TODAY'S GAME: Down 0-2 in the series, the Giants look to climb back into the series with a win this evening before tomorrow afternoon's series finale...SF has been outscored 24-5 through the first two games of this four-game series.

- ▶ The Giants enter today having lost seven of their last eight, eight of their last 11 and 14 of their last 19 dating to May 13...since May 13, the Giants 5-14 record is tied for worst in the National League with the Chicago Cubs (who the Giants visit after this series).
- ▶ The Giants enter today with the worst record in the National League at 23-38 (.377), half a game behind the Colorado Rockies at 24-38...the .377 win % is tied for the second-lowest in the Majors with Kansas City, just ahead of the Angels (23-39, .371).
- ▶ SF is also 15 games under .500 for the first time this season and for the first time since they were 16 games under following a loss on the season's final day in 2018 (73-89).

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to today's game, **LHP Matt Gage** was placed on the 15-day injured list (retro to June 2) with right knee inflammation...**RHP Dylan Smith** (#66) has been recalled from Triple-A Sacramento to take Gage's spot in the bullpen.

READ IT ON THE WORLD WIDE WEBB: **RHP Logan Webb** takes the ball for a second time since coming off the IL last Friday and for the 10th time overall in 2026...SF's Opening Day starter is searching for his first win since April 17 at Washington.

- ▶ Webb came off the IL last Friday after missing time with right knee bursitis that had been bothering him for some time...in that start in Colorado last Friday, Webb allowed a run on three hits in 4.1 innings while striking out five and walking three in SF's 8-6 loss.
- ▶ He got his pitch count up to 86 in the outing after throwing 62 pitches in his lone rehab start for Triple-A Sacramento a week earlier.
- ▶ Against Milwaukee in his career, Webb has been superb with a 4-0 record to go with a 2.08 ERA (10er, 43.1ip) across seven starts...the Giants are 6-1 as a team in Webb's seven career outings against the Brewers...in two starts against them last season he was 2-0 with a 0.73 ERA (1er, 12.1ip) and 11 strikeouts.

DON'T STOP ME NOW: **OF Jung Hoo Lee** has hit safely in 10 straight games entering play today, going 18-37 (.486) with two doubles, a triple, a homer, six RBI and eight runs...the 10-game streak is one shy of his career-best 11-game hit streak from April 7-20, 2024.

- ▶ The 27-year-old extended the streak yesterday with a pinch-hit single...the 10-game hit streak is the longest by any Giants player this season...Lee's 10-game streak is the only active double-digit hit streak in the Majors entering play today.
- ▶ Lee hasn't struck out in 11 straight games and his last 44 plate appearances, the longest active such streak in MLB just ahead of CHC's Nico Hoerner (27 PA).

PUT IT ON THE BOARD: **IF Willy Adames** homered as part of a 2-for-3 day yesterday...the homer was his 64th career homer at American Family Field after playing for Milwaukee from 2021-2024...three of the 64 homers have come as a Giant.

- ▶ The 64 homers are tied with Richie Sexon for seventh-most in the ballpark's history.
- ▶ Over Adames' last 24 games dating to May 8 he's slashing .320/.362/.588 (.950 OPS) with six doubles, a triple, six homers, 18 RBI and 16 runs scored...Adames' .950 OPS in that time is best among primary shortstops in the Majors (min. 75 PA)...SF, however has gone 9-15 in those 24 games.

ELDER STATESMAN?: **IF Bryce Eldridge** delivered a pinch-hit RBI single last night and has gone 14-for-39 (.359) in his last 12 games dating to May 18...eight of the 14 hits (seven doubles, one homer) have gone for extra bases while he's also scored eight runs and walked five times.

- ▶ During this stretch Eldridge has a 58% hard-hit rate (which is also his hard-hit rate for the year), an 11% walk rate and a 20% strikeout rate...his 58.7 hard hit rate for the season would be tied for second-best in the Majors with CWS Munetaka Murakami if he had enough at-bats to qualify...PIT's Oneil Cruz leads the Majors with a 59.9% hard hit rate.

CHECK THE STARTER...: Only once in SF's last 12 games have they had a starter record an out in the 6th inning of a game (it was **RHP Trevor McDonald** back on May 27 vs. Arizona when he pitched 6.1 innings)...since that date (May 20), SF's starters have averaged 4.2 innings/game (tied for 22nd of 30 teams) while the team overall is 3-9 in that time.

- ▶ After posting a 4.40 ERA through April, Giants starters have a 5.55 ERA since May 1...that figure is second-lowest in the Majors ahead of only the Rockies (7.09).

THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

JUNE 3, 2006

In a long day at Shea Stadium, rookie catcher **Eliezer Alfonzo** hit a two-run home run for his first Major League hit. His homer helped the Giants to a 6-4 victory over the New York Mets in the first game of a doubleheader, which ended after 3 hours and 12 minutes. In the second game, already delayed two and a half hours due to rain, the Mets won 3-2 in extra innings. Lastings Milledge scored the winning run in the bottom of the 11th on a short sacrifice fly by Chris Woodward. The twin bill ended close to 11 p.m. ET.

GOLD GLOVE: 2025 | ALL-STAR: 2024, 2025

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023... the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision on Friday at Coors Field in SF's 8-6 defeat to the Rockies...worked 4.1 innings with one run on three hits with three walks and five strikeouts...the outing marked his first start since returning from the 15-day injured list with right knee bursitis...Webb had missed 20 games with the injury.

VS. MILWAUKEE: Will face the Brewers for the eighth time in his career...Webb is a perfect 4-0 with a 2.08 ERA (10er, 43.1ip), .195 BAA, 0.99 WHIP and 50 strikeouts in the seven starts...in his two starts vs. Milwaukee last season, Webb allowed just one run over 12.1 innings (0.73 ERA) with 11 strikeouts, earning the win in each of the two starts...overall, the Giants as a team are 6-1 in his seven starts vs. MIL.

