YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles beat the Red Sox, 5-3, to even the series... Albert Suárez won his eighth game of the year after allowing one run in 6.0 innings while striking out a career-high eight batters... Cedric Mullins hit two home runs, his fifth career multi-homer game and first since June 19, 2021 vs. Toronto; marked his first time doing so on the road... 0's pitching generated 33 whiffs, the second most of the season (36, 4/26 vs. 0AK)... The team has fanned 13 batters in each of the last two games for the second time this season (14, 3/28 & 13, 3/30 vs. LAA).

WHAT'S TRENDING: The 0's snapped a three-game losing streak last night, but have lost four of the last six games since September 4...Despite this stretch, the team is 83-63 (.568) and within a half game of the Yankees (.572, 83-62) in the AL East...Baltimore is 25-25 (.500) since the All-Star break and 30-32 (.484) since July 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 184-124 (.597), the second-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.606, 186-121) during that time.

① An AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since Boston in 2017 (.574, 93-69); the Red Sox also won the division in 2016 with that same record, as did Toronto in 2015.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 214 home runs behind the Yankees (215)...The Dodgers rank third with 199...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and the 214 are the most by the club since 2017 (232)...Baltimore is averaging 1.47 homers per game this season, which would be the third-best mark in team history behind 1996 (1.58) and 2016 (1.56).

① Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: Anthony Santander (40), Gunnar Henderson (36), Colton Cowser (20), Adley Rutschman and Jordan Westburg (18), Cedric Mullins (15), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (13), and Ramón Urías (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.
② Henderson and Santander are one of three duos with at least 30 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (51) and Juan Soto (38) and New York-NL's Pete Alonso (31) and Francisco Lindor (30); Baltimore did not have a player reach 30 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2021 that the team has had multiple players with 30+ home runs (Mountcastle, 33 & Mullins, 30).
③ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (14); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind Brady Anderson, who hit all 12 in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the 0's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson was named the AL Player of the Week on Monday...The award marked the second of his career, joining June 11, 2023...He slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games while ranking among AL leaders during the period in slugging percentage (1°¹), home runs (T-1°¹), total bases (T-1°¹, 20), OPS (2°¹, 1.297), batting average (T-2°¹), and hits (T-2°¹), home runs (T-1°¹), total bases (T-1°¹, 20), OPS (2°¹, 1.297), batting average (T-2°¹), and hits (T-2°¹).

⑤ Henderson's 111 runs are the most by an Orioles shortstop in team history, surpassing the record of 34 held by Cal Ripken, Jr. (1991) and Miguel Tejada (2004).

⑤ Henderson's 111 runs scored rank third in the AL and fourth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since Jonathan Villar (111) in 2019; the last Oriole with 112 or more runs is Roberto Alomar, who set the club record with 132 in 1996; Henderson is the sixth player in 0's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with Manny Machado (2, 2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

⑥ He's on pace to score 123 times; Alomar (132 in 1996), Frank Robinson (122 in 1966), and Ripken,

a season. He ranks fourth in the AL and MLB with 7.4 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; eight Orioles (13 occurences) have finished a season with at least 7.0 fWAR in a season; he's also among AL leaders in walks (3^{rd} , 72), home runs (4^{th} , 36), total bases (3^{rd} , 307), hits (6^{th} , 161), extra-base hits (6^{th} , 68), on-base percentage (7^{th} , 308), OPS(7^{th} , 906), and slugging percentage (8^{th} , 538). Henderson has hit 30 of his home runs as the leadoff hitter, the second player in Orioles history to do so, along with **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996; he's batting .323/.381/.708 (31-for-96) with seven doubles and 10 home runs when leading off the game...His 1.089 OPS to begin a game is the best such mark in MLB this year and the second-best such OPS by an Oriole in team history, behind Anderson (1.256) in 1996 (min. 55 GS).

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander launched his 40th home run of the year on Monday, becoming the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to do so and the first since Mark Trumbo in 2016 (see chart at right)... He's the eighth switch-hitter (12th occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

(b) He's six RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since Jonathan Schoop (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is Bobby Bonilla (116) in 1996.

(c) Santander has hit 31 home runs since the start of June, tied with New York-AL's Aaron Judge and trailing Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (32) for the most in MLB during that time; his 40 home runs rank third in MLB behind Judge (51) and Ohtani (46).

(d) His 101 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and second in the AL, behind only Judge (150).

(d) He's the ninth player in 0's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining Manny Machado (3, 2015-17), Chris Davis (4, 2012-13, 15-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Rafael Palmeiro (4, 1995-98), Eddie Murray (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), Boog Powell (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), Frank Robinson (3, 1966-67, 69), and Jim Gentile (2, 1961-62).

(d) Santander is tied for 13th in team history with 151 home runs with Chris Hoiles, seven behind Melvin Mora for 12th.

HOLY COWSER: Colton Cowser leads AL rookies and is second among MLB rookies with 20 home runs, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (23)...He's the 10th rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since Gunnar Henderson (28) last year...He also has 21 doubles, the ninth rookie in 0's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Cowser is second among AL rookies and ranks third among MLB rookies with 3.5 fWAR, trailing New York-AL's Austin Wells (3.6) and San Diego's Merrill (4.4)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 70), extra-base hits (2nd, 43), total bases (2nd, 192), doubles (T-2nd, 21), RBI (3nd, 62), and OPS (4nd, 756).

Ð. His 10 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; the next closest left fielders have four OAA.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore's penultimate road trip began in Boston on Monday...Following an off day on Thursday, the Orioles face Detroit for three games beginning Friday...Despite losing 14 of the last 25 road games, the Orioles are 41-30 (.571) away from Oriole Park, the third-best road record in MLB this season behind the Padres (.592, 42-29) and Yankees (.600, 45-30)...He Birds are 93-59 (.612) on the road since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 in that time.

HIGH SOX: The Orioles and Red Sox complete their season series tonight at Fenway Park...At 8-4, Baltimore has won the season series with Boston for a second straight year after going 7-6 in 2023...

This marks the first time the O's have won the season series with the Sox in back-to-back years since doing so in four straight from 2012-15...Last night's win guarantees a winning percentage of at least 600 against the Red Sox for the 15th time in team history (since 1954) and for the first time since 2012 (.722, 13-5)...A win tonight would secure the fourth-best winning percentage against the Sox in Orioles history, behind 2012 and 1970 (.722, 13-5), and 1960 (.727, 16-6).
