BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles conclude a six-game, seven-day homestand today against the Pirates (2-0, 1 to play), having taken two of three over the weekend from the NL West-leading Dodgers...This afternoon continues a stretch of 13 games in 13 days for the Birds, who, following today's series finale, will travel to face the Blue Jays (9/12-14) and White Sox (9/15-17) for three-game sets before returning to Camden Yards to face the Yankees (9/18-21) for four games...Baltimore is 49-41 (.544) since May 30, tied with Houston (also 49-41, .544) for the fourth-best winning percentage in the AL behind Toronto (55-34, .618), Boston (54-35, .607), and Texas (50-40, .556).

♫ Last night, **Dylan Beavers** (1B) became the fourth Oriole (fifth occurrence) with a walk-off this season, joining **Samuel Basallo** (2x, last: 9/9 vs. PIT, 1B), **Emmanuel Rivera** (9/6 vs. LAD, 1B), and **Jackson Holliday** (8/13 vs. SEA, 2B).

♫ **Samuel Basallo** (9/9) and **Dylan Beavers** (9/10) became the first pair of Oriole rookies in franchise history (since 1954) to record walk-off hits in back-to-back games, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...It marked the first occurrence in MLB since the 2019 Dodgers from June 21-23 (Matt Beaty/Alex Verdugo/Will Smith).

♫ The Birds have recorded four walk-off wins in their last five games, marking the second time in franchise history (since 1954) accomplishing the feat along with June 23-27, 1954, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

♫ With the 2-1 victory, the O's have won each of their last five one-run games, tying their longest streak of the season from May 24 (G2)-June 5...They last won six straight one-run affairs from July 2-24, 2023 (6 G).

♫ O's batters have struck out 10+ times in a franchise-record 10 straight games, the longest streak by any MLB club since the 2024 Tigers struck out 10+ times in 12 consecutive games from September 15-28.

♫ Oriole relievers have allowed one or zero earned runs in each of their eight games this month, recording a 1.25 ERA (5 ER/36.0 IP) and .156 (19-for-122) opponent average.

♫ With a win today, Baltimore can earn its seventh series sweep of the season, including its third at home (5/30-6/1 vs. CWS & 6/13-15 vs. LAA).

WALK THE PLANK: With last night's win, the Orioles improved to 7-0-0 (1.000) against the Pirates all-time at Camden Yards, the best home series record by any active MLB franchise against a single opponent, per *Stats Perform*...It is tied for the third-longest series win streak at Camden Yards against a single team behind an 11-series run against the Yankees (2014-2017) and nine straight against the Twins (1997-2002).

HOLLIDAY SEASON: **Jackson Holliday** paces the Birds with 17 home runs, one ahead of **Gunnar Henderson** (16 HR)...The only Oriole under 22 years old to finish the season leading the club in homers is **Eddie Murray** (27 HR, 1977).

♫ Holliday's 17 long balls are fifth-most by an Oriole in their age-21 season or younger (as of age of July 1 of season) in franchise history (since 1954), per *Stats Perform*, trailing **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (28 HR, 1982), **Eddie Murray** (27 HR, 1977), **Boog Powell** (25 HR, 1963), and **Curt Blefary** (22 HR, 1965).

♫ He has seven multi-walk performances in 26 games since August 10, tied for the MLB lead with NYY's Aaron Judge, NYM's Juan Soto, and LAA's Mike Trout/Taylor Ward...Prior to August 10, Holliday had two multi-walk performances in 169 career games.

♫ Holliday owns a .465 on-base percentage against right-handed pitchers since August 17, the fourth-highest mark in MLB (min. 60 PA) behind NYM's Juan Soto (.507 OBP), PHI's Harrison Bader (.500 OBP), and TOR's Bo Bichette (.493 OBP).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS: **Dylan Beavers** has reached base safely in 17 of his first 20 career games since debuting on August 16, slashing .305/.453/.441 (18-for-59) with five doubles, one homer, 10 runs scored, seven RBI, 16 walks, and one stolen base.

♫ He has reached base safely 34 times to begin his career, tying **Ryan Mountcastle** (34 TOB, 2020) for the most in franchise history (since 1954) through an O's first 20 games...**Billy Ripken** (35 TOB, 1987) holds the club record through 21 career games.

♫ Beavers is the second Oriole to draw 16+ walks in his first 20 career games, joining **Glenn Gulliver** (18 BB, 1982)...He has walked in an MLB-best five straight games and can become the first Oriole to draw a free pass in six straight since Anthony Santander (7 G) from May 18-25, 2023.

♫ Since his debut, Beavers' .453 on-base percentage leads all qualified MLB rookies, while ranking in walks (2nd) and OPS (9th, .894).

ACTION JACKSON: Since making his MLB debut on August 1, **Jeremiah Jackson** is slashing .304/.336/.504 (38-for-125) with six doubles, two triples, five home runs, 16 runs, and 18 RBI across 34 games, ranking among all qualified MLB rookies during that stretch in triples (T-3rd), hits (4th), total bases (4th, 63), home runs (T-4th, 13), extra-base hits (T-5th, 13), on-base percentage (6th), RBI (7th), slugging percentage (7th), batting average (9th), and OPS (10th, .840).

♫ His 60 total bases through 31 starts are fourth most in club history (since 1954) behind **Trey Mancini** (71 TB, 2016-17), **Chito Martínez** (70 TB, 1991), and **Jim Traber** (61 TB, 1984-86).

♫ Jackson is one of seven Orioles in franchise history to have 37+ hits through his first 31 career starts (last: **Ryan Mountcastle**, 37 H, 2020).

