THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

JULY 11

2021 - A 9th-inning, walkoff homer by **2B Jose Altuve** gives the Astros one of the most memorable, comeback wins in club history...trailing in the 9th to the visiting Yankees, 7-2, the Astros rally for six runs for an improbable 8-7 win...Altuve ends it with his walkoff, three-run homer as both clubs head into the All-Star Break.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros and Rangers will continue their rivalry tonight in Arlington, TX, with the middle game of their big three-game weekend series at Globe Life Field...**RHP Peter Lambert** (7-5), who's been the Astros most consistent starter this season, will get the start for Houston opposite **RHP Kumar Rocker** (2-7) and the Rangers.

RIDING THE LAMBO: Tonight's starter **RHP Peter Lambert**, who was a minor league free agent signing this offseason, has gone 5-1 with a 3.02 ERA (15ER/44.2IP) in his last eight starts dating back to May 24, which ties him for second in the AL in wins in that span...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 starts.

THE SILVER BOOT SERIES: The Astros are 5-3 vs. the Rangers thus far in the 2026 Silver Boot Series, which includes winning three of four in Arlington earlier this season from May 25-28...since the start of the 2017 season, the Astros have won or split nine straight season series against the Rangers, going 98-54 against the Rangers in that span.

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 26-19 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros are 16-11 on their last four road trips combined and are 22-17 on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the season...the Astros have won four of their last six road series dating back to May 22.

WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are 9-6 in one-run games and 21-11 in two-run games...nine of the Astros last 10 wins and 14 of their last 16 victories have come by two-or-fewer runs...the last time the Astros won a game by four-plus runs was on June 19 vs. CLE, in a 9-3 win.

TONIGHT'S TELECASTS: All games this series will be televised by Space City Home Network with **Kevin Eschenfelder**, **Geoff Blum** and **Lauren Calender** on the call...**Shelby Coppedge** and **Brian Bogusevic** will host the pre- and postgame shows.

DRAFT DAY 1: The first day of the MLB Draft (rounds 1-4) began earlier today with the Astros taking **OF Logan Hughes** out of Texas Tech with the 17th overall pick in the first round...following the Hughes selection, the Astros will make another five picks today, their PPI selection (#28), second round (#57), third round (#93), fourth round (#121) and compensation picks (#133).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros dropped a 7-3 game to the Rangers last night in the series opener in Arlington...**RHP Hunter Brown** (3ER/6IP) battled through shaky command to post a quality start despite tying his career high with five walks...**C Yainer Diaz** (1x3) blasted a two-run home run, while **DH Yordan Alvarez** (2x4) smacked his 30th homer of the season and the 200th of his career.

ASTROS AYA ALL-STARs: The Astros Youth Academy has its baseball and softball teams currently playing in tournaments in Philadelphia this weekend, with the boys participating in the Commissioner's Cup and the girls participating in the Jennie Finch Classic...both teams won their opening games yesterday, with the boys defeating Puerto Rico 8-2, and the girls downing the Rangers 3-1...these events are a part of Major League Baseball's baseball and softball development events taking place throughout the city of Philadelphia as part of this year's All-Star Week activities.

ALL-STAR ALVAREZ: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has been voted by the fans as the starting DH for the AL All-Star team...this marks the fourth All-Star selection for Alvarez (2022-24, 2026) and the second time that he has been voted as a starter (also in 2024).

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is a strong MVP candidate, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.038), OBP (.417), SLG (.621), and total bases (213)...additionally, he ranks first in the AL in HR (30), first in RBI (68), tied for first in XBH (46), second in hits (107), second in batting average (.312), tied for third in runs (63), and tied for fourth in walks (59).

THE LONG BALL LIST: **DH Yordan Alvarez** hit his 200th career homer last night becoming the sixth player in club history to reach the 200-homer mark.

SECOND HOME: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is hitting .421 (8x19) with six homers, nine RBI and three walks in five games at Globe Life Field this season...in just 35 career games at Globe Life Field, Alvarez ranks 12th all-time at the stadium in homers (18), just ahead of the Rangers **DH Joc Pederson** (16 HR in 95g) and **1B Jake Burger** (12 HR in 96g).

