RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals open a six-game road trip to Kansas City and Cincinnati tonight playing the first of a two-game set with the Royals in Interleague play before moving on to Cincinnati for a four-game series wrapping up their play in the Queen City for the 2019 season...the Cardinals entered play today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 2.0 games behind 1st place Chicago and hold the 2nd Wild Card position 1.0 game behind Washington... the Cardinals are 17-11 since the All-Star Break T-3rd best winning pct. in the National League.

MOLINA ACTIVATED; AROZARENA SELECTED; MARTINEZ PLACED ON I.L.; KNIZNER OPTIONED: Following Sunday's game the Cardinals optioned catcher **Andrew Knizner** to Memphis (AAA). Prior to today's game, the Cardinals activated catcher **Yadier Molina** (right thumb tendon strain) from the 10-day Injured List, placed outfielder **José Martínez** on the 10-day Injured List (right AC joint sprain) and selected the contract of outfielder **Randy Arozarena** from Memphis. Arozarena played in 319 career minor league games prior to his arrival.

CARDINALS COACHING STAFF CHANGE: The Cardinals relieved assistant hitting coach **Mark Budaska** of his duties on Monday. **Jobel Jimenez**, the hitting coach at the Cardinals Triple-A affiliate in Memphis, will join the Major League staff for the remainder of the 2019 season.

ROAD HOUSE: According to *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Cardinals' career .661 road win pct. (37-19) in Kansas City is the 3rd-highest between any two teams in MLB history (minimum 50 games), trailing only the Houston Astros at the Seattle Mariners (.667), and Boston Braves at the Washington Senators (.667, 34-17, from 1892-99).

SOMETIMES THEY COME BACK: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the Cardinals .661 road win pct. at Kauffman Stadium is the 2nd-highest among all Major League teams (min. 10 games), trailing only Arizona (.667, 12-6).

SLAMMIN' SUCCESS: The Cardinals rallied from an 8-4 deficit on Sunday for an 11-9 victory over Pittsburgh as **Andrew Knizner** took a hit by pitch to score the first run before **Lane Thomas** smashed a two-out grand slam to give St. Louis a lead they would never relinquish...Thomas hit the 3rd grand slam by a Cardinals player this season and 2nd by a rookie (**Tommy Edman** at CIN)...he also became the first Cardinals rookie to record a triple, grand slam and at least 5 RBI in a game in the franchise history. *Elias Sports Bureau*

BEAT THE STREAK: The Cardinals are playing their first road game since a 2-1 loss on August 7 at Dodger Stadium. St. Louis is looking to snap a five-game road losing streak (Oakland-2, Los Angeles-3), their longest streak since dropping eight straight in 2017 (COL-1, CHI-3, CIN-4).

Tsunami Alert: Cardinals relief pitcher **Carlos Martínez** ranks 15th among National League relievers with 12 saves, but leads all National League pitchers with nine saves since the All-Star Break, tied with the Royals' **Ian Kennedy** for the most in MLB over that period.

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the St. Louis Cardinals lead all teams with a .298 BA from their designated hitters, soundly ahead of the Boston Red Sox (.272) in 2nd place...**Matt Holliday** (.119 AB, .277 BA), **Jose Martínez** (.78 AB, .295) and **Albert Pujols** (.50 AB, .360) have the most at-bats among Cardinals in Interleague play.

KANSAS CITY CONNECTIONS

José Martínez was signed by the Royals as a minor league free agent (Jan. 28, 2015) and played parts of two seasons in Omaha (AAA)...hit .384 to win the 2015 PCL batting title, setting a modern era PCL record that was the circuit's highest since **Gene Woodling's** .385 mark in 1948 for the San Francisco Seals (AAA)...acquired by the Cardinals in exchange for cash considerations (May 25, 2016).

Miles Mikolas pitched his first career complete-game shutout against the Royals on May 21, 2018 with a career-high 9 strikeouts.

