



# San Francisco Giants (29-32) at Arizona Diamondbacks (28-32)

LHP Kyle Harrison (4-2, 4.15) vs. LHP Blake Walston (0-0, 2.16)

**THE GIANTS:** Will play game two of this three game set tonight...SF dropped game one of it's current six game, seven day road trip to Arizona and Texas (Friday-Sunday) last night... it marked the Giants third loss this season via walk-off (also: May 21 at PIT and May 26 at NYM).

- ▶ The Giants have lost a season-high five consecutive games, dating back to Wednesday vs. Philadelphia, being outscored 30-13 during the skid...it marks the first time they have lost five consecutive games since they lost six straight games from Sept. 1-6, 2023.

**AGAINST THE DIAMONDBACKS:** SF is looking to turn things around at Chase Field where they have struggled over the last few seasons posting a 4-12 record in it's last 16 games here, dating back to July 4, 2022.

- ▶ Arizona has outscored San Francisco 87-50 during that 16 game stretch.
- ▶ The Giants have dropped each of their last six games here... the last time SF dropped six-or-more consecutive games at Chase Field was June 16, 2011-May 11, 2012 when they lost eight straight games.
- ▶ Despite their recent struggles, the Giants 261-196 (.571) record against the D-backs all-time is the Giants' highest winning percentage against any divisional opponent and the second-most wins by any franchise against the D-Backs trailing by only one win to the Dodgers (262) (Stats, LLC).
- ▶ **Bob Melvin** owns a career 34-23 (.596) record against the Diamondbacks as a manager, his second best against any opponent (64-36, .640, vs. Tigers)...it is the fifth-best record by any manager with at least 50 career games against the D-Backs (Stats, LLC).

**HARRY ON THE MOUND:** LHP Kyle Harrison is schedule to take the hill tonight for his 13th start of the season and his first career outing at Chase Field...he faced the Diamondbacks earlier this season at Oracle Park and allowed three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings of work.

- ▶ According to S/S, his breaking ball had a rough go in his last start against the Phillies on May 29 - he allowed five hits in five AB ending with it...in seven starts spanning April 20 to May 24, Harrison threw 123 breaking balls, on which he allowed just one hit and got 21 outs...he was throwing it for strikes 65% of the time, so it was a highly effective pitch.

**LEADING THE WAY:** Since joining the Giants on May 8, **OF Heliot Ramos** is hitting .295 with 10 runs, four doubles, four homers and 17 RBI in 24 games...in his last eight games, he's 10-for-29 (.345) with two homers and eight RBI.

**BULLIES:** San Francisco's bullpen has thrown 245.2 innings this season, which ranks as the second-most in MLB behind the Brewers (248.2ip).

**ON THE OTHER SIDE:** The Giants will face Diamondbacks' LHP Blake Walton for the first time tonight...Arizona's 2019 first round selection has made two career starts and allowed two runs in 8.1 innings of work...he most recently started on May 26 at Miami and tossed 4.2-scoreless innings.

- ▶ The Giants have struggled against left-handed starters this year, posting a 5-11 record.

**PACK YOUR BAGS:** San Francisco is 12-18 over 30 road games with a -25 run differential...however, SF has won six of its last 10 road contests.

- ▶ The Giants have won each of their last three series on the road (at Colorado, at Pittsburgh and at New York-NL), their longest streak since winning five straight series in May and June of last year...prior to this current stretch, the Giants owned a 1-4-1 series record on the road this season.

**KEEP ROLLIN: IF Matt Chapman** extended his on-base streak last night to 21 games with an RBI double in the 4th inning... the 21-game streak is the fifth-longest streak among active players in the Majors.

- ▶ Chapman is slashing .300/.398/.563 with 19 runs, nine doubles, four homers and 14 RBI during his 21-game streak that started on May 11 vs. Cincinnati.
- ▶ The 21-game streak is tied for the third-longest of Chapman's career...his second-longest on-base streak is a 24-gamer from June 11-July 9, 2021 with the A's.

**LOOKING FOR RUNS:** Since scoring eight runs in their victory over the Phillies on Monday afternoon, the Giants have scored a total of 14 runs in their last six games dating to Tuesday.

