RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their seven-game homestand this afternoon with the final game of a three-game series with the division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates at Busch Stadium ... A win today would give the Redbirds a winning record on their seven-game homestand vs. Colorado (2-2) and Pittsburgh (1-1) ... After today's game, the Cardinals begin a seven-game road trip through Chicago's Wrigley Field (June 14-16), Miami's loanDepot park (June 17-19), and Birmingham, Alabama's Rickwood Field (June 20).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today tied with Chicago (33-35) and Cincinnati (33-35) in 2nd place in the NL Central, 7.0 games behind Milwaukee, and are one of seven teams separated in the NL Wild Card standings by 1.5 games ... Since Mother's Day (May 12-present), the Cardinals sport MLB's 5th-best winning pct. (.630, 17-10 record).

HIGHS & LOWS: The Cardinals have alternated wins and losses for the last eight games since June 4 (L-W-L-W-L-W-L-W) ... The last time St. Louis alternated wins and loss over a nine-game stretch was the final nine games of the COVID-shortened 2020 season from Sept. 20-27, 2020 (W-L-W-L-W-L-W-L-W).

YO HO HO! With a victory today, the Cardinals can win a series over Pittsburgh for the first time since Sept. 9-11, 2022 at PNC Park and avoid losing four series in a row to the Buccos for the first time since six straight from Sept. 18, 1991-Sept. 15, 1992.

CENTRAL CASTING: St. Louis has won six of its last eight divisional games since beginning the season 0-6 (all vs. Milwaukee).

HAPPY FLIGHT: The Redbirds are 9-13 in series finales, but are winners of their last seven since May 22 (vs. Orioles, vs. Cubs, at Cincinnati, at Philadelphia, at Houston, and vs. Rockies).

EARLY BIRDS: Today begins a stretch of four straight day games as the Cardinals head to Wrigley Field this weekend, matching Aug. 2-5 for the club's most matinees in a row this season ... St. Louis also plays day ball all three games of the upcoming August weekend series at Wrigley Field, followed by a 4:15 p.m. makeup game at Busch Stadium with the Mets (May 8 rainout) ... The Cardinals are 10-17 in day games (5-8 at Busch Stadium) in 2024.

HEATING UP: Nolan Arenado last night collected his 15th multi-hit effort and 3rd straight multiple-hit game for the first time since July 17-19, 2023 ... Arenado is 8-for-his-last 14 (.571), raising his batting average from .248 to .264 since June 8.

BRONCO: With four strikeouts today, Lance Lynn would reach 986 for his Cardinals career (2011-17, '24) and tie 2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer Matt Morris (1997-2005) for 6th all-time in Cardinals history ... Arenado is batting .324 at home (11th in MLB).

CLOSE CALLS: Forty-seven of the Cardinals 66 games (71.2%) this season have been decided by three runs or fewer, tied with the Mets for 2nd-most in Major League Baseball behind the Cubs (48) ... St. Louis is 9-9 in one-run games, 8-8 in two-run games, and 8-5 in three-run games (25-22 combined record).

- The Cardinals sport MLB's 2nd-lowest average margin of victory (2.53) ahead of only Tampa Bay (2.34).
- St. Louis 18-1 this season when the trio of JoJo Romero, Andrew Kittredge, and Ryan Helsley all pitch in the same game (lost May 4 vs. the Chicago White Sox)

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (June 13, 2006): Jason Isringhausen strikes out Ronny Paulino to close out a 2-1 win at Pittsburgh's PNC Park to pass Lee Smith for the Cardinals all-time saves record with his 161st ... Chris Carpenter fans 13 over 7.0 innings earlier in the night.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Michael Siani's younger brother, **Sammy Siani**, was selected by Pittsburgh with the 37th overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft and is an outfielder for Altoona (AA) in the Pirates organization.

Nolan Arenado (2009) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (SS).

Marco Gonzales pitched parts of three seasons in St. Louis (2014-15, '17)...was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#19) of 2013 MLB Draft...2014 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year...traded to Seattle for **Tyler O'Neill** (July 21, 2017).

Willson Contreras (June 17, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Sonny Gray** (July 10, 2013 at PNC Park), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park), and **Drew Rom** (Aug. 21, 2023 at PNC Park) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

David Bednar was teammates of **Adam Wainwright**, **Miles Mikolas**, **Paul Goldschmidt**, and **Nolan Arenado** on Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale, Ill... caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58).

Johan Oviedo signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22)...traded to Pittsburgh with **Malcom Nunez** for **José Quintana** and **Chris Stratton** (Aug. 2, 2022).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956... played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

NL Ranks: Lowest Run Support Average (3.44, 4th), Most Pitches/IP (17.7, 2nd), Unearned Runs (12, 1st*), No-Decisions (8, T-1st)

- Makes his 14th start of the season and the 331st of his career (355th appearance).
- His 25th career appearance against Pittsburgh today surpasses the Chicago Cubs for his most against any opponent.
- Has come away with losing decisions in 3 of his last 6 starts (3.94 ERA) since May 10, receiving one or zero runs of support in all three defeats.
- The Cardinals are 7-6 in his starts, with wins in three of his last four outings since 5/21.
- Needs four strikeouts to reach 986 for his Cardinals career and tie 2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** (1997-2005) for 6th all-time in franchise history.
- Is 31 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 45.2 innings from 2,000.
- Has thrown Fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, or cutter) for exactly 1,000 of his 1,157 total pitches (86.4%) this season, highest percentage of fastballs thrown among MLB starting pitchers. Only **Nestor Cortes** (1,021 of 1,290, 79.1%) has thrown more fastballs than Lynn.
- In the *Baseball Savant* database (2008-present), Lynn has thrown the 3rd-most fastballs (27,529) of any MLB pitcher behind **Justin Verlander** (27,572) and **Jon Lester** (32,520).
- St. Louis has played extra innings in four of his 13 starts this year
- Ranks T-1st among NL starters with eight no-decisions in his 13 starts.
- Ranks T-3rd in MLB with team-leading with 11 batters faced with the bases loaded, and leads MLB pitchers with 7 strikeouts.
- Has pitched 6.0 innings or more in just three of his 13 starts (all quality).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout in National League play on May 10 at Milwaukee after fanning Brice Turang (swinging) to lead off the 1st inning.

LAST TIME OUT

- Came away with a no-decision in last Friday's 8-5 win over the Rockies on Friday at Busch Stadium. All four runs came in the 4th inning as Michael Toglia hit a bases-loaded triple and scored on a throwing error. Exited with the scored tied at 4-4.

- Has never pitched at Busch Std. III as a visitor. Before the 2024 Home Opener (April 4), his last appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- Ranks 2nd in Busch Stadium III history to **Adam Wainwright** in starts (83), innings pitched (513.2), strikeouts (479), and wins (41).

CAREER

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, DNP) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field in 2021 in relief of pitcher **Shohei Ohtani**. Current teammates **Kyle Gibson** and **Andrew Kittredge** also pitched for the A.L. in that game.
- Placed in Top 10 in the AL Cy Young Award voting in 2019 (5th), 2020 (6th) & 2021 (3rd).
- Has returned to his original drafting/signing team (1st round, 2008) for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** in Single-A Quad Cities (2008) and High-A Palm Beach (2009).
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals. Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).
