**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles were victorious in yesterday's series opener at Arizona, 5-1...The Birds improve to 3-1 in series openers on the year...Baltimore continues their six-game road trip this evening in Arizona (2 to play) before enjoying their second off day of the season on April 10.

👉 **Zach Eflin** completed his third consecutive quality start to begin the season, becoming the first Orioles starter to do so since **Dylan Bundy** in 2018 (also 3) and just the seventh to do so since 2000...The last Orioles starter to have four or more consecutive quality starts to open a season was also Bundy, who did so in eight consecutive starts in 2017.

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** tallied his second career game of at least two hits, two runs scored, and two stolen bases...Henderson is one of eight Orioles with multiple such games since 2000, joining teammate, **Cedric Mullins**, who has six such games since 2021.

👉 The Birds have registered one home run or fewer in eight straight games (2 HR overall), marking their longest run since September 20 to October 1, 2023 (11 G).

👉 The Orioles have not recorded a save through the first 11 games of the season for the first time since 2002 (12 G)...The Braves, Twins, and White Sox are the only other clubs in the majors that have yet to tally a save.

**KNOCK(S) ON WOOD:** The Birds have recorded 95 hits, ranking fourth in the AL behind the Red Sox (105), Yankees (99), and Blue Jays (96), and seventh in the majors...The 95 hits are the most by a Baltimore club through 11 games since the 2016 O's (109 H).

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of 10 players in the AL with two games of three or more hits...Of the 10, seven reside in the AL East (BOS' Wilyer Abreu/Alex Bregman, NYY's Paul Goldschmidt/Aaron Judge, TB's Jake Mangum, and TOR's Bo Bichette).

**FEEL THE RUTSCH:** **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first 10 games, the longest season-opening streak by an Oriole since **Anthony Santander** (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022...**Aaron Hicks** reached base safely in each of his first 12 games from May 31 to June 14, 2023, but did not sign with the club until May 30 that season.

👉 Rutschman has also gone 17 straight games with one strikeout or fewer since September 21, 2024, tied for the second-longest streak of his career (also 8/3-24/24)...His career best streak is 18 straight from July 23 to August 12, 2022.

**SOUTHPAW SUCCESS:** Since 2024, **Tyler O'Neill's** 1.126 OPS against left-handed pitching ranks third in MLB behind NYY's Aaron Judge (1.296) and SF's Heliot Ramos (1.170)...During the same time frame, **Ryan Mountcastle** (.326, 47-for-144) and **Adley Rutschman** (.324, 56-for-173), rank sixth and seventh, respectively, in batting average against lefties among AL batters...Last season, the Orioles' .253 batting average against left-handers ranked second in the AL and eighth in the majors...Baltimore's 59 homers versus lefties were tied for the most in the AL and for fifth in MLB.

**GONE SNAKE HUNTING:** **Tyler O'Neill** has played in a team-high 16 games at Chase Field and produced a .527 slugging percentage, having gone 14-for-55 at the plate with six doubles and three home runs with eight runs scored, 10 RBI, and one walk.

👉 In five career games at Chase Field, **Ryan O'Hearn** has gone 8-for-22 with three doubles, one home run, three runs scored, and five RBI...The lone homer came yesterday off Zac Gallen in the first inning, his first home run of the season.

👉 **Cedric Mullins** has gone 5-for-15 with a home run, two runs scored, five RBI, and two walks in four games at Arizona.

**SHAKE AND BAKE:** **Bryan Baker** has tossed 5.1 scoreless innings to open the season, scattering three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts across five appearances.

👉 **Gregory Soto** has thrown 5.0 scoreless innings over his first five appearances, allowing three hits, two walks, and one hit batter while fanning eight...In 25 appearances since August 8, 2024, Soto is 1-0 with a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP), 0.94 WHIP, and 28 strikeouts.

👉 **Seranthony Domínguez** has gone 1-0 across 4.2 scoreless innings pitched this season, allowing just one hit and four walks with six strikeouts...He has struck out multiple hitters in consecutive outings and at least one in each of his last four games.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER:** In Baltimore's five wins this season, **Cedric Mullins** is 7-for-19 (.368) with one double, two home runs, 11 RBI, five runs, three walks, one steal, and one hit-by-pitch...In the O's six losses, he is 3-for-16 (.188) with one double and one home run.

👉 Mullins has drawn a walk in a career-high-tying four straight games (7x, last: 7/28-31/2024).

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Baltimore is an MLB-best 103-67 (.606) on the road since 2023, ahead of Houston (95-70, .576) and Los Angeles-NL (96-72, .571).

👉 **Cedric Mullins** has reached base safely in 11 straight road games since September 25, 2024, going 14-for-39 (.359) with two doubles, two home runs, and seven RBI in that time...It is tied for the second-longest streak of his career, trailing only a 12-gamer from September 24, 2020 to April 17, 2021.

👉 **Ryan O'Hearn** has reached base safely in nine straight road games since September 27, 2024, batting .406 (13-for-32) with three doubles, three homers, and five RBI in this span.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** The O's are batting .345 (19-for-55) with runners in scoring position in their five wins, compared to .125 (3-for-24) in their six losses...**Cedric Mullins** paces the club with a .556 (5-for-9) RISP average.

👉 O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .202 (19-for-94) clip with RISP, the second-lowest mark in the AL behind the Blue Jays (.200, 15-for-75) and the sixth-lowest in MLB.

**SMALL SAMPLE:** Oriole batters have a 10.8 percent barrel rate, the fifth-highest mark in the majors behind the Yankees (15.2%), Mets (11.7%), Red Sox (11.4%), and Braves (10.9%).

