THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their seven-game roadtrip, winning their first game in Cleveland on Monday night, followed by three consecutive losses at Progressive Field from Tuesday-Thursday...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three at Fenway Park over the weekend.

Over the last 10 games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +24 (48-24)... they now sit at +4 overall on the season (123-119).

TWINS WALKED-OFF IN CLEVELAND...AGAIN: The Twins were walked-off by the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Progressive Field by a score of 4-3 in 10 innings...it marked their second walk-off defeat of the season — both coming during the Cleveland series...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on two hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with a career-high five walks and four strikeouts...Twins pitchers walked eight batters overall, marking a season-high...the offense recorded 13 hits, three apiece from Ty France and Harrison Bader.

Twins hitters finished the game 3-for-14 with runners in scoring position, making them 3-for-20 with RISP over the final three games of the series.

BOSTON COMMON: Minnesota went 3-3 against the Red Sox last season, going 2-1 at Target Field from May 3-5 and 1-2 at Fenway Park from September 20-22...the Twins began 2024 3-1 against the Red Sox until getting swept in a doubleheader in their last meeting on September 22 at Fenway Park.

Carlos Correa is hitting .290 (62-for-214) with eight doubles, 11 home runs, 32 RBI, 37 runs scored, 37 walks, a .391 on-base percentage, a .481 slugging percentage and an .873 OPS in 58 career regular season games against the Red Sox.

Byron Buxton has hit safely in six-straight games against the Red Sox, going 9-for-25 (.360) with a 1.145 OPS in that span, including three home runs and five RBI.

Harrison Bader is 6-for-12 (.500) in three career games at Fenway Park (all 2022 w/ STL).

Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with one home run, seven RBI and an .824 OPS in his last seven games against the Red Sox.

Ryan Jeffers is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with four doubles, one home run and an .885 OPS in his last seven games against the Red Sox.

Christian Vázquez has hit safely in all four games at Fenway as an opponent, going 5-for-16 (.313)...he has hit safely in seven-straight starts vs. Boston.

Twins manager and former Red Sox outfielder (2009) Rocco Baldelli, has a career managerial record against Boston of 15-18 (since 2019), 7-9 at Fenway Park...the Woonsocket, Rhode Island native grew up approximately 49 miles southwest of Fenway Park...he attended Bishop Hendricken High School in Warwick, RI...he grew up a Red Sox fan, watching Wade Boggs, Ellis Burks, Roger Clemens (who's son he now manages), Mike Greenwell, et al.

LOVE THAT DIR-TY WATER: Ty France is hitting .292 (31-for-106) with 15 doubles and eight RBI in 27 career games against the Red Sox...the 15 doubles are his second-most against any opponent (LAA - 16)...he has hit safely in all 11 career games at Fenway Park, hitting .320 (16-for-50) with 10 doubles, a .520 slugging percentage and an .866 OPS in this ballpark...the 11-game hitting streak here is the longest active streak for an opponent...10 doubles here are his most in any opposing ballpark.

RYAN KING: In his last start on April 27 at Cleveland, Joe Ryan induced 26 whiffs from Guardians batters, the second-most in a start in baseball this season, trailing only MacKenzie Gore's 28 from April 19 at Colorado...Ryan has 78 whiffs on the season, eighth-most in baseball...below are more of Ryan's ranks among AL pitchers in a few categories this season (minimum of 30.0 innings pitched):

C4. IGNITING: Carlos Correa has hit safely in six of his last seven games, hitting .393 (11-for-28) with two doubles, four RBI and an .864 OPS in that span...below are his first 16 games (March 27-April 16), compared to his last 15 games (since April 15):

ALSO: Over the 15 games, he has raised his batting average 70 points, from .153 to .223.

PARDON MY FRENCH: Ty France enters tonight with a six-game hitting streak, tied for the longest by a Twin this season with Edouard Julien (4/8-13) and Luke Keaschall (4/18-24)...during the streak, France is hitting .480 (12-for-25) with four doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .760 slugging percentage and a 1.222 OPS.

