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BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a nine-game road trip tonight against the Cardinals (2-1), Athletics (3-0), and Rockies (1-0, 2 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-4 homestand, having been swept by the Yankees before taking two of three from the Rays...The O's are in fourth place in the AL East and 0.5 games behind the Guardians for the final Wild Card spot.

👉 **Coby Mayo** has scored a run in a career-high six straight games, the longest active streak in MLB ahead of PHI's Edmundo Sosa (5 G)...The only Oriole to score a run in seven straight games in 2026 is **Gunnar Henderson**, who did so in eight straight from August 9-17.

👉 Yesterday marked the fourth win of the season in which the Orioles scored two or fewer runs...They had lost 23 straight games when scoring two runs or less, with their last such victory coming on May 10 vs. the Athletics (also 2-1).

👉 Tonight, the Birds can win a fifth straight game for the first time since a season-best seven-game run from July 9-19, and move above .500 for the first time since completing play on April 14 (9-8)...Baltimore looks to secure a fifth straight road victory for the first time since a five-game stretch from May 24 (G2)-June 5, 2025.

👉 The Birds have won each of their last four games despite being outthit in every contest...It's the second time in team history (since 1954) the Orioles have won four straight games despite being outthit in every contest behind a five-game streak from May 23-28, 1987...The current four-game stretch ties the longest such streak in the majors this year, joining Boston from July 18-22...No MLB team has done so in five consecutive games since the O's 1987 run of five, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles announced the following roster moves:

👉 Activated outfielder **Luis Robert Jr.**...He was claimed off waivers from the New York Mets yesterday...He will be the fourth Oriole (since 1954) to wear No. 88 and the first since Albert Belle (1999-2000).

👉 Selected the contracts of left-handed pitcher **Luis De León** and right-handed pitcher **Albert Suárez** from Triple-A Norfolk...For De León, he will be making his MLB debut in his first appearance.

👉 Recalled outfielder **Heston Kjerstad** from Triple-A Norfolk...He will make his season debut in his first game.

👉 Placed outfielder **Christian Franklin** (left hand inflammation) on the 10-day Injured List, retroactive to August 31.

👉 Optioned left-handed pitcher **Cade Povich** to Triple-A Norfolk after yesterday's game.

👉 Designated right-handed pitcher **Cameron Weston** and left-hander **Nick Raquet** for assignment.

COW DID HE DO IT?! **Colton Cowser** sealed the win for the Orioles, robbing a home run with two outs in the ninth inning.

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, **Jake McCarthy's** bid for a walkoff homer went an estimated 425 feet, but was stolen by Cowser, marking the longest distance of a game-ending robbery of a potential walk-off home run in MLB's Wild Card era (since 1995).

👉 Cowser's nine defensive runs saved lead the Orioles...He is credited with seven defensive runs saved in center field, sixth most in MLB and second in the AL behind BOS' Ceddanne Rafaela (18 DRS).

PICKIN' IT: The Orioles have gone a season-high 10 straight games without committing an error, the longest active streak in MLB ahead of the Braves (7 G)...The Birds last went 11 straight games without an error during a 12-game stretch from September 16-28, 2021.

👉 Baltimore recorded a .991 fielding percentage in August, the sixth highest clip in the majors during that period, after opening the season with a .982 fielding percentage through July, ranking fifth lowest in the majors ahead of Miami/Toronto (both .982), New York-NL (.981), and Washington (.979).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's drew four walks in the seventh inning last night, marking the first time they have drawn four free passes in a single inning since July 10, 2025 vs. New York-NL (4 BB, 8th inn.)...Overall the Birds drew six walks, marking their 30th game of the year with 6+ free passes.

👉 The 30 such games are the most by a Baltimore club since the 1999 Orioles (35).

👉 Baltimore has drawn an AL-best 517 walks, ranking third in MLB behind Chicago-NL (583) and Milwaukee (568).

👉 The Birds are averaging 3.98 pitches per plate appearance, second in MLB behind the Brewers (3.99).

'PEN PALS: Over the last 11 games since August 20, Oriole relievers have pitched to a 0.98 ERA (4 ER/36.2 IP)...It is the lowest bullpen ERA in MLB during that period, ahead of the Braves (1.83) and Padres (1.93).

👉 In 28 appearances since June 24, **Andrew Kittredge** has posted a 1.05 ERA (3 ER/25.2 IP) and eight saves.

👉 **Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 11 appearances (9.0 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5...His streak of 11 consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run is tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the AL behind HOU's Josh Hader (18 G), TOR's Mason Fluharty (17 G), and NYY's Paul Blackburn (15 G).

