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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore begins its final homestand of the year with a pair of three-game sets against Milwaukee and Toronto...The Orioles completed a six-game road trip at the Blue Jays (1-2) and Mets (3-0) on Wednesday...The O's are 3.0 games behind the Guardians for the final Wild Card spot with the Rangers (2.0 GB) and Blue Jays (2.0 GB) also in the mix.

🦅 **Pete Alonso, Christian Encarnacion-Strand, and Jeremiah Jackson** have all homered in back-to-back games...It's the first time three O's have gone deep in consecutive games since Chris Davis, Manny Machado, and Mark Trumbo on August 18-19, 2016, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

🦅 He Birds have hit four home runs in back-to-back games, tied for the longest such stretch in the majors this year with the Red Sox (8/2-4), Braves (7/3-4), Cubs (6/30-7/1), Astros (6/12-13), Athletics (6/8-9), Mariners (5/29-30), Reds (4/24-25), and White Sox (4/19-21)...No MLB team has done so in three straight since the Athletics from August 28-30, 2024...The O's current stretch is tied for the longest in team history (14x, last: 7/28-29 (G2), 2025).

🦅 **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** went 3-for-4 with two doubles, a homer, three runs, and two RBI on Wednesday at New York-NL...He set career highs in extra-base hits (3) and runs while becoming the fourth Oriole (5th occurrence) with three extra-base hits in a game this year along with **Gunnar Henderson** (2x, last: 8/30 at ATH), Adley Rutschman (6/5 at TOR), and Taylor Ward (4/8 at CWS).

🦅 **Chris Bassitt** tied a season high with 6.2 innings on Wednesday, joining August 25 at St. Louis and April 30 (G1) vs. Houston.

🦅 The O's have struck out 10+ times in a season-high seven straight games, the longest such stretch since a franchise-record 10-game streak from August 30-September 10, 2025.

POLAR PLUNGE: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (1st, 102), total bases (3rd, 288), home runs (4th, 37), OPS (5th, .864), slugging percentage (5th, .503), extra-base hits (6th, 61), hits (7th, 153), and runs (8th, 91)...Since the All-Star break, his 16 home runs lead the AL.

🦅 He leads the AL in RBI ahead of HOU's Yordan Alvarez (99 RBI)...Alonso led the NL with 131 RBI in 2022 with the Mets and looks to become the first player to lead the AL and the NL in RBI in a season...Seven Orioles have led the AL in RBI: Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

🦅 Alonso hit his 300th career home run on Tuesday at New York-NL, a game-tying solo homer in the ninth inning...According to *STATS Perform*, Alonso became the 10th fastest player to reach 300 career home runs at 1,160 games, trailing Aaron Judge (955 G), Ralph Kiner (1,087 G), Ryan Howard (1,093 G), Juan Gonzalez (1,096), Shohei Ohtani/Alex Rodriguez (both 1,117 G), Giancarlo Stanton (1,119 G), Harmon Killebrew (1,137 G), and Mark McGwire (1,148 G)...He's hit 301 career home runs, the third most in a player's first eight seasons in MLB history behind Ralph Kiner (329) and Albert Pujols (319).

🦅 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

🦅 Alonso's 37 home runs this year are tied for the fourth most by an Oriole in their first season with the club with Mark Reynolds (2011) and Albert Belle (1999), trailing Frank Robinson (49, 1966), Mark Trumbo (47, 2016), and Nelson Cruz (40, 2014).

🦅 He has started all 153 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with ATL's Matt Olson and PHI's Bryce Harper...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.

🦅 Alonso has played in 569 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (935 G).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 20 straight games, slashing .278/.350/.583 (20-for-72) with one double, seven home runs, 15 runs, 16 RBI, and seven walks.

🦅 It is tied for the longest on-base streak by an Oriole this season along with Taylor Ward from July 1-27...Baltimore has not had a longer streak since **Gunnar Henderson's** 36-game stretch from May 22-June 29, 2024.

🦅 Mayo's .563 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is the highest in the AL (min. 150 AB).

🦅 Since August 31, he is 8-for-32 (.250) with four home runs against right-handed pitching after going 0-for-29 off righties from August 11-30.

🦅 Mayo is batting .321/.383/.729 (45-for-140) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.112) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole trailing Gary Roenicke's 18 in 1983.

'PEN PALS: **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 19 games (17.0 IP) since August 6, the longest streak by an Oriole since Zack Britton had a franchise-record-tying 25-game stretch from June 22-August 22, 2016.

🦅 Orioles relievers have not allowed a run in 13.1 consecutive innings since Monday...The group had a 19.2-inning scoreless streak earlier with season from August 20-27 and a 20.2-inning stretch from May 10-16.

🦅 Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 560 walks this season behind the Cubs (643 BB), Brewers (635 BB), and Dodgers (597 BB)...The White Sox are second in the AL with 557 free passes.

🦅 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Birds look to lead the AL in walks for the seventh time in franchise history (since 1954) and for the first time since 1990 (660 BB).