France has a team-leading 18 RBI on the season...of those 18 RBI, 16 have come in his last 21 games, since April 9...since that date, the 16 RBI are tied with Alex Bregman for second-most in the AL, trailing Spencer Torkelson (19).

Among all MLB players with a minimum of 25 RISP at-bats, his .406 RISP average is tied with Jarren Duran for the third-best in the AL, trailing Aaron Judge (.560) and Paul Goldschmidt (.444) and just ahead of fifth-place Harrison Bader (.385).

France's 32 hits on the season are tied for 11th-most in the AL.

He has posted a barrel percentage of 14.0% this season, up 6.7% from 2024 (7.3%), the eighth-best year-to-year increase in the AL.

His MLB percentile rankings in a few categories: 89th in xwOBA (.399), 89th in xBA (.297), 89th in xSLG (.554) and 88th in K% (13.8%).

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX: Over his last 16 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits eight times and is hitting .303 (20-for-66) with two doubles, two triples, four home runs, 11 RBI, 13 runs scored, a .576 slugging percentage and an .890 OPS in that span.

His 10 multi-hit games on the season are tied for ninth-most in the AL.

In his last six road games, he is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with four RBI, a .615 slugging percentage and a 1.008 OPS.

- ☞ Making his seventh start of 2025 and 91st of his career...earned his second win of the year in his last outing on April 28 vs. the Angels (7.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 11 K).
- ☞ In five career starts against Boston, is 3-2 with a 3.38 ERA (32.0 IP, 12 ER), five home runs, three walks and 32 strikeouts...last started at Fenway Park on April 19, 2023 (6.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R, BB, 3 K).
- ☞ Is 1-1 with a 3.71 ERA (17.0 IP, 7 ER), one walk and 14 strikeouts in three road starts this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second victory of the season on April 28 vs. the Angels at Target Field, leading the Twins to their second shutout victory and first sweep of the season; Ryan was also the starter for Minnesota's first shutout on April 9 at Kansas City...Twins won 5-0 against José Soriano and the Halos bullpen...Ryan allowed four hits over 7.0 shutout innings, walking one and striking out a season-high 11...tied season high 7.0 innings pitched, the 16th time in his career going 7.0-or-more innings...retired the first three batters of the game on foul pop flies...did not allow a base runner until the fourth inning.

- ☞ His 11 strikeouts match the second-highest single-start total of his career...has struck out 10+ in 10 starts; his career high is 12, recorded in Game 1 of a April 13 2024 doubleheader in Detroit.
- ☞ Recorded a career-high 26 whiffs, second-most by a pitcher in baseball this season, trailing MacKenzie Gore's 28 on April 19 vs. Colorado.
- ☞ Struck out the side in the second inning, the third time this season he's retired all three batters in an inning via the strikeout and the 17th time in his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started on April 20 at Truist Park in Atlanta opposite right-hander Grant Holmes...took the loss, his second of the season, allowing six runs on eight hits (3 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings...surrendered a run in each of his innings except the fourth, including two-run homers in the first and third, and a solo shot in the fifth...prior to the game, Ryan had not allowed six earned runs in an outing since September 29, 2023 at Colorado, when he also allowed eight hits and three home runs in 5.0 innings.

- ☞ The Twins pitching staff entered the game with a major league best 20 two-out runs allowed until the first five runs scored by Atlanta came with two outs in their respective innings...Ryan had previously allowed two two-out runs this season – on March 29 in St. Louis and April 14 vs. New York at Target Field.

FACING BOSTON: In five career starts against the Red Sox, Ryan is 3-2 with a 3.38 ERA (32.0 IP, 12 ER), three walks and 32 strikeouts...took the loss in his last start on May 5, 2024 at Target Field, allowing three runs on four hits (1 HR) over 6.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts; Twins lost 9-2...on June 22, 2023, went the distance in a three-hit shutout against the Sox in Minnesota, Ryan's only career complete-game and the eighth in Target Field history (Pablo López pitched the ninth CG shutout in Target Field history on July 5, 2023 vs. Kansas City).

