PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Major League Baseball yesterday announced **IF/OF Spencer Steer** as the National League Player of the Week for 4/1-4/7... Steer, in 6 games last week, batted .409 (9-for-22) with 3 HR, 1 3B, 1 2B, 9 RBI, 3 BB, .955 SLG, 1.455 OPS and 1 SB (stole home on 4/6 vs NYM)...he became just the third Reds player since 1957 to have a steal of home and a grand slam in the same week (Adam Dunn in 2004 & Vada Pinson in 1960)...it's Steer's first NL Player of the Week award.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 4-game set vs the defending National League Central Division champion Milwaukee Brewers, and Game 5 (2-2) of a 7-game homestand that included a 3-game series loss (1-2) to the Mets.
- Following this homestand the Reds will embark on a 6-day, 6-game road trip at **WSox** (4/12-4/14) & **Sea** (4/15-4/17).
- The Reds are coming off their first road trip of the season in which they won 2 of 3 games in **Philadelphia**.

SERIES NOTES: The Brewers have won each of the last 6 series, 7 of the last 8 series, and 10 of the last 12 series dating back to 2021.

- Last year from 7/9-7/16, Mil shut out Cin in 28 consecutive innings.
- The Reds are 11-28 (.282) vs Mil beginning 7/16/21.
- Beginning in 2018, the Brewers' .700 winning percentage (35-15) at Great American Ball Park is the best of any NL team in that span.

ELLYMANIA: In last night's 10-8 win vs Mil, **SS Elly De La Cruz** went 3-for-4 with 2 HR, 2 RBI, 4 runs scored, and a stolen base.

- His 4th inning single off **LHP Aaron Ashby** was his 100th career hit.
- His HR off **RHP JB Bukauskas** in the 5th inning traveled 450 feet.
- His inside-the-park HR off **LHP Bryan Hudson** in the 7th inning was the first of his career...he rounded the bases in 15.00 seconds.
- He's the third Reds batter ever (fourth occurrence) to homer in a game from both sides of the plate (**Javier Valentin** 7/17/05 vs Col; **Pete Rose** 8/2/67 vs Atl & 8/30/66 vs Stl) *courtesy Elias*.
- He's the first Reds batter ever to homer in a game from both sides of the plate with 1 of those HRs being an inside-the-park HR *courtesy Elias*.
- Was his second career multi-homer game (2hr, 9/26/23 at Cle).
- Became the first Reds batter to hit an inside-the-park HR as part of a multi-homer game since **Dan Driessen** did it on 5/31/82 at Phi.
- He's the first Reds player with at least 6 steals in the team's first 10 games of a season since **Billy Hamilton** had 8 in the first 10g in 2015.

INDESPENCEABLE: **LF Spencer Steer** on Sat (4/6) off NYM's **RHP Yohan Ramirez** belted a go-ahead 3-run homer in the eighth inning to propel the Reds to a 9-6 victory.

- It was **Steer's** second home run in as many days and his Major League leading third go-ahead homer of the season.
- It was Steer's second **go-ahead** HR after the seventh inning...he is the first Reds batter to hit multiple go-ahead HRs in the **eighth inning or later** within a **5-game stretch** since **Joey Votto** did it in 2015 (8/29 at Mil and 9/2 at Chc).
- Steer** is the first Reds batter to have as many as 3 HR and 9 RBI in a 5-game span since **C. Encarnacion-Strand** (4hr, 10rbi) last September.

STEERING COMMITTEE: **LF Spencer Steer's** 10th inning go-ahead grand slam on 4/1 off **RHP Connor Brogdon** led to the Reds' 6-3 win at Citizens Bank Park...it marked the first Reds grand slam in extra innings since **3b Todd Frazier's** GS in the 13th inning off Det's **RHP Joakim Soria** on 6/17/15 (8-4 win at GABP)...**Steer's** slam put him over 100 RBI for his career (101rbi/188g)...he's the sixth-fastest Red to reach that milestone since 1957.

