**THE TWINS**: Are playing their final game of 2025 this afternoon and wrapping up a six-game roadtrip with the series finale in Philadelphia...Minnesota will begin their 2026 season on March 26 in Baltimore, with three games in four days against the Orioles, followed by three in Kansas City against the Royals...they will open Target Field on April 3 with a seven-game homestand against the Rays and Tigers.

MICKKKKKKKKK: The Twins shut out the Phillies last night at Citizens Bank Park, winning by a score of 5-0, their 10th shutout of the season...Mick Abel (3-4) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, one walk and a career-high-tying nine strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, three being home runs from Byron Buxton (35) James Outman (4) and Ryan Fitzgerald (4)...Carson McCusker recorded his first career RBI with a fielder's choice groundout in the fourth inning.

PHILLY SPECIAL: The Twins are playing the Phillies for the 30th time in their history today... Twins are 16-13 all-time against Philadelphia, going 2-1 at Veterans Stadium (2002), 1-2 at the Metrodome (2004), 7-5 at Target Field in (2012, '13, '16 & '24), and 6-5 at Citizens Bank Park (2010, '19, '23 & '25)...they have won five of their last seven vs. Philly, since August of 2023 & Christian Vázquez is hitting. 467 (28-for-60) with seven doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, a .515 on-base percentage, a .783 slugging percentage and a 1.298 OPS in 20 career regular season games vs. the Phillies...has 14 hits in 31 at-bats in eight career regular season games at CBP.

THE MIZ ENTERS THE RING: The Twins have returned left-handed pitcher Anthony Misiewicz from his rehab assignment and have reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List... Misiewicz, who has missed the last 60 games with left shoulder impingement, appeared in two games on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul on September 19 and 21, pitching 1.2 scoreless innings, with no hits, one walk and one strikeout... prior to being placed on the Li in mid-July, the lefty appeared in four games for the Twins, allowing five runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...to make room for Misiewicz on the 28-man roster, the Twins optioned Pierson Ohl.. Ohl appeared in 14 games (3 starts) for the Twins in 2025, going 0-3 with a 5.10 ERA (30.0 IP, 17 ER), seven walks and 27 strikeouts.

MAJORITY RULES: A win today and the Twins will earn their 19th series victory of the season... Minnesota is 18-31-2 in series play, going 11-13-2 at home and 7-18-0 on the road... Twins are 7-14 in rubber games, winning in their last try, on Thursday at Texas. 

◆ Twins' last series win against the Phillies was July 22-24, 2024, taking two of three at Target Field...their last series win at Citizens Bank Park was August 11-13, 2023, taking

STEAL AWAY: The Twins have 113 stolen bases on the season, tied for 10th-most in club history.

Prior to the July 31 trade deadline, Minnesota stole 55 bases, tied for 24th-most in baseball.

since August 1, they have 58 stolen bases, tied with New York-AL and New York-NL for the most in baseball.

17 different Twins have stolen a base this season, which ties the 2004 team for second-most in a season in Twins history (since 1961)...the team record is 18 separate players with at least one stolen base in 2001...active players on the 28-man roster that need a stolen base still are: Ryan Jeffers, Edouard Julien and Carson McCusker.

**STONE COLD AUSTIN**: Austin Martin went 2-for-4 last night and is now hitting .326 (31-for-95) with seven doubles, 16 walks, just 17 strikeouts, a .429 on-base percentage and an .829 OPS in his last 28 games, dating back to August 26...since that date, he ranks fourth in the AL (7th in baseball) in on-base percentage and tied for 10th in walks.

MORE THAN ABEL: Minor League Baseball last night announced the league awards and All-Star teams for the two leagues that make up the Triple-A classification in Major League Baseball's player development system...Mick Abel was named International League Pitcher of the Year and an International League All-Star, after combining to go 7-2, 2.20 ERA (98.1 IP, 24 ER) with 40 walks, 114 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP in 18 starts between Triple-A Lehigh Valley and St. Paul.

GUARDING CLEVELAND: Last pitched on September 21 vs. Cleveland, opposite Joe Cantillo, where he did GUARDING CLEVELAND: Last pitched on September 21 vs. Cleveland, opposite Joe Cantillo, where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-2 victory...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...both runs allowed came in the first inning; permitted a leadoff homer to Steven Kwan and a sacrifice fly to Bo Naylor... Over his last seven games at Target Field, he has allowed just a .187 opponent batting average.

This leadoff homer run to Steven Kwan marked the second of his career...the first was also to Steven Kwan on August 10, 2024 vs. Cleveland at Target Field...three of his five career first inning homers have been against the Guardians.

Has fanned 27 batters so far this month, his most strikeouts in a single month in his career.

A BITE OUT OF THE BIG APPLE: Last pitched on September 15 vs. New York-AL, opposite Carlos Rodón, where he earned his seventh win of the season in Minnesota's 7-0, shutout victory...extended his single-season career-high as well as extended his career-high win-streak to five-straight decisions (dating back to June 26)...allowed just two hits with three walks and a career-high 11 strikeouts in 6.0 shutout innings...was his second quality start of the season and ninth of his career...surpassed 100.0 career innings pitched.

© Is the fourth Twins pitcher (5th time) to record double-digit strikeouts in a game this season (Joe Ryan x2, Pablo López and Chris Paddack).

© Picked off José Caballero in the fourth, his second pickoff this season and third of his career...is the first Twins pitcher to record a pickoff in back-to-back starts since Matt Shoemaker did so from April 25-May 1, 2021.

© Marked his 27th new opponent faced...excluding the Twins, Simeon has now faced every major league team except the Colorado Rockies and the St. Louis Cardinals...he is 8-5 when facing opponents for the first time and 4-2 when facing new opponents at home.

FIGHTING THE PHILS: Woods Richardson's lone starts against Philadelphia came on July 23, 2024 where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 0-3, shutout defeat...allowed three hits wit one walk and five strikeouts in 6.0 scoreless innings of work...recorded his first career pickoff in the sixth inning, 
◆ SWR is 4-5 in 17 career games (15 starts) against Interleague opponents...has posted a 4.60 ERA (76.1 IP, 39 ER), with 35 walks, 63 strikeouts and a .266 (78-for-293) opponent batting average.

OUR NECK OF THE WOODS: In his career, Sim has gone 6-4 with a 3.91 ERA (129.0 IP, 56 ER), 8.79 K/9, 3.49 BB/9 and 1.05 HR/9 in 26 games (25 starts) at home compared to 6-6 with a 4.74 ERA (119.2 IP, 63 ER), 7.30 K/9, 3.69 BB/9 and 1.50 HR/9 in 26 road games (25 starts).

◆ He is 2-2 in 10 games (9 starts) on the road so far this season, posting a 5.89 ERA (44.1 IP, 29 ER) with 24 walks, 39 strikeouts and a .266 (45-for-169) opponent batting average.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 22 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .238/.321/.394 in 193 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .238/.316/.427 in 206 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 88.1 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 36.2 compared to righties' 91.8 mph and 47.7 percent.

◆ Has whiff rate of 23.2 percent (lefties, 19.1 percent; righties, 26.6 percent)...compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

MAKE MY DAY: In 24 career day games (23 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 3.62 ERA and a .235 opponent batting average, .295 slugging percentage, 16 home runs, 40 walks and 111 strikeouts; compared to a 4.94 ERA, .251 opponent batting average, .333 slugging percentage with 19 home runs, 59 walks and 112 strikeouts in 28 night games (27 starts).
