Willy Do It?

Willy Adames has a franchise-record 32 HR as a shortstop this season, breaking his own record of 31 HR in 2022......Adames (111 RBI) needs just 2 RBI to tie Robin Yount (113 in 1982) for the most RBI as a shortstop in a season in franchise history.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 45-33 at home, going 14-9-2 in series play.....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 45-35 on the road, going 14-9-2 in series play.....are 20-10 in their last 30 road games.....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 42 replay challenges this season, going 24-18....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/25 at Pittsburgh as an out call at second base involving Willy Adames was confirmed.

CIVALE AT A GLANCE: Aaron Civale, 29, makes his 31st start of the season and 14th with the Brewers.....Civale last started last Saturday vs. Arizona and took a 5-0 defeat [4.1ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 3bb, 2k, 2hr, 1hbp, 91 pitches].....his teams are 12-18 in his starts (7-6 with Brewers).....he has 7 quality starts.....opponents are batting .256 [155-for-605, 29hr].....Civale was acquired from Tampa Bay on July 3 for INF Gregory Barrios.....he went 2-6 with a 5.07 ERA in 17 starts with the Rays [87ip, 93h, 51r, 49er, 27bb, 84k]..... he is 5-3 with a 3.84 ERA in 13 starts with the Brewers (68ip, 62h, 31r, 29er, 24bb, 60k, 13hr).....he is signed through the 2025 season.....name is pronounced "sih-VAH-lee."

CAREER: Has gone 38-35 with a 4.07 ERA in 116 starts (630.1ip, 285er).....is in his sixth Major League season pitching for Cleveland (2019-23), Tampa Bay (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2024).....Civale was selected by Cleveland in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Northeastern University.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-2 with a 2.38 ERA in 8 starts, all coming this season for the Brewers (45.1ip, 12er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 17-16 with a 4.12 ERA in 59 starts (314.1ip, 144er).....is 2-3 with a 6.34 ERA in 13 starts this season (61ip, 43er).

CAREER vs. PIRATES: Is 1-2 with a 3.94 ERA in 5 starts (29.2ip, 29h, 13r, 13er, 4bb, 22k, 4hr), going 0-1 with a 1.59 ERA in 2 starts this season (11.1ip, 9h, 2r, 2er, 3bb, 9k, 1hr).
