TODAY'S GAME: Following an off day in Florida, the Giants kick off their first of six games in the Sunshine State with today's series opener in St. Petersburg...following this three-game series, SF will head southeast to Miami, taking on the Marlins for three games.

- ▶ After taking two of three vs. San Diego for their first series win of 2024, SF wrapped up its .500 homestand on Wednesday with a win to salvage the series against the Nationals...the victory snapped a six-game losing streak to Washington (dating to May 10 of last year).

SMALL BALL: The Giants have totaled 22 hits over their last two games with a 10-hit performance on Tuesday night, followed by a 12-hit matinee on Wednesday...of those 22 hits, however, only two have gone for extra-bases, with both coming on Wednesday (double by **IF/OF Tyler Fitzgerald** and triple by **IF Nick Ahmed**).

- ▶ The Giants have gone three straight games with 10 or more hits and two or fewer extra-base hits just six times since 1958, with their lone instance over the past 40 seasons coming June 17-19, 2013 (2-1 in those games).

HOME ROAD SPLITS: After homering in each of the seven games to start the season, the Giants did not homer over the six-game homestand, which is the longest homerless streak in MLB this season.

- ▶ The franchise's last homerless streak of six games was September 10-16, 2018...SF's last six-game homerless streak in the month of April was April 8-13, 2009.
- ▶ Even with the current homer drought at home, the Giants' seven-game homer streak on the road to start the season is the second longest in franchise history, trailing the 10-game road streak to open the 1962 season (*Stats, LLC*).

STEALING THE SHOW: After the Giants went without a steal in 12 straight games to open the season, **IF/OF Tyler Fitzgerald** (twice) and **IF Matt Chapman** (once) stole the team's first three bases of 2024 on Wednesday...they join the 1984 Milwaukee Brewers as the only other team since 1901 to start the season with zero steals over their first 12 games before ending the drought with a three-steal game (*Stats, LLC*).

RISP-Y BUSINESS: The Giants broke out of their offensive funk on Wednesday, snapping their nine-game streak of scoring four runs or fewer.

- ▶ SF went 6-for-8 with runners in scoring position on Wednesday, matching its total of hits with RISP over its previous nine games (March 31-April 9).
- ▶ The Giants also logged six two-out RBI after entering the game with 13 two-out RBI in their first 12 games.
- ▶ SF has trailed at some point in a game in nine straight contests.

IT'S WINNSDAY: **RHP Keaton Winn** will start his third game of 2024...With the rookie drawing today's start, SF will extend its large lead over the rest of MLB with 52.0 innings pitched by rookies this season (next closest is CHC with 34.0 innings).

- ▶ Winn has thrown his splitter 68 times this season (40.2%) according to *Baseball Savant*...Tampa Bay is 0-for-17 against splitters this season with a 35.3% strikeout rate...dating back to 2023, Tampa Bay has a .132 batting average against splitters, which ranks tied for lowest in MLB, and a .437 OPS, which ranks 29th.
- ▶ Winn has thrown at least 4.0 innings while allowing four or fewer hits and two or fewer walks through his first three career road starts, which is the longest such streak by a Giants pitcher to begin their career since 1901 (*Stats, LLC*).

JUNG OF ALL TRADES: **OF Jung Hoo Lee** reached base safely in five of his nine plate appearances vs. Washington (4-for-8 with a double, run scored and one walk).

- ▶ Lee hasn't struck out in his last 26 plate appearances...his 26 consecutive PA's without a strikeout is currently the third-longest such streak in MLB behind NYM's Francisco Lindor (31) and ARI's Joc Pederson (28).
- ▶ According to *Statcast*, Lee has seen 199 pitches so far this season...he's swung and missed at just five, with his last swing and miss coming in the 5th inning on April 2 at LAD.

BANG, BANG: **IF Matt Chapman** has 24 hard-hit balls (95+MPH), and **OF Jung Hoo Lee** has 22 according to *Statcast*, which is tied 2nd and 10th in MLB respectively.

WHAT DO YOU CALL THIS LAND...TAMPA?: This marks SF's fourth-ever trip to Tropicana Field, where SF is 5-4 all-time.

- ▶ The Giants last played at Tropicana Field June 17-19, 2016, sweeping a three-game series from the Rays...**RHP Jeff Samardzija**, **RHP Hunter Strickland** and **RHP Derek Law** picked up the wins in those three games.
- ▶ Not one member of SF's current 26-man roster was on the club when these teams last played in Tampa, however **LHP Blake Snell** was on TB's roster as a rookie...the current longest tenured Giant, **OF Austin Slater**, did not make his debut with SF until nearly a year later on June 2, 2017.