🦅 Baltimore has had 10 different players this season record at least 30 walks, tied for most in MLB with Milwaukee and Minnesota...It is tied for the most by the Orioles in a single season in franchise history (since 1954), along with 1999, 1982, 1973, and 1970.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 50-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the second-most such games in the majors with the Cardinals (53-48) and Royals (44-57), trailing the Guardians (54-48)...Their .495 winning percentage in those games ranks 18th in the majors.

🦅 Baltimore is 17-22 in one-run games this year, but the O's are 7-4 in their last 11 such contests since August 14.

QUICK HITS: Povich is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season (8th appearance)...Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster in 2025 and went 3-8 with a 5.21 ERA (65 ER/112.1 IP) on 125 hits (17 HR), 43 walks (2 IBB), one hit batter, and six wild pitches with 118 strikeouts in 22 appearances (20 GS)...Acquired from Minnesota along with **RHP Yennier Cano**, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nunez in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022.

👉 Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk prior to tonight's game, marking his fifth stint with the Orioles this season.

👉 Spent time on the 15-day Injured List (left elbow inflammation) from May 8-June 27.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 2-1 Orioles win on August 31 at Colorado after tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball on five hits and a season-high-tying three walks (also 4/5 at PIT) with four strikeouts...Threw 87 pitches, 51 strikes.

👉 Over his last three starts since August 4, he is 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA (4 ER/14.0 IP)...The O's have won all of those games.

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?: Povich is scheduled to make his first career start vs. Milwaukee, marking the 26th team he's faced since debuting in 2024...Has yet to face Arizona, Chicago-NL, and New York-NL.

👉 Is 1-0 with a 3.10 ERA (7 ER/20.1 IP) across four Interleague games (3 GS) this season after going 2-4 with a 5.87 ERA (30 ER/46.0 IP) over nine Interleague starts from 2024-25.

LEFT-SIDE STORY: Left-handed hitters have recorded a 1.092 OPS against Povich with four doubles and four home runs...The 1.092 OPS vs. lefties is the highest mark in MLB (min. 50 BF) among left-handed pitchers, with the next closest hurler HOU's Bennett Sousa (1.084).

👉 In 2025, Povich held an .845 OPS against left-handed batters, the fourth-highest mark among southpaws in MLB (min. 100 BF).

AHEAD OF THE CURVE: Through seven major league appearances (6 GS) this season, opponents are slashing .160/.276/.200 (4-for-25) against Povich's curveball with a 38.8 percent whiff rate...Last season, hitters slashed .309/.358/.485 (30-for-97) on the curve with a 29.0 percent whiff rate.

👉 Using the pitch 29.6 percent of the time against right-handed batters, who are hitting .100 (2-for-20) off it with one double.

👉 Holds a 43.6 percent whiff rate on the pitch against righties, the sixth-best mark in MLB (min. 100 curveballs thrown) trailing leaders MIN's Taj Bradley and MIL's Aaron Ashby (both 50.0%).

TERRIBLE TWOS: Povich has recorded a 6.00 ERA (4 ER/6.0 IP) in the second inning, his highest mark in any inning this season...Has a 5.21 ERA (11 ER/19.0 IP) from innings one to three compared to a 2.51 ERA (4 ER/14.1 IP) from the fourth inning on.

👉 With two outs, opponents are batting .333 (14-for-42) with five doubles, two home runs, and a 1.024 OPS...With one and zero outs, batters are hitting a combined .244 (21-for-86) with one double, three home runs, and a .661 OPS.

CHANGES: Opponents are 7-for-17 (.412) with no extra-base hits and a 17.2 whiff rate on Povich's changeup this season, which he uses 10.2 percent of the time...In 2025, he used the pitch 15.0 percent of the time with hitters going 12-for-63 (.190) with five extra-base hits (3 2B, 2 HR) and a 35.2 whiff rate.

👉 Povich's average velocity on his changeup this year is 85.0 miles per hour, up 1.4 percent from last season (83.6).

HEATING UP: Povich has recorded a run value of three on his four-seam fastball this season, the highest mark on any of his pitches... He is holding opponents to a .218/.295/.364 (12-for-55) average on the offering, which he is using a career-high 45.0 percent of the time compared to 37.2 percent in 2025.

👉 Last season hitters slashed .268/.349/.444 (41-for-153) on the offering, which held a run value of one.

WHIFFIN': Recorded 17 swings and misses on April 12 vs. San Francisco, the second most in his career behind August 16, 2025 at Houston (18 whiffs)...Tallied a career-high seven whiffs on his curveball, surpassing his previous high of six (4x, last: 9/25/25 vs. TB).

MINORS RECAP: Povich has made 15 starts this season between Triple-A Norfolk (13 GS) and Double-A Chesapeake (2 GS), going 2-6 with a 6.02 ERA (46 ER/68.2 IP)...Has recorded a 9.00 ERA (11 ER/11.0 IP) over two starts this month after he was optioned to the Tides following his last MLB start on August 31 at Colorado.
