## AROUND THE HORN

**SERPIENTES REPLICA JERSEY AND POSTGAME FIREWORKS:** Tomorrow, Postgame Fireworks return with music from My Chemical Romance and Jimmy Eat World to celebrate their upcoming concert at Chase Field on September 6...on Saturday, the first 25,000 fans can get a Serpientes Replica Jersey courtesy of Talking Stick Resort.

**MEXICAN BASEBALL HALL OF FAME:** On May 12, the Mexican Baseball Hall of Fame announced its Mexican Baseball Immortals of Class 2026, featuring the D-backs' own **Erubiel Durazo** and **Rodrigo Lopez** in the "Mexicans in Major Leagues" category...**Durazo**, who was a member of the D-backs' 2001 World Championship team, played 4 seasons (1999-2002) with Arizona and has served as D-backs Special Advisor on Mexico to the President, CEO & General Partner since 2016...**Lopez** pitched for the D-backs in 2010, where he led the team in innings (200.0) and starts (33), and has served as an analyst for D-backs Spanish Radio broadcasts since 2014 as well as GM of Team Mexico in the WBC in 2023 and 2026.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs' 4 straight wins match their longest win streak of the season (also: April 14-18)... last had 5+ straight wins in 2025 (April 12-17 and June 9-14).

- The D-backs are 5-1 in their last 6 games and 8-3 since May 9, tied for the second-best NL record in the span (also: Braves and Phillies), behind the Brewers (9-2).
- The D-backs' bullpen has held opponents scoreless in 3 straight games and 12 of 18 games in May.
- At home vs. Rockies, the D-backs have won 4 straight games, 9 of their last 10 and are 20 of 25 since July 9, 2022.
- The D-backs have consecutive comeback wins and their 16 are second in MLB, behind the Braves.
- **Ketel Marte** has a 4-game hitting streak, batting .500 (8-for-16)/1.526 with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 2 walks (0 K).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely 2+ times in a career-high 8 straight games (also is season-high 8-game hit streak), batting .423 (11-for-26)/1.506 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 10 walks (4 K).

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 6-3 vs. Giants yesterday for their second series sweep.

- **Merrill Kelly** tossed his third consecutive quality start (6.0 IP, 8 H, 0 BB, 4 K).
- **Ketel Marte** set season highs with 3 hits and 4 times on base (3 H, 1 BB)...homered in his second consecutive game and recorded 2+ RBI for a third straight game.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** had a season-high-tying 3 RBI with a sac fly and 2-run double.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** went 2-for-3 and has reached base safely in 3 straight games.
- **Paul Sewald** recorded his NL-third-best 11th save and at home is 6-for-6 in saves.

**MINORS LEADERS:** D-backs' farmhands among Minor League Baseball's Top 10 leaders (among all levels):

- Double-A Amarillo INF **Manuel Peña:** HR (2nd, 16), RBI (T-7th, 40), XBH (T-3rd, 25) and TB (4th, 105)

**MILESTONES:** **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy (49 in 533 G) of 50 career and 4 from setting the club record (current: Stephen Drew, 52 in 773 G).

**PEN IN MAY:** In May, the D-backs bullpen ranks among the Majors in fewest hits (1st, 28), fewest walks (1st, 14), WHIP (1st, 0.92), opponent AVG (1st, .177), OBP (1st, .256), fewest homers (T-1st, 0), OPS (2nd, .490), fewest extra-base hits (2nd, 8) and ERA (3rd, 1.97).

**RISP:** In their last 6 games with runners in scoring position, the D-backs are hitting .361 (22-for-61)/.949 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 31 RBI and 7 walks.

**DIVISION SHOWDOWNS:** The D-backs are 5-1 in this stretch of 13 straight NL West matchups (2-1 from May 15-17 @ Rockies, 3-0 from May 18-20 vs. Giants, May 21-24 vs. Rockies, May 25-27 @ Giants) and 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

**SEWALD SAVES:** **Paul Sewald's** 8 saves facing the minimum batters are most in MLB, ahead of Mason Miller/SD (6).

**ABOVE .500:** The D-backs are 2 games above .500 for the first time since April 30 (16-14)...the last time they were 3 games above was April 29 (16-13).

- The D-backs were a season-high 5 games above .500 on April 18.

**SERIES WINS:** The D-backs have won 3 of their last 4 series (won 2-1 vs. Mets, lost 1-2 @ Rangers, won 2-1 @ Rockies, won 3-0 vs. Giants).

**OFFENSE OUT OF THE GATES:** Since May 15 from innings 1-3, the D-backs have scored 20 runs and are batting .373 (28-for-75)/1.017 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 10 walks and 7 stolen bases.

**STARTING STRONG:** Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded a MLB-leading 11 quality starts in their last 15 outings and allowed 2 or fewer runs in 9 of those.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 98.1), IP/G (1st, 6.2), OBP (2nd, .258), ERA (3rd, 2.65), WHIP (4th, 1.00), opponent AVG (6th, .208) and strikeouts (T-6th, 81).

**BULLPEN AT HOME:** In their last 9 home games, they carry a 0.42 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 21.2 IP) with an opponent .113 AVG (8-for-71), 4 walks and 17 strikeouts.

- In their combined 24 May appearances, has held lefties to a 1.00 ERA (1 ER in 9.0 IP), .133 AVG (4-for-30)/.354 OPS with 2 walks and 7 strikeouts.

**VS. ROCKIES:** The D-backs have won 11 of their last 13 series since 2023, going 29-13 (.690).

- Have won 7 straight home series since Aug. 7, 2022 and 13 of their last 14 home series since Sept. 27, 2020.

- **Ketel Marte** has his safely in 11 of his last 14 games, batting .415 (22-for-53)/1.209 OPS with 10 doubles, 2 homers, 14 RBI and 7 walks.

- **Corbin Carroll** has a 10-game hitting streak, batting .350 (14-for-40)/1.258 OPS with 3 doubles, 5 homers, 10 RBI and 8 walks.

- Earned his team-leading sixth win on May 17 @ Rockies (2 ER in 5.2 IP, 6 H, 2 BB, 8 K).
