**OPENING ACT:** The Orioles opened the 2021 season by shutting out the Boston Red Sox yesterday by a score of 3-0...It was the sixth shutout on Opening Day in club history (also: 1973, 1975, 1976, 1992, 2005).

⚾ The two hits O's pitchers allowed were the fewest in team history on Opening Day...It was the 30<sup>th</sup> time in the majors (since 1954) a club allowed two-or-fewer hits in their first game of the season; The Pittsburgh Pirates also did it this year in their opening game against the Chicago Cubs on Thursday.

⚾ **C Pedro Severino** went 2-for-4 in the opener, becoming the first O's catcher to record a multi-hit game on Opening Day since 2017 (**Wellington Castillo**).

**I MEANS, WHAT A START:** LHP **John Means** tossed 7.0 shutout innings in yesterday's Opening Day start, allowing just one hit...The 7.0 innings matched a career-high (sixth time)...It was the second time in his career not allowing a run in a start, also on 6/28/19 vs. CLE when he tossed 5.0 innings allowing just one hit.

⚾ Means became the first pitcher in Orioles history to work at least 7.0 innings, while allowing one or fewer hits and no runs in a start at Fenway Park.

⚾ Means became the 17<sup>th</sup> pitcher in Major League history, and first Oriole, to toss at least 7.0 innings, while allowing one or fewer hits in a start on Opening Day.

⚾ Means became the third pitcher in MLB history to go at least 7.0 innings on Opening Day and allow one or fewer hits while not walking a batter (**Jordan Zimmermann** - DET, 2019 and **Irv Young** - Boston Beaneaters, 1906).

⚾ Means extended his streak of starts allowing one or fewer runs to five games, dating back to last season, tied for the second longest such streak in O's history (also, **Erik Bedard** and **Brian Matusz**); Hall of Famer and current Orioles broadcaster, **Jim Palmer**, holds the record with six-straight (5/20-6/10/1978).

**RIGHT BACK AT IT:** INF/OF **Trey Mancini** appeared in his first game yesterday in over a year (9/29/19 at BOS), finishing 1-for-3 with a walk...His walk in his third plate appearance extended his on-base streak to 23-straight games, dating back to 2019...It is the longest active streak in the American League and the second-longest in the majors (**Justin Turner**, LAD - 33-straight).

**A GRAND OLE TIME:** INF **Freddy Galvis** has appeared in 999 career games (642 - PHI, 162 - SD, 115 - TOR, CIN - 79, BAL - 1)...He will become the 59<sup>th</sup> active player to reach the 1,000 game plateau.

⚾ There are 18 players in Orioles history to have played 1,000 career games for the club.

**FEELING THE FENWAY LOVE:**

⚾ INF/OF **Trey Mancini** is a career .358/.431/.604 (38-for-106) hitter with 10 doubles, four home runs, and 21 RBI in 28 career games at Fenway Park...Mancini has hit safely in 25 of the 28 games and reached base safely in 27 of 28...Among active players with 100-or-more career at-bats at Fenway Park, Mancini ranks first in both batting average and on-base percentage, and third in slugging percentage.

⚾ INF **Maikel Franco** has hit safely in all five games he has played at Fenway Park in his career, hitting .500/.577/.591 (11-for-22) with two doubles, two runs scored, and two RBI in these games.

**TAKE 5:** RHP **Tyler Wells** and RHP **Mac Sceroler** each made their first career Opening Day roster after being selected in last year's Rule 5 draft...Their first appearance will be their Major League debut...The Orioles currently have three Rule 5 picks on their 26-man roster, also OF **Anthony Santander**, and four total on their 40-man roster (also INF **Richie Martin**).

⚾ Five Orioles made their Major League debuts during the 2020 season.

**DAYLIGHTFUL:** The Orioles won their first game of the season yesterday, and play two more, including today, to wrap up the series...Since the beginning of the 2020 season, the Orioles are 11-6 (.647) in day games...Their .647 winning percentage is the third-highest in baseball during this stretch.

**DE-PEN-DABLE:** The Orioles bullpen begins the season with five members (LHP **Paul Fry**, LHP **Tanner Scott**, RHP **Cole Sulser**, RHP **Dillon Tate**, and RHP **César Valdez**) from last year's group that posted a 3.90 ERA (109 ER/251.2 IP), which ranked seventh-best in the American League and ninth-best in the majors.

**ROSTER BREAKDOWN:** The Orioles open the 2021 season with 15 players who were not on their 2020 Opening Day roster: 10 pitchers (**Matt Harvey**, **Dean Kremer**, **Jorge López**, **John Means**, **Adam Plutko**, **Mac Sceroler**, **Dillon Tate**, **César Valdez**, **Tyler Wells**, and **Bruce Zimmermann**), four infielders (**Maikel Franco**, **Freddy Galvis**, **Trey Mancini**, and **Ramón Uriás**), and one outfielder (**Ryan Mountcastle**)...Of the 26, seven are home grown O's...Eight O's are making their first Opening Day roster...LHP **Wade LeBlanc** is the oldest (36 years and 238 days) on the roster and INF/OF **Ryan Mountcastle** is the youngest (24 years and 43 days) on the club.

**GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE RECAP:** The Orioles played in 28 games during Spring Training, finishing with a 10-17-1 record...The O's went 7-7 at Ed Smith Stadium and 3-10-1 on the road...OF **Austin Hays** led the O's on offense, collecting a team-high 20 hits and batting a team-best .392...INF/OF **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Hays** each recorded four home runs and 13 RBI...INF/OF **Trey Mancini** hit safely in each of his last 14 spring games to close out the schedule, finishing with the second-most hits for the O's this spring (17).

**QUICK HITS:** Harvey is making his Orioles debut and 145<sup>th</sup> career start (153<sup>rd</sup> appearance)...Today marks his first start since 9/6/20 when he was used as the designated "Opener" with the Royals...Made four starts in 2020, going 0-3...Has not earned a win since 7/13/19 with Los Angeles-AL when he threw 5.2 innings, allowing one run on four hits...His contract was selected by the Orioles on 3/25/21.

**CAREER VS THE RED SOX:** Will be making his second career start vs. the Red Sox, and his first since 8/28/15, in which he did not earn a decision, throwing 4.0 innings and giving up two runs on five hits (one home run) and two walks...Is making his first appearance at Fenway Park.

**FACING THE AL EAST:** Today marks Harvey's sixth career appearance, all starts, against an AL East foe...He owns a career record of 1-0 with a 0.38 ERA (7 ER/37.2 IP) against the division...All of his appearances have come vs. the Yankees, Red Sox, and Orioles.

**ON THIS DAY:** Today will mark Harvey's fourth career start on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, in which he is 1-1 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) with 17 strikeouts...His previous starts on this day came in 2013, 2016, and 2018...In his first start of the season, Harvey has pitched to a career 2.04 ERA (10 ER/44.2 IP) with a 4-2 record.

**I ONLY SEE DAYLIGHT:** In 46 starts (48 appearances) during day games, Harvey is 15-17 with a 4.39 ERA (129 ER/264.2 IP) and .267 AVG, compared to a 29-35 record in 98 starts (104 appearances) during night games, in which he has a 4.03 ERA (257 ER/574.0 IP), and a .247 opponents' average.

**HIGHWAY DON'T CARE:** Harvey is 20-30 in 71 career starts (76 appearances) on the road, with a 4.33 ERA (195 ER/405.1 IP), compared to a 24-22 record in 73 starts (76 appearances) at home, in which he has a 3.97 ERA (191 ER/433.1 IP)...Will mark just his third start at an AL East Ballpark, in which he is 1-0 with a 2.95 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP).

**RIGHT VS. LEFT:** Has held right-handed batters to a .251 (401-for-1597) opponents' average with 43 home runs, compared to a .255 (408-for-1600) mark and 62 home runs vs. left-handed batters in his career.

**SPRING TRAINING:** Harvey went 0-1 in four starts during Spring Training 2021, and pitched to a 4.80 ERA (8 ER/15.0 IP) with three walks, and nine strikeouts...His longest outing was 5.0 innings on 3/28 vs. PIT, in which he allowed two runs on five hits, two walks, and three strike outs...He allowed a home run in each of his first three starts.

**2020 HIGHLIGHTS:** Made seven appearances (4 starts) with Kansas City after signing a minor league deal with the Royals, posting an 0-3 record with an 11.57 ERA (15 ER/11.2 IP) and 10 strikeouts...Harvey made three relief appearances, including his first since 5/8/18 vs. ATL (with NYM), after making just five relief appearances from 2012-19...As a starter, he allowed 13 runs on 20 hits — five of which were home runs — in 9.1 IP; nine of the 15 runs he allowed came via home runs.

Zimmermann will be making his first start of the season, after being named to his first career Opening Day Roster...Went 0-1 in one start (four appearances) during Spring Training, only giving up one hit in his first three appearances...Allowed nine hits and seven runs in his final outing, pitching to a 4.73 ERA (7 ER/13.1 IP) overall, with three walks and 13 strikeouts...Made one start (two appearances) in 2020, did not earn a decision in either appearance, pitching to a 7.71 ERA (6 ER/7.0 IP)...Will be making his first career start (second appearance) against Boston, both at Fenway Park, in which he has a 2.25 ERA (1 ER/4.0 IP) and a career-high five strike outs...Made his Major League debut on 9/17/20 vs. TB (G1)...All of his appearances have been against the AL East.
