**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The defending National League Central Division Champion St. Louis Cardinals and division rival Pittsburgh Pirates play the third game of a four-game series today at Busch Stadium ... The Arizona Diamondbacks make their annual visit to St. Louis on Monday for three games ... Last night's win moved the Cardinals to 4-1 in the second game of series this season after starting 0-5 in series openers.

**42:** In honor of Jackie Robinson Day, all of Major League Baseball will be wearing Dodger blue No. 42 jersey numbers today .. On April 15, 1947 **Jackie Robinson** broke baseball's color barrier and played his first Major League Baseball game for the Brooklyn Dodgers ... The Cardinals are 13-4 overall (6-2 at home) on Jackie Robinson Day since the remembrance day was initiated on April 15, 2004 ... The only time the Cardinals and Pirates have played on Jackie Robinson Day was 2013, a 10-6 Redbirds winner at PNC Park.

**NOOT NEWS:** The Cardinals today activated **Lars Nootbaar** from the 10-Day Injured List and optioned 1B/OF **Juan Ypez** to Memphis (AAA) following last night's game ... Nootbaar missed the previous 13 games after jamming his left thumb while sliding into third base on Opening Day.

**100:** **Oliver Marmol** is closing in on his 100th career win as Cardinals manager, going 99-77 over his first 176 games ... A win today would make Marmol the:

- 8th-fastest Cardinals manager to reach 100 wins in terms of games
- 11th MLB manager in the Expansion Era (1961-present) and 93rd overall in MLB history to win his 100th game before his 37th birthday
- 52nd manager all-time to reach 100 wins with a winning record before age 37 and first since **Sparky Anderson** (age 36.216, 100-59 record) in 1970.
- 3rd Cardinals manager to reach 100 wins with a winning record before age 37, joining *player managers* **Rogers Hornsby** (age 30.057, 100-79 record) in 1926 and **Frankie Frisch** (age 36.341, 100-72 record) in 1934.

**SHIVER ME TIMBERS:** **Oliver Marmol's** first career win as Cardinals manager was April 7, 2022 in a 9-0 shutout win over the Buccos on Opening Day, and since Oli became skipper in 2022, his clubs have beaten Pittsburgh (14) more than any other team.

**10 YEARS FOR ARENADO:** Congratulations to **Nolan Arenado** for reaching 10,000 years of Major League service time today ... Since making his MLB debut on April 28, 2013 with the Rockies, the 2nd round pick from El Toro High School has made seven NL All-Star teams while earning 10 consecutive Gold Gloves, six Platinum Gloves, and five Silver Sluggers.

**SATURDAY IN THE PARK:** The Cardinals (2-0) are one of seven MLB teams to be undefeated on Saturday this season ... Last season, St. Louis was an MLB-best 21-7 (.750) on Saturday, including a 12-3 mark at home while wearing their Saturday cream uniforms.

**AHOY, MATEY:** St. Louis has won the season series over Pittsburgh for nine consecutive seasons (2014-22) and 20 times in the last 23 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013). **BURIED TREASURE:** St. Louis owns MLB's best overall win pct. against the Pirates (.590, 108-75) dating back to 2013 when the two teams squared off in the Division Series.

**STREAKING WITH GOLDDY:** **Paul Goldschmidt** has reached base safely in all 14 games this season, tied with two others for MLB's 2nd-longest active on-base streak behind **Xander Bogaerts** (15) ... Goldschmidt, who ranks among MLB leaders in on-base percentage (.460, 10th) and times on base (29, T-4th), has compiled 52 double-digit on-base streaks in his career, highlighted by his career-best 46-gamer last season ... Goldy's longest on-base streak to begin a season is 15 games in 2013.

**BURLY BALL:** Rookie **Alec Burleson** has hit safely in a career best nine consecutive games (.324, 11-34) since April 2, T-4th longest active hitting streak in MLB ... Among rookies this season, only **Jordan Walker** (12 games) has recorded a longer hitting streak.

**ZEROS TO HEROES:** St. Louis is 2-0 in games following shutouts (12-4 last season) ... Twice this season the Cardinals have been shut out and then blanked the same opponent the following game: April 7-8 (L 4-0 & W 6-0 at Milwaukee) and April 13-14 (L 5-0 & W 3-0 vs. Pirates).

**MAYBE IT'S A SIGN:** The last time the Cardinals sported a 3-5 record in their first eight home games was 2011.

**THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (April 15, 2016):** The Cardinals set a Busch Stadium III record with six home runs in a 14-3 win over the visiting Cincinnati Reds on Jackie Robinson Day ... 12 of 13 runs came from blasts by **Matt Holliday** (twice) **Aledmys Díaz**, **Randal Grichuk**, **Brandon Moss**, and **Matt Adams**.

