YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles dropped the series to the Rays with a 2-0 loss...Baltimore failed to record an extra-base hit, snapping a streak of 32 straight games with at least one...Corbin Burnes was charged with two runs in 6.0 innings...Gunnar Henderson had three hits and Cedric Mullins added two, providing all the offense for the 0's. ding all the offense for the O's.

Mullins recorded his 600<sup>th</sup> career hit with his ninth-inning single.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The 0's have lost three of the last four games while scoring just six runs in that time after winning four of five games from August 30 to September 3...The Orioles trail the Yankees (.573, 82-61) by a half game in the AL East...Baltimore is 24-24 (.500) since the All-Star break and 29-31 (.483) in the last 60 games since July 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 183-123 (.598), the second-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.610, 186-119) during that time.

Os An AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since Boston in 2017

93-69); the Red Sox also won the division in 2016 with that same record, as did Toronto in 2015.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 211 home runs behind the Yankees (213)...The Dodgers rank third with 195...The 0's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and for the first time since 2019 (213)...Baltimore is averaging 1.47 homers per game this season, which would be the third-best mark in team history behind 1996 (1.58) and 2016 (1.56).

② Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: Anthony Santander (39), Gunnar Henderson (36), Colton Cowser (20), Adley Rutschman and Jordan Westburg (18), Cedric Mullins (15), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (13), and Ramón Urías (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

③ Henderson and Santander are one of three duos with at least 30 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (51) and Juan Soto (38) and New York-NL's Pete Alonso (31) and Francisco Lindor (30); Baltimore did not have a player reach 30 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2021 that the team has had multiple players with 30+ home runs (Mountcastle, 33 & Mullins, 30).

③ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and tied with the Phillies for the most in MLB; Gunnar Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one year by an Oriole behind Brady Anderson, who hit all 12 in 1996; Colton Cowser (2) and Jordan Westburg (1) have the other three for the 0's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson is slashing .295/.375/.585 (122-for-414) with 20 doubles, five triples, 30 home runs, 83 runs scored, and 66 RBI in 103 games, all starts, as the leadoff hitter this season... He's the second player in Orioles history to hit at least 30 homers from the leadoff spot, trailing Brady Anderson (35) in 1996...His .980 OPS batting first is the third-best mark in MLB this season behind Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (.994) and Oakland's Lawrence Butler (.985)...Henderson is also batting .319/.379/.702 (30-for-94) with six doubles and 10 home runs when leading off the game...His 1.081 OPS to begin a game is the best such mark in MLB this year and the second-best such OPS by an Oriole in team history, behind Anderson (1.256) in 1996 (min. 55 GS).

② He hit his 35th home run of the season on September 4 vs. Chicago-AL, surpassing Cal Ripken, Jr. (1991) and Miguel Tejada (2004) for the most by an O's shortstop in a single season.

③ Henderson ranks fourth in the AL and MLB with 7.3 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. in 1991 (10.6); eight previous Orioles (13 occurences) have finished a season with at least 7.0 fWAR in a season.

④ His 108 runs scored are the most by an Oriole since Jonathan Villar (111) in 2019 and rank fourth in the AL and fifth in MLB; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with Manny Machado (2, 2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

He's also among AL leaders in walks (3<sup>rd</sup>, 70), home runs (4<sup>th</sup>, 36), total bases (4<sup>th</sup>, 304), hits (6<sup>th</sup>, 159), extra-base hits (1-6<sup>th</sup>, 67), on-base percentage (7<sup>th</sup>, .367), OPS (7<sup>th</sup>, .907), and slugging percentage (8<sup>th</sup>, .540). He's on pace to score 121 times; **Roberto Alomar** (132 in 1996), **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander leads MLB switch-hitters with a career-high 39 home runs, the most by an 0's switch-hitter in team history...Ken Singleton held the previous record when he hit 35 in 1979...The last MLB switch-hitter with 39 homers in a season was Cleveland's José Ramírez in 2018... Only seven switch-hitters (11 occurrences) in MLB history have hit at least 40 home runs in a season: New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2, 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4, 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

② Santander has hit 30 home runs since the start of June, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (32) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (31) for the most in MLB during that time; his 39 home runs rank third in MLB behind Judge (51) and Ohtani (46).

③ His 100 home runs since the start of 2022 are tied for the sixth most in MLB during that time and for tied for second most in the AL with Houston's Yordan Alvarez, behind only Judge (150).

﴿ He's the ninth player in 0's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining Manny Machado (3, 2015-17), Chris Davis (4, 2012-13, 15-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Rafael Palmeiro (4, 1995-98), Eddle Murray (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), Boog Powell (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), Frank Robinson (3, 1966-67, 69), and Jim Gentille (2, 1961-62).

③ Santander ranks 14<sup>th</sup> in team history with 150 home runs, one behind Chris Hoiles for 13<sup>th</sup>.

HOLY COWSER: Colton Cowser leads AL rookies and is second among MLB rookies with 20 home runs, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (23)...He's the 10<sup>th</sup> rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since Gunnar Henderson (28) last year...He also has 21 doubles, the ninth rookie in 0's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Cowser is second among AL rookies and ranks third among MLB rookies with 3.4 fWAR, trailing New York-AL's Austin Wells (3.5) and San Diego's Merrill (4.5)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 69), extra-base hits (2nd, 43), total bases (2nd, 191), doubles (T-2nd, 21), RBI (3nd, 62), slugging percentage (3nd, 436), OPS (4nd, 759), and hits (T-4nd, 106).

