THE GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE: The St. Louis Cardinals enter their 135th season of play in the National League and are conducting their 29th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2026) ... The Cardinals previously hosted spring training at Al Lang Stadium (1947-1997) in St. Petersburg.

THE GRAPEFRUIT GANG: The 2026 Cardinals Major League Spring Training roster sports 68 players with 28 non-roster invitees ... 49 in camp were signed/drafted and developed by the Cardinals, including seven first round picks: INF Nolan Gorman (2018), LHP Zack Thompson (2019), OF Jordan Walker (2020), RHP Michael McGreevy (2021), LHP Cooper Hjerpe (2022), OF Chase Davis (2023), and INF JJ Wetherholt (2024).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: Happy 43rd birthday to Cardinals President of Baseball Operations Chaim Bloom and 61st birthday to Cardinals TV broadcaster Chip Caray!

GEORGE KISSELL AWARD: Dominican Summer League Cardinals (R) Manager Fray Peniche was recently named the 2025 recipient of the George Kissell Award ... Since 2008, winners have been selected by a poll of Cardinals minor league staff ... The award is presented to a Cardinals staffer who exhibits excellence in player development ... Peniche, 52, enters his 16th season as a coach in the Cardinals organization (28th overall), all as manager for the DSL Cardinals at the Cardinals Dominican Academy in Boca Chica ... The Dominican native has compiled a 449-462 record since he was hired in 2011.

NEW FACES IN NEW SPACES: Acquired during the offseason and appearing in their first Cardinals spring camp include pitchers Scott Blewett (FA), Justin Bruhl (Trade), Jurrangelo Cijntje (Trade), Hunter Dobbins (Trade), Richard Fitts (Trade), Dustin May (FA), Matt Pushard (Rule 5), Jared Shuster (FA), George Soriano (Trade); Ryne Stanek (FA), and Bruce Zimmermann (FA); infielder Ramón Urías (FA); and outfielder Nelson Velázquez (FA).

PARDON OUR DUST: St. Louis moved into its newly-renovated Cardinals Complex this spring, featuring a new performance center, conference center, clubhouse and "Birdfeeder" dining hall...the final phase of the three phase project that began back in 2023 is slated to be completed later this year.

WORLD CLASS: The Cardinals have nine players, two coaches, and one athletic trainer on provisional rosters for the 2026 World Baseball Classic taking place from March 5-17 ... Among those in Major League camp include Riley O'Brien (Korea), Leo Bernal (Panama), Gordon Graceffo (Italy), Thomas Saggese (Italy), Luis Gastelum (Mexico), Matt Koperniak (Great Britain), Bryan Torres (Puerto Rico), coaches Stubby Clapp (Canada), Julio Rangel (Panama), and Certified Asst. Athletic Trainer Chris Conroy (Puerto Rico).

IN FULL BLOOM: The Cardinals introduced Chaim Bloom on Sept. 30 as the team's new President of Baseball Operations taking the post that had been held by John Mozeliak who headed the team's baseball operations since Oct. of 2007 ... Bloom, who worked previously with the Boston Red Sox (2020-23) and Tampa Bay Rays (2005-19) had served as an advisor for the Cardinals the past two seasons.

BE OUR GUEST: Those scheduled to visit Jupiter in a coaching capacity this Spring Training include special Guest Instructors David Freese, Kolten Wong, Adam Wainwright, and Ozzie Smith, and Cardinals Special Assistants Yadier Molina and Willie McGee.

LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION: The Cardinals are launching a new way for fans to watch the games this season on MLB produced Cardinals.TV ... Chip Caray, Brad Thompson, Dani Wexelman, and Stefan Caray will be part of the team calling games this spring ... 16 Spring Training games on Cardinals.TV/MLB.TV will be free to stream with an MLB.com account ... Additionally, eight of the Cardinals.TV Spring telecasts will be simulcast locally on free, over-the-air Matrix Midwest.

100: Masyn Winn was named the 2025 winner of the Rawlings Gold Glove Award at shortstop, the first of his career and the 100th by the Cardinals - the most all-time for any MLB franchise since the award's inception in 1957 ... Winn joined Ozzie Smith (11 times), Edgar Rentería (2), and Dal Maxvill (1) as the fourth Cardinals shortstop to win the award.

