**NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES**

- The Yankees have split the first two games of their three-game set vs. Arizona...are 2-3 on their six-game homestand.
  - With today's loss, the Yankees were eliminated from postseason contention for the first time since 2016.
  - Are still 8-5 in their last 13 games (since 9/10), 16-9 in their last 25 games (since 8/28) and 18-12 in their last 30 games (since 8/23).
- LHP Carlos Rodón** (6.1IP, 5H, 5R/3ER, 1BB, 4K, 0HR) recorded the loss after allowing 5R/3ER in 6.1IP.
  - After allowing hits to each of his first two batters faced, retired 17 of his next 18 batters faced (1BB).
  - Has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his last seven starts (since 8/22).
  - Has tossed at least 6.0IP in back-to-back starts (also a season-high 6.2IP on 9/17 at Pittsburgh) after doing so just once in his first 11 starts of the season (6.0IP on 8/22 vs. Washington).
- 1B DJ LeMahieu** (1-for-2, 3BB) reached base a season-high-tying four times...also reached base four times on 8/25 at Tampa Bay and 5/5 at Tampa Bay...his 3BB also matched a season high (also 3BB on 7/25 vs. the Mets and 7/26 vs. the Mets).
  - Has reached base multiple times in 20 of his last 38 games (since 8/4) and 26 of his last 48 games (since 7/21).
  - Has reached base in 18 of his last 20 games, 36 of his last 40 games (since 8/1), 53 of his last 59 games (since 7/4) and 60 of his last 68 games (since 6/23).
  - Has hit safely in 20 of his last 27 games (since 8/23) and 43 of his last 57 games (since 7/6).
- DH Aaron Judge** (1-for-3, 1 double, 1RBI, 2BB) reached base three times...walked in the third inning, hit a double in the eighth and drew a bases-loaded walk in the ninth...each of his last six hits have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 3HR).
  - Has 8RBI in his last three games.
  - Is batting .433/.575/.933 (13-for-30) with 7R, 3 doubles, 4HR, 13RBI and 10BB over his last nine games (since 9/14-G2).
  - Has reached base in 38-of-80 plate appearances over his last 18 games (since 9/5), posting a .475 OBP in that span (18H, 20BB).
  - Has hit .336/.447/.727 (37-for-110) with 24R, 4 doubles, 13HR, 27RBI, 22BB and 15B in 30 Interleague games this season...has batted .313/.410/.656 (141-for-450) with 94R, 21 doubles, 2 triples, 43HR, 85RBI, 73BB and 9SB in 124 career Interleague games.
- CF Estevan Florial** (1-for-4, 1 triple) recorded his first career triple in the fifth inning...has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games (since 9/12-G2).
- RF/LF Oswaldo Cabrera** (1-for-4, 1 double) hit a double in the ninth inning...is batting .295 (13-for-44) with 5R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 3RBI, 5BB and 15B over his last 12 games (since 9/10).
- 2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-5) has hit safely in 49 of his last 66 games (since 7/6), hitting .301/.368/.504 (77-for-256) with 38R, 14 doubles, 1 triple, 12HR, 30RBI, 27BB, 3SF, 2HP and 6SB in that span.
- RHP Randy Vásquez** (2.1IP, 3H, 2ER, 2BB, 2K, 1WP) allowed 2ER over 2.1IP...also allowed an inherited runner to score in the seventh inning.
  - Is 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA (11.2IP, 5ER) and 11K in five relief appearances this season...has tossed 2.0-or-more innings in four of those games.
- RHP Zach McAllister** (0.1IP) retired his only batter faced in the ninth inning.
- Yankees starters** have posted a 2.95 ERA (173.2IP, 57ER) in their last 32 games (since 8/20)...have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 29 of those 32 starts.

**ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS NOTES**

- The Diamondbacks defeated the Yankees in the second game of their three-game set...are 1-1 on their current six-game road trip.
  - Have won six of their last seven games (since 9/15), seven of their last 11 games (since 9/11) and 11 of their last 16 games (since 9/6).
  - Improve to 19-20 in Interleague games this season.
  - Are 10-14 vs. the Yankees all-time and 3-4 at the current Yankee Stadium.
  - With a victory tomorrow, would clinch their first series win at Yankee Stadium in franchise history (0-3-1 all-time in series at Yankee Stadium).