NIP AND TUCK: Since August 10, 12 of Baltimore's 17 home games have been decided by one run, with the O's going 6-6 in those contests...Overall, following the All-Star break, Baltimore has played an MLB-high 24 one-run affairs (11-12), ahead of Chicago-NL and Cleveland (both 17 G)...The Birds opened the year playing 22 one-run games (12-10), tied for second fewest in MLB ahead of the Tigers (21 G).

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: Baltimore has used a franchise record 67 players this season, surpassing the previous team record held by the 2021 Orioles (62 players)...The 67 players used are second most in MLB behind the Braves (68 players).

♫ **Samuel Basallo** became the 23rd different player to homer for the team this season, breaking the franchise record (since 1954) previously shared by the 2018 and 2012 Orioles...The current number leads the majors this season and is the most by an MLB club since the 2024 Giants (also 23).

♫ **Dylan Beavers** became the 19th Oriole to swipe a base this year, marking the most players to steal 1+ base in team history, surpassing the previous record of 17 shared by the 2018, 2001, 1990, 1988, and 1955 Orioles.

♫ **Samuel Basallo** became the seventh player to appear at catcher for Baltimore this year, setting the franchise record...The previous record of six was shared by the 1986, 1962, and 1960 O's...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The last to use eight were the 2022 Pirates.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his 20th appearance of the season (19th GS) and the 36th of his career...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (left hip inflammation) prior to his start on August 4...Placed on the IL on June 16...Pitched to a 3.98 ERA (9 ER/20.1 IP) through five rehab outings between Triple-A Norfolk (4 GS) and High-A Aberdeen (1 GS)...Was the first Oriole pitcher to make his major league debut in 2024 when he started on June 6 at Toronto, and became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since **Wei-Yin Chen** on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL...Acquired by the Orioles along with **RHP Yennier Cano**, **LHP Juan Rojas**, and **RHP Juan Nuñez** from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for **RHP Jorge López** and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on September 3 at San Diego, his first winning decision since June 15 vs. Los Angeles-AL...Allowed four runs on seven hits (1 HR) and three walks with three strikeouts in 5.0+ innings...Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings before allowing the first five batters to reach and two runs to score in the sixth, with two runners scoring after he exited with the bases loaded and no outs...Threw 85 pitches, 48 strikes.

- Received seven runs of support, the second-most runs of support he has received in his career (9 RS, 9/3/24 vs. CWS).
- Had allowed four total runs in the sixth frame through his first 18 outings of the year.

IFELL IN IT, THE PITT: Set to make his first career start against the Pirates and his third against an NL Central opponent...Is 0-2 with a 13.50 ERA (12 ER/8.0 IP) through his two starts against the division, with his last outing coming on May 28 vs. St. Louis (4.2 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 1 HR, 3 BB, 9 K).

DAY 'N' NITE: Holds a 3.18 ERA (14 ER/39.2 IP) through eight day appearances (7 GS) compared to a 6.55 ERA (41 ER/56.1 IP) across 11 night games (10 GS)...However, opponents are batting .302 (49-for-16) with a 1.56 WHIP off Povich during the day while batting .258 (56-for-217) with a 1.38 WHIP at night.

SPLIT THE DIFFERENCE: Povich has allowed a .280 (26-for-93) average to left-handed hitters compared to a .276 (79-for-286) clip against righties...His most effective offering against right-handed hitters has been his changeup, holding them to a .185 (10-for-54) mark with 16 strikeouts.

- Lefties are 17-for-48 (.354) across his last nine outings since May 28 while righties have gone 34-for-134 (.254) in that span...Left-handed batters were 9-for-45 (.200) through Povich's first nine appearances between March 31-May 23.
- His .354 opponent average against lefties since May 28 is the third-highest mark by an American League southpaw in that span (min. 50 BF), ahead of teammate **Dietrich Enns** (.382 AVG) and **HOU's Bryan King** (.362 AVG).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Since May 16 (12 G/11 GS), Povich has held opponents to a .208 clip (20-for-96) off his four-seam fastball after batters hit .319 (15-for-47) off the pitch through his first seven starts of the season from March 31-May 6...In that same span, opponents are hitting .270 (10-for-37) off his sinker (two-seam) after batting .412 (7-for-17) on the offering through his first seven outings of the year.

TWO-STRIKE SUCCESS: Has held opponents to a .198/.278/.314 (41-for-207) slash line with two strikes after batters hit .210 (34-for-162) with two strikes off Povich last season...Opponents have gone 9-for-44 (.205) in full counts, but they also hold a .478 on-base percentage with 22 walks.

TWO-OUT TROUBLE: Opponents are batting .288 (34-for-118) with a .884 OPS with two outs off Povich...His .884 opponent OPS with two outs is the second-highest mark among major league pitchers currently on a 27-man roster (min. 125 BF), ahead of KC's **Michael Lorenzen** (.898 OPS).

- Hitters are slashing .296/.345/.519 (8-for-27) with runners in scoring position and two outs.
- THE LONG GAME:** In starts of at least 5.0 innings, Povich holds a 3.67 ERA (23 ER/56.1 IP) compared to an 8.42 ERA (29 ER/31.0 IP) in starts of fewer than 5.0 innings...This season, he has held opponents to two earned runs or fewer in seven of 10 starts in which he completes at least five frames.
- Has held opponents to a .697 OPS in 5.0+-inning starts compared to a 1.014 mark in starts of 4.2 innings or fewer.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP TREVOR ROGERS (8-2, 1.51)

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on September 6 vs. Los Angeles-NL after allowing two runs on a season-high-tying eight hits (also 8/6 at PHI) and one walk with six strikeouts in 5.1 innings...Snapped a franchise-record 10-start streak of 6.0+ innings and two or fewer runs allowed.
