THIS IS THE SKIN OF A KILLER, BELLA: Fresh off the All-Star Break, the Giants return to action tonight in Seattle with the first of three games against the Mariners this weekend.

- ▶ SF ended the “first half” with a 3-1 series victory over the Rockies, outscoring Colorado 18-9 over the four games.
- ▶ The Giants come out of the break at 41-55 (.427), which tied for the fifth-lowest winning percentage in the Majors with the A’s, and ahead of only the Mets (41-57, .418), Rockies (39-59, .398), Angels (38-59, .392) and Royals (38-59, .392).
- ▶ On the road in 2026, SF is 19-30 (.388), which is the fifth-lowest road winning percentage this season.

BELLA! WHERE THE HECK HAVE YOU BEEN, LOCA?: The Giants announced the following roster moves prior to today’s game.

- ▶ **C Eric Haase** designated for assignment.
- ▶ **C Daniel Susac** (#6) returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 10-day Injured List.

YOU BETTER HOLD ON TIGHT, SPIDER MONKEY: The Giants are in Seattle for the first time since the 2024 season when they lost two of three that series...last season in SF, the Giants opened their home schedule vs. the Mariners with a 3-0 sweep.

- ▶ Seattle starter Bryce Miller relies heavily on his four-seamer (42.6% usage rate) and splitter (24.4% usage rate)...SF has a .260 batting average vs. four-seamers this season (eighth in MLB) and a .303 batting average vs. splitters (second in MLB).
- ▶ The Giants are 8-13 (.381) in interleague games this season, which is the fourth-lowest interleague winning percentage in the Majors, and lowest among all NL teams.
- ▶ **IF Rafael Devers** has a career .330 (58x176) batting average against Seattle, which is the best among all active players with at least 150 career plate appearances vs. SEA (*Stats, LLC*)...all-time, Devers' .330 average ranks T-15th best (min. 175 career ABs vs. Seattle).

SAY IT. OUT LOUD. SAY IT.: **RHP Landen Roupp** will open up the second half for SF, making his first start since July 6 (vs. TOR)...in that outing, he struck out five while allowing three runs on three hits (one homer) and two walks across a career-high 8.0 innings.

- ▶ Notable from his last two outings, Roupp has heavily relied on his cutter...he's set career-highs in cutter usage each of his last two starts (20 cutters on June 30 at AZ and 26 cutters vs. TOR on July 6)...Roupp held Toronto 1-for-9 with three strikeouts on his cutter.
- ▶ Roupp’s go-to out pitch this year has been his curveball (28.3% putaway rate)...the Mariners are batting .197 vs. curveballs this season (25th in MLB).
- ▶ The righty's 28.2% hard hit rate this season is the lowest in the Majors (min. 250 batted ball events) and his 2.4% barrels per plate appearance is also the lowest in MLB.

VAMPIRE: The Giants have three players with 15+ homers 96 games into the season in **IF Willy Adames** (15), **IF Rafael Devers** (19) and **IF Casey Schmitt** (19)...the last time three Giants had 15+ homers through 96 team games in the same season was **Will Clark** (17), **Kevin Mitchell** (17) and **Matt Williams** (18) in 1991.

YOU NICKNAMED MY DAUGHTER AFTER THE LOCH NESS MONSTER?! Both **IF Willy Adames** and **IF Rafael Devers** found their power after the break in 2025.

- ▶ Adames has a career .800 OPS following the All-Star Break compared to his .722 OPS pre-All-Star Break...last season he had an .828 OPS with 18 homers after the break.
- ▶ Devers tied Adames for a team-leading 18 homers after the break last season, which also tied for 10th-most in the Majors over that span...the 18 homers out of the break tied **Brandon Belt** in 2021 for most home runs by a Giants batter in the second half since **Barry Bonds** hit 22 homers in 2004.