- **RHP Zac Gallen** (6.0IP, 3H, 0R, 2BB, 8K) earned his 17<sup>th</sup> win of the season after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings.
  - Has recorded eight scoreless starts this season, tied for the second-most in the Majors (trails only San Diego's Blake Snell – 11)...has thrown 6.0 innings-or-more in each of his eight scoreless starts.
  - His eight scoreless starts this season are tied for the second-most such starts by a Diamondbacks pitcher in single season in franchise history, trailing only his own 10 scoreless starts in 2022 (Merrill Kelly also had eight scoreless starts in 2022 and Randy Johnson had eight such starts in 2001).
  - Surpassed 200.0IP this season in the third inning...marks the first season of his career with at least 200.0IP...became the 21<sup>st</sup> Diamondbacks pitcher to toss 200.0 innings in a season...his 203.2IP this season are a team high.
  - With 203.2IP and 213 strikeouts this season, he's the sixth pitcher (12<sup>th</sup> time) in Diamondbacks history to toss at least 200.0 innings and record 200K-or-more in a season, joining Randy Johnson (five times: 1999-2002, '04), Curt Schilling (twice: 2001-02), Dan Haren (twice: 2008-09), Patrick Corbin (2018) and Zack Greinke (2017).
  - His 17 wins this season rank second in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta's Spencer Strider (18 wins), who is scheduled to start tonight at Washington.
- **RF/LF Corbin Carroll** (2-for-5, 2R, 1 double) recorded his team-leading 45<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season...hit a single, advanced to second base on an error, and later scored a run in the first inning...also doubled in the eighth...marked his 15<sup>th</sup> game this season with at least 2H and 2R, tying Ketel Marte for the most such games amongst Arizona batters.
  - In his last 31 games (since 8/19), is batting .347/.406/.542 (41-for-118) with 26R, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 4HR, 14RBI, 8BB, 5HP, 2SF and 13SB...has recorded 16 multi-hit games in that span.
  - Has recorded 62 extra-base hits this season (28 doubles, 9 triples, 25HR)...is 3XBH away from setting a new franchise record for extra-base hits in a season by a rookie (trails only Chris Young's 64XBH in 2007).
  - Is batting .302/.361/.574 (39-for-129) with 24R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 7HR, 20RBI, 11BB, 2HP, 2SF and 9SB in 36 Interleague games this season.
- **DH Tommy Pham** (2-for-3, 1R, 1RBI, 1SF) drove in Arizona's first run of the game with a sacrifice fly in the first inning...singled in the seventh and eighth inning.
  - Has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 games (since 9/9), batting .294 (15-for-51) over that span.
  - Has recorded four multi-hit games in his last 12 contests (since 9/10).
- **1B Christian Walker** (1-for-3, 1R, 2RBI, 1SF) hit a sacrifice fly in the first inning, singled in the seventh and drove in a run on a fielder's choice in the eighth.
- **3B Evan Longoria** (1-for-3, 2RBI) hit a two-run single in the seventh inning...was removed from the game in the seventh inning for a pinch runner (Jake McCarthy).
  - In 79 career games at Yankee Stadium, is hitting .272/.340/.495 (83-for-305) with 42R, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 16HR, 50RBI, 30BB, 4HP, 5SF and 3SB.
- **C Gabriel Moreno** (2-for-5, 1R, 1 double, 1RBI) hit an RBI double in the ninth inning... was one of three D-Backs batters to record multiple hits.
  - Has recorded an RBI in three of his last four games (since 9/19) and in four of his last six games (since 9/16).
  - Has recorded multiple hits in two of his last three games (since 9/20).
  - Started in the leadoff spot for the first time in his career.
- **2B Geraldo Perdomo** (0-for-2, 1R, 1RBI, 1BB, 1SF) hit a sacrifice fly in the seventh inning...also walked and later scored a run in the ninth.
- **RHP Ryan Thompson** (1.0IP, 1K) tossed a perfect seventh inning.
  - Has not allowed a run in each of his last 10 appearances (since 8/27), the second-longest such streak of his career (did not allow a run in 15 straight outings from 6/21-8/3/22).