- ▶ SF's offense in that time has slashed .209/.259/.306 with 11 extra-base hits.
- ▶ The Giants are 7-23 (.233) when scoring three or fewer runs and 22-9 (.710) when scoring at least four.

**LIGHT AT THE END OF THE TUNNEL:** After playing the two best teams in baseball last weekend, the Giants have a lighter stretch of games ahead, as they won't play a team above .500 until June 28, when they face the Dodgers...next up they will face the D-backs (28-32), Rangers (29-31), Astros (27-34), Angels (22-38), Cubs (29-31), Cardinals (28-30) and will close the stretch out again with the Cubs.

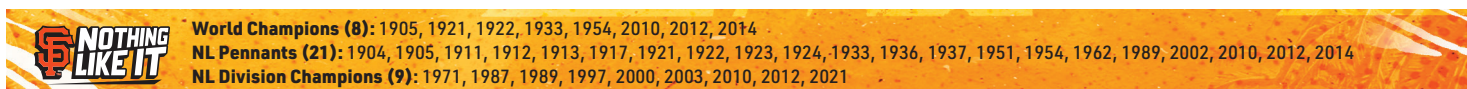
### This Date in Giants History

**June 4, 2009** - The Giants beat the Nationals 5-1 in the first half of a doubleheader. **Randy Johnson** allowed two hits and one run in 6.0 innings to win his 300th career game. He was the first pitcher since Tom Seaver in 1985 to join the 300 win club on his first try, and the second-oldest after Phil Niekro. This milestone came on the 10th anniversary of his 150th career win, and 20th anniversary of his fifth career win.

**TODAY'S START:** Harrison is scheduled to make his 13th start of the season today in the middle game of this three-game series against the Diamondbacks...Harrison is 4-2 with a 4.15 ERA (30er, 65.0ip) in his 12 starts this season...**the Giants are 9-3 in his starts this season, having winning eight of his last nine outings.**

**LAST TIME OUT:** Surrendered four runs, including two homers on a career-high 12 hits in 5.0 innings of work last Wednesday vs. Philadelphia...it was his fourth consecutive start of pitching 5.0 innings.

**NEED AN INNINGS EATER:** The Giants will look for Harrison to eat up innings tonight after using five pitchers in yesterday's bullpen game...Harrison has pitched 5.0 or more innings in 11 of his 12 starts this season, but has pitched 6.0 or more frames just five times.

**NO FREE PASSES:** After allowing just five walks over his first six starts and 33.0 innings, he's issued 17 in his last six starts and 32.0 innings pitched...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.

**LEAVING THE YARD:** Harrison has struggled with the longball of late, giving up four home runs over his last two starts...he hadn't allowed a homer in his previous six outings.

**FROM SIS:** According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues...opposing hitters are 31-for-98 (.316) with five homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball...they're 38-for-156 (.244) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

**THE FASTBALL:** Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 63.9% of the time, highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 400 pitches.

**VS. ARIZONA:** Has faced the Diamondbacks once in his career, back on April 20 at Oracle Park...lasted just 4.0 innings in that start while allowing three runs on six hits in a 7-3 Giants victory.

**3RD TIME THE CHARM:** When he's gotten to the third time through the batting order, it's gone very well...batters are hitting .230 (14-for-61) off him with just six RBI.

**GETTING THAT LAST ONE IS TOUGH:** Opponents have a slash line of .326/.394/.528 off Harrison with two outs.

**2023 SEASON:** Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia.

**ABOUT KYLE:** Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

- ▶ Matched his career-high with four runs allowed on Sunday and allowed a career-high four hits...marked his second blown save of the season and his second in his last three chances.
- ▶ Issued 17 walks in 23.1ip...his 15.6% walk rate is in the bottom 4% of the league.
- ▶ Has struck out 30 batters over 23.1 innings of work (11.57 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 16 of his 30 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Lefties are hitting .304 (14-for-46 off him).
- ▶ In 13 non-save situations, he is 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip), eight hits allowed (two homers), 11 walks and 16 strikeouts.
