**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 3-2 through five games on their current seven-game homestand, going 1-2 against Detroit over the weekend, followed by consecutive victories over Chicago-AL the last two nights...tonight, Minnesota will host the White Sox for the third of four games...after the series finale tomorrow afternoon, the Twins will travel to Anaheim to begin a six-game roadtrip with three games at Angel Stadium over the weekend and three games at Guaranteed Rate Field next Monday-Wednesday.  
 ☞ Last night marked the third time the Twins have won back-to-back games...they are looking to win three-straight for the first time since September 24-27, 2023 when they beat the Angels once and Athletics twice.

**IN THE END, AK GETS THE LAST LAUGH:** The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 6-5 in come-from-behind walk-off fashion — their first walk-off victory of the season...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits, highlighted by Byron Buxton, who went 3-for-4 with a game-tying home run in the ninth inning...Alex Kirilloff struck out in his first four at-bats, but recorded the game-winner with an RBI-single — his second career walk-off hit (May 10, 2023 vs. SD - 1B)...Minnesota went 3-for-6 with runners in scoring position, making them 5-for-12 with RISP this series.

**WEARING OUT THE SOX:** The Twins and White Sox are playing the third of 13 games this season...after this series, they will play three games at Guaranteed Rate Field from Monday-Wednesday...Minnesota has gone 9-1 in their last 10 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.  
 ☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 89-69 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.  
 ☞ The Twins have beat the Sox 72 times (53 losses) at Target Field (since 2010), tied for most against any opponent (Kansas City - 72).  
 ☞ Carlos Santana is the all-time leader among actives in walks (114) and games (182) against the White Sox...also, on that list, he ranks second in runs (88), and third in hits (148), home runs (24) and RBI (79).  
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .364 (36-for-99) with six doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 24 RBI, an .838 slugging percentage and a 1.266 OPS in his last 26 games against the Sox...since the start of last season, Buck has hit five home runs in 10 games (9 RBI).  
 ☞ Christian Vázquez is hitting .315 (41-for-130) with seven doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, 10 walks, a .364 on-base percentage and a .757 OPS in 41 career games vs. the Sox.  
 ☞ Since the start of last season, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with a 1.055 OPS in nine games vs. the White Sox...he has hit safely in six straight vs. Chicago.

**REVVING UP THE BUCK TRUCK:** Byron Buxton hit his first home run of the season last night and set a season-high with three hits...below are Buck's first 14 games (from March 28-April 14), compared to his last seven games (since April 15):

**THE LEFTORIUM:** Twins hitters are slashing .212/.280/.344 with a .624 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .203/.286/.351 with a .637 OPS vs. right-handed pitching...five of their 20 homers have been hit off lefties (Royce Lewis off Cole Ragans, Manny Margot off James Paxton, Ryan Jeffers off Alex Vesia, Edouard Julien off Vesia and Jose Miranda off Cole Irvin).  
 ☞ The only lefty starter the Twins have dealt a loss to was Cole Ragans on Opening Day in Kansas City.  
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .298 (17-for-57) with seven home runs and a 1.099 OPS in his last 35 games against left-handed pitching, dating back to June 22, 2023.  
 ☞ Manny Margot is hitting .313 (5-for-16) with three walks and a .921 OPS vs. lefties in 2024.

**MAJORITY RULES:** The Twins are looking for their second series win this season...their only series win came to open the season at Kansas City (full list to the lower right)...Minnesota went 27-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 15-8-3 at home and 13-11-2 on the road.  
 ☞ In two of their last three series, they have entered the finale with a chance to secure the series win and fallen short, missing taking three of four in Detroit by losing the finale on April 14 and losing the finale on Sunday, entering the third game 1-1 against the Tigers.  
 ☞ Twins are looking to win their third-straight series against the White Sox...additionally, the Twins have not lost a series at home to the White Sox since dropping three of four from July 14-17, 2022 — they have gone 3-0-0 here vs. Chicago since.

**FASHIONABLY LATE:** The Twins have scored 41 of their 80 runs from the seventh inning-or-later, accounting for 51% of their runs scored...the 41 runs scored are tied with Cleveland for fourth most in the American League, trailing Baltimore (51), Tampa Bay (44) and Detroit (42)...Minnesota has scored 13 runs in the seventh inning, five runs in the eighth inning, 15 runs in the ninth inning and eight in extra innings.  
 ☞ Minnesota's 15 ninth-inning runs are second-most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (17).

**BROCKSTAR ENERGY:** Brock Stewart has begun the season with nine-straight scoreless appearances (9.1 IP), allowing six hits with 12 strikeouts...he has allowed just one hit to a right-handed batter (Carson Kelly single on April 19 vs. DET)...Stewart's last run allowed came on a Jose Altuve grand slam on May 29, 2023 at Houston...he enters today with a 22.0-scoreless inning streak, the third-longest active streak in baseball, trailing only Ranger Suarez (25.0) and Brusdar Graterol (25.0) - Elias...since the start of last season, he leads baseball with a 0.49 ERA (minimum of 30.0 innings pitched).

**A MATTER OF FEELING:** Jhoan Duran made his first appearance on rehab assignment last night for Triple-A St. Paul, pitching 1.0 inning against Rochester, allowing two runs on four hits, with no walks and three strikeouts, throwing 27 pitches...he averaged 98.1 mph on his four-seam fastball and topped out at 99.0 mph.

**HBD WILLI!:** Twins utility player Willi Castro is celebrating his 27th birthday today...Castro has appeared in one major league game on his birthday going, 1-for-3 with a home run in 2021 against the Royals...he shares a birthday with Jovani Moran, who also turns 27 today.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1996, Greg Myers and Paul Molitor each recorded five RBI as the Twins set a team record for runs and beat the Detroit Tigers, 24-11.

