RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game homestand against the Orioles (0-4) and Cubs (1-0, 2 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...last night, snapped a four-game skid and are 7-7 their last 14 games on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...are 7-13 in their last 20 contests after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 from May 3-18...the Rays are 1-4 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

- ★ Tampa Bay trailed, 2-1, entering the 9th inning, but plated four runs to secure the win...it marked the first time the Rays scored 4+ runs in the bottom of the ninth inning since July 22, 2018 vs. Miami (5R, trailed 4-1, won 6-4)...**Daniel Robertson** hit a walk-off grand slam in that game, the first and only walk-off grand slam in franchise history.
- ★ Tampa Bay has secured 15 wins when its opponents scores first, tied with New York-NL for the second-most such victories in the majors behind New York-AL (18)...the Rays have fallen behind first in each of their last five games.
- ★ The Rays have drawn 3+ walks in three straight games after drawing just one free pass in their previous two games...Tampa Bay is 23-15 this year when drawing 3+ walks compared to 9-20 with two walks or fewer.
- ★ The Rays 11-4 (.733) mark in Interleague play is second best in the majors behind the Phillies (10-2/.833)...they have won six straight games against NL opponents.

BIRTHDAY BOY—Aaron Civale takes the mound tonight on his 29th birthday...it marks the first time he will toe the slab on his birthday...in franchise history, four Tampa Bay starters have earned a win on their birthday: **Jeremy Hellickson** (April 8, 2012 vs. NYY), **Jason Hammel** (Sept. 2, 2007 ay NYY), **Jaе Weong Seo** (May 24, 2007 vs. SEA) and **Mark Hendrickson** (June 23, 2005 at NYY)...two starters in the majors this season have earned a victory on their birthday: **PIT Paul Skenes** (May 29 at DET-G2) and **PIT Martin Pérez** (April 4 at WSH).

THE DAWG DELIVERS—Last night, **Brandon Lowe** recorded his fifth career walk-off plate appearance, including his third career walk-off homer (Sept. 5, 2023 vs. BOS & April 21, 2023 vs. CWS)...his four walk-off plate appearances since the beginning of the 2023 season lead MLB...his three walk-off home runs are tied with **Carl Crawford** for third most in franchise history, trailing **Evan Longoria** (5HR) and **B.J. Upton** (4HR).
★ Lowe has 14 RBI in his last 13 games since May 26...it marks his most RBI in a 13-game span since Aug. 27-Sept. 10, 2023...his most career RBI in a 14-game span in a single season is 19 RBI (Aug. 7-21, 21, 2021).
★ His four games this season with 3+ RBI lead the club, ahead of **Jonny DeLuca** (3G).

THE CHAMP IS HERE—**Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely in a season-high 14 straight games, batting .278/.365/.352 (15-for-54) with 2 2B, 1 3B, 8 BB and 8 SO during the run...it marks his longest on-base streak since July 5-28, 2023 (also 14G)...his last 15-game on-base streak came during a career-high-tying 22 game stretch from April 27-May 28, 2023...he is one of three Rays to produce a 14+ game on-base streak this season, joining **Isaac Paredes** (18G, April 28-May 19) and **Amed Rosario** (14G, April 5-22).
★ Diaz has four straight multi-hit games for the first time since a career-best six-game streak from Aug. 16-23, 2023...the four-game run is tied with NYY **Aaron Judge** for the longest active streak in the majors.

CARDIAC KIDS—The Rays 18 comeback wins are tied with the Brewers for fourth most in MLB behind the Yankees (20) and Orioles/Phillies (both 19)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in seven of its last eight wins.
★ Tampa Bay's five walk-off victories are tied for the MLB lead with Baltimore, Miami and New York-NL.
★ The Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after sixth (T1st, 8), seventh (1st, 7) and eighth (T1st, 4) frames.
★ Each of Tampa Bay's six wins from May 18-June 4 came in come-from-behind fashion, their longest streak since May 8-18, 2013 (8G), per Elias.

HOT AND COLD—**Isaac Paredes'** .352 (19-for-54) batting average in Interleague play is fifth highest in the majors (min. 50AB) behind NYY **Aaron Judge** (.394), MIL **Brice Turang** (.358), COL **Elias Diaz** (.356) and HOU **Kyle Tucker** (.353)...he has eight multi-hit efforts in 14 games against NL foes this year, adding three doubles, two home runs and 12 RBI.

