THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 5-1 (2-1 vs. Chicago-AL and 3-0 vs. Los Angeles-AL), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a win in Cleveland last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of four at Progressive Field...they will complete the series on Thursday then travel to Boston for a three-game series at Fenway Park over the weekend.

☞ Twins are currently on a season-long four-game winning streak, seeking their first five-game winning streak since July 31-August 5, 2024 (1 at NYM, 3 vs. CWS, 1 at CHC).
☞ Twins are 8-4 in their last 12...after starting the season 0-4, Minnesota has gone 13-12.
☞ Over the last seven games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +28 (42-14)...they now sit at +8 overall on the season (117-109) — first time in the positive in 2025.

CLEVELAND ROCKED: The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 11-1, their largest margin of victory this season...11 runs matched a season-high, done on Friday night against the Angels in an 11-4 win...Bailey Ober (3-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on eight hits in 7.2 innings pitched — the longest start for a Twin this season...the offense recorded a season-high 17 hits, as six Twins had multiple hits...Jonah Bride went 3-for-4 with one RBI...Edouard Julien and Ryan Jeffers each homered, as Julien's was his fourth career leadoff homer and Jeffers' was his first homer of the season.

GUARD PLAY: The Twins are playing the Guardians today, for the second of 13 games in 2025...the Twins are seeking back-to-back wins against the Guardians for the first time since sweeping a doubleheader at Target Field on August 9, 2024...last time they won two-straight at Progressive Field came September 4-5, 2023.

☞ Two more wins in these next three days will give the Twins their first series win over the Guardians since taking two of three from September 4-6, 2023 at Progressive Field.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .313 (41-for-131) with seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .400 on-base percentage, a .496 slugging percentage and an .896 OPS in 35 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022 (since he joined the Twins)...Correa is 6-for-17 (.353) with one walk lifetime against Tanner Bibee.

☞ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 71 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most of any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (91)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 55).

☞ Harrison Bader is 6-for-19 (.316) with three doubles, two home runs and a 1.170 OPS in six career regular season games at Progressive Field.

☞ Christian Vázquez is hitting .296 (37-for-125) with 10 doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and a .358 on-base percentage in 40 career games vs. the Guards.

11 POINT BUCK: Over his last 11 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits six times and is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with one double, two triples, three home runs, 10 RBI, 11 runs scored, a .630 slugging percentage and a .957 OPS in that span.

☞ Buck ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball in hard hit percentage (55.2%) and in the 89th percentile in barrel percentage (16.4%).

BY-RUN: Byron Buxton ranks second in baseball in average sprint speed at 30.1 mph, trailing Bobby Witt Jr. (30.3 mph)...he ranks in the 100th percentile in baseball in baserunning value...Buck enters today with six stolen bases (6 att.) on the season...he stole seven all of 2024...he has 99 for his career, eighth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

NOTE: With Buck's 139 career home runs, he will become the third player in club history to reach 100+ steals and 100+ home runs, joining Kirby Puckett (207 HR/134 SB) and Torii Hunter (214 HR/128 SB).

LUMBER UP: In the last six games, the Twins are hitting .323 (65-for-201) with 16 doubles, six home runs, 38 runs scored (6.3 R/G) and a .906 OPS...over the last four games, the Twins are hitting .420 (21-for-50) with runners in scoring position.

C4 WHEEL DRIVE: Over this last four games, Carlos Correa has eight hits in his last 15 at-bats (.533) with one double, one walk and three RBI...below are his first 18 games (March 27-April 16), compared to his last 10 games (since April 18):

TY BREAKERS: Ty France drove in two more runs last night, giving him 17 on the season, tied with Buxton for team-lead...of those 17 RBI, 15 have come in his last 18 games, since April 9...since that date, the 15 RBI rank second in the AL, trailing Spencer Forkelson (17).

☞ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 25 RISP at-bats, his .419 RISP average ranks second-best, trailing Gavin Lux (.423).

MY NAME IS JONAH: Since being acquired from Miami in a trade on April 16, Jonah Bride has gone 7-for-14 (.500) with two RBI, one walk and a 1.033 OPS...in 12 games for the Marlins, Bride went 4-for-40 (.100) with no extra-base hits and 15 strikeouts.

