RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game homestand with the finale of a three-game series against their National League Central Division rivals, the Milwaukee Brewers (0-2). The Brewers won the first two games, 2-1 in 10 innings on Friday and 12-5 yesterday. On Monday, the Cardinals will host the Arizona Diamondbacks for three games (April 22-24). St. Louis plays 19 of their first 28 games against teams who made the 2023 Postseason.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 5.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (13-6) and 2.0 games behind Pittsburgh for 4th place. St. Louis has lost three straight games, marking their season high losing streak and longest losing stretch since Sept. 19-22, 2023 (4 games), with the first three losses of that streak to Milwaukee. The last time the Cardinals lost three straight home games and the last time they dropped four straight was a six-game streak from 6/10-24/2023 (2 vs. CIN, 3 vs. SF, 1 vs. CHI).

CARDINALS RECALL ROBERTSON & PAGÉS; OPTION SCOTT II & PAL-LANTE: Prior to today's game, the Cardinals optioned OF **Victor Scott II** and RHP **Andre Pallante** to Memphis (AAA). C **Pedro Pagés** and RHP **Nick Robertson** were recalled from Memphis. Pagés was last on the Major League roster on April 10 when he made his Major League debut. Robertson will be making his Cardinals debut, previously pitching 18 total games for the Los Angeles Dodgers and Boston Red Sox in 2023.

SKUNKY BEER: The Cardinals need a win today to avoid their first three-game sweep of the season and first at home since June 12-14, 2023, to the San Francisco Giants. Currently, St. Louis has lost their last five home games to Milwaukee, a feat not accomplished since they dropped six straight during the 2008 season (4/17-8/26), which is their longest losing streak to the Brewers in Busch Stadium III history. The Brewers have not swept the Cardinals since Sept. 24-26, 2018 at Busch Stadium.

DIVISIONAL DIVIDE: Only three of the Cardinals first 37 games are against divisional opponents. Prior to this season, the fewest divisional games for St. Louis through the first 37 games was six in 1996. - *Elias Sports Bureau*

SON-DAY: The Cardinals look to **Sonny Gray** to be the stopper as the Cardinals ace has won his first two starts for the Cardinals and has not allowed a run or issued a walk in his first 11 innings pitched, a feat no Cardinals pitcher has done before in his first two starts. - *Elias Sports Bureau* ... In the Wild Card Era (since 1995), only **Jordan Montgomery** (2022) and **Pat Hentgen** (2000) have won their first three starts as a member of the Cardinals.

SHUFFLING THE DECK: For the first time since April 14, 2013, first baseman **Paul Goldschmidt** will be starting and batting in the No. 5 position. Goldschmidt has started 84 games in his career batting 5th, all with the Arizona Diamondbacks. Goldschmidt has appeared in the No. 5 slot in the order 87 games in his career and is batting .309 with 16 HR. Of active players with 300 or more plate appearances batting 5th, Goldschmidt ranks 3rd in batting (.309) behind only **Juan Soto** (.326) and **Matt Duffy** (.324).

DAY GAMES: St. Louis is 2-8 in day games this season, while the Brewers are a Major League-best 8-2 (.800) under the sun. The Cardinals are scheduled to play 29 home day games this season and 34 on the road.

GIVES ME THE WILLIES: **Willson Contreras** has reached base safely in a career-high 25 straight games dating back to Sept. 6, 2023. Contreras is also riding a career-best 13-game hitting streak since April 1 (.357/.471/.643, 15-42), currently the longest active in MLB and 2nd-longest this season to **Marcell Ozuna**, who snapped his streak at 17 last night.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Ryan Helsley made his MLB debut on April 16, 2019 at Milwaukee...his first strikeout victim was Ryan Braun (swinging) that night.

Willson Contreras' younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

Devin Williams was born in nearby Florissant, Mo...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Pre-season High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Joe Ross's older brother **Tyson Ross**, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** in exchange for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 3rd start of the season, and his 2nd at home this year.
- Has opened the season with 11.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher since **Austin Gomber** (14.2 IP) in 2020. **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003 has the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Is seeking to post three consecutive winning decisions for the first time since four in a row from April 1-30 of last season. Had 16 no-decisions while pitching for the Twins.
- Received 4+ runs of support in just 7 of his 32 starts last season; one run or fewer in 11 starts. His run support average (3.91) last season was 5th-lowest in MLB.
- Recently became the 13th active pitcher to reach the 100 win milestone, joining teammates **Lance Lynn** (137, 5th) and **Kyle Gibson** (105, 10th).
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn & Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Blanked his drafting team while striking out six over 6.0 innings in a 3-1 win over the Athletics at the Oakland Coliseum on Monday. Marked his 100th career win.
- Is the 20th pitcher in MLB history (and first associated with the Cardinals) to record career wins #1 and #100 in the same stadium for two different teams and first since **Jason Marquis** at Turner Field (w/ Atlanta & Washington). - *Elias*

CAREER

- Selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- His 3.45 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,532 strikeouts rank 15th.
- Has made seven career starts at Busch Stadium, with four of those being Quality Starts. He is 2-3, 2.90 ERA career at Busch (40.1 IP/13 ER). Five of his seven starts at Busch Stadium were with the Cincinnati Reds.

2024

- Made his Cardinals regular season debut on April 9 vs. Philadelphia. Joined **John Smoltz** (Aug. 23, 2009 at San Diego - 5 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K) as the 2nd Cardinal since 1901 (37th MLB pitcher overall) to pitch 5.0+ scoreless innings with 5 hits or fewer, zero walks, and 5+ strikeouts in his first game with the franchise.
- Struck out **Bryce Harper** (swinging) on April 9 for his first strikeout in a Cardinals uniform.
- Began the season on the 15-day I.L. with right hamstring injury, suffered on March 4.
- Had been named the team's Opening Day starter for 2024 before suffering injury. Was 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (3.2 IP) in his two Grapefruit League starts in spring.
- Worked in minor league training games at the Cardinals Jupiter complex and in a simulated game against the Springfield Cardinals (AAA) on April 3 while rehabbing his injury and building up his pitch count.

2023

- Pitched his second season with the Twins organization and his first season making 32 or more starts since a career-high 33 with Oakland in 2014.
- Finished 2nd in the 2023 American League Cy Young Award voting behind Gerrit Cole (NYY) who received 30 unanimous 1st place votes. Also ranked 18th in AL MVP voting.
- Led all Major League pitchers with an 0.39 HR/9 IP ratio in 2023, allowing just eight home runs over 184 innings pitched.
- Ranked 2nd in the American League with a 2.79 ERA (3rd in MLB) and was the lowest by a Twins pitcher since Johan Santana posted a 2.77 mark in 2006. Was 20th lowest qualifying ERA in Twins franchise history.
- Tied for first on the Twins staff in games started (32), ranked 2nd in innings pitched (184.0) and 3rd in strikeouts (183).