One Cowser is slashing .2757.3487.462 (50-for-182) with eight doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 36 runs, 28 RBI, 20 walks, and one hit-by-pitch in 48 games (47 GS) since the All-Star break.

His 10 Outs Above Average are more than all other 0's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; the next closest left fielders have four OAA.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore's penultimate road trip is a six-gamer that begins tonight with the first of three games in Boston...Following an off day on Thursday, the Orioles face Detroit for three games beginning Friday...Despite losing 13 of the last 23 road games, the Orioles are 40-29 (.580) away from Oriole Park, the third-best road record in MLB this season behind the Padres (.586, 41-29) and Yankees (.600, 45-30)...The Birds are 92-58 (.613) on the road since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road wings presented above. road winning percentage above .600 during that time.

HIGH SOX: The Orioles and Red Sox complete their season series with three games this week at Fenway Park...At 7-3, Baltimore has clinched the season series for a second straight year after going 7-6 against Boston in 2023...This marks the first time the 0's have won the season series with the Sox in back-to-back years since doing so in four straight from 2012-15...The 0's have finished with a winning percentage of at least .700 in a season against the Red Sox three times since 1954: 1960 (.727, 16-6), 2012 and 1970 (.722, 13-5).

(b) The Birds swept a three-game series in Boston from April 9-11, the 14th road series sweep of at least three games against the Red Sox by the Orioles team history (since 1954) and the first

at least three games against the Red Sox by the Orioles team history (since 1954) and the first since April 2-4, 2021 (3 G); the best winning percentage by the Orioles at Fenway Park in one year came in 1966 (.889. 8-1).

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is three wins away from 400 for his career, all with Baltimore... Four previous managers have won 400 games at the helm of the Orioles: **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (669), **Paul Richards** (517), and **Hank Bauer** (407).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 13th career start tonight against the Red Sox... Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk on August 20 before appearing in a game after Zach Eflin landed on the 15-day IL; marks his third stint with the Orioles this season; also served as the 27th man for the doubleheader against Toronto on July 29...Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his Major League debut this season and fourth Oriole overall, joining INF Jackson Holliday, C David Bañuelos, and INF/OF Connor Norby... Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL; is the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, joining Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...On June 12 vs. Atlanta, he became the 11th Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP); at 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23y, 249d) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, he became the second-youngest Oriole (24y, 144d) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martinez (24y, 81d) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nuñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Juar Rojas, and RHP Juan Nuñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jurge Lopez and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

LAST TIME OUT: Secured his second career win on September 3 vs. Chicago-AL after tossing a career-high 7.1 shutout innings on five hits and a career-high 10 strikeouts; exited with a runner on first, who was stranded...The 10 strikeouts are the most by an Orioles rookie since Kyle Bradish on September 22, 2022 vs. Houston (also 10)... Became the first Oriole to complete 7.1 innings since Corbin Burnes on July 25 at Miami (also 7.1 IP) and the first Orioles rookie to do so since Grayson Rodriguez on September 16, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay (8.0 IP)...Retired 15 of the first 17 batters faced... Threw 20 of 27 first-pitch strikes...Threw 98 pitches and a career-high 70 strikes.

**AGAINST THE RED SOX:** Slated to make his second career start against Boston... Was dealt the loss on August 17 at Oriole Park after allowing two runs on six hits with six strikeouts in 6.1 innings; left with a runner on first who later scored...Marked his second career quality start.

**AGAINST THE AL EAST:** Owns an 0-4 record with a 5.19 ERA (15 ER/26.0 IP) in five career appearances against the AL East...Made his MLB debut on June 6 at Toronto, taking the loss after allowing six runs on five hits (1 HR) and four walks with two strikeouts in 5.1 innings...AL East foes are slashing .242/.358/.364 (24-for-99) off Povich.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Is 0-3 with a 12.56 ERA (20 ER/14.1 IP) with three homers in four road starts compared to 2-4 with a 3.60 ERA (18 ER/45.0 IP) and six home runs allowed in eight starts at Oriole Park.

**NIGHT OWL:** Making his 10<sup>th</sup> career night start...Has gone 2-4 with a 3.88 ERA (21 ER/48.2 IP) in his nine prior night outings compared to 0-3 with a 14.34 ERA (17 ER/10.2 IP) in three afternoon starts...His two career MLB wins came in night starts (6/29 vs. TEX, 9/3 vs. CWS).

**HIGH TIDE:** Has gone 6-1 with a 3.48 ERA (30 ER/77.2 IP), a 1.11 WHIP, and 89 strikeouts against 27 walks across 15 outings (14 GS) for the Tides this year...When Povich was first promoted, he ranked among International League leaders in strikeouts ( $2^{nd}$ ), opponent average ( $3^{rd}$ , .203), ERA ( $4^{th}$ ), WHIP ( $4^{th}$ , 1.11), and wins (T- $4^{th}$ ); only trailed teammate RHP Chayce McDermott (82) in strikeouts...At the time, his 75 strikeouts were tied for fifth among all minor league pitchers.

**FOREVER YOUNG:** At 24 years, 150 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the fourth-youngest player overall behind Gunnar Henderson (23y, 72d), Coby Mayo (22y, 236d), and Jackson Holliday (20y, 280d).

**FLOWERS, NOT SHOWERS:** Named the International League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and a league-best 40 strikeouts in five starts... Also named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month after leading 0's minor leaguers (min. 20 IP) in ERA, WHIP, and strikeouts... Named International League Pitcher of the Week for April 1-7 after going 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP), three hits, three walks, and 14 strikeouts in two starts at Charlotte during the week.
