**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles wrap up a six-game homestand and a stretch of 15 games in 14 days, which started with an April 30 doubleheader vs. the Astros, today against the Yankees... The club has its first scheduled off day this month tomorrow before hitting the road for a six-game road trip at Washington (5/15-17) and Tampa Bay (5/18-20).

👤 **Taylor Ward** snapped an 0-for-19 stretch at the plate and a career-long 16-game stretch without an extra-base hit with a sixth-inning double...He also singled in the eighth for his first multi-hit effort since April 25.

👤 **Josh Walker** tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in his Orioles debut.

**BURNING RUBBER:** The Orioles and Yankees play a rubber game to determine the series today...Baltimore is 3-2 in rubber games this season after going 9-15 in such situations a year ago.

**20-SOMETHING:** The Orioles are one of 11 teams in the majors this season with four players having at least 20 RBI...The Braves lead the league with six, while the O's are tied with the Angels, Brewers, Cardinals, Cubs, Nationals, Phillies, Pirates, Twins, and Yankees...**Pete Alonso** (22), **Gunnar Henderson** (21), **Jeremiah Jackson** (24), and **Adley Rutschman** (21) all have at least 20, while **Leody Taveras** (19), **Samuel Basallo** (16) and **Coby Mayo** (15) are close.

**GARCIA'S GREATNESS:** **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) with one hit, seven walks, and 22 strikeouts across 20 appearances to begin the season...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

👤 His .018 (1-for-57) opponent average and 0.42 WHIP are the best among MLB relievers. 🏆 Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 20 outings of a season was six (Jesse Orosco, 1997).

👤 He has not allowed a hit in each of his last eight outings, tied for the longest active run in the majors with SEA's Matt Brash.

👤 Garcia has yet to allow a hit in his first 10 home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, the only Oriole in team history to begin a season with such a stretch...It is tied for the fourth-longest such streak by an MLB pitcher since 1900 behind SF's Scott Eyre (15 G, 2004), OAK's Ryan Cook (14 G, 2012), and SEA's Jeff Nelson (11 G, 2001).

**BASALLO BREAKING OUT:** **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .403/.439/.645 (25-for-62) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, nine runs, and 12 RBI over his last 18 games since April 20.

👤 During this period, he is 15-for-34 (.441) with four doubles, one triple, and one home run off fastballs.

👤 Basallo's 93.0 mph average exit velocity is tied for the lead among MLB catchers along with ATH's Shea Langeliers.

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** leads the majors with 81 times on base (39 H, 41 BB, 1 HBP) and 41 walks...He's second in the majors with a .4241 on-base percentage behind MIL's Brice Turang (.4242) and second with 14 doubles behind ATL's Matt Olson (15).

👤 He doubled in the sixth inning last night to snap a career-long 16-game stretch without an extra-base hit...It marked his first double since April 22 at Kansas City.

👤 His 81 times on base are tied for the third most in a players' first 42 games to begin his time with the Orioles with Albert Belle (1999), trailing Roberto Alomar (91 in 1996) and Frank Robinson (82 in 1966).

👤 Ward became the first player in Orioles history (since 1954) to draw 40 walks in his first 40 games with the club.

👤 According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2<sup>nd</sup>, .410).

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE:** The O's have drawn 171 walks this year, sixth in MLB behind the Cubs (196), Yankees (195), Guardians (188), Pirates (176), and Brewers (175)...The Birds are averaging 9.42 plate appearances per walk, fifth best in the majors behind the Yankees (8.33), Cubs (8.44), Brewers (8.66), and Guardians (8.81).

👤 **Taylor Ward** is averaging an MLB-best 4.66 plate appearances per walk, ahead of ATH's Nick Kurtz (4.74) and LAA's Mike Trout (4.90).

👤 Baltimore has 18 games with 5+ walks, tied with Milwaukee for the third most such games in the majors behind Chicago-NL (23) and New York-AL (19)...The 2025 Orioles had 34 such games.

**DEUCES WILD:** Baltimore pitching has allowed a .769 opponent OPS with two outs, the fourth-highest mark in the majors ahead of Houston (.798), Chicago-AL (.798), and Cincinnati (.777).

👤 With two strikes, the opposition owns a .553 OPS, fourth highest in MLB ahead of Colorado (.603), Houston (.585), and Washington (.584).

**'PEN PALS:** The Orioles bullpen has a 15.1 percent inherited runners scored rate (8 IRS/53 IR), second best in the majors behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR)...Baltimore posted a 27.6 percent rate last season, ranked eighth in MLB.

