AND AWAY WE GO: The Detroit Tigers this afternoon play the series finale of their three-game set at the Houston Astros after suffering setbacks in each of the first two games ... the Tigers have now dropped just their third series of the season and their first in two weeks since losing two of three in Milwaukee April 14-16 ... the Tigers are now 7-3 in their 10 series this season ... the Tigers have lost the first two games of this road trip after turning in an 8-2 homestand into this journey.

- Despite back-to-back losses, the Tigers are still tied with the Yankees for the best record in the American League at 18-12 ... the Tigers have their best record through 30 games to start a season in 10 years when they began 19-11 in 2015.
- After today's series finale, the Tigers continue their season-long 11-day, 10-game, three-city road trip tomorrow with the first of four games at the Los Angeles Angels ... the trek concludes with three games next week in Colorado.
- This week marked Detroit's first visit to Houston since sweeping the American League Wild Card Series here in two games last October, Detroit's first playoff appearance in 10 years.
- The Tigers today continue their stretch of 23 games in 24 days through this Sunday, May 4.

APRIL POWERS: With 17 wins, the Tigers have the second-most wins within the month of April in franchise history and are one victory short of tying the all-time club mark of 18 wins in April set by the 1984 Tigers ... nevertheless, thanks to a win in March this year, the 2025 Tigers will wake up on May 1 with at least 18 wins for just the second time in club history, joining 1984 (18-2).

- Kerry Carpenter and Spencer Torkelson have each hit seven home runs in April, the fourth set of Tigers teammates to ever hit seven homers in the same April (first since Curtis Granderson and Brandon Inge in 2009) ... in franchise history, only three Tigers players have hit more homers in April than Carpenter and Torkelson: Chris Shelton (10 in April of 2006), Cecil Fielder (10 in 1996) and Tony Clark (eight in 1997).
- Torkelson also has 23 RBI this April, tied for seventh most by any Tiger in the month of April and the most by any Tiger since Miguel Cabrera (28) and Prince Fielder (27) in 2013.
- Casey Mize is the first Tigers pitcher win four games in April since Jordan Zimmermann won five games in April of 2016.
- Tigers starters have a 2.69 ERA (43 ER/144.0 IP) in April, the second-lowest mark by the club's starting staff in April in the last 51 years starting in 1974 behind only the 1984 club (2.45 ERA).

A RARE FEAT: Zach McKinstry enters today riding an active nine-game hitting streak, tied for the third-longest active hitting streak in the A.L. and already McKinstry's second hitting streak of eight or more games on the young season ... he joins Milwaukee's William Contreras as the only players with multiple hitting streaks of at least eight games this year and is the first Tigers player with multiple hitting streaks of eight or more games in April since Miguel Cabrera in April of 2013.

- According to Fangraphs, McKinstry has posted a team-leading 1.5 WAR, tied for second-best in the A.L. with Bobby Witt Jr., Hunter Brown, Wilyer Abreu, Alex Bregman and Cal Raleigh.

QUALITY IS JOBE ONE: Tigers starter Jackson Jobe makes the fifth big league start of his career today but his first in 12 days after a sixth starter, off day and rainout pushed Jobe's next start back a couple of times ... the Tigers are 4-0 in his starts this season ... entering this year Jobe had made a pair of regular season and playoff relief appearances but had not yet made a big league start.

- Jobe is the first starting pitcher to make the Tigers opening day rotation at age 22 or younger since Rick Porcello in 2011.
- Jobe was selected by the Tigers with the third overall pick of the 2021 Draft out of Heritage Hall School in Oklahoma City ... the 22-year-old righthander made his major league debut late last September and pitched in both rounds of the Tigers playoff run ... Jobe entered the 2025 campaign ranked the #3 prospect in the game by *Baseball America*.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ: The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.79 ERA (31 ER/100.0 IP) this season, just behind Houston (2.77 ERA) for lowest in the American League and the fourth-lowest mark in all of baseball, also behind San Diego (1.66) and San Francisco (2.23) ... Tigers relievers have also combined to limit opponents to a .608 OPS, tied for the third lowest mark in the A.L. ... Detroit's 100.0 relief innings pitched are the fourth fewest in the A.L.

THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE: The Tigers begin the day tied for the best record in the A.L. on the strength of a +37 run differential this year, the second-best mark in the A.L. behind the Yankees (+53) ... the Tigers are one of seven A.L. teams in positive run-differential territory, but they and the Yankees are well ahead of the third-best Mariners (+17) and Red Sox (+17) ... overall, the Tigers are fifth in the majors with their +37 run differential.

AND FINALLY: Only four Tigers rookie pitchers in club history have recorded three wins in a single month of April: Justin Verlander (2006), Jeff Weaver (1999), Greg Keagle (1996) and Jon Warden (1968) ... Jackson Jobe is 2-0 in April into this afternoon's start.

- Earned his first Major League win against the Twins on April 12, 2025, allowing two hits and one walk while striking out two over 6.0 scoreless innings.
- Entered the 2025 season ranked as MLB's No. 5 overall prospect and the top prospect in the Tigers' system according to *MLB Pipeline*.
- Earned a spot on the Opening Day roster for the first time in his career after going 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA in five Spring Training starts.
- Was promoted to the Majors near the end of the 2024 season and pitched in two regular season games with the Tigers, working 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, one walk and two strikeouts.
- Made his Major League debut on Sept. 25 vs. Tampa Bay last year, closing out Detroit's win with a scoreless ninth inning.
- At 22 years and 64 days old, was Detroit's fourth-youngest pitcher to appear in a postseason game (Oct. 2), trailing only Joel Zumaya (2006), Fred Hutchinson (1940) and Ralph Works (1909).

- Earned a spot on his first career Opening Day roster after a standout spring camp, during which he didn't allow a single earned run over 10.2 innings (nine games) of relief...went 1-0, surrendering seven hits and three walks while striking out nine
- Appeared in 21 games (three starts) for the Tigers in 2024, posting a 1-1 record with a 1.84 ERA (6ER/29.1IP), six walks and 23 strikeouts...also made 34 appearances with Triple-A Toledo last year, going 1-2 with one save, a 5.17 ERA (27ER/47.0IP) and 53 strikeouts.
- Made his first career Major League start on Aug. 8 at Seattle...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, became the first Tigers pitcher to finish and then start consecutive games since Steve Sparks, who finished the July 26, 2000, game vs. Tampa Bay and started on July 27, 2000, at Texas.
- Allowed only one earned run over 13 outings from Aug. 4-Sept. 7, posting a 0.49 ERA (1ER/18.1IP) with 13 hits allowed, three walks and 12 strikeouts.

- Spent the entire 2024 season with the Tigers, pitching in 66 games (nine starts) and going 7-2 with eight saves, a 2.19 ERA (23ER/94.1IP) and 77 strikeouts.
- Led all Major League pitchers last season (min. 90.0 innings) with a 0.78 WHIP, a .173 opponent batting average, a .222 opponent on-base percentage and a .500 opponent OPS...earned one 10th place AL MVP vote last season, joining Tarik Skubal as the second Tigers player to record at least one vote for the award.
