After being shut out, 5-0, in Friday night's series opener, the Rays returned the favor with a 4-0 win yesterday afternoon, their first time shutting out a team the day after that same opponent blanked them since Aug. 19-20, 2024 at OAK...it was also their first shutout victory over the Dodgers in franchise history. It marked the Rays ninth shutout win overall, tied with the Royals for fifth most in the AL, but one shy of four co-leaders: the Guardians, Rangers, Tigers and Yankees (all 10). Neither team drew a walk in the contest, the Rays first such game since April 28, 2024 at CWS...Rays hitters have not walked in three straight games for the third time in club history, joining streaks from Sept. 8-11, 2000 (4G) and Sept. 13-15, 2021 (3G). The Rays are 46-15 when scoring four runs or more (26-7 at home) compared to 9-42 with three runs or fewer (6-22 at home).

Tampa Bay is 21-11 (.656) at Steinbrenner Field since May 20, the AL's third-best home record in that span behind Toronto (25-6/.806) and Boston (23-10/.697).

The Rays 20-15 (.571) Interleague record ranks fifth in the AL and is tied with the Dodgers (20-15) for eighth in the majors.

Under Kevin Cash (2015-pres.), the Rays are 165-109 (.602) in August, second in the majors, trailing only the Dodgers (186-92/.669).

Today, the Rays look to win back-to-back games for the second time since the calendar flipped to July, which would join July 18-19 vs. BAL...dating back to June 29, they are 1-7 in their last eight games following a win.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Snap a three-game losing streak in rubber games, tallying their first such victory since June 8 vs. MIA (3-2)...improve to 4-1 in their last five home rubber matches... snap a season-high five-game losing streak in series finales with their first series-closing win since July 9 at DET.

Earn their first series win since July 18-20 vs. BAL, improving to 2-3-0 in series play since the All-Star break...would mark their second series win in their last 10 sets. Improve to 3-2-1 in their last six series at Steinbrenner Field.

Move to 3-3-5 all-time in series against the Dodgers, earning their third series win along with May 26-28, 2023 and June 22-24, 2007, both at Tropicana Field. Improve to 9-3-0 in series play against NL opponents, including 6-1-0 at home. Record their first series victory over a team that entered with a winning record since June 24-26 at KC, snapping a four-series skid (at DET, at BOS, at CIN, at NYY). Earn their fifth series win in their last six sets vs. clubs that entered leading their division, joining series victories over the Tigers (June 20-22), Mets (June 13-15), Yankees (May 2-4) and Padres (April 25-27).

DÍAZ DINGERS—In yesterday's 4-0 win, Yandy Díaz clubbed his 20th career leadoff homer, extending his franchise record while becoming the 11th active player to reach the mark, before adding a two-run shot in the 3rd inning to secure his third career multi-homer game, fourth including postseason contests...it joined his previous efforts on June 20, 2025 vs. DET, May 11, 2019 vs. NYY and the 2019 AL Wild Card Game on Oct. 2, 2019 at OAK...he became the third player to homer off Blake Snell twice in the same game in the two-time Cy Young winner's career, joining BOS Rafael Devers on May 19, 2023 and CLE José Ramírez on Aug. 24, 2022...both blasts were hit to right field—Díaz's 13 opposite-field homers are tied with NYY Aaron Judge for the most in the majors.

* His leadoff home run marked the 900th hit of his career, 825 of which have come with the Rays, sixth most in franchise history.

* Between Díaz and Junior Caminero (28HR), the Rays are one of nine teams in the majors with multiple players who have 20 HR or more...if Brandon Lowe (19HR) were to homer today, they would join the Cubs (Busch/Crow-Armstrong/Suzuki), Diamondbacks (Carroll/Marte/Suarez), Mets (Alonso/Lindor/Soto) as the only teams with three players who have hit 20 HR for them this season.

