I DON'T KNOW WHAT YOU'VE BEEN UP TO... The St. Louis Cardinals conclude a seven-game road trip over eight days in the Golden State with the final game of a three-game series against the A.L. West division-leading Athletics in West Sacramento. The Cardinals split a four-game series at San Diego (2-2) to begin the road trip and have split the first two games of this series (1-1). A win today would give them their 4th straight road trip with a .500 or better record.

OH LOOK, HE'S FLYING: Following today's game, the Cardinals will fly back to St. Louis and begin a six-game, seven-day homestand against Kansas City and Pittsburgh at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals and Royals are "natural rivals" and will play a weekend series in St. Louis (May 15-17) and in the City of Fountains (June 18-21). St. Louis will not travel west of the Twin Cities until after the All-Star Break to Phoenix.

ALL YOUR WORK'S DONE, LET'S GO: St. Louis enters play today at 24-18 and in 3rd place in the National League Central, 2.5 games behind first place Chicago and percentage points behind 2nd place Milwaukee.

THE OTHER GUYS: Yesterday, all five teams in the National League Central lost for the first time all season. Three times this season, all five Central Division teams won (April 5, 15 & 17). Entering play today, all five teams in the National League Central have winning records with Cincinnati anchoring the division at 22-21. -Elias Sports Bureau

YOU LOSE THAT BATTLE 9 TIMES OUT OF 10: Through nine games played on **Tuesday** and **Thursday**, the Cardinals are an unblemished 9-0. They are the only team with an undefeated record on days that begin with the letter "T". The next closest teams in wins are Minnesota (8-4) and New York-AL (8-3).

DIRTY MIKE AND THE BOYS: Today's starting pitcher is California native **Michael McGreevy**. The Cardinals 2021 first round pick out of UC-Santa Barbara enters today's game on a team-best 14.0-inning scoreless streak, sporting a 2.18 ERA (9th NL), 0.86 WHIP (3rd) and .186 opponent BA (8th). McGreevy struck out a career-high nine batters in his last start at San Diego (5/8) over 6.0 innings of one-hit ball. Since April 26, McGreevy ranks 4th in MLB with an 0.50 ERA behind **Shane Bieber** (0.00, 16.2 IP, TB), **Jacob deGrom** (0.00, 18.1 IP, MIL) and **Foster Griffin** (0.45, 20.0 IP, WSH).

I'M A PEACOCK, YOU GOTTA LET ME FLY!: Cardinals rookies **JJ Wetherholt (9)** and **Nathan Church (6)** rank 1st and tied for 2nd among Major League rookies in go-ahead RBI. Wetherholt is also tied for the MLB rookie lead with **Owen Caissie (MIA)** for game-winning RBI with six. The second baseman also ranks 4th among rookies with eight home runs, which is second only to **Jordan Walker (11)** on the Cardinals.

I FEEL LIKE I'M PARTNERS WITH THE HULK: **Alec Burleson** and **Jordan Walker** are tied for the Cardinals team lead with 45 hits and 30 RBI through the first 42 games. Walker leads the Cardinals with 11 home runs, while Burleson leads with 11 doubles.

IT'S THE MOST STABLE JOB I CAN THINK OF: Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** is one away from career win No. 350 and two from tying Hall of Fame manager **Joe Torre (1990-95)** for 10th in Cardinals history with 351. Earlier this trip, the 39-year old Marmol passed **Miller Huggins (346)** into 11th place all-time on the Cardinals list. Marmol, is the 3rd-longest tenured manager among his National League peers (**Dave Roberts, LA & Torey Lovullo, ARI**) and the 2nd-youngest manager in MLB.

WE NOW HAVE A TASTE OF LION: With his 12th save Tuesday night, **Riley O'Brien** has the 5th-most saves by a Cardinal through 42 games since **Ryan Helsley** locked down 13 in the first 42 of the 2024 season, a year when he set the franchise record with 49. **Lee Smith (14 in 1992)** holds the mark for the most Cardinals saves through 42 games.

WE'RE IN THE GAME AND WE KNOW THE SCORE: Cardinals lefty reliever **JoJo Romero** achieved his 14th Hold of the season, tying **Steve Kline (2001-04)** for 3rd place all-time in Cardinals history with his 71st Hold. Only southpaw **Kevin Siegrist (78)** and RHP **Giovanny Gallegos (78)** stand above.

SACRAMENTO & ATHLETICS CONNECTIONS

Jacob Wilson's father, **Jack Wilson**, was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1998 MLB Draft and played parts of three minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization before being traded to the Pirates for LHP **Jason Christiansen (July 29, 2000)**.

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray's** son, **Chris Caray**, is an Athletics broadcaster.

Justin Bruhl was born in nearby Petaluma, Calif. **Joel Kuhnel** made his MLB debut on Aug. 16, 2019 vs. St. Louis while pitching for Cincinnati.

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City, Calif...graduated from St. Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at University of California, Davis (2005-07)...resides in Danville, Calif.

Cardinals Minor League Outfield Coordinator **Ryan Ludwick** was a 2nd round draft pick of the Athletics in 1999 and Cardinals Special Advisor & Pitching Instructor **Jason Isringhausen** pitched for the Athletics from 1999-2001 before he signed with St. Louis as a free agent in December 2001.

Cardinals Pitching Strategist **Dean Kiekhefer** pitched in four games for the Athletics during the 2018 season.