I GUESS THE WOLF'S OUT OF THE BAG: The Giants released their 2027 regular season schedule yesterday...SF will open the season at home vs. Colorado on March 25th, marking the second straight season in which the Giants open at home...for the first time since 2022, the Giants will finish the season on the road, traveling to Minnesota (September 21st - September 23rd) and Colorado (September 24th - September 26th) to end the year.

ROUPPER: Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco...the 27-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on July 6 vs. Toronto...the righty turned in one of the best starts of his MLB career, striking out five while allowing three runs on three hits (one homer) and two walks across a career-high 8.0 innings.

VS. SEATTLE: Will be making his first career start vs. the Mariners...pitched a single scoreless frame with two walks and a strikeout in his lone appearance vs. the Mariners (a relief appearance on August 23, 2024 at Seattle)...the lone Mariners batter with a career hit against Roupp is Josh Naylor (1-for-2 with a single).

LET'S MAKE IT 2 IN A ROW: Earning the win in his last start, Roupp snapped a streak of 11 straight team losses in his starts...the streak was the longest for the Giants in games started by a single pitcher since **Pat Misch** from 2007-2008 (11 starts).

SO WHAT CHANGED?: Possibly stating the obvious, but Roupp's success has deeply depended on how his sinker performs...in his last start, Roupp held the Blue Jays 1-for-8 (albeit the one hit was a homer)...In his first six starts this season, in which he went 5-1, opponents slashed .114/.264/.159 with two extra-base hits (zero homers) and a .423 OPS vs. his sinker...during the 11-game team losing streak, opponents slashed .365/.460/.662 with 13 extra-base hits (four homers) and a 1.122 OPS.

SOMETHING TO WATCH: Roupp has heavily relied on his cutter as of late...he's set career-highs in cutter usage each of his last two starts (20 cutters on June 30 at AZ and 26 cutters vs. TOR on July 6)...Roupp held Toronto 1-for-9 with three strikeouts on his cutter.

WHERE'S THE K COUNTER LOCATED?: He has 104 strikeouts in 97.0 innings in 2026 with his 25.3% strikeout rate currently standing as a career-best (21.7% rate in 2024 and a 21.4% rate in 2025)...the 25.3% strikeout rate is 11th best in the NL among qualified pitchers.

WHAT'S THE COUNT?: Roupp's 17.9 pitches per inning is the third highest mark in MLB among pitchers with at least 95.0 innings pitched this season, behind only COL's Michael Lorenzen (18.2) and NYM's Freddy Peralta (18.1)...Roupp's 4.22 pitches per batter faced is also the second highest in MLB (min. 95.0ip) behind only Toronto's Dylan Cease (4.28 pitches per batters faced).

NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED: The righty's 28.2% hard hit rate this season is the lowest in the Majors by (min. 250 batted ball events) and his 2.4% barrels per plate appearance is also the lowest in MLB...Roupp's 49.6% ground ball rate in 2026 is ninth-highest in MLB (among qualified pitchers).

CALLING CARD: Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, Roupp's curveball has a whiff rate of 35.4%, a putaway rate of 28.3% and a run value of +5...Roupp's 45 strikeouts with a curveball this season are tied for fourth-most in the Majors this season.

CLUTCH UP: With two outs and RISP, opponents are batting just .143 (5x35) with a .545 OPS vs. Roupp...the .143 opposing batting average with two outs and RISP is sixth-best in the NL among qualified pitchers while the .545 OPS is ninth-best.

▶ Suffered the loss his last time out after giving up five runs on five hits over 7.0ip on July 8 vs. Toronto.

▶ Since coming back from the IL on May 29, Webb is 3-3 with a 2.75 ERA (16r, 52.1ip) and .199 BAA in eight starts... however, he is 0-2 with a 10.80 ERA (12er, 10.0ip), a .340 BAA, three HRs and four strikeouts over his last two starts.

▶ Will face the Mariners for the fourth time in his career...is 0-1 with a 5.29 ERA (10er, 17.0ip) and 20 K's in 3 starts.

▶ Was named NL Pitcher of the Month in June after leading all MLB pitchers with a 0.71 ERA (3er, 38.0ip) & .370 OPS.
