RAY REPORT-The Rays continue a seven-game homestand against the Orioles ( $0-4$ ) and Cubs (1-0, 2 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...last night, snapped a four-game skid and 19-25...are 7-13 in their last 20 conteests of a season-high six-game losing streak from May May 3 -18...the Rays are 1-4 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26. Tampa Bay trailed, 2-1, entering the 9th inning, but plated four runs to secure the win it marked the first time the Rays scored $4+$ runs in the bottom of the ninth inning since July 22, 2018 vs. Miami (5R, trailed 4-1, won 6-4)...Daniel Robertson hit a walk-off grand slam in that game, the first and only walk-off grand slam in franchise history
Tampa Bay has secured 15 wins when its opponents scores first, tied with New York-NL for the second-most such victories in the majors behind New York-AL (18)...the Rays have fallen behind first in each of their last five games.

The Rays have drawn 3+ walks in three straight games after drawing just one free pass in their previous two games. Tampa Bay is $23-15$ this year when drawing $3+$ walks compared to $9-20$ with two walks or fewer.
The Rays 11-4 (.733) mark in Interleague play is second best in the majors behind the Phillies (10-2/.833)...they have won six straight games against NL opponents.

BIRTHDAY BOY-Aaron Civale takes the mound tonight on his 29th birthday...it marks the first time he will toe the slab on his birthday...in franchise history, four Tampa Bay starters have earned a win on their birthday: Jeremy Hellickson (April 8, 2012 vs. N Jason Hammel (Sept. 2, 2007 ay NYY), Jae Weong Seo (May 24, 2007 vs. SEA) and Mark Hendrickson (June 23,2005 at NYY)..two starters in the majors this season have earned a victory on their
Pérez (April 4 at WSH).

THE DAWG DELIVERS-Last night, Brandon Lowe recorded his fifth career walk-off plate appearance, including his third career walk-off homer (Sept. 5, 2023 vs. BOS \& April 21,2023 vs. CWS)... his four walk-off plate appearances since the beginning of the
2023 season lead MLB...his three walk-off home runs are tied with Carl Crawford for 2023 season lead MLB...his three walk-off home runs are tied with Carl Crawford
most in franchise history, trailing Evan Longoria (5HR) and B.J. Upton (4HR). game span since Aug. 27-Sept. 10, 2023... his most career RBI in a 14-game span in a single season is 19 RBI (Aug. 7-21, 21, 2021).
His four games this season with 3+ RBI lead the club, ahead of Jonny DeLuca (3G).
THE CHAMP IS HERE-Yandy Díaz has reached base safely in a season-high 14 straight games, batting . $278 / .365 / .352$ (15-for-54) with 2 2B, $13 \mathrm{~B}, 8$ BB and 8 SO during the run... on-base streak came during a career-high-tying 22 game stretch from April 27-May 28, 2023 ... he is one of three Rays to produce a $14+$ game on-base streak this season, joining Isaac Paredes (18G, April 28-May 19) and Amed Rosario (14G, April 5-22).

Díaz has four straight multi-hit games for the first time since a career-best sixgame streak from Aug. 16-23, 2023...the four-game run is tied with NYY Aaron Judge for the longest active streak in the majors.

CARDIAC KIDS-The Rays 18 comeback wins are tied with the Brewers for fourth most in MLB behind the Yankees (20) and Orioles/Phillies (both 19)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in seven of its last eight wins.

Tampa Bay's five walk-off victories are tied for the MLB lead with Baltimore, Miami and New York-NL.
The Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after sixth (T1st, 8), seventh (1st, 7) and eighth (T1st, 4) frames.
Each of Tampa Bay's six wins from May 18-June 4 came in come-from-behind fashion, their longest streak since May 8-18, 2013 (8G), per Elias.
HOT AND COLD-Isaac Paredes' 352 (19-for-54) batting average in Interleague play is fifth highest in the majors (min. 50 AB ) behind NYY Aaron Judge (.394), MIL Brice Turang (.358), COL Elias Díaz (.356) and HOU Kyle Tucker (.353)...he has eight multi-hit efforts in 14 games against NL foes this year, adding three doubles, two home runs and 12 RBI.

Amed Rosario is a career .363 (33-for-91) hitter with 42 B and 10 RBI in 24 games against the Cubs...min. 50 AB , only ATL Ozzie Albies (.391) owns a higher mark among active players.
Jose Siri is O-for-11 with 8 SO over his last three games after going 13-for-48 (.271) with 3 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 5 BB and 14 SO in his previous 15 games.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES-Tampa Bay pitching has posted a .253 opp. average with two outs, the third-highest mark in the majors, ahead of only Colorado (.276) and Chicago-AL (.265).. Rays starters have allowed opponents to hit 268 with two outs, third highest among MLB rotations, ahead of Colorado (.279) and Los Angeles-AL (275). Tampa Bay relievers posted a . 234 opp. average with two outs, the seventh-highest clip in the majors.

Seven of Chicago's 10 hits last night came with two outs.
HOMER (UN)HAPPY-The Rays have allowed an MLB-high 89 HR, ahead of the White Sox (88HR) and Blue Jays (87HR)...the 89 HR are tied with the 2007 club for the secondmost long balls allowed through 67 games in franchise history, ahead of only the 2000 Devil Rays (99HR).

Tampa Bay has the fewest home runs hit (51) in the majors, with the next closest performance over their last 24 games dating to May 15 (3HR, May 30 vs. OAK).

TIME FOR A TURNAROUND-The bottom third of Tampa Bay's lineup has produced a 203 AVG, tied with Miami for the third-lowest clip in MLB, ahead of Oakland (.195) and Chicago-AL (.198)...the Rays seven-, eight- and nine-hole hitters have a combined 250 SO times, the most in the majors, with the next closest team being the Pirates (239SO).
NORTH SIDERS IN ST. PETE-Tampa Bay and Chicago continue a three-game set tonight at Tropicana Field...the Cubs took two of three from the Rays last season at Wrigley Field from May 29-31...each game was decided by one run...RHP Marcus Stroman tossed a complete game, one-hit shutout in the series opener...the Cubs took the first two games and the Rays needed a two-run rally in the 8th inning of the series finale to avoid the sweep. Ionight's contest marks only the 21st game between the two franchises, with Tampa Bay holding a 12-8 edge in the all-time series...the Cubs have played just two series at Tropicana Field. a two game set from Sept. game series from June 17-19, 2008.