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis has gone 3-for-6 in two games on his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...he plans to play nine innings as the club's designated hitter today...Royce has missed all 29 games with a left hamstring strain, an injury he suffered in spring training on March 16, running out a ground ball to third base.

FYI: Right-handed pitcher Matt Canterino has re-signed with the organization on a two-year minor league contract...he was DFA'd on April 18 to make room on the 40-man roster for Luke Keaschall...Canterino underwent right shoulder surgery in mid-March and will not pitch in 2025.

- ⚡ Making his sixth start of the season and 88th of his career (91st appearance)...took the loss in his last outing on April 24 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field (5.0 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 5 K).
- ⚡ Facing Cleveland for the second time in his career...did not factor into the decision of his first start, a 5-2 Twins loss at Progressive Field on May 19, 2024 (8.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 1 HR, 6 K).
- ⚡ Is 0-3 with an 8.10 ERA (13.1 IP, 12 ER) in three starts this season against the American League Central (White Sox-2, Detroit-1).

LAST TIME OUT: Took his third loss of the season on April 24 vs. Chicago-AL, a 7.0-inning rain-shortened game at Target Field opposite Shane Smith...allowed two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings, with four walks and five strikeouts...Twins were shut out 3-0, their third time being shut out this season – Paddack started each of the three games; Twins are 0-5 in Paddack's starts this season...four walks allowed tied his season and career high.

- ⚡ Surrendered a home run to Lenyn Sosa off the first pitch of the second inning, the 17th time in his career and second time this season allowing a homer on the first pitch of an at-bat (did so on 3/31/25 at Rate Field, Andrew Benintendi was the batter).
- ⚡ Walked in a run in the fourth inning after loading the bases on two walks and a single with two outs...marked his first career bases-loaded walk and his 13th bases-loaded RBI allowed.
- ⚡ Five strikeouts mark his third consecutive outing with five-or-more strikeouts, a streak Paddack had not yet accomplished in a Twins uniform...struck out five-or-more batters in three consecutive outings seven times while playing for San Diego, including one five-game streak and four four-game streaks.

TWO STARTS AGO: Faced the Braves in Atlanta on April 18 opposite right-hander Bryce Elder...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-4 loss, allowed one run on three hits, including a solo home run by Jared Kelenic in the fifth inning, with one walk and six strikeouts...Twins led the Braves 4-1 when Paddack exited the game; Minnesota's bullpen allowed five one-out runs in the bottom of the eighth inning.

- ⚡ Marked second time this season the Twins have blown a lead that they held when Paddack left the game; also, April 6 vs. Houston...prior to this season, the Twins had never lost a game in which they led their opponent at the time of Paddack's exit.
- ⚡ Marked just the second time since joining the Twins that Paddack's lone run allowed came via a solo home run; also did so on May 8, 2024 vs. Seattle.

FACING CLEVELAND: Faced Cleveland for the sole time in his career on May 19, 2024 at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-2 loss; allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) over a career-high 8.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts...home run was hit by Andrés Giménez with a runner on in the first inning; after, Paddack faced just one batter over the minimum the rest of the game, a one-out double by Gabriel Arias in the fifth inning.

- ⚡ Of the 28 teams he has faced in his career, Cleveland is one of two that Paddack has yet to face twice...Miami is the other, while San Diego and Minnesota are the only two teams Paddack has never faced in his career.

DIVISION WORK: Did not face the American League Central until joining the Twins pitching staff in 2022...in nine starts against the division (CWS-4, KC-2, DET-2, CLE-1), Paddack is 1-4 with a 4.17 ERA (49.2 IP, 23 ER); Twins are 4-5...of the eight Twins pitchers with nine-or-more divisional starts since 2022, Paddack's 3.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks sixth, while his 7.25 hits-per-nine innings pitched trails only Joe Ryan (6.30).