👤 The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**YANKEE DOODLES:** The Orioles and Yankees are meeting this week for the second of four series this season...New York swept a four-game set in the Bronx from May 1-4...The Yankees return to Camden Yards from August 18-20 before the clubs wrap up the regular season at Yankee Stadium from September 25-27.

👤 The Birds snapped a nine-game losing streak against the Yankees on Monday, the longest against the club since dropping a team-record 19 straight to New York from April 4, 2019-September 4 (G1), 2020.

👤 Since 2023, **Gunnar Henderson** has 43 hits against the Yankees, tied for second most in the majors during that time with SF's Rafael Devers and TOR's George Springer, behind TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (45).

👤 Orioles Infield Coach **Miguel Cairo** worked for the Yankees as a minor league field coordinator from 2018-2020 and played three seasons in the Bronx in 2004 and 2006-07.

**QUICK HITS:** Bradish is scheduled to make his ninth start of the season and 76<sup>th</sup> of his career today in the series finale vs. New York-AL...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his fifth loss of the season on May 8 vs. the Athletics after allowing three runs on five hits, one walk, and one hit batter with 10 strikeouts in a season-high 7.0 innings pitched...Marked his fourth career start with at least 7.0 innings pitched and 10+ strikeouts, and his first since May 26, 2024 at Chicago-AL (7.0 IP, 11 K)...Threw 96 pitches, 60 strikes.

- ⚾ Generated a season-high-tying 15 whiffs (also 4/20 at KC), nine of which came on his curveball (5 K).
- ⚾ Allowed one walk or fewer for the second time this season (also 4/15 vs. AZ, 1 BB).

**EMPIRE CITY:** Bradish is set to make his ninth career start opposite New York-AL, having gone 1-2 with a 3.92 ERA (17 ER/39.0 IP)...Took the loss in the Bronx on May 2 after permitting five runs on six hits (2 HR) and four walks (1 IBB) with four strikeouts in 4.0 innings pitched...Hasn't reached 5.0 innings in three of his last four starts vs. them.

- ⚾ Is 5-14 with a 5.48 ERA (97 ER/159.1 IP) over 33 career starts vs. the AL East...Has lost his last three decisions against the division since August 26, 2025.

⚾ Holds a 3.93 ERA (123 ER/281.1 IP) in 54 career starts vs. the American League compared to his 2.84 ERA (37 ER/117.1 IP) in 21 starts against the National League.

**DAY TRIPPER:** Bradish's six daytime starts are tied for the most in the majors with CIN's Andrew Abbott, CLE's Slade Cecconi, AZ's Zac Gallen, CHC's Shota Imanaga, and NYM's Freddy Peralta...Is 1-4 with a 5.65 ERA (18 ER/28.2 IP) in day games this year after going 5-4 with a 2.67 ERA (39 ER/131.1 IP) over 25 daytime starts from 2022-25.

**BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL:** Bradish owns a 53.5 percent first-pitch strike rate, the third-lowest mark in the majors (min. 40.0 IP), ahead of LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (52.5%) and SF's Tyler Mahle (52.7%)...However, he recorded a 64.0% (18/28) first-pitch strike rate in his last start on May 8 vs. the Athletics

- ⚾ In his six starts last season, Bradish posted a 63.5 percent first-pitch strike rate.

**WALK DON'T RUN:** Bradish's 11.9 percent walk rate this season is the highest of his career (9.2%; 2024) and is the ninth-highest mark in the majors (min. 30.0 IP) ahead of leader DET's Jack Flaherty (15.9%)...His 22 walks in eight starts this season are his most over any eight-game span in his career with the next closest being his 21 walks from September 28, 2025-May 2, 2026...However, he allowed one walk in his last outing on May 8 vs. the Athletics.

**BREAKDOWN:** Bradish's 44.6 percent whiff rate on his curveball is the fourth-best mark in the majors (min. 20 AB) behind HOU's Spencer Arrighetti (53.8%), MIN's Taj Bradley (50.0%), and ATH's Scott Barlow (46.3%)...Last season, he recorded a 46.9 whiff rate on his curve.

- ⚾ On his slider, his .500 slugging percentage is the fifth-highest mark in the majors (min. 40 AB ending in the pitch) ahead of MIN's Simeon Woods Richardson (.625), SEA's Logan Gilbert (.565), ATH's Jeffrey Springs (.521), and AZ's Zac Gallen (.511)... Opponents slashed .063/.063/.156 (2-for-32) off his slider with one home run in 2025.