- LHP Nick Lodolo** (15-day IL, left calf tenosynovitis) on Sun (4/7) for AAA-Louisville at Gwinnett made his second rehab app in the 8-2 loss... he started for the Bats, and allowed 4 runs (4er) on 5 hits over 2.2 innings (0bb, 2k, 64TP)...Lodolo began his rehab assignment on 3/31 (2g/2gs, 0-2, 5.87, 7.2ip, 7h, 5r/5er, 3bb, 10k, 1hr, 3hb).
- RHP Ian Gibaut** (15-day IL, right forearm strain) began a rehab assignment Friday (4/5) and has made 2 scoreless apps for A-Dayton, including a perfect inning of relief Sun (4/7) in the Dragons' 7-6 vs Lansing...Gibaut is expected to pitch again tomorrow for Louisville vs Columbus.
- LHP Sam Moll** (15-day IL, left shoulder impingement) began a rehab assignment on 3/29 and has made 5 relief apps for Louisville (1-1, 10.38, 4.1ip, 8h, 5r/5er, 0bb, 5k, 1hb)...Moll is expected to pitch again tomorrow for Louisville vs Columbus.

- 2024:
- Is making his third start of the season, his second career app vs Milwaukee (last: 9/16/22 at Mil).
 - Is the first Reds Opening Day starter to earn the winning decision in each of his first 2 starts of the season since **RHP Aaron Harang** did it in 2007.
 - Made his Reds debut on Opening Day (3/28) vs Wsh... was his 100th career start and his third career Opening Day start (also: 2020 & 2022 w/ Oak)...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings.
 - That outing marked the longest scoreless app by a Reds righthander in his team debut since **Tom Seaver** fired a shutout on 6/18/77 at Mon after being acquired from NYM.
 - Became the first Reds pitcher to produce at least 6.0 scoreless innings in a season opener since **Johnny Cueto** on 4/6/15 vs Pit (7ip, 4h, 1bb, 10k, 100TP).
 - Montas and relievers **RHP Emilio Pagán** and **LHP Brent Suter** all made their Cin debuts in the season opener (3/28) vs Wsh...According to Elias, it was the first time since 1893 (the first season current pitching mound distance was established) that the Reds had each of their multiple Opening Day pitchers make his franchise debut... the last such time it happened in the majors was by the White Sox on 4/6/15 (**Jeff Samardzija**, **Kyle Drabek**, & **Dan Jennings**).
 - On 1/2/24 signed a 1-year contract with the Reds through the 2024 season with a mutual option for 2025.

- CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:
- Made 5 Opening Day rosters, all for the Athletics (2017, 2019-2022)...began the 2023 season on the Yankees' 15-day injured list.
 - Was the Athletics' Opening Day starter in the 10-inning, 7-3 win vs LAA in 2020 and in their 9-5 loss at Phi in 2022.
 - His 3.70 ERA over the 5 seasons from 2018-2022 was the fifth-lowest in the American League (500ip minimum) behind **Justin Verlander** (2.33), **Gerrit Cole** (3.00), **Shane Bieber** (3.17) and **Framber Valdez** (3.38).
 - His 349 strikeouts over the 2021 and 2022 season were eighth-most among American League pitchers (331.1ip).
 - Finished sixth in the BBWAA's 2021 American League Cy Young Award voting.
 - His 207 strikeouts during the 2021 season were the second-most in a season by an Athletics pitcher since the franchise moved to Oakland in 1968 (**Vida Blue**, 301k in 1971) and second-most by a righthander in franchise history (**Jack Coombs**, 224k in 1910).

- 2024:
- Will make his third start of the season, his first vs Mil since 9/22/22 at Great American Ball Park.
 - Made 5 apps during Spring Training (1-2, 7.20)...fanned 19 batters over 15.0 innings and held opponents to a .250 batting average (.314 batting avg on balls in play).

- 2023:
- Was the Reds' Opening Day starting pitcher.
 - For the second consecutive season led Reds pitchers in strikeouts.
 - For the second consecutive season was the Reds' nominee for Major League Baseball's prestigious **Lou Gehrig Memorial Award** for exemplary contributions to his community and philanthropy.
 - Missed 71 days while on injured lists with right hip pain (6/19-8/19) and COVID-19 (9/1-9/9).
 - Went 2-4, 3.93 in 14 starts before he went on the 15-day injured list with the hip injury and 2-3, 6.52 in 8 starts after he was reinstated on 8/20...from 8/1-8/15 made 4 rehab apps for the ACL Reds (1gs, 2ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) and Louisville (3gs, 12ip, 6h, 5r, 4er, 7bb, 12k, 2hr).
 - Went 1-2, 9.73 in 3 starts between his 2 stints on the injured lists.
 - Finished the season 1-1, 5.06 in 5 starts after he came off the COVID-19 injured list on 9/10.
