AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their six-game road trip today with the final game a three-game series at Cleveland (2-0 thus far)...will also travel to Toronto for a three-game series this weekend (Fri.-Sun.).

- Their 40-26 (.606) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors.
- **Have won each of their last three games (since 6/7) and four of their last five (since 6/4)...are 10-4 in their last 14 games (since 5/24)** and 12-7 in their last 19 games (since 5/18)...**are 32-19 in their last 51 games (since 4/13).**
- Are a season-high-tying 14G over .500 (also 25-11 on 5/5 and 26-12 on 5/7).
- The Yankees'+99 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors...have outscored their opponents, 82-48, over their last 14 games (since 5/24).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees won their third straight game with a 3-2 victory against the Guardians on Tuesday at Progressive Field...**RHP Gerrit Cole** (4.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 4K, 0HR, 1HP) started and did not record a decision...**RF Spencer Jones** (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his first Major League home run with a go-ahead two-run shot in the second inning...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (1-for-3, 2R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base twice and hit his ninth HR of the season with a go-ahead solo shot in the eighth inning...**1B Paul Goldschmidt** (2-for-4, 1BB) and **3B Ryan McMahon** (2-for-3, 1BB) each reached base three times...**Yankees relievers** combined to toss 5.0 scoreless innings (5H, 2BB, 5K)...**RHP Fernando Cruz** (1.2IP, 1BB, 4K) tossed 1.2 scoreless innings of relief and stranded two inherited runners to earn his third career save and first of the season.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt reached base three times on Tuesday at Cleveland...**has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games (since 5/25), batting .327/.362/.545 (18-for-55) with 8R, 3 doubles, 3HR, 13RBI, 3BB and 1SB over that span.**

- Is batting .313/.378/.565 (36-for-115) with 18R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 7HR, 24RBI, 10BB, 2HP and 1SB over his last 32 games (since 4/26).
- **Has hit .379/.526/.655 (11-for-29) with 2 doubles, 2HR, 19RBI, 7BB and 2HP with RISP this season...** as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .326/.421/.449 (45-for-138) with 8 doubles, 3HR, 53RBI, 21BB/51BB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.
- **Has hit .400/.500/.800 (22-for-55) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 5HR, 8BB and 3HP vs. left-handed pitching this season...** ranks first in the Majors in OPS (1.300), SLG, and OBP, third in BA (first in AL) and tied for fifth in XBH (11, tied for first in AL).
- As a Yankee (since 2025), has batted .353/.436/.632 (72-for-204) with 19 doubles, 1 triple, 12HR, 25BB/51BB and 5HP vs. left-handed pitchers...ranks third in the Majors in BA (second in AL), OPS (1.068, third in AL) and SLG (third in AL), and fifth in OBP (third in AL).
- Has hit 3HR in his last 10 games (since 5/29).

ON A ROLL: OF Spencer Jones hit his first Major League home run with a go-ahead two-run shot in the second inning on Tuesday at Cleveland...has hit .500/.500/.786 (7-for-14) with 1R, 1 double, 1HR, 3RBI and 1SB over his last four starts (since 5/21).

McMAHON OF THE HOUR: INF Ryan McMahon reached base three times on Tuesday at Cleveland...has hit .326/.341/.628 (14-for-43) with 6R, 1 double, 4HR, 8RBI, 1BB and 1SB over his last 13 starts (since 5/19)...since 4/25, is batting .345/.367/.552 (10-for-29) with 2HR, 12RBI and 1BB with RISP.

TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: The Yankees are 15-6 when facing a left-handed starter this season...have won 13 of their last 15 games when facing a left-handed starter (since 4/18) and 14 of their last 18 games (since 4/13).

PEN PALS: Yankees relievers combined to toss 5.0 scoreless innings on Tuesday at Cleveland (5H, 2BB, 5K)...have posted a 0.90 ERA (20.0IP, 2ER) and 18K over their last five games (since 6/4).