- ⚔ Making his first start of the year vs. Chicago-AL...earned no-decision in his last start against the Tigers, allowing seven hits, four runs, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings.
- ⚔ Career-high 12 strikeouts on April 12 against the Tigers.
- ⚔ Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Faced the Detroit Tigers for the second-consecutive start...took his third no-decision of the year and second in a row, allowing four runs on seven hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings...his four runs and seven hits allowed are both season highs...allowed a sixth-inning run on a Kerry Carpenter single, which had an exit velocity of 57.6 MPH...it was the slowest exit velocity for any base hit in the game...was later relieved by Kody Funderburk, who recorded two outs to finish the sixth inning.

- ⚔ Generated 12 swings and misses on 63 pitches.
- ⚔ Tied for 12th in the American League with 30 strikeouts...his 11.91 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings rank second in the AL, behind only tonight's opponent, Garrett Crochet (11.92).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Faced the Detroit Tigers for the first time this season, recorded his second consecutive quality start of the year...Ryan did not factor in the decision for the second time in three starts this year...allowed three runs (1 ER) on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and a career-high 12 strikeouts; two unearned runs scored in the first-inning, two-run home run by Kerry Carpenter after a Jose Miranda throwing error...Ryan also had a career-high 12 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...the Twins would go on to win 11-5 in 12 innings.

- ⚔ Generated 19 whiffs on 96 pitches thrown.

**WE MEET AGAIN:** Facing the White Sox for the fourth time in his career...in the previous three starts he is 1-0, 3.38 ERA (16.0 IP, 6 ER), 13 hits, five walks, 20 strikeouts, 1.13 WHIP and a .220 (13-for-59) opponent batting average...his win against the White Sox came on July 21, 2023, when he tossed 6.0 innings with four runs on seven hits, one walk and 10 strikeouts.

- ⚔ Has tallied 10 strikeouts in 57 total at-bats vs. current White Sox hitters.

**HOME COOKING:** Through two starts in 2024 at home, Ryan has thrown 11.1 innings with 12 hits, 13 strikeouts and one home run - David Fry's three-run shot on April 6, when Ryan was dealt his only loss thus far in 2024.

- ⚔ In 34 career home starts, he is 14-10, 3.76 ERA (191.1 IP, 80 ER), 153 hits, 49 walks and 229 strikeouts...Twins are 19-15 in Ryan's 34 home starts.
- ⚔ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads all Twins pitchers with 14 home wins...behind him are Griffin Jax and Sonny Gray with eight.
- ⚔ Allowed 32 home runs in 2023...12 of them came at home.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .280/.321/.420 with four extra-base hits and two walks in 53 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .179/.200/.333 with three doubles, one home run and one walk in 40 plate appearances.

- ⚔ Over his career, lefties are batting .213 (139-for-652) with a .643 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .239 (168-for-704) with a .737 OPS.
- ⚔ In three games vs. Ryan, White Sox left-handed hitters have hit .263 (5-for-19), with two home runs...right-handed hitters are hitting .200 (8-for-40) with one home run.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in his four starts this season, with a few sinkers in his first three outings...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and split finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 74.2 percent of the time in his last start against the Tigers...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

**RUNNERS ON NIGHTMARE:** With runners in scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .438 (7-for-16), with one home run, one walk and one strikeout...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .169 (10-for-59).

**NIGHT AT LAST:** Making his second night start of the year...went 5-5, 5.24 ERA (87.2 IP, 51 ER) with 18 walks, 109 strikeouts and a .267 opponent batting average in 16 night starts in 2023...is 12-9, 3.06 ERA (155.2 IP, 53 ER), .207 BAA in 28 career day starts, compared to 14-11, 4.71 ERA (197.0 IP, 103 ER), .239 BAA in 36 career night starts.

**2023 NOTES:**

- ⚔ Made Twins Opening Day roster, the second of career...posted career highs in innings (161.2), strikeouts (197) and starts (29).
- ⚔ Posted his best month in May 2-2, 2.73 ERA (33.0 IP, 11 ER) 30 hits, nine walks, 40 strikeouts and two home runs.
- ⚔ First career complete-game shutout vs. the Boston Red Sox on June 22, logging nine strikeouts and zero walks...season-high 122 pitches.
- ⚔ 11 win tied Pablo Lopez for team lead, 197 strikeouts ranked second and 181.2 innings ranked third.
- ⚔ Made Postseason debut on October 11 in Game 4 of the ALDS vs. the Houston Astros, allowing one run (a second-inning home run to Michael Brantley) in 2.0 innings with one strikeout.
- ⚔ Placed on 15-day injured list on August 3 with a left groin strain...made on rehab start assignment with Triple-A St. Paul and was reinstated on August 26.
- ⚔ Was supported with 97 runs of offense for a run support average of 5.40, 11th highest in the AL.
- ⚔ Went 8-6, 3.70 ERA (107.0 IP, 44 ER) with 18 walks and 124 strikeouts in 18 starts pre-All-Star break...ranked fifth in the AL in strikeouts and 14th in innings pitched.
- ⚔ Posted a 1.78 home runs-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio, the fourth highest in the AL.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2024: 1-1, 4.91 ERA // CAREER: 14-13, 3.70 ERA)**

The right-handed pitcher is set to start tomorrow afternoon's four-game series finale vs. Chicago-AL...since giving up eight runs in 1.1 innings on March 31 in Kansas City, he has allowed two runs in 17.0 innings (1.06 ERA), with three walks and 16 strikeouts in his last three starts...picked up his first win of 2024 in his last start against the Tigers, allowing one run on two hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...has made 10 career starts vs. Chicago-AL, going 3-1 with a 3.35 ERA (51.0 IP, 19 ER), 10 walks and 56 strikeouts.
