**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals opened the post All-Star break portion of their schedule in Arizona on Friday and were swept by the Diamondbacks at Chase Field for the first time since 2007...the Cardinals begin a three game series against the Colorado Rockies tonight to conclude their six-game roadtrip...the Cardinals wrapped up their pre-break schedule by splitting a six-game homestand with Washington (2-1) & Atlanta (1-2).

**BIRD WATCHING:** St. Louis posted 51 wins before the All-Star Break,their most since 2015 (56)...it marked the first time the Cardinals had logged 50+ victories prior to the Break in back-to-back years since 2014-15 (52 & 56)...the Cardinals began today in 4th place in the NL Central, 8.5 games behind first place Chicago and 3.5 games behind San Diego for the 3rd and final NL Wild Card spot.

**TAP THE ROCKIES:** The Cardinals have won the season series vs. the Rockies 22 times in 31 seasons since Colorado joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993...the Cardinals & Rockies are meeting for the 1st time this season tonight.

**MILE HIGH HIKE:** The Cardinals (108g), Cubs (105g), and Mets (107g) are the only three National League teams that have never had a pitcher throw a complete game at Coors Field ... **Braden Looper** (8.1 IP) came the closest by a Cardinal in Denver on May 6, 2008 ... The Cardinals, who also had no route-going efforts in their 12 games played in 1993-94 at Denver's Mile High Stadium, also lack a complete game effort in their 66 regular season games at Philadelphia's Citizens Bank Park, although they did have **Chris Carpenter's** Divison Series clinching gem in 2011.

**FOUR!** The Cardinals have scored four or more runs in all 9 games that they have played at Coors Field since Oliver Marmol became manager in 2022. It's currently the longest active streak of four-run games at Coors Field of any Major League opponent. It's also one game shy of the Cardinals longest streak in team history at the 30-year old ballpark, in which they had 10-game streaks twice (2002-05 & 1996-98).

**HOW DO YOU SPELL RELIEF?** **Ryan Helsley** is one of five pitchers all-time and one of two active pitchers along with **Devin Williams** (10 app, 9.1 IP) to make 10+ appearances without allowing an earned run against the Rockies. Helsley has made 11 career appearances covering 12.0 IP & has 2 wins to go along with a perfect 5-for-5 in save opportunities. His lone unearned run came in his first career appearance vs. COL at Busch Stadium (8/25/19) earning the win with 2.1 innings in relief of Michael Wacha.

**WESTWARD EXPANSION:** Dating back to a June 8 loss to the Los Angeles Dodgers, the Cardinals have lost four straight games to National League West opponents. The Cardinals haven't lost five straight games to N.L. West opponents since May 31-June 30, 2009 when they lost at San Francisco (1), were swept in four-game at home by Colorado (4) and then lost two more to San Francisco (2) at home for a seven game streak.

**THE BIG FIVE-0:** Happy birthday to former Colorado resident, Centaurus High (Lafayette, CO) grad, and Mizzou Journalism School alum **Derrick Goold** who today is celebrating his 50th birthday...the award-winning author, podcaster & comic book web-slinger formerly worked the sports beat for the Rocky Mountain News...DG, who served as the BBWAA Chapter President in 2016, joined the Cardinals coverage with the St. Louis Post-Dispatch in 2004 working alongside Baseball Hall of Fame writer, the late Rick Hummel, and the late Joe Strauss.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY HUNGO:** Cardinals Class of 2025 Hall of Fame selection **Al Hrabosky** is celebrating his 76th birthday today...The Mad Hungarian, who currently serves as a studio analyst for Cardinals games on FanDuel Sports, will be inducted into the Cardinals Hall of Fame with Edgar Renteria and the late Walt Jocketty during an enshrinement ceremony that will be held at Ballpark Village during Hall of Fame Weekend presented by Edward Jones on Saturday, September 6.

**ON THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY:** The Cardinals won a 13-11 slugfest over the Rockies at Coors Field on this date in 1993, thanks to an eight-run 6th inning that was highlighted by two-run singles from **Bernard Gilkey** and **Gregg Jefferies**. Closer **Lee Smith** allowed a pair of Colorado runs in the 9th, but converted his league-leading 34th save.

#### COLORADO CONNECTIONS

**Nolan Arenado** played eight seasons with Colorado (2013-20), where he was a five-time NL All-Star and the winner of four Silver Sluggers, eight Gold Gloves, and four Platinum Gloves...originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft...Acquired by St. Louis with cash in exchange for **Austin Gomber**, **Elehuris Montero**, **Tony Locey**, **Mateo Gil** and **Jake Sommers**.

**Nolan Arenado's** cousin, **Josh Fuentes**, played three seasons with the Rockies (2019-21) and college baseball at Missouri Baptist Univ. (2014).

**Garrett Hampson** was selected by Colorado in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played parts of five seasons for the Rockies (2018-22).