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice has hit .297/.392/.626 (66-for-222) with 49R, 15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR, 45RBI, 34BB/31BB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 61 games this season...has reached base safely in 46-of-57 starts...35 of his 66H this year have been XBH (15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR).

GET THE BROOMS OUT: The Yankees will look to complete their sixth sweep of the season today...would mark their first sweep of the Guardians since a three-game sweep from 4/22-24/22 at Yankee Stadium and first sweep at Progressive Field of at least 3G since 8/10-12/07 (also 3G)...recorded a two-game sweep at Cleveland from 4/8-9/13.

CRUZ CONTROL: RHP Fernando Cruz tossed a season-high 1.2 scoreless innings of relief and stranded two inherited runners to earn the save on Tuesday at Cleveland (1BB, 4K)...marked his third career save and first of the season (also 4/16/25 vs. Kansas City and 4/20/25 at Tampa Bay)...struck out 4-of-6BF...marked his longest appearance since 8/31/25 at Chicago-AL (also 1.2IP).

- **Has stranded 25 of his 29 inherited runners this season, including 21 of his last 22 inherited runners (since 4/24).**
- **Has not allowed a run in 19 of his last 21 games (since 4/25), going 2-1 with one save, a 0.86 ERA (21.0IP, 2ER) and 24K during that stretch.**
- Has not allowed a run in 27 of his 32 games this season, going 3-1 with one save, a 1.84 ERA (29.1IP, 6ER) and 37K.

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. reached base twice and hit his ninth HR of the season with a go-ahead solo shot in the eighth inning on Tuesday at Cleveland...**five of his 9HR this year have either tied the game (two) or given the Yankees the lead (three)**...marked his fourth career HR that either tied the game or gave his team the lead in the eighth inning-or-later (first since a go-ahead two-run HR in the ninth inning on 4/8/22 at San Francisco with Miami).

- **Has hit 2HR in his last three games (since 6/7), 3HR in his last six games (since 6/3) and 4HR in his last 10 games (since 5/26).**
- Is batting .291/.360/.557 (23-for-79) with 15R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 5HR, 12RBI, 9BB, 1SF and 5SB over his last 21 games (since 5/13).

CLOSE CALLS: The Yankees have had five of their last six games (since 6/3) and 14 of their last 20 games (since 5/17) decided by 2R-or-fewer...eight of their last 20 games have been one-run games.

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger is hitting .296/.388/.533 (40-for-135) with 20R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 29RBI, 22BB, 4SB and 3SF over his last 37 games (since 4/28).

- Has hit .300/.330/.500 (27-for-90) with 8R, 3 doubles, 5HR, 15RBI, 6BB, 4SF and 4SB in 23 career games vs. Cleveland.
- Has recorded 11RBI in his last 13 games (since 5/25).
- Since 5/1, is hitting .349/.408/.651 (15-for-43) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR and 5BB vs. left-handed pitching.
- As a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .329/.392/.570 (75-for-228) with 16 doubles, 3 triples, 11HR, 27BB and 1HP against left-handed pitching...ranks seventh in the Majors in BA (fourth in AL), eighth in OPS (.962, fifth in AL) and 10th in SLG (seventh in AL) over that stretch.
- Is batting .316/.380/.456 (18-for-57) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 28RBI, 9BB and 5SF with RISP this season.
- According to FanGraphs, leads all Major Leaguers in DRS (15)...is tied for first in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (13, tied for first in AL) and tied for fifth in game-winning RBI (seven, tied for second in AL).

RODOMINANT: LHP Carlos Rodón will make his sixth start of the season today...has gone 1-2 with a 2.88 ERA (25.0IP, 8ER) and 27K in five starts this year, holding opponents to a .165 (14-for-85) BA...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of his five starts and 2ER-or-fewer in four starts.

- Has allowed 1R-or-fewer in each of his last three starts (since 5/21), posting a 1.59 ERA (17.0IP, 3ER) over that stretch.
- Has allowed only 1HR to 104BF this year, posting a 0.36 HR/9.0IP ratio.