NEW COACHES: Two new members of the team's 2026 coaching staff include Assistant Hitting Coach Casey Chenoweth and Assistant Pitching Coach Kyle Driscoll.

TODAY'S PITCHERS

#60 QUINN MATHEWS · LHP · 6-4 · 210 LBS · AGE 25

- Invited to Major League Spring Training camp for the second consecutive season; worked 6.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts in two outings (1 start) in 2025 Spring Training.
- Enters the 2026 season rated as the No. 5 prospect in the Cardinals organization by both Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus, as well as the No. 150 prospect, overall, by ESPN.com.
- Ranked among Cardinals 2025 minor league leaders in strikeouts (115, 6th) and games started (24, T-5th).
- Led Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (202) in 2024 while splitting time among all four Cardinals full-season minor league affiliates. Was the 2nd MiLB pitcher to eclipse 200 K's in a season since 2011, joining ARI's Brandon Pfaadt (218 in 2022).
- Became the 10th Cardinals minor league pitcher in franchise history to reach the 200-strikeout threshold and first since Rick Ankiel (222 in 1998).
- 2024 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year. Was the 4th to be honored in his first pro season, joining Max Rajcic (2023), Anthony Reyes (2004) and Rick Ankiel (1998).
- Started the club's 2025 Spring Breakout game March 14 against Miami, tossing 3.0 scoreless frames with one hit allowed, three walks and three strikeouts in a game that ended in a 3-3 tie.

#67 MATT PUSHARD · RHP · 6-3 · 250 LBS · AGE 28

- Selected from the Miami Marlins in the 2025 Major League Baseball Rule 5 Draft. Became the first Major League Rule 5 Draft Pick the Cardinals have selected from the Marlins.
- Member of the 2025 International League Champion Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (AAA).
- Was originally signed by the Miami Marlins as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Maine in 2022.
- Made professional debut in the Florida Complex League at 24-years old making five appearances.
- Has held his opposition to a .197 BA over 722 total batters faced over his minor league career.
- Developed a sweeper during the 2025 season, an east-to-west pitch from his over-the-top pitching slot.
- Appeared in 134 minor league games as a member of the Marlins organization. Made only one start, coming in 2025 in Jacksonville (AAA). A spot start at Syracuse (6/17) pitching 2.0 innings.
- Joins former Cardinals outfielder and current television talent Mark Sweeney as collegiate players to play at Maine.

#64 RYAN FERNANDEZ · RHP · 6-0 · 205 LBS · AGE 27

- 2023 Rule 5 pick from Boston spent his first full season in the Majors in 2024 and appeared in a professional season high in games (62) and innings pitched (66.2).
- Became the first Rule 5 Selection to play an entire season with St. Louis since RHP Matt Bowman (2015).
- His 62 appearances for St. Louis in 2024 were the most by a Cardinals rookie since Giovanny Gallegos (66 in 2016).
- Made Major League debut on April 3, 2024 at San Diego, striking out the side in the 9th inning. Became the 38th pitcher in MLB history and the 2nd Cardinal (Braden Loper, March 31, 1998 vs. Dodgers) to strike out three in 1.0 inning pitched in an MLB debut.
- Pitched in 32 games over two stints with St. Louis. Began the season on the Opening Day roster and appeared

#47 JUSTIN BRUIHL · LHP · 6-0 · 215 LBS · AGE 28

- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Guardians for cash considerations, January 6, 2026.
- Former non-drafted free agent looking to appear in games with fifth Major League club, previously appearing in 94 total games with the Dodgers (65), Blue Jays (15), Rockies (7) and Pirates (7). Signed as a free agent with the Reds in 2024, but did not pitch in a Major League game.
- Pitched in 15 games in relief for the American League Champion Blue Jays.
- Appeared in four career postseason games, three with the Dodgers in the 2021 National League Championship Series and one with the Blue Jays vs. NYY in the 2025 American League Division Series. Did not allow a run in his three appearances vs. ATL with one hit and five strikeouts.
- Played college baseball at California Polytechnic State University at San Luis Obispo (Cal Poly-SLO), the same college that produced Cardinals Hall of Fame shortstop Ozzie Smith and former Cardinals relief pitcher Bud Norris.