TOUGH LUCK: SF is 2-7 in his nine starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago (they were 16-17 in his 33 starts in '24)...since 2022, SF as a team is 69-72 in Webb's 141 starts, yet his 3.31 ERA in that time is sixth-best in MLB among starters who have made at least 100 starts.

COMPARE AND CONTRAST: Looking at Webb's pitch mix through nine starts compared to his 34 starts year a season ago, you see that most things are relatively the same except for Webb's whiff rate on his sweeper (21.3%) and four-seamer (22.4%)...the sweeper a season ago had a 29.0% whiff rate while his four-seam had a 33.6% whiff rate.

WORKHORSE: Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 872.1 innings...the next closest pitcher is Framber Valdez, who has logged 835.1 innings...Webb's 90 quality starts since 2022 are tied for most in MLB over that span with Valdez...lastly, his 141 starts in that span are tied with Dylan Cease for most in MLB.

HARD COPY: Through nine starts, Webb's 47.5% hard hit rate ranks in the bottom 8% of MLB...the figure is over 7% higher than it was a season ago (40.2%) and it would be the highest of his career (had a 46.2% hard hit rate in 2024).

SWEEP IT UNDER: As noted, Webb's sweeper has its effectiveness fall this season...in 2025, the sweeper had an opponent batting average of .286 (52x182), a whiff rate of 29.0% and a .317 wOBA...in 2026, opponents have a batting average of .318 (7x22), a 21.3% whiff rate and a .370 wOBA.

ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

- ▶ Took a loss his last time out at Colorado after allowing four earned runs on eight hits over 3.2 innings...it was his shortest start since Aug. 27, 2023 vs. SD (2.0ip).
- ▶ Will face his former team for the first time in his career... Houser owns 12-16 record and a 3.61 ERA in 66 games (48 starts) at American Family Field, the stadium he's pitched the most at.
- ▶ Went 2-2 with a 3.81 ERA (11er, 26.0ip) in 5 starts in May.

Last Game: 6/2 at MIL; 1.0ip, 5h, 4r, 4er, bb, k (42 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Sunday (second stint with SF)...has surrendered six runs in 2.0ip in two games since his recall and has a 10.80 ERA in four appearances (5.0ip) for SF so far.
- ▶ Had gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...x` recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25... left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinkers, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/31 at COL; 1.2ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Has tossed 8.2 scoreless innings over his last four outings...has a 0.73 ERA (1er, 12.1ip) in his last seven games.
- ▶ Has a 0.61 ERA (1er, 14.2ip) in 11 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 11 of 20 contests (4.5 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .194 (6-for-31) off his slider, .222 (10-for-45) off his sinker and .267 (4-for-15) off his changeup.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 6/2 at MIL; 0.1ip, r, er, 2bb (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has made nine appearances with SF, logging 8.0 innings and allowing two runs on four hits with 10 walks and nine strikeouts.
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-14 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 6/2 at MIL; 0.2ip, h, bb (20 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May...had allowed one run in 14.0 innings in 13 March/April games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 10-for-54 (.185) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 8-for-41 (.195) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 6/2 at MIL; 1.0ip, h, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 13 walks in his 17.1ip (6.75 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 62.1 innings pitched dating back to August, 2024.
- ▶ Right-handers are 5-for-30 (.167) off him while left-handers are 6-for-32 (.188).
- ▶ Holding opponents 1-for-22 off his slider and 5-for-32 (.156) off his sinker.

#71 WILKIN RAMOS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, 4-Seam FB, Curveball

Last Game: 6/1 at MIL; 2.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2bb (40 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A Sacramento on Monday and made his MLB debut that night...struck out Christian Yelich in the 6th inning for his first career strikeout.
- ▶ Was 3-1 with a 2.00 ERA (6er, 27.0ip), 27 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP in 17 games with Sacramento...had a 1.42 ERA (2er, 12.2ip) in May.
- ▶ Was an NRI with SF this spring after signing an MiLB contract with the Giants in February of this year.
- ▶ This marks his ninth season in professional baseball, pitching for four organizations (OAK, PIT, NYM and SF), 10 different Minor League teams and totaling 205 MiLB games before being promoted to MLB for the first time on Monday.

#66 DYLAN SMITH ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sweeper, Splitter, Sinker

Last Game: 5/31 at RNO (AAA); 2.0ip, 2h, r, er, 2k (31 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento earlier today, his second recall of the season...made one appearance for SF on May 10 vs. PIT, throwing 0.2 scoreless innings with a walk.
- ▶ Had a 3.98 ERA (9er, 20.1ip) .205 BAA and 23 strikeouts in 15 games with the River Cats.
- ▶ Acquired from Detroit on March 30 in exchange for cash.
- ▶ Drafted by Detroit on the third round in 2021 out of the University of Alabama...had spent the past five seasons in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut with Detroit last season...in seven games at the Major League level last year, the righty went 1-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2er, 13.0ip), four strikeouts, a 0.85 WHIP and .150 BAA.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/29 at COL; 1.1ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, hr (18 pitches)

- ▶ Leads SF with 11 holds, which is tied for the fifth-most in MLB.
- ▶ 19 of his 25 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 15-for-88 (.170) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 6-for-47 (.128) with 17 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 85.6 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 7% of the league while his 26.9% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 3%.

- ▶ Has six homers in his last 14 games dating to May 18...had just three home runs in 46 games prior.
- ▶ Hit his sixth career grand slam and first as a Giant on Sunday.