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF Trent Grisham has hit safely in 14 of his last 17 games (since 5/19), batting .369/.438/.538 (24-for-65) with 11R, 5 doubles, 2HR, 6RBI, 8BB and 2SB over that span...has reached base multiple times in eight of his last 12 games (since 5/26) and 11 of his last 17 games (since 5/19).

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 13 of their last 17 starts (since 5/20), posting a 2.88 ERA (97.0IP, 31ER) over that span...have allowed 1ER-or-fewer in nine of their last 16 starts (since 5/21).

► Have posted a 3.15 ERA (362.2IP, 127ER) and 353K in 66 starts this season...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 54 starts this season, the most in the AL and the fourth-most in the Majors...marks their third-most in franchise history through their first 66 games of a season, trailing only their 57 starts in 2022 and 55 starts in 2024.

- Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.334), rank second in ERA (3.15, first in AL), WHIP (1.11, first in AL), opponents' BA (.212, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.282, first in AL), opponents' OPS (.616, first in AL) and HR/9.0IP (0.87, first in AL), sixth in strikeout rate (23.9%, third in AL) and K/BB (2.99, third in AL), seventh in strikeouts (353, fourth in AL) and eighth in innings pitched (362.2, fourth in AL) and BB/9.0IP (2.93, fourth in AL).

WALK IT OUT: Yankees batters lead the AL and rank third in the Majors with 281BB...marks their most walks through their first 66 games of a season in the last 20 years (since 2007) and their most since recording 281BB in 2006.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP CARLOS RODÓN (1-2, 2.88 ERA)

LHP Carlos Rodón will make his sixth start of the season in today's series finale at Cleveland...the 33-year-old will make the start on extended five days' rest...made his fifth start of the season on Thursday vs. Cleveland, recording a no decision despite allowing just 1R/ER in 6.0IP (2H, 3BB, 7K, 0HR)...missed the first 40 team games of the season...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list on 5/10...made three rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, posting a 3.38 ERA (16.0IP, 13H, 7R/6ER, 3BB, 16K, 3HR)...was placed on the 15-day injured list on 3/25 (retroactive to 3/22) recovering from left elbow surgery...underwent a left elbow arthroscopy procedure on 10/15/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at the Kerlan-Jobe Surgery Center in Los Angeles, Calif...went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts last season...set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco)...opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR)...recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...since 2021, ranks fifth in the Majors with an 10.64 K/9.0IP ratio...is also tied for seventh in double-digit strikeout games (21) over that span, trailing only Dylan Cease (28), Kevin Gausman (25), Blake Snell (25), Gerrit Cole (25), Zack Wheeler (23) and Corbin Burnes (22)...has recorded at least 10K and OBB in nine games, tied for the fifth-most such games in the Majors during that stretch, trailing only Wheeler (13), Gausman (12), Jacob deGrom (11) and Cole (10)...has pitched over parts of 12 Major League seasons with the Chicago White Sox (2015-21), San Francisco Giants (2022) and Yankees (2023-26)...has finished in the top-six of Cy Young voting three times (fifth in 2021 and sixth in 2022 and '25)...is a three-time All-Star (2021-22, '25)...has made six Opening Day rosters (2016, '19-22, '24-25)...began the 2017, 2018, 2023 and 2026 seasons on the injured list...was originally selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 16th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play three seasons at North Carolina State University (2012-14)...was selected by the Chicago White Sox in the first round (third overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft...signed a six-year Major League contract with the Yankees extending through the 2028 season on 12/21/22.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his fifth start of the season on Thursday vs. Cleveland, recording a no decision despite allowing just 1R/ER in 6.0IP (2H, 3BB, 7K, 0HR).

- ★ Did not allow a hit to his first 10BF (1BB)...also did not allow a hit to 10 of his final 11BF (1BB).

