**BIRD WATCHING:** The St. Louis Cardinals open the post All-Star break portion of their schedule tonight in Phoenix when they open a three-game weekend series against the Arizona Diamondbacks...their six-day roadtrip will continue next week (Mon.-Wed.) in Anaheim, CA when the Cardinals play a three-game series against the Los Angeles Angels...with a make-up game slated for next Thu. (July 23) at Busch Stadium vs. Arizona, the Cardinals are scheduled to play 20-straight days before their next open date on August 6.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis entered play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 8.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee, and 3.5 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are currently in 4th place in the NL Wild Card standings, just 1.0 game back of 3rd place Miami and 1.5 games in front of Arizona.

**IT'S WHACKING DAY:** The Cardinals .604 win pct. (113-74) against the Diamondbacks is their best against any opponent (min. 25 games) and the highest in MLB vs. the Snakes among National League and common interleague opponents. **RAZING ARIZONA:** St. Louis is 53-40 (.570) all-time at Chase Field, the best win pct. by any annual visitor and the club's 3rd-best winning pct. in any road city.

**THE ROAD AHEAD:** The Cardinals are scheduled to play 38 games on the road following the All-Star break, their most since playing 39 post-ASG road games in 2007. **HOME BODIES:** The team's 52 Home games before the ASG break this season matched the 1973 season for their most in a full season.

**DERBY DANDY:** Cardinals All-Star **Jordan Walker** edged out hometown hero **Kyle Schwarber** to win the T-Mobile MLB Home Run Derby on Monday at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia to become the Cardinals 1st ever HR Derby winner among a list of past participants that has included Albert Pujols, Carlos Beltrán, Matt Holliday, Jim Edmonds, Mark McGwire, Ray Lankford and Jack Clark. **MORE JORDAN:** Walker brings a career best 18-game on-base streak into tonight's game and he was the 1st Cardinal since **Albert Pujols** (87 in 2009) to lead the majors in RBI at the All-Star break with his 74.

**NIFTY 50:** The Cardinals 50 wins prior to the ASG marked the 11th time since 2000 and 17th overall (since 1933) that the team had 50 or more wins pre-All Star, and the 3rd straight season that they have done so (**2026-50, 2025-51, 2024-50**)...the Cardinals have advanced to the postseason in seven of their 10 prior seasons when winning 50 or more games pre-ASG.

**DRAFT RECAP:** The Cardinals completed the 2026 MLB Draft last Sunday and took a total of 23 players over the two-day event, with OF **Trevor Condon** (Etowah, Ga. High School) as their top pick in the 1st round (13th overall)...the Cardinals selected 21 collegiate players and two high school prep players in a group that included 12 pitchers, 6 outfielders, 4 infielders and one catcher. **Condon** agreed to terms yesterday as did RHP **Tegan Kuhns** (CB-A, 32), OF **Andrew Williamson** (CB-B, 68), RHP **Dawson Montesa** (CB-B, 72), OF **Caden Ferraro** (3rd, 86), SS **Dee Kennedy** (4th, 114), SS **Owen Henne** (6th, 175), RHP **Derek Schaefer** (7th, 204), LHP **Luke Harrison** (8th, 234), C **Jayden Lobliner** (9th, 264), RHP **Nick Bonn** (10th, 294).

#### ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

**Nolan Arenado** played five seasons in St. Louis (2021-25), where he was a three-time NL All-Star and the winner of one Silver Slugger Award and a pair of Platinum Gold Gloves Awards...traded to Arizona with cash considerations for RHP Jack Martinez (Jan. 13, 2026).

**Matthew Liberatore** was born in Peoria, Ariz....graduated from Mountain Ridge High School in Glendale...signed his letter of intent to the University of Arizona before being drafted by the Rays.

**JoJo Romero** played college baseball at Yavapai College in Prescott, Ari...committed to transfer to the University of Arizona, but first spent a season at Yavapai due to transfer restrictions, and was subsequently drafted before transferring.

**George Soriano** made his MLB debut vs. Arizona (April 16, 2023), tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with a pair of strikeouts...fanned Corbin Carroll for his first career strikeout.

**Jon Jay** played 84 games for Arizona in 2018.

**Kyle Driscoll** previously worked two seasons (2024-25) as Pitching Coordinator with Arizona.

Dbacks Hitting Coach **Joe Mather** was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB Draft...played parts of two years in St. Louis (2008, '10).