HOME SWEET HOMERS—Junior Caminero (18HR) and Yandy Díaz (16HR) have combined for 34 HR at Steinbrenner Field, second most in the majors by a pair of teammates at their home ballpark behind LAD Shohei Ohtani (22HR) and LAD Andy Pages (15HR) who have launched 37 HR at Dodger Stadium... Caminero, whose 979 OPS at home ranks third among qualified AL hitters behind NYY Aaron Judge (1.157) and MIN Byron Buxton (1.006), has reached base safely in 20 of his last 21 games in Tampa, hitting .361/411/.723 (30-for-83) with 6 2B, 8 HR and 18 RBI...Díaz has multiple hits in nine of his last 16 games at Steinbrenner Field, slashing .391/466/813 (25-for-64) with 3 2B, 8 HR 15 RBI and a 1.278 OPS...since June 8, both players rank among MLB leaders in home slugging pct. (min. 75PA)—see the table to the right for the full list.

WHIFF CITY—Rays pitchers have struck out nine batters or more in six straight and 10 of their last 13 games dating back to July 20...the six-game streak is their longest single-season run since an 11-game stretch from Sept 18-29, 2024...over the 13-game span (July 20.-pres.), they lead the majors with 10.27 strikeouts per 9.0 IP, and their 129 SO rank second behind the Rangers (132SO)...entering that timeframe, the Rays 8.23 strikeouts per 9.0 IP ranked ninth in the AL/17th in the majors.

Rays pitchers have generated 20 whiffs or more in six of their last seven games dating back to July 27, producing a 30.6 pct. whiff rate, third in MLB behind the Astros (32.2%) and Rangers (30.8%)...entering that span, they had reached the mark in six of their previous 19 games (July 4-26).

O(PEN) SEASON—The Rays bullpen has thrown 11.2 consecutive scoreless frames over the last three games, holding opponents to a .128 (5-for-39) average while recording 17 SO (13.1 SO/9.0IP) against 3 BB... they have not allowed a run in six of the last eight games, pitching to a 1.27 ERA (28.1IP, 4ER) in that span... Rays relievers have fanned five batters or more in six consecutive games, their longest streak since April 8-14, 2022 (7G)... the franchise record is eight straight games with 5 SO or more, set from Sept. 2-10, 2018... the current streak is the bullpen's longest while recording 5.0 IP or fewer in each game in team history.

**Mason Englert (10 of 21) and Edwin Uceta (17 of 37) have combined to strike out 27 of their 58 batters faced (46.6%) since the All-Star break...Englert's 12.2 scoreless inning streak is the second-longest active run among AL relievers (see table to the right)...Uceta has not allowed an earned run in his last seven outings (11.2IP).

MILESTONE WATCH—Yandy Díaz is three runs from tying Kevin Kiermaier (410R) for fifth on the Rays all-time list...his 65 three-hit games are tied with Aubrey Huff (65G) for third...Christopher Morel is 4 RBI away from 200 for his career...Jonny DeLuca is one hit shy of 100 career hits...Junior Caminero is 3 RBI away from 100, while Nick Fortes is 4 RBI shy of 100...Pete Fairbanks' 291 SO as a reliever are tied for third most in Rays history (see table to the right)...his 81 saves are four shy of Fernando Rodney (85SV) for third in team history. team history.

ON DECK—The Rays kick off a a season-high 12-game West Coast road trip tomorrow night in Anaheim, their longest road trip since Aug. 2-14, 2005 (12G, 3G each in TEX, LAA, BAL, CLE)...it also marks their first four-city trip since June 2-13, 2011 (SEA, LAA, BAL, DET), which culminated with a one-game make-up in Detroit...they also had a 10-game trip from July 19-29, 2013 in which they traveled through Toronto, Boston and New York before returning to Boston for a make-up game to close the trip.

TODAY'S START—Joe Boyle will make his third start as a Ray, his second since joining the Rays rotation and his seventh appearance for the club... it marks the 16th career start (23G) of his career and his first against the Dodgers...is in his second stint with the Rays this season, joining April 13-14...acquired from the Athletics along with INF Will Simpson, RHP Jacob Watters and a Competitive Balance Round A selection for LHP Jeffrey Springs and LHP Jacob Lopez on Dec. 14, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT—He gave up six runs (4ER) over 3.1 innings on four hits (1HR) and three walks with six strikeouts on July 29 at NYY...four hits, six runs, four earned runs and three walks each were season highs for Boyle and his one home run allowed tied his season and career high... he scattered a walk and a double over the first two innings, before being tagged for a three-run home run to Cody Bellinger...he allowed another unearned run on a José Caballero error.

His six runs allowed were the most he has allowed in a start since April 19, 2024 at CLE.