BEST IN TEXAS: **2B Jose Altuve** has 38 home runs and 101 RBI in his career vs. the Rangers, which are his most vs. any opponent...all-time in MLB history opposite the Rangers, Altuve ranks fifth in runs scored (144), seventh in homers (38), and eighth in hits (244)...all-time leaderboards vs. TEX below:

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader** is 3-0 with 10 saves (in 10 chances), has a 0.59 ERA (1ER/15.1IP), 25 strikeouts in 15.1 innings, a .061 (3x49) opponent average, and a 0.72 WHIP in 16 appearances...prior to allowing an infield hit in his last appearance on Tuesday at WSH (0ER/0.1IP), Hader had not allowed a hit in eight straight appearances (8IP).

TOMORROW'S FUTURES GAME: The Astros top two prospects, **OF Kevin Alvarez** and **IF Xavier Neyens**, will represent the club in the 2026 All-Star Futures Game, which will be played tomorrow in Philadelphia...both prospects, which currently play for Class A Fayetteville, are considered top 100 prospects per MiLB.com, with Alvarez ranking 69th overall and Neyens 87th overall.

LAST START, JULY 5 VS. TB: Allowed 3 hits and 1 walk with 6 strikeouts in 5.2 scoreless innings on Sunday vs. TB...marked his 3rd scoreless start of the season (also, 7.0 IP on May 5 vs. LAD and 6.0 IP on April 22 at CLE).

THE LAMBO: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has become a stabilizing force in the Astros rotation since making his season debut in mid-April...has recorded a quality start in 5 of his 14 outings, including 2 scoreless outings...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 6 of his 14 starts...among AL pitchers with 80.0+ innings pitched this season, Lambert ranks T-7th in H/9IP (6.75) and 7th in opponent batting average (.205)...began the year at Triple A Sugar Land before being added to the Major League roster on April 17.

STREAK SNAPPED: Had his career-long 4-game winning streak snapped on June 29 vs. MIN, spanning 6 starts from May 24-June 23...within the streak, he's posted a 2.97 ERA (11ER/33.1IP)...the streak ties as the longest by an Astro this season, also reached by **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (April 15-May 2).

HIGH FIVE: Has worked 5.0+ innings in 10 of his last 11 starts (since May 5) and 12 of his 14 starts this season...worked 5.0+ innings in a career-best 8 consecutive starts from May 5-June 17, surpassing a 6-game streak from Aug. 12-Sept. 10, 2023.

SLIDER COMBO: Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .186 average on the pitch (8x43)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO': Logged the best start of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros 2-1 victory.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...prior to this year, had appeared at the Major League level in 4 seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 Major League appearances with the Rockies, including 35 starts, he recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, **RHP Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/7 at WSH): Allowed 1 hit and struck out 1 in 1.0 scoreless inning on Tuesday night at WSH.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.61 ERA (6ER/20.2IP) with 22 strikeouts, a 1.16 WHIP and a .203 opponent batting average in his last 22 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (14-game streak).

VS. TEX: In 31 career regular-season appearances vs. the Rangers, he's posted a 3.90 ERA (14ER/32IP) and 10.30 SO/9IP...his 31 appearances vs. TEX since his 2019 debut season rank 2nd among all MLB pitchers, behind only former teammate RHP Ryan Pressly (39 apps.)...has posted a 1.28 ERA (2ER/14.1IP) in his 14 games vs. the Rangers since the beginning of the 2024 season...has held IF Josh Jung to 0x7 with 3 strikeouts and IF Jake Burger to 0x5 with 4 strikeouts in their career matchups.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has recorded 350 career relief appearances with the Astros...recorded his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history...now trails RHP Brad Lidge (377) for No. 4 on the list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (486) and 10th in IP (359.2).

CAREER: In 350 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.90 ERA (116ER/359.2IP) with 486 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.16 K/9 and a 0.80 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