**Daniel Descalso** played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).

**Kyle Leahy** was born in and resides in Boulder...graduated from Erie High School, and selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).

**Austin Gomber** pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2018, '20)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft...shared Cardinals Co-Minor League Pitchers of the Year honors with **Alex Reyes** in 2015.

**John Mozeliak** began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season...graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher...graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Holliday** was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.

Rockies Bench Coach **Clint Hurdle** played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.

Rockies MLB.com **Thomas Harding** covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer **Anne Rogers**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist **Benjamin Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is originally from Boulder...graduated from Centaurus High School in Lafayette...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Rockies Communications Coordinator **Kevin Collins** previously served as the 2015 Media Relations Intern for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Rockies Digital Comm. Manager **Nora Farrell** previously worked in communications and social media for St. Louis for part of seven seasons (2016-22).

TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- Cardinals 2021 first round pick (18th overall) out of the University of California-Santa Barbara was recalled today from Memphis (AAA). His 5th recall, including an appointment for a doubleheader.
- Tonight's outing his his first times facing an opponent for the second time in his career, last facing Colorado at Coors Field on Sept. 24, 2024. Received a no decision in a 7-3 Cardinals win.
- Has received two no-decisions in each of his last two MLB starts with the Cardinals winning both games (6/19 at CWS-G2 & 6/24 vs. CHI).
- Has made three starts and one relief appearance this season. Has faced 1st place teams in the National League in his games started at the time (CHI, NYM & LAD).
- Has yet to be scored upon in the 1st inning of any of his six Major League starts.
- Is 8-3 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts at Memphis this season.
- Ranks 3rd among International League in winning percentage (.727, 8-3), 5th in wins (8) wins and 8th in ERA (3.72) and WHIP (1.24).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Started on July 12 on the Saturday before the All-Star Break in the Majors and Triple-A. Allowed seven runs (6 ER) on a season-high eight hits over 5.0 innings in a 19-0 loss to Charlotte (White Sox).

2025:

- Was recalled twice from Memphis (AAA) and optioned back the following day on May 4-5 and June 8-9. Appointed as the 27th player for a doubleheader (June 19). Recalled on June 24 and again today.
- Did not pitch 5.0 or more innings for the first time in his most recent MLB start vs. CHI (6/24) getting removed after 4.2 innings allowing a career-high five runs in a no decision the Cardinals won 8-7.
- Sustained most of his damage from the 5-9 batters in the Dodgers lineup on June 8; as they were 7-for-14 while the Top 5 batters were a combined 1-for-12 which included Shohei Ohtani (1-3, 2B), Mookie Betts (0-3, K), Freddie Freeman (0-3, K) &Teoscar Hernandez (0-3).
- Made his 2025 debut against the New York Mets in Game 2 of a doubleheader on May 4. Earned the win and held the Mets scoreless to one hit over 5.2 innings with a walk and five strikeouts.
- Held Francisco Lindor (0-2, K), Juan Soto (0-2), Pete Alonso (0-2, K) and Mark Vientos (1-3, K) to 1-for-9 with 3 strikeouts.
- Is holding the top 5 batters of each lineup to 9-for-37 (.184) with a double and a home run while the bottom four batters have done most of the damage 10-for-33 (.303) with a home run, two triples and a double.**

CAREER:

- Since the start of 2022 leads all of Minor League Baseball in wins (39), Games Started (97), Innings Pitched (522.1) and Complete Games (4). Ranks tied for first in double plays induced (55), 11th in ERA (4.00) and 3rd in strikeout/walk ratio (3.59) among qualifiers.**
- Is 4-1 with a 3.05 ERA, 0.90 WHIP and .212 opp BA in eight career Major League appearances, making six starts.
- Cardinals are 7-1 in his eight Major League appearances.**
- No batters in the Top 5 slots in the lineup are batting better than .200 in his career with one home run (Seiya Suzuki, in his last start).**
- Made his Major League debut against the Texas Rangers on July 31, 2024, firing 7.0 innings allowing one run on five hits with three strikeouts.
- Scouted the Rangers while watching the game on TV from the hotel bar/restaurant across the street the night before he started.
- Posted a 1.96 ERA in 2024, the best four game start by a Cardinals pitcher since Rene Arocha in 1993 (1.52 ERA, 23.2 IP, 4 ER).
- Is the only pitcher in Cardinals history to earn a win as a starting pitcher (7/31/24 vs. TEX) and then as a relief pitcher in his second appearance (9/18/24 vs. PIT) in his first two MLB appearances.
- Entered the 2025 season as the No. 10 prospect in the Cardinals organization by *Baseball America*.

McGREEVY vs. COLORADO:

- Is facing Colorado for the second time in his career, his most appearances against any MLB opponent.
- Last start vs. Colorado came at Coors Field on Sept. 24, 2024 in a no decision the Cardinals won 7-3.
- Pitched 5.0 innings with a then-career-best five strikeouts (which was broken in his next start) and surrendered his first home run to Aaron Schunk.