Dbacks 1B Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for St. Louis for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

**Casey Chenoweth** served as a Diamondbacks hitting coordinator from 2020-22 in Scottsdale prior to joining the Cardinals organization.

**Daniel Descalso** played two seasons for the Diamondbacks (2017-18)...served as a Special Assistant to Baseball Operations for Arizona in 2023.

**Brandon Allen** played parts of three seasons (2009-11) with the D-Backs...made his MLB debut with Arizona (Aug. 22, 2009 at Minute Maid)...singled off **Brian Moehler** for first career hit.

**Ildemaro Vargas** was signed by St. Louis as an international free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league system (2008-14).

**Zac Gallen** was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons in Cardinals minor league system before being traded to Miami as part of the package to acquire **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a Dbacks Baseball Operations Executive for parts of four seasons (2014-17).

D-Backs Player & Media Relations Coordinator **Kat Ritter** previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate in 2019.

Arizona VP of Latin American Scouting **César Gerónimo** previously worked six seasons (2011-16) as a Cardinals international crosschecker.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Makes his single-season career high 19th start of the season tonight. It's his 38th career start (40th career game).
- Allowed two runs or fewer in 12 of his 17 starts this season; his 12 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2 or fewer runs allowed tie Arizona's Eduardo Rodriguez for 2nd in MLB behind Philly's Cristopher Sanchez (13).**
- Since making his MLB debut (July 31, 2024), leads qualifying Cardinals starting pitchers in ERA (3.51), opponent BA (.246), and WHIP (1.13), Hits/9 (8.37).
- Held his opposition to 3 runs or fewer in all 9 home starts this season (2-2, 1.89 ERA, 52.1 IP); ranks 4th among MLB starters in home ERA.
- Has made 20 career appearances (18 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 7-5 with a 3.28 ERA (112.1 IP).
- The Cardinals are 23-16 (.590 win pct.) in his 39 career games started.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 37 career starts, longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal. Seattle's **George Kirby** leads active leaders with 130.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 24 of 37 career starts (21 quality starts).
- Since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 18 of his starts - three shy of **Matthew Liberatore** for the most among all STL starters.

**LAST TIME OUT (Wednesday, July 8 vs. Milwaukee):**, W, 5-1; 6.1 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 6 SO; 90 pitches

- Celebrated his 26th birthday with a 5-1 win over the division-leading Brewers last Wednesday at Busch, limiting the Brew Crew to one run over a season-high 6.1 innings.
- Marked his 12th start this season of 6.0+ innings and 2 runs or fewer, tying Arizona's **Eduardo Rodriguez** for 2nd in MLB behind Philly's **Cristopher Sanchez** (13).
- Received five runs of support for the first time since six runs May 8 at San Diego.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE:** Has induced 10 ground into double plays, matching his single-season high.

**THOU SHALL NOT STEAL:** Earned his first career pick-off, getting Estuary Ruiz (6/26) at first base.

**HELLO SUNSHINE:** His 2.21 ERA (40.2 IP/10 ER) in Day games is tops among all Cardinals pitchers with 26-to-5 strikeout to walks ratio, however has 6 HR's allowed in his 7 afternoon starts.

**EMPTY HANDED:** The Cardinals have given him 2 runs of support or fewer in 8 of his starts. The Cardinals have been shut out five times this season, four of which when McGreevy starts.

**FAITH IN FIELDERS:** Has the NL's 3rd-lowest percent (19.4) of Swing & Miss and 8th-best BABIP (.254) ... His difference in Opponent BA (.237) vs. xBA (.292) leads all MLB qualified starting pitchers (-.052).

**NESTING:** Has worked at least 5.0 innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in eight of his nine home starts this season, and did so in each of his 1st four starts before allowing three runs in his 5/20 start vs. PIT.

**HAPPY IT HAPPENED:** Had a 14.0 scoreless innings streak that covered portions of three starts from April 26-May 8 snapped on a leadoff HR by **Nick Kurtz** that was his only run allowed during a 6.0-inning start 5/14 at ATH during a 5-4 St. Louis victory.

**ONE-HIT WONDER:** Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (May 8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

**DODGE BALL:** Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

**CURL YW:** Limited Washington to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on April 8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

**"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS:** Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak *as a starter* (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*