- ⚡ His lone career win against the AL Central came on April 22, 2024 vs. the White Sox in Minnesota...since, is 0-3 with a 5.63 ERA (32.0 IP, 20 ER) in six starts; Twins are 2-4 and have been outscored by division opponents 36-14.
- ⚡ Since 2022, American League Central batters are slashing .220/.275/.385 in 182 at-bats against Paddack, compared to a slash line of .281/.323/.437 in 556 at-bats against all opponents.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Is making his third road start of the season...since the start of 2024, is 1-3 with a 7.30 ERA (49.1 IP, 40 ER) over 10 road starts; Twins are 3-7...in that span, he is averaging 10.4 hits-per-nine innings pitched with a 2.29 strikeout-to-walk ratio; has allowed 10 home runs, a .284 (57-for-201) opponent batting average and an .812 opponent OPS...in 12 home starts since the start of 2024, is 4-3 with a 3.67 ERA (61.1 IP, 25 ER), a 3.53 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a .741 opponent OPS.

- ⚡ In his career, Paddack is 11-14 with a 4.74 ERA (224.0 IP, 118 ER) over 45 road appearances (44 starts)...over that span, road opponents are slashing .248/.294/.446 with 41 home runs, 52 walks and 209 strikeouts against Paddack.
- ⚡ First pitched at an American League Central ballpark on April 20, 2022 at Kansas City...since then, has pitched in Cleveland once and Chicago twice...in those four starts, is 0-2 with a 6.33 ERA (21.1 IP, 15 ER), five home runs, a 2.50 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 1.08 WHIP...nine of his runs allowed, including three home runs, came in his start in Chicago on March 31 to open this season; prior to that game, held a 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 6 ER) and a 0.72 WHIP at AL Central ballparks.

PLATOON SPLITS: So far this season, left-handed hitters are batting .242 (8-for-33) with two home runs, six walks, six strikeouts and six RBI against Paddack, while righties are batting .278 (15-for-54) with three home runs, seven walks, 14 strikeouts and 11 RBI...since the start of 2024, lefties are slashing .294/.348/.450 with nine home runs and 2.11 strikeouts-per-walk against Paddack, while righties are slashing .267/.310/.441 with 10 home runs and 3.81 strikeouts-per-walk.

- ⚡ In a Twins uniform, Paddack has allowed a .296 BAA with 18 walks and 49 strikeouts against lefties and a .268 BAA with 19 walks and 78 strikeouts against righties.
- ⚡ In nine career games facing the American League Central, Paddack has allowed a .203 BAA with four homers, six walks and 17 strikeouts to lefties, compared to a .233 BAA with four homers, nine walks and 28 strikeouts to righties.

THE ARSENAL: Through five starts in 2025, Paddack has a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

- ⚡ So far this season, Paddack's changeup has the highest whiff rate (28.3 percent) while his four-seamer has the highest putaway rate (15.5 percent)...overall, he is inducing weak contact 8.5 percent of the time while batters are barreling the ball at an identical rate of 8.5 percent.
- ⚡ Paddack has thrown 437 pitches so far this season...his average arm angle is 49 degrees, up from 45 in 2023 and 46 in 2024, while his average spin rate is 2,097 rpm, up from 2,088 rpm in 2024...his average extension ranks in baseball's 90th percentile (7.0 feet for 4-seam and slider, 6.9 feet for changeup, 6.8 feet for curve)...his perceived velocity is 89.2 mph, compared to 88.1 in 2024.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2025: 2-1, 2.08 ERA // CAREER: 56-50, 3.86 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is set to start tomorrow night's game at Progressive Field...last pitched on April 25 vs. the Angels at Target Field, his first start since being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right hamstring strain); earned his second win of the season while allowing two runs on five hits over 5.0 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts...is 2-2 in six career starts against Cleveland, posting a 3.50 ERA (36.0 IP, 14 ER) with one home run, 12 walks and 25 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025 marks his ninth professional season and fourth with the Twins...is seeking his first unabridged major league season since his rookie year in 2019.
- Finished 2024 season on 15-day IL with a right shoulder strain, retroactive July 20.
- Pitched a career-high 8.0 inning game on May 19, 2024 at Cleveland...previous high of 7.2 innings, May 6, 2019 and July 17, 2019 with San Diego.
- Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
- In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
- Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
- In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
- In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
- Made Postseason debut in 2020 NL Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, surrendering six earned runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings...credited with loss in Game 1.
- In 2020, made Opening Day start and earned win July 24 vs. Arizona...posted 4.73 ERA across 12 regular season outings...became seventh pitcher in San Diego franchise history with 200+ strikeouts in first 35 career starts.