Kolten Wong's first MLB home run was a grand slam vs. Kansas City (June 2, 2014).

Royals Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** played in 34 games over two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96)...selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft and spent his first eight seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Cardinals Hall of Fame manager **Whitey Herzog** managed the Royals for three seasons (1976-78)...piloted the club to three straight American League Western Division titles.

Royals Pitching Coach **Cal Eldred** pitched for St. Louis for three seasons (2003-05)...served as Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM (2013-15).

Royals Assistant Pitching Coordinator **Jason Simontacchi** pitched for St. Louis in parts of three seasons (2002-04)...was a minor league pitching coach in the Cardinals organization for parts of six seasons (2012-17).

Cardinals Asst. Athletic Trainer **Jeremy Clipperton** worked one season (2001) with the Rookie-level Northwest League Spokane Indians of the Royals organization.

Royals Special Asst. to the GM **Tim Conroy** worked as an area scout and an East Coast regional supervisor with St. Louis (1994-2000)...pitched for St. Louis for two seasons (1986-87).

Royals Northwest Arkansas (AA) Hitting Coach **Abraham Nuñez** was a member of the Cardinals 2005 N.L. Central championship team.

Cardinals broadcaster and former pitcher **Al Hrabosky** pitched in 116 games over two seasons (1978-79) with Kansas City...traded to Kansas City for pitcher **Mark Littell** and catcher **Buck Martinez** (Dec. 8, 1977).

Royals Senior Advisor to the GM/Scouting & Player and Development **Mike Arbuckle** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1969 MLB Draft.

Royals Special Advisor-Player Development **Mike Matheny** was Cardinals Manager from 2012-2018 and played five seasons (2000-04) as an All-Star catcher for the Cardinals. His 591 managerial wins rank 5th all-time for Cardinals.

Royals Special Assistant to the GM **Jim Fregosi Jr.** was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 2nd round of the 1985 MLB Draft.

Royals Asst. Dir. of Scouting **Dan Ontiveros** worked in the Cardinals Scouting Department from 1998-2004.

Royals Pitching Coordinator **Larry Carter** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 10th round of the 1986 MLB Draft.

Royals Roving Pitching Coordinator **Jeff Suppan** pitched parts of four seasons with St. Louis (2004-06, '10)...named 2006 NLCS MVP...member of 2006 World Series Champions.

Cardinals broadcaster **Brad Thompson** pitched part of the 2010 season with Kansas city.

FOX Sports Kansas City reporter **Joel Goldberg** covered the Cardinals for FOX Sports Midwest for three seasons (2005-07)...worked parts of six years for KTVI FOX 2 in St. Louis.

Royals broadcaster **Steve Stewart** is a St. Louis native...called Cardinals games on KMOX in 2002.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 24th start of the season and his 57th career start (58th appearance).
- With nine strikeouts tonight, would tie Bob Gibson for the franchise record for four straight games with nine or more strikeouts.
- Has 12 starts this season pitching 6.0 or more innings and holding his opposition to four hits or less, most in the N.L. (J. Verlander 15, G. Cole 15, T. Bauer 13 12/1).
- In five starts post All-Star Break, ranks 4th among National League pitchers with an 0.86 ERA.
- Has allowed just 4 runs on 19 hits (2 HR) in last six starts covering 38.1 IP (0.94 ERA).
- Leads the Cardinals with 138 strikeouts Post All-Star Break over the last two seasons and ranks 6th among National League pitchers.
- Received seven runs of support vs. CHI (8/1) and has not receiving more than three in his prior 9 of his last 10; has received two runs or less in 15 of 23 starts this season (0 runs in five starts).

LAST TIME OUT

- Struck out 10 batters allowing four hits over 7.0 scoreless innings in a no decision at LAD (8/7), in which the Cardinals lost 2-1 in the bottom of the 9th. Was his 2nd double-digit strikeout game of the season (5th career) and ran his scoreless inning streak to a career-high 16.0, the longest active streak in MLB at the end of the day.