- ☞ His last start at Fenway Park came on April 19, 2023, a Twins 10-4 victory, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts.
- ☞ Red Sox hitters are slashing .215/.246/.372 with four doubles and five home runs in 121 at-bats against Ryan...his first of three career grand slams was surrendered to the Red Sox on August 31, 2022 at Target Field.

AL EAST BEAST: In 16 career starts against the American League East, Ryan is 6-5 with a 3.51 ERA (95.0 IP, 37 ER), 16 walks and 100 strikeouts...10 of his 16 starts against the AL East have been quality, and the Twins own a 10-6 record when he pitches against the division...has two 10-or-more strikeout games against the AL East (10 K on April 13, 2023 at New York-AL; 10 K on July 9, 2023 vs. Baltimore)...threw his first career complete-game shutout on June 22 vs. Boston (9.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K).

- ☞ Owns a .224 (81-for-362) career opponent batting average vs. the AL East, the lowest by a Twins pitcher against the division since it was formed in 1969 (min. 15 GS)...of such pitchers, Ryan's 1.02 WHIP and 6.25 strikeout-to-walk ratio rank first.

JOE ON THE ROAD: Is making his fourth road start of the season; is 1-1 with a 3.71 ERA (17.0 IP, 7 ER), one walk and 14 strikeouts away from Target Field, compared to 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (17.0 IP, 5 ER), three walks and 25 strikeouts in three home starts...in his career, is 15-15 in 44 road starts with a 4.11 ERA (240.2 IP, 110 ER), a 1.11 WHIP and a 4.85 strikeout-to-walk ratio, compared to 20-13 in 46 home starts with a 3.65 ERA (263.2 IP, 107 ER), a 1.02 WHIP and a 5.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ☞ Compared to Minnesota starters this season, Ryan's 14.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 0.94 WHIP rank first while his 3.71 ERA trails only Pablo López (1.66 ERA, 23.0 IP, 5 ER).
- ☞ In two career starts at Fenway Park, is 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 4 ER), two home runs, one walk and 10 strikeouts...last pitched in Boston on April 19, 2023, a 10-4 Twins victory; allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR) over 6.0 innings, with one walk and three strikeouts.

IT'S GONNA BE MAY: In 15 career starts in the month of May, Ryan is 7-5 with a 2.84 ERA (85.2 IP, 27 ER), six home runs, 21 walks and 89 strikeouts...since 2021, his 15 starts, seven wins, 85.2 innings, and 89 strikeouts in the month of May lead the Twins pitching staff...among Minnesota pitchers with six-or-more May starts in that span, Ryan's 2.84 ERA trails only Sonny Gray's 2.73 (52.2 IP, 16 ER).

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .250/.278/.404 with two doubles, two home runs, no walks and nine strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .192/.263/.370 with four doubles, three home runs, four walks and 30 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .209/.269/.364 with 62 walks and 218 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .235/.280/.446 with 51 walks and 346 strikeouts.

- ☞ In his five career starts against the Red Sox, lefties have slashed .200/.238/.300 with one homer, two walks and 12 strikeouts, while righties have slashed .230/.254/.443 with four homers, one walk and 20 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through six starts in 2025, Ryan has relied on a five-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Of all major league pitchers with 500-or-more pitches thrown so far this season, Ryan's 58.3 percent four-seamer usage is the third highest...of pitchers with 200-or-more four-seamers thrown this season, his .187 BAA off the pitch is the ninth best.

SUNNY WHIFF A CHANCE OF RYAN: After inducing nine whiffs, his second-fewest of the season, on April 20 in Atlanta, Ryan recorded a career-high 26 whiffs on April 27 against the Angels at Target Field - the second most in an MLB game this season at the close play on 4/27 (MacKenzie Gore had 28 whiffs on April 19)...with 98 pitches thrown, Ryan had a game whiff rate of 46.4 percent, the second most of his career in outings with 60-or-more pitches (48.7 percent on April 8, 2023 vs. Houston).

- ☞ This season, Ryan has a 43.6 percent whiff rate on his sweeper...of the 27 sweepers he threw on Sunday, he induced six whiffs (60 percent).

- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive season in the Twins' opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