👉 O's pitching has produced a 30.5 percent chase rate, the fourth-highest mark in the AL behind the Rays (32.3%), Twins (31.1%), and Red Sox (30.7%)...Baltimore also owns a 63.2 percent first pitch strike rate, the fourth-best mark in the AL.

**THE VALLEY:** The Orioles and D-Backs continue a three-game set this evening at Chase Field...The O's won the 2024 season set, 2-1, taking the first two games before dropping the series finale in Baltimore...Since 2016, the Birds have gone 3-1 in their last four series against Arizona, including a three-game sweep at Oriole Park in 2016...The O's have compiled a 9-4 record against the D-Backs during this stretch.

**QUICK HITS:** Morton is set to make his third start of the season and 16<sup>th</sup> of his career tonight against Arizona...Made four Grapefruit League starts, recording a 3.38 ERA (3 ER/8.0 IP) on nine hits and one walk with six strikeouts...Signed a one-year contract with the Orioles on January 3, 2025...Made 30 starts with the Braves in 2024, going 8-10 with a 4.19 ERA (77 ER/165.1 IP) on 154 hits (23 HR), 85 total runs, 65 walks, and 18 hit batters with 167 strikeouts...Was on Atlanta's NLWC roster, but did not appear in a game.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was dealt his second consecutive loss in his Orioles home debut on April 3 vs. Boston...Allowed five runs on six hits (2 HR) and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Has received losing decisions in each of his first two starts of the season for the second time in his career (2010, five straight losses)...At 41 years, 142 days old, he became the oldest Orioles pitcher to record 10 strikeouts in a game in franchise history (since 1954), per [@SlangsOnSports](#)...Threw 98 pitches, 63 strikes.

**SNAKE EYES:** He has made 15 career starts opposite Arizona, going 5-3 with a 4.27 ERA (41 ER/86.1 IP) on 78 hits (7 HR), 34 walks, and six hit batters with 87 strikeouts...Is 2-2 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER/50.1 IP) on 47 hits (6 HR), 17 walks, and four hit batters with 48 strikeouts in nine career starts at Chase Field.

🍷 Has pitched 5.0+ innings in 12 consecutive starts against the Diamondbacks, dating back to September 20, 2011.

🍷 In 70 career starts against NL West opponents, he is 23-20 with a 3.54 ERA (162 ER/412.1 IP) on 361 hits (38 HR), 157 walks, and 39 hit batters with 381 strikeouts.

**LIKE FINE WINE:** In his Orioles debut, at 41 years and 136 days old, Morton became the oldest pitcher in franchise history to start a game for the Orioles, surpassing Orlando Peña (39y, 177d) on May 13, 1973-G1 at New York-AL...The oldest pitcher to ever appear in a game in club history is Jesse Orosco (42y, 160d) on September 28, 1999 at New York-AL.

🍷 His 167 strikeouts were the most by an Atlanta pitcher age 40 or older since Phil Niekro in 1980 (176).

**MODEL OF CONSISTENCY:** Morton has made 30+ starts in each of his last six full seasons (excluding 2020) since 2018...He joins Toronto's José Berríos, Texas' Patrick Corbin, and Philadelphia's Aaron Nola as the only pitchers in MLB to accomplish the feat during that stretch...Morton had not reached the 30-start mark in each of his first 12 seasons from 2008-19.

🍷 Last season, he became the fifth player in Braves franchise history to make 30 starts in his age 40 season or older, joining R.A. Dickey (2017), Phil Niekro (1979-80, 82-83), John Smoltz (2007), and Warren Spahn (1961-63).

**ABOVE THE CURVE:** In 2024, Morton utilized his curveball 42.2 percent of the time, limiting opponents to a .200 (55-for-275) average on the offering while producing a 34.2 percent whiff rate...Of his 167 strikeouts last season, 102 came on the curveball (61.1%).

🍷 He held left handed hitters to a .181 (26-for-144) clip against the curveball with 62 strikeouts, compared to .221 (29-for-131) with 40 strikeouts against right handers.

**WALK THIS WAY:** Morton has issued at least one walk in fifteen straight starts dating back to July 20, 2024 (G1)...The 15-game stretch is the fifth-longest active streak among MLB starters...Has walked multiple batters in 10 of the 15 outings.

**IT'S A MARATHON:** Last season, opponents slashed .272/.371/.491 (62-for-228) with 16 doubles, two triples, 10 home runs and 27 walks against Morton from innings 1-2... From innings 3-5, however, he limited the opposition to a .230/.314/.390 (69-for-300) line with 15 doubles, 11 home runs, and 29 walks.

**UPS AND DOWNS:** Morton's 3.97 run support average in 2024 was the sixth lowest in MLB (min. 120.0 IP) behind Pittsburgh's Luis Ortiz (3.32), Pittsburgh's Jared Jones (3.48), Washington's Patrick Corbin (3.50), Cincinnati's Hunter Greene (3.89), and St. Louis' Andre Pallante (3.93).

🍷 Under the same parameter, Morton's 6.72 run support average in 2023 was third highest in the major behind San Diego's Michael Wacha (7.50) and Chicago-NL's Drew Smyly (6.83).

🍷 Since 2023, Morton is 19-5 with a 3.33 ERA (69 ER/186.1 IP) when receiving three runs or more of support, compared to 3-19 with a 4.96 ERA (83 ER/150.2 IP) when receiving two runs or fewer.

**CHECKING THE BOXES:** Last season, Morton earned the victory on June 28 vs. Pittsburgh, giving him a win against all 30 teams; became the 22<sup>nd</sup> pitcher to accomplish the feat since baseball's most recent expansion in 1998, and one of four active players (TOR's Max Scherzer, NYY's Gerrit Cole, and SF's Justin Verlander) to do so.