Athletics Hitting Coach **Mike Aldrete** was the Cardinals Asst. Hitting Coach (2008-11) and Bench Coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 NL pennant winner...his son, **Michael Aldrete**, was selected by St. Louis in the 39th round of the 2012 Draft.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and A's Special Assistant to Player Development **Mark McGwire** played parts of 12 seasons in Oakland (1986-97)...1987 AL Rookie of the Year...1989 World Series Champion & member of three AL pennant winners (1988-90)...eight-time AL All-Star (1987-92, '95-97)...won two Silver Sluggers (1992 & '96) and one Gold Glove (1990)...selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#10) in the 1984 MLB Draft...traded to St. Louis for **Eric Ludwick, T.J. Mathews** and **Blake Stein**.

Hall of Famer and A's Special Assistant to the President **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

Athletics Quality Control Coach **Marcus Jensen** played 16 games for St. Louis in 1999.

Athletics Roving Coach **Stephen Piscotty** was a Cardinals 2012 1st round draft pick and played in 323 games for St. Louis from 2015-17 before the A's acquired him on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Yairo Muñoz** and **Max Schrock**.

Cardinals Assistant Hitting Coach **Brandon Allen** played in 44 games for the A's from 2011-12 & was the A's Opening Day First Baseman in 2012.

Athletics Head Athletic Trainer **Jeff Collins** is a SIU Carbondale graduate.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a manager of the Athletics (1986-95) and Cardinals (1996-2011)...is only manager to win multiple pennants in both leagues and one of two (Sparky Anderson) to win a World Series in both...His 70 postseason victories (50 with St. Louis, 19 with Oakland, & 1 with Chicago) rank 2nd to Joe Torre (84)...La Russa piloted the A's to four division titles, three AL pennants, and the 1989 World Championship...is A's franchise wins leader (798)...also played parts of four seasons in Oakland (1968-71).

Mgr. of Baseball Info. & Media Services **Chris Tunno** was the clubhouse manager for the Athletics California League affiliate, Stockton Ports (A) at the beginning of the 2007 season under manager **Darren Bush**, current A's bench coach..

TODAY'S STARTER:

- The 25-year-old San Clemente native is making his 9th start of the 2026 season today, 30th career start (32nd career game).
- Since his Major League debut July 31, 2024, ranks 13th in MLB in winning percentage (.700, 14-6).
- The Cardinals are 20-9 (.690 win pct.) in his 29 career games started**, losing consecutive games that he has started just twice. St. Louis is 5-3 (.625) in his games started this season.
- Enters today's start on an active 14.0 scoreless innings streak dating back to April 26, and **has compiled consecutive scoreless 6.0 inning starts (May 2-present). The last Cardinal to hurl three consecutive shutout starts of 6.0+ innings was Kwang Hyun Kim (19.0 IP) from July 5-17, 2021.**
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 17 of 27 career starts, including his last three (April 26-present).
- Allowed two runs or fewer in six of eight starts this season.
- Since joining the Cardinals rotation last June, St. Louis has posted 15 wins in his games started - the most among all Cardinals starters.
- Has made 15 career appearances (13 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-3 with a 3.58 ERA (83.0 IP). Boasts a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP) in four starts at home this season.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, May 8 at Petco Park): W, 6-0; 6.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 9 SO; 94 pitches

- San Clemente native fanned a career-high nine batters (all swinging strike three) while hurling 6.0 shutout frames of one-hit ball as the Cardinals shut out the Padres in San Diego last Friday night.
- McGreevy's lone blemish was a Jackson Merrill single to begin the 4th inning.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's 6th-lowest percent (20.2) of Swing & Miss; Ranks 2nd in the NL among starting pitchers with a .200 BABIP and his difference in Opp. BA (.184) vs. xBA (.275) is the largest among all MLB starting pitchers (-.091).

ONE-HIT WONDER: Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (5/8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

DODGE BALL: Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

THROW IT BACK: Didn't hook any keepers in 5-3 loss at Miami on April 20, allowing a season-high 4 runs over his 5.2 IP; the loss snapped the Cardinals season-high 5-game win streak.

CURLY W: Limited Washington to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on April 8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS: Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elías*

RARE BIRD: In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the second pitcher in Cardinals history to throw a hitless start in one of the first two starts of the season (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0 or more innings. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) followed with 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

SPRING FLING: Went 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 Spring Training starts, striking out 16 to just 2 walks but did allow a team-high 6 HR's; Led MLB with his 4 Spring Training wins and ranked in top 10 in ERA (2.45), Opp. BA (.229) and WHIP (0.98)

MCGREEVY vs. ATHLETICS:

- Southern California native is making his 1st career appearance/start against the Athletics and just his 8th career Interleague appearance (1-1, 2.04 ERA, 30.2 IP).
- His lone A.L. win came when he defeated Texas in his MLB debut (July 31, 2024 at Busch Stadium).
- This is his 5th Interleague opponent in his nine starts this year, having already faced Tampa Bay, Detroit, Cleveland, and Seattle.
- Has worked 5.0 or more IP in six of his seven career Interleague starts (four Quality Starts).
- Lifetime 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (19.0 IP) in three starts vs. the AL West Division.
- Has made three starts at American League ballparks: Chicago's Rate Field, Seattle's T-Mobile Park, and Detroit's Comerica Park.