**Willson Contreras** (June 17, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), and **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

**Turner Ward** played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (A-SS).

**Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

**Andrew Knizner's** uncle, **Matt Knizner**, was a quarterback at Penn State Univ. and was on the 1986 National Championship Nittany Lion squad.

**Tyler Heineman** played in 21 games for Memphis (AAA) last season.

**Chris Stratton** pitched parts of four seasons with the Pirates (2019-22)...traded to St. Louis with **José Quintana** for **Malcom Nunez** and **Johan Oviedo** (Aug. 2, 2022).

**Génesis Cabrera**, **Luis Ortiz**, and **Roansy Contreras** were teammates for the Dominican Republic in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

**David Bednar** pitched for Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic with **Adam Wainwright**, **Miles Mikolas**, **Paul Goldschmidt**, and **Nolan Arenado**.

**Derek Shelton** was born in Carbondale, Ill... caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

**Rich Hill** pitched in 23 games for Memphis (AAA) in the Cardinals organization in 2010.

**Rob Zastryzny** pitched three seasons at the University of Missouri (2011-13).

**Johan Oviedo** signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956... played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

**TODAY'S GAME**

- Makes his 159th career appearance (149th start) and 13th start as a Cardinal.
- Is seeking his 1st win as a starter at Busch Stadium since May 2, 2022 vs. Kansas City.
- Missed 102 games on the Injured List with a left shoulder impingement (5/23-7/16) and strained left knee (7/24-9/16). Was activated from his second stint in mid-September and was added to the bullpen where he made five appearances.
- Prior to the 7/23/22 start at Cincinnati, Matz had missed approx. two months with a left shoulder impingement.
- Ranks 3rd in MLB in Pitch Tempo with bases empty (11.5 sec/pitch) and 5th with runners on base (14.8 sec/pitch), leading all Cardinals.
- Has yet to allow a hit (0-for-8) against opposing left-handed batters to begin the season.
- His lifetime .619 winning percentage (13-8) in the month of April ranks 7th among active pitchers with 20 or more career April decisions. San Diego's Michael Wacha leads the list at .778 (21-6).
- Ranks 14th among active MLB left-handed pitchers with 8.68 SO/9 IP (min. 700 IP).
- St. Louis is his third MLB organization, entering his second Cardinals season with a 50-52 record and 4.32 ERA in career 157 games (147 starts) while pitching for the New York Mets (2015-20), Toronto Blue Jays (2021) and St. Louis (2022-23).
- Went 2-0, 1.53 ERA in four Grapefruit League appearances (three starts).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Logged 5.2 IP in his start last Mon. (4/10) at Coors Field, but was dinged for 6 runs on 9 hits and suffered his 2nd-straight loss, losing 7-4 to the Rockies.

**CAREER**

- Joined the Cardinals on a four-year contract (2022-25) after previously pitching for the New York Mets (2015-20) and Toronto Blue Jays (2021) organizations.
- In 2021, tied for the American League lead with 14 wins among left-handed pitchers.
- Since 2021, his 19 total wins rank T-10th among MLB left-handers, with Julio Urias (37) leading the list.
- Has landed on the Injured List 11 times over his Major League career, missing time in every season except for 2021 in which he missed time for a positive COVID-19 test.
- Also missed the 2010 and 2011 minor league seasons after undergoing Tommy John ligament replacement surgery.
- His one career complete game shutout is also a "Maddux" where he threw 99 pitches on July 27, 2019 vs. Pittsburgh.
- Finished 6th in the 2016 NL Rookie of the Year voting, going 9-8 with a 3.40 ERA, and 1.21 WHIP in 22 starts.

**2022 SEASON**

- Missed 102 games on the Injured List with a left shoulder impingement (5/23-7/16) and strained left knee (7/24-9/16). Was activated from his second stint in mid-September and was added to the bullpen.
- Ranked 8th in MLB in Pitch Tempo (14.4 sec/pitch) with bases empty; 21.6 sec/pitch with runners on, leading all Cardinals relievers.
- Recorded the best strikeout (26.1%) and lowest walk rates (4.8%) of his career.
- Led Cardinals starting pitchers in strikeouts/9 IP (10.72 K).
- Began the season as a starting pitcher and was 4-3 with a 5.70 ERA in 10 starts.
- Was 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA in five relief appearances to end the year. Limited the opposition to a .150/.190/.250 slashline with a .440 OPS out of the bullpen.
- Made his first relief appearance of the season on 9/17 [2] vs. Cincinnati and first since 9/27/20 at WSH, earning the win with scoreless 11th inn. while stranding a runner.
- Earned a win in his start at Cincinnati (7/23) before going on the I.L. Three of his 5 wins in 2022 came vs. CIN.

- Has allowed just 4 career HR's vs. the Pirates in 36.0 IP.

**LAST TIME OUT**