- ★ **Amed Rosario** is a career .363 (33-for-91) hitter with 4 2B and 10 RBI in 24 games against the Cubs...min. 50 AB, only ATL **Ozzie Albies** (.391) owns a higher mark among active players.
- ★ **Jose Siri** is 0-for-11 with 8 SO over his last three games after going 13-for-48 (.271) with 3 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 5 BB and 14 SO in his previous 15 games.
- ★ **Josh Lowe** is in the midst of an 0-for-13 skid with 6 SO during that period.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES—Tampa Bay pitching has posted a .253 opp. average with two outs, the third-highest mark in the majors, ahead of only Colorado (.276) and Chicago-AL (.265)...Rays starters have allowed opponents to hit .268 with two outs, third highest among MLB rotations, ahead of Colorado (.279) and Los Angeles-AL (.275)...Tampa Bay relievers have posted a .234 opp. average with two outs, the seventh-highest clip in the majors.
★ Seven of Chicago's 10 hits last night came with two outs.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have allowed an MLB-high 89 HR, ahead of the White Sox (88HR) and Blue Jays (87HR)...the 89 HR are tied with the 2007 club for the second-most long balls allowed through 67 games in franchise history, ahead of only the 2000 Devil Rays (99HR).
★ Tampa Bay has the fewest home runs hit (51) in the majors, with the next closest teams being Miami and Washington (both 52HR)...the Rays have one multi-homer performance over their last 24 games dating to May 15 (3HR, May 30 vs. OAK).

TIME FOR A TURNAROUND—The bottom third of Tampa Bay's lineup has produced a .203 AVG, tied with Miami for the third-lowest clip in MLB, ahead of Oakland (.195) and Chicago-AL (.198)...the Rays seven-, eight- and nine-hole hitters have a combined 250 SO times, the most in the majors, with the next closest team being the Pirates (239SO).

NORTH SIDERS IN ST. PETE—Tampa Bay and Chicago continue a three-game set tonight at Tropicana Field...the Cubs took two of three from the Rays last season at Wrigley Field from May 29-31...each game was decided by one run...RHP **Marcus Stroman** tossed a complete game, one-hit shutout in the series opener...the Cubs took the first two games and the Rays needed a two-run rally in the 8th inning of the series finale to avoid the sweep.
★ Tonight's contest marks only the 21st game between the two franchises, with Tampa Bay holding a 12-8 edge in the all-time series...the Cubs have played just two series at Tropicana Field: a two-game set from Sept. 19-20, 2017 and a three-game series from June 17-19, 2008.
★ Tampa Bay's 20 games played vs. Chicago are tied with Los Angeles-NL for its fewest against any opponent, with the next closest being (Cincinnati/Pittsburgh/San Francisco (all 21G).

CONNECTIONS

- ★ Chicago RHP **Jameson Taillon** is a Central Florida native, hailing from Winter Haven...reliever RHP **Mark Leiter Jr.** was born in Fort Lauderdale.
- ★ Rays RHP **Jason Adam** made 25 appearances for the Cubs across two seasons (2020-21), going 3-1 with a 4.44 ERA (24.1IP, 12ER).
- ★ After showcasing a 90+mph fastball in a U-15 World Baseball Cup matchup between Mexico and the United States in 2014, Tampa Bay 3B **Isaac Paredes** drew the interest of scouts and was ultimately signed by the Cubs for \$850,000 in July of 2015.
- ★ Cubs LHP **Drew Smyly** started 49 games for the Rays between 2014-16, pitching to a 3.95 ERA, before being traded to the Mariners for a package that featured LHP **Ryan Yarbrough**.
- ★ Triple-A Durham LHP **Tyler Alexander** was born in Chicago...Bulls RHP **Manuel Rodriguez** went 5-3 with a 4.88 ERA (31.1IP, 17ER) and five saves over 34 appearances with the Cubs from 2021-22.
- ★ The Devil Rays selected three Cubs in the 1997 Expansion Draft: 2B **Miguel Cairo** (1st round), LHP **Ramón Tatis** (2nd round) and 1B **Brooks Kieschnick** (3rd round).
- ★ Cubs 1B Coach **Mike Napoli** hails from Hollywood, FL and resides in Fort Lauderdale.
- ★ Double-A Montgomery Manager **Kevin Boles** was a 1998 Cubs draftee out of the University of South Florida.
- ★ The first game between two major league teams in St. Petersburg took place on March 27, 1914 as the Grapefruit League was established...the St. Louis Browns hosted the Chicago Cubs, who were training in Tampa and made the trip by steamboat across Tampa Bay...the Cubs won, 3-2, as James **Leslie (Hippo) Vaughn** was the winning pitcher for the Cubs.

