YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Rays, 9-1, on Monday at Yankee Stadium...LHP Carlos Rodón (7.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 10K, 1HR) earned his 10th win of the season after allowing only 1R/ER in a season-high-tying 7.0IP...Yankees batters hit a season-high-tying 5HR...RF Juan Soto (3-for-5, 2R, 1 double, 2HR, 4RBI) recorded his 21st career multi-HR game and fourth of the year with a solo home run in the seventh inning and a three-run HR in the eighth inning...**C Austin Wells** (3-for-5, 2R, 1HR, 1RBI) recorded a career-hightying 3H and hit his seventh home run of the year with a solo tying 3H and nit his seventh nome run of the year with a solo shot in the second inning...SS Anthony Volpe (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit his seventh HR of the year with a solo HR in the second inning...3B DJ LeMahieu (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base twice and hit his first home run of the season with a solo shot in the fifth inning...2B Oswaldo Cabrera (2-for-4, 1R, 2RBI) hit a two-run single in the fourth inning.

Recorded a career-high 14K on 5/18 vs. Chicago-AL (W, 6.IP, 5H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 0HR)...his 14K are the most in a game by a Yankees rookie in franchise history, surpassing Orlando Hernández's 13K on 8/13/98 vs. Texas...is just the 11th pitcher in franchise history (15th time) to record at least 14K in a game...his 14K match the most by a pitcher in the Majors
