### TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 1 of 3-game series vs **Josh Lederman's Mets** and Game 1 of a 7-game homestand that includes an upcoming 4-game set vs the defending National League Central Division champion **Brewers**.
- Following this homestand the Reds will embark on a 6-day, 6-game road trip at **WSox** (4/12-4/14) & **Sea** (4/15-4/17).
- The Reds are coming off their first road trip of the season in which they won 2 of 3 games in **Philadelphia**.

**TODAY'S TRANSACTION:** The Reds placed on a rehab assignment at A-Dayton RHP **Ian Gibaut**...Gibaut is currently on the 15-day injured list with a right forearm strain.

**NO FIREWORKS:** There will be no postgame fireworks show tonight due to the Ohio River level affecting the safe operation of the fireworks barge.

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds won last season's 6-game series, 4-2, including a 2-1 series win from 5/9-5/11 in Cincinnati and a 2-1 series win from 9/15-9/17 in New York.

- Beginning 9/24/13, the Reds are 19-40 vs NYM, including a 14-game losing streak from 9/7/14 - 9/7/16 that ranks as Cin's longest ever vs the Mets and its longest vs any team since a 16-game skid vs AZ from 5/8/01 - 8/13/03.
- Dating back to 1962, the 7-0 series win by the Mets in 2015 was the first season series sweep by either team, followed by NYM's 6-0 series win in 2016.
- The Mets' .619 winning percentage (39-24) at Great American Ball Park is the highest of any National League team.

**STEERING COMMITTEE:** LF **Spencer Steer's** 10th inning go-ahead grand slam Mon night off RHP **Connor Brogdon** led to the Reds' 6-3 win at Citizens Bank Park...it marked the first Reds grand slam in extra innings since **3b Todd Frazier's** GS in the 13th inning off Det's RHP **Joakim Soria** on 6/17/15 (8-4 win at GABP)...**Steer's** slam put him over 100 RBI for his career (101rbi/188g)...he's the sixth-fastest Red to reach that milestone since 1957.

**IT AIN'T OVER 'TIL IT'S OVER:** On Sun vs Wsh, the Reds trailed 5-3 with 2 outs in the bottom of the ninth and RHP **Kyle Finnegan** pitching for the Nationals...**2b Jonathan India** doubled in a 10-pitch at-bat...the next batter **CF Will Benson** hit a 2-run HR to tie the game...**1b Christian Encarnacion-Strand**, who was riding an 0-for-12 skid, went back-to-back with **Benson** for a game-winning HR...it was **Encarnacion-Strand's** third walkoff RBI in just 66 career games, a club record...he also became the first Reds player to break a 12+ hitless at-bat streak by hitting a walkoff HR since **Devin Mesoraco** snapped an 0-for-15 with a walkoff HR vs Atl in the 10th inning on 6/2/17 at GABP (3-2 win) courtesy: Elias.

### 2024 SPRING TRAINING NOTES:

- The Reds went 11-15-2 in Cactus League play with a .255 team batting avg and a 5.54 team ERA...their .472 SLG ranked first and 41 stolen bases ranked 3rd among all Major League teams.
- INF Christian Encarnacion-Strand** (16g, .333/.382/.784, 5hr, 10 XBH, 14rbi, 3bb, 40TB) and **INF/OF Spencer Steer** (17g .340/.393/.700, 4hr, 9 XBH, 12rbi, 5bb, 3sb, 35TB) each led the Reds with 17 hits during the 2024 Cactus League season.
- INF/OF Jonathan India** (.393/.485/.607) hit safely in 9 of 10g, including 7 straight from 3/10-3/20.
- SS Elly De La Cruz** (.280/.379/.540) hit safely in 8 straight games from 2/29-3/16...his 470-foot home run on 3/2 off Col's Cal Quantrill is the longest home run on record of **De La Cruz's** career.

#### 2024:

- Is making his second start of the season, his first vs NYM since 9/15/23 at Citi Field.
- Leads the Major Leagues with 16 pitches that have reached or exceeded 100 MPH, 1 more than **Oak's Mason Miller**.
- Made 5 apps during Spring Training (1-2, 7.20)...fanned 19 batters over 15.0 innings and held opponents to a .250 batting average (.314 batting avg on balls in play).

#### 2023:

- Was the Reds' Opening Day starting pitcher.
- For the second consecutive season led Reds pitchers in strikeouts.
- For the second consecutive season was the Reds' nominee for Major League Baseball's prestigious **Lou Gehrig Memorial Award** for exemplary contributions to his community and philanthropy.
- Missed 71 days while on injured lists with right hip pain (6/19-8/19) and COVID-19 (9/1-9/9).
- Went 2-4, 3.93 in 14 starts before he went on the 15-day injured list with the hip injury and 2-3, 6.52 in 8 starts after he was reinstated on 8/20...from 8/1-8/15 made 4 rehab apps for the ACL Reds (1gs, 2ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) and Louisville (3gs, 12ip, 6h, 5r, 4er, 7bb, 12k, 2hr).
- Went 1-2, 9.73 in 3 starts between his 2 stints on the injured lists.
- Finished the season 1-1, 5.06 in 5 starts after he came off the COVID-19 injured list on 9/10.

#### 2024:

- Will make his first career start vs NYM (4 relief apps) and his 200th career appearance.
- In Spring Training went 0-0 with a 3.12 ERA in 3 apps (2 starts)...struck out 11 batters over 8.2 innings (5h, 4r/3er,

#### SLICK NICK:

- On 12/1/23 signed with the Reds to a 2-year contract through the 2025 season with a player opt out provision after 2024.
- In 2022, became the first pitcher in Major League history to produce at least 10 starts, 8 saves and 4 holds in a single season.
- In the 2022 Postseason, didn't allow a run in 8.1 innings over 6 apps vs LAD in the Division Series and vs Phi in the National League Championship Series.
- In Game 4 of the 2022 NLCS at Phi, became the first Padres pitcher ever to throw at least 3.0 innings without allowing a hit in a Postseason game...relieved starter **Mike Clevinger**, who didn't record an out in SD's 10-6 loss.
- Won a silver medal while pitching for Team USA in the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games (2g, 1-1, 1.64)...started the gold medal game vs Japan and allowed just 1 run in the 6.0 innings.
- From 2018-2021 posted a 2.96 ERA in 68 relief apps in the Japan Pacific League (majors), Japan Eastern League (minors) and Japan Western League (minors).

#### 2023:

- Led SD with a career-high 63 apps...also had career bests in strikeouts (106) and ERA (3.43).
- Posted ERAs of 2.32 in his 9 starts and 4.12 in 54 relief apps.
- Didn't allow a run in any of his last 6 starts covering 25.0 innings.
- His opponents' exit velocity of 84.7 was the third-lowest in the Statcast era behind Hou's **Rafael Montero** (84.6, 2017) and Phi's **Zach Wheeler** (84.6, 2021)...minimum 1500 pitches.
- His hard-hit ball percentage of 29.9 was fourth-lowest in the Major Leagues and the lowest by any righthanded pitcher (200 batted ball events minimum).
- In his last 9 apps of the season overall, beginning 8/29 and including 3 starts, posted a 0.45 ERA...was the lowest ERA of any pitcher in the Major Leagues in that span (minimum 20ip).