👉 **Yennier Cano** has gone 47 consecutive appearances (35.2 IP) without allowing a home run...It is the fourth-longest active streak among all MLB relievers behind MIL's Trevor Megill (61 G), CLE's Colin Holderman (52 G), and LAD's Edgardo Henriquez (48 G).

👉 Ten Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, tying the 1987 Orioles for the most in franchise history (since 1954)...The Birds are one of 11 teams in MLB to have at least 10 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (13).

ROAD TRIPPING: Since the All-Star Break, the O's are averaging 5.42 runs per game on the road, the second-highest figure in the majors behind the Cubs (6.42)...Prior to the break, the Birds averaged 4.32 runs per game away from Camden Yards, ranking 18th in the majors.

👉 Baltimore is 17-9 (.654) on the road following the All-Star break, the most such wins in MLB ahead of Tampa Bay (15-8).

POLAR BEAR SIGHTING: In 19 career games at Coors Field, **Pete Alonso** is slashing .359/.419/.744 (28-for-78) with four doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 18 runs, and 18 RBI...Among all active players with at least 80 career plate appearances, his 1.194 career OPS at Coors Field is second highest in MLB behind LAD's Shohei Ohtani (1.194).

👉 Alonso enters play today with 91 RBI, ranking second in the AL behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (94)...Alonso looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 27th start of the season and 94th of his career tonight at Colorado...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

☯️ Agreed to terms on a five-year contract with the O's on July 18, extending him through 2031.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of an 8-7 Orioles win on August 26 at St. Louis after allowing a career-high-tying seven earned runs (3x, last: 4/25/23 vs. BOS) in 4.1 innings pitched on nine hits (1 HR) and two walks with four strikeouts...Threw 91 pitches, 64 strikes.

☯️ Gave up six runs in the fifth inning, the most runs allowed in a single frame in his career.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH: Bradish is scheduled to make his second career start opposite Colorado...Earned the win on August 26, 2023 at Camden Yards after tossing 6.0 innings of two-run ball on six hits and one walk with eight strikeouts in a 5-4 Orioles victory.

☯️ Over 25 career Interleague starts, he is 6-6 with a 3.43 ERA (52 ER/136.1 IP)...Has suffered the loss in four of his six Interleague starts this season.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS: Bradish has allowed only two runs in the opening frame this season, during which opponents are slashing .195/.271/.276 (17-for-87) with four doubles, one home run, eight walks, and 32 strikeouts.

☯️ His two runs allowed in the first inning this season are tied with two others for the second fewest in MLB (min. 15 GS) behind SD's Casey Mize (1).

SLIDE AWAY: Bradish's .525 slugging percentage on his slider is the fourth-highest mark in MLB (min. 100 AB ending in pitch) ahead of ATH's Jeffrey Springs (.684), CWS' Luis Castillo (.569), and Miles Mikolas (.547)...In 2025, he held a .156 slugging percentage on the pitch over six starts.

☯️ Overall, his breaking balls (slider, curveball) own a negative seven run value, which ranks in the bottom eight percent of MLB... Opponents are slashing .242/.311/.454 (55-for-227) with 11 doubles, two triples, and 11 home runs on his breaking pitches.

WALK DON'T RUN: His 10.2 percent walk rate is the seventh-highest mark in MLB and the highest mark of his career (9.2%, 2024)...However, holds a 7.1 percent walk rate (15 BB/210 BF) over his last nine starts since July 5 with one walk or fewer in four of those games.

☯️ His 13 games with three or more walks are tied for the sixth most among MLB starters ahead of leader TOR's Dylan Cease (15).

FOURSEAM FOCUS: Opponents slashed .667/.727/.889 (6-for-9) with one triple off his four seamer in August after hitting .235/.235/.353 (4-for-17) with one triple on the pitch over four games in July...Bradish opened the season holding opponents to a .308/.400/.400 (20-for-65) slash line on his four seamer with three doubles and one home run over 17 starts from March-June.

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 56.2 percent first-pitch strike rate, the second-lowest mark in MLB among qualified pitchers ahead of ATH's J.T. Ginn (55.2%)...Threw 16 of 23 (70.0%) first pitches for strikes in his last start on August 26 at St. Louis.

BREAKING BRAD: Over two starts from June 17-22, Bradish allowed one run over 15.2 innings with 21 strikeouts to become the third pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to have 20+ strikeouts and no more than one run allowed over a two-start span in a single season, joining Mike Mussina (2000) and Erik Bedard (2007).

👉 Has not allowed a home run in a career-high 47 straight games (35.2 IP) since 4/24
