July 24.

- ▶ In 17 career games vs. COL, he has a slash line of .409/.458/.864 (1.322 OPS) with nine runs, 18 hits, nine extra-base hits (three doubles, a triple and five homers) and 13 RBI.
- ▶ His .409 batting average is the best by a Giants batter through their first 14 career games with an at-bat vs. the Rockies since J.T. Snow had a .426 average (1997-1998).

MOM, DAD, I LOVE YOU. PLEASE DON'T SELL ME TO PARIS HILTON: The Giants will hit the road postgame and after an off day in Cleveland tomorrow, will play three games vs. the Guardians (Tuesday-Thursday) before ending the week with three games vs. the Red Sox (Friday-Sunday)...SF went 1-2 vs. Cleveland last year, and 2-1 vs. the Red Sox in 2025.

- ▶ The Giants are 14-25 (.359) against Interleague opponents this season.

BALL ME BLADE: Tidwell is in his second season in the Majors, first with the Giants after being acquired from New York-NL at last year's trade deadline as part of the return for reliever **Tyler Rogers**...the Giants also acquired **OF Drew Gilbert** and **RHP José Buttó**...Tidwell ranks as the Giants' No. 13 prospect per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Was added into the Giants rotation following the trade deadline...made his second start of the year on August 10 against the Houston Astros and threw a career-high 5.2 innings, allowing one run on four hits with a career-high six strikeouts in the Giants' 6-3 loss to Houston...he generated 12 whiffs with his sweeper, which were the most by a Giant with a breaking ball in a single start this year.

VS. COLORADO: Is facing the Rockies for the first time in his career.

IN THE 'PEN: Pitched eight games for the Giants out of the bullpen in April, logging a 3.00 ERA (4er, 12.0ip), 10 strikeouts and a 1.08 WHIP before being optioned back to Triple-A to get stretched out as a starter.

WITH THE RIVER CATS: Tidwell went 2-3 with a 4.38 ERA (35er, 72.0ip), 78 strikeouts and a 1.46 WHIP in 16 starts (15 games) with Triple-A Sacramento this season...his 78 strikeouts were the second-most on the River Cats this season behind **LHP Carson Whisenhunt** with 90.

SWEEP THE LEG: His sweeper has been his most used pitch in the Majors (38.1%)...opponents were just 1-for-8 off his sweeper in his last start and 3-for-17 over his last two starts...in the minors opponents were .208 (16x77) with 33 strikeouts.

HEY BUDDY: Tidwell, **OF Drew Gilbert**, Manager **Tony Vitello**, Director of ML Pitching **Frank Anderson** and Director of Performance **Quentin Eberhardt** were all together at the University of Tennessee...Tidwell is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.

RIGHT ON: Has held righties to just seven hits in 44 at-bats (.159 average) compared to a .325 mark (13x40) against lefties...left-handers are 11-for-their-last-30 (.367) off him over his last four outings, dating back to April 23.

HOME SWEET HOME: In eight home starts for the River Cats, Tidwell went 2-2 with a 2.82 ERA (12er, 38.1ip) compared to a 6.11 ERA (19er, 28.0ip) in seven road games (six starts)...in the Majors, Tidwell has allowed just one run in 12.2 innings (0.71 ERA) at home while allowing six runs in 10.0 innings on the road (5.40 ERA).

Prior to his solid outing, he'd allowed 14 runs on 17 hits in 11.2 innings in his prior three starts from July 26-August 5...he walked nine and struck out 14 in that time.