IT'S IOWA: The rookie made his first career Opening Day roster and is slated to face the Rays for the first time in his career...Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Iowa Western Community College and made his debut last season.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his second loss of the season on Saturday in SF's 4-0 defeat to the Padres...Winn gave up a two-out grand slam to Jurickson Profar in the 1st inning which accounted for all of the runs in the game...after surrendering the grand slam, however, the right-hander pitched 5.0 innings of no-hit baseball, including a seven-pitch 5th inning...his only baserunners for the remainder of the game were the two batters he walked.

SPRING TRAINING: Missed most of the spring while dealing with right elbow soreness...saw Cactus League action twice (one start) in late March and went 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA (2er, 5.2ip) and three strikeouts for SF.

2023 SEASON: After starting the year in Triple-A Sacramento, Winn made his Major League debut on June 13 at St. Louis in relief, firing 4.0 innings and picking up the save...he joined SF's rotation two weeks later and made five starts for the Giants, going 1-3 with a 6.04 ERA as a starter...overall, the right-hander posted a 1-3-1 record with a 4.68 ERA and 1.04 WHIP across nine MLB appearances.

SAVING THE DAY: After collecting the save in his Major League debut on June 13, 2023 at St. Louis, Winn became the third MLB pitcher since 1969 (when saves became an official stat) to pitch at least 4.0 innings and earn the save in his debut (*Elias*)...the other pitchers to achieve the feat were St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022) and Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977).

#58 NICK AVILA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/6 vs. SD; 2.0ip, h, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
- ▶ Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach...would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/7 vs. SD; SV, 1.0ip, h, 3k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first save of the season on Sunday, striking out the side and allowing one hit vs. San Diego.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only **Rod Beck** in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/10 vs. WSH; 1.0ip, 3k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last three outings, Miller struck out six hitters over 3.1 innings and held batters to just one hit in 11 at-bats (.091).
- ▶ Has appeared in six games for SF, allowing six runs in 6.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 4/9 vs. WSH; 0.2ip (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in five games for SF so far, allowing two runs over 4.2 innings of work.
- ▶ Averaged 15.95 SO/9 this spring after striking out 13 of 38 batters faced.
- ▶ Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- ▶ Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- ▶ His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).
- ▶ Allowed just four earned runs in 27 road games (23.1ip) last season...his 1.54 road ERA was seventh-lowest in the NL (min. 20.0ip).

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/9 vs. WSH; 1.1ip, 2h, r, er, k (27 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in six of SF's first 13 games, allowing three runs (two on HRs) in 5.1ip.
- ▶ Averaged just 5.64 pitches per inning this spring.
- ▶ Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- ▶ His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- ▶ Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ 45 of his 60 strikeouts last year came with his slider, with batters hitting .187 off the pitch.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (267g).

#65 LANDEN ROUPE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter

Last Game: 4/10 vs. WSH; 1.0ip (7 pitches)

- ▶ Made his MLB debut on March 29 and has appeared in six of the Giants' first 13 games.
- ▶ Roupp struck out 13 of the 29 batters he faced this spring (44.8%).
- ▶ Is the Giants No. 11 prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 14 according to *Baseball America*.
- ▶ Was selected by SF in the 12th round of the 2021 draft and appeared in his first big league camp this year.
- ▶ Roupp struck out 42 batters over 31.0 innings (12.2 K/9ip) with Double-A Richmond in 2023 and held opponents to a .206 average.
- ▶ His 1.74 ERA prior to hitting the IL last season ranked as the fourth-lowest in all Double-A (min. 30.0ip).
- ▶ Did not pitch after June 30 last year after landing on IL w/back inflammation.

#70 KAI-WEI TENG ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball, Changeup

Last Game: 4/8 vs. WSH; 3.1ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, HB, 2k (61 pitches)

- ▶ Made his Major League debut on March 31 at SD and tossed 3.0 innings with three runs allowed...became the 17th ever Taiwanese-born player in MLB history and the first in Giants history.
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A on March 29 and has appeared in two games for SF in a bulk innings role, allowing five runs in 6.1ip...has pitched at least 3.0 innings in both of the outings.
- ▶ Rated as No. 23 prospect in SF farm system according to *MLB.com*.