ROAD RULES: Will make his fourth road start of the season...in three road starts this season, is 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA (14.0IP, 6ER) and 13K...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of those starts.

- ★ As a Yankee (since 2023), has gone 18-17 with a 4.36 ERA (243.1IP, 118ER) and 266K in 46 road starts.
- ★ Made 18 starts on the road in 2025, going 8-5 with a 3.18 ERA (104.2IP, 84H, 44R/37ER, 41BB, 110K, 9HR)...tossed at least 6.0IP in 12 of those starts...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 13 of those starts...went 4-1 with a 2.25 ERA (36.0IP, 30H, 10R/9ER, 12BB, 28K, 2HR) over his last six road starts (8/6-9/20)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in all six starts.

VS. CLEVELAND: In 24 career games (22 starts) vs. Cleveland, is 10-5 with a 2.54 ERA (145.0IP, 107H, 45R/41ER, 47BB, 147K, 10HR)...his 24 games and 22 starts vs. Cleveland are his most vs. a single opponent in his career...his 2.54 ERA vs. Cleveland in the regular season marks his third-lowest ERA against an American League opponent in his career, trailing only his 2.17 ERA vs. Seattle (5GS) and 2.42 ERA vs. Houston (12GS).

- ★ Made one start vs. Cleveland this season, recording a no decision despite allowing just 1R/ER in 6.0IP (2H, 3BB, 7K, 0HR) on Thursday at Yankee Stadium.
- ★ In his 22 regular season starts, is 10-4 with a 2.40 ERA (142.1IP, 102H, 42R/38ER, 44BB, 146K, 10HR)...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 17 starts and one-or-zero earned runs in 14 of those starts.
- ★ **Recorded no-hitter vs. Cleveland on 4/14/21 at Guaranteed Rate Field with Chicago-AL** (9.0IP, 7K, 1HP)...retired his first 25BF before hitting Roberto Pérez in the ninth inning...was the 20th no-hitter in franchise history and was the first no-hitter by a White Sox left-handed pitcher since Mark Buehrle's perfect game on 7/23/09 vs. Tampa Bay.
- ★ Made two starts vs. Cleveland in the 2024 ALCS, going 1-0 with a 2.53 ERA (10.2IP, 3ER) and 15K...made his first start in Game 1 at Yankee Stadium, allowing 1R/ER over 6.0IP (3H, 0BB, 9K, 1HR)...also started the American League pennant-clinching Game 5 at Progressive Field (ND, 4.2IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 1BB, 6K, 0HR).

ALL THAT'S LEFT: In his career, left-handed batters have hit just .214/.289/.332 (217-for-1,012)...has also surrendered just 25HR.

- ★ His 9.89 K/9.0IP ratio since his Major League debut in 2015 ranks fourth among left-handed pitchers in that span (min. 1,000.0IP), trailing only Chris Sale (11.71), Blake Snell (11.20) and Robbie Ray (10.81).
- ★ Since 2015, his 1,436K are the fifth-most among active left-handed pitchers...his 28 double-digit strikeout games over that stretch among lefties are the fifth-most in the Majors, trailing only Sale (74), Ray (40), Clayton Kershaw (39) and Snell (38).

2026: In five starts this year, is 1-2 with a 2.88 ERA (25.0IP, 14H, 9R/8ER, 16BB, 27K, 1HR)...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those starts and 2ER-or-fewer in four starts.

- ★ Has allowed 1R-or-fewer in each of his last three starts (since 5/21), posting a 1.59 ERA (17.0IP, 3ER) over that stretch.
- ★ Has tossed at least 6.0IP and allowed 1R-or-fewer in each of his last two starts.
- ★ Has held opponents to a .165/.301/.247 (14-for-85) slash line this season...has allowed just 1HR to his 104 batters faced.
- ★ Has allowed 4H-or-fewer in each of his five starts, allowing just 5XBH.

2025: Went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts...**set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched**...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco).