TONIGHT'S START—Civale will take the ball for his club-leading 14th start of the season, including his eighth at Tropicana Field...is celebrating his 29th birthday today...has turned in a 4.11 ERA over his last three starts...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA—has a career-high four-decision losing streak...the Rays have lost each of his last six starts...has gone 4-8 with a 5.45 ERA (112.1IP, 68ER) in 23 starts since the Rays acquired him from the Guardians on July 31, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT—Took the loss on June 7 vs. BAL, yielding a season-high-tying 2 HR in a 6-3 Tampa Bay defeat (L, 5.0IP, 7H, 4ER, BB, 8SO, 2HR)...allowed two runs in the 2nd frame when an **Anthony Santander** homer preceded a **Ramón Urias** RBI-double...struck out the side in order in the 4th, but allowed a two-run homer to **Ryan Mountcastle** in the 5th...his 8 SO matched a season high (3x, last: April 16 vs. LAA)...threw a season-high 105 pitches, his most since a career-high 114 on May 19, 2021 at SEA.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP TAJ BRADLEY (1-4, 5.17)

LAST START—Limited the Orioles to one run over 5.0 frames of work, but received zero runs of support for the fourth time in six starts in a 5-0 Rays loss (L, 5.0IP, 3H, ER, BB, 7SO)...Bradley has been the starting pitcher in three of Tampa Bay's four shutout defeats.

vs. CUBS—In his first career start opposite Chicago last season, he was the tough-luck loser of a pitching duel with **RHP Marcus Stroman**, who tossed a one-hit shutout...Bradley did not allowed an earned run over 5.2 frames (L, 5.2IP, 1R, OER, BB, 8SO).

CIV vs. CUBS—Civale has not earned a decision in three career starts opposite the Cubs, all at Wrigley Field, despite posting a 1.62 ERA (16.2IP, 3ER) in those games...has allowed two runs or fewer in all three starts...marks his second-lowest ERA against any opponent in his career, trailing only the Reds (1.29)...started opposite Chicago on July 2, 2023 on the road, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball in an 8-6 Cleveland win (ND, 6.0IP, 13H, 3ER, 1BB, 2SO, 2HBP).

★ He is 2-0 with a 5.23 ERA (20.2IP, 12ER) in four Interleague starts since joining the Rays...excluding his May 3 outing vs. NYM (4.2IP, 7ER), he has a 2.81 ERA (16.0IP, 5ER) in the other three starts.

BIRTHDAY BASH—Civale is celebrating his 29th birthday today...this will mark the first time he has pitched on his birthday in his career...he is the second Ray to do so this season, joining **Zach Eflin** on April 8 at LAA...since the start of 2022, four Rays have started on their birthday: Eflin, **Drew Rasmussen** (July 27, 2022 at BAL), **Shane Baz** (June 17, 2022 at BAL) and **Corey Kluber** (April 10, 2022 vs. BAL)...they have pitched to a combined 3.10 ERA (20.1IP, 7ER), with Eflin allowing five of the seven runs...no other club has had more than two pitchers record birthday starts over that span.

★ He is the seventh pitcher in the majors to start on their birthday this season, first since **PIT Paul Skenes** on May 29 (G2) at DET...the Rays will join the Pirates (Skenes/**Martin Pérez**) as the only clubs having multiple pitchers start on their birthday this season.

★ This marks the third time the Rays have had multiple pitchers start on their birthday in a season, joining 2022 (3) and 2007 (2: **Jason Hammel**, **Jae Weong Seo**)...Civale will become the 14th pitcher (16th instance) to start on his birthday in franchise history.

UPS AND DOWNS—Over his last three starts, Civale has posted a 4.11 ERA (15.1IP, 7ER) while limiting opponents to a 1-for-10 (.100) clip with RISP...this, following a six-start stretch from April 21-May 19 in which he went 0-3 with an 8.48 ERA (28.2IP, 27ER) and .462 (12-for-26) opp. RISP average...in his first four starts to open the season, he went 2-1 with a 2.74 ERA.

★ He has tossed 5.0+ IP in each of his last five starts after failing to do so in each of his previous four from April 21-May 8, the longest streak of his career.

★ The Rays have lost each of his last six starts, the longest team losing streak in a pitcher's starts since **Taj Bradley** (6) from June 27-July 29, 2023...the last longer streak belongs to **Ryan Yarbrough** (7, May 8-July 28, 2022).