DODGE A BALL, DODGE A WRENCH—Boyle has not faced the Dodgers in his career...he has only made one career start against the NL West on Sept. 17, 2023 vs. SD (3.0IP, H, 2BB, 4SO)...in eight games (7 GS) agianst the National League in his career, he is 2-3 with a 5.72 ERA (28.1IP, 18ER) with a .196 (20-for-102) opp. average.

BACK IN THE BAY—In three appearances (1GS) at Steinbrenner Field this season, he is 1-0 with a 0.90 ERA (10.0IP, 1ER), a .032 (1-for-31) opp. average and a 0.40 WHIP...his lone run he has allowed at home came on a **Kyle Teel** solo home run on July 23 vs. CWS.

In 12 career outings (9GS) in home ballparks, he is 4-4 with a 3.66 ERA (46.2IP, 19ER) and a .185 (31-for-168) opp. average and a 10.03 strikeouts per 9.0 IP rate.

MINOR MATTERS—In his 15 games (14GS) with Triple-A Durham in 2025, Boyle pitched to a 1.85 ERA (73.0IP, 15ER)...posted a 0.99 WHIP and limited opponents to a .160 batting average (41-for-256).

* Was named International League Pitcher of the Week three times this season and named International League Pitcher of the Month for June...he went 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (30.0IP, 6ER) with a 0.97 WHIP, and a .167 (18-for-108) opp. average in six outings (5GS) during the month...was also named Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month.

ALRIGHT, **ALRIGHT**—Boyle has held righties to a .158 batting average (24-for-152) in his career...he has allowed just five extra-base hits, walked 20 batters and struck out 52 right-handed batters...meanwhile, lefties have hit at a .226 clip (36-for-159) against him with 15 extra-base hits, 34 walks and 43 strikeouts...has allowed just four hits (.118/4-for-34) to righties this season.

BREAKING OUT THE ARSENAL—Boyle has yet to surrender a hit off of his splitter this season, with opposing hitters going 0-for-10 with five strikeouts...against his slider opposing hitters are 5-for-29 (.172) with 14 strikeout of his 24 total strikeouts...opponents are batting .128 (5-for-39) combined against the two pitches...min. 30 PA, the opp. AVG is the 10th lowest combined AVG on those two pitches in the AL...in his career, he has held opponents to a combined .152 (19-for-125) clip with 53 SO on the slider and spliter, while he has allowed a .214 (36-for-168) clip on his fastball.

FLAMETHROWER—Boyle averaged 97.7 mph on his four-seam fastball in 2024, the seventh-highest mark in the majors (min. 500 four-seamers thrown)...he tallied 38 pitches over 100 mph, seventh most in the AL...he made one start in a Statcast-equipped ballpark this past spring, Feb. 28 at Pittsburgh's LECOM Park...touched 100.0 mph on 14 of his 19 four-seam fastballs.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS—Boyle's first start for the Rays came in a spot start on April 13 vs. ATL...he earned his first and only win of 2025 after tossing 5.0 hitless innings (2R, 0ER) with 2 BB, 1 HBP and 7 SO...the right-hander retired 13 straight batters to open the game before allowing his first baserunner to reach via walk in the 5th inning...put out the next two batters before yielding a hit-by-pitch and a walk to end his outing.

With the start, he became one of 22 players in the majors since 1901 to toss five hitless innings (or more) in his debut with a team and the second Ray to turn the trick (Nathan Eovaldi - 6.0IP on May 30, 2018 at OAK).

2024 RECAP—He went 3-6 with a 6.42 ERA (47.2IP, 34ER) and 56 SO across 13 appearances (10GS) with the Athletics...was on the 15-day IL (low back strain) from May 6-June 5...optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas following his reinstatement and recalled on Aug. 13...optioned back to Las Vegas on Sept. 4 and finished the season there.

- Limited opponents to a .164 (11-for-67) average with 26 SO against his slider compared to a .270 (27-for-100) clip with 25 SO against his fastball.
- Held opponents to a combined .200 (30-for-150) average the first and second times through the lineup compared to .414 (12-for-29) the third time through.
- * On Aug. 19 vs. TB, turned in the longest scoreless outing of his career (6.0IP, 2H, 0R, 3BB, 6SO) in the Rays final trip to Oakland Coliseum.
