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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore completes its final homestand of the year today vs. Toronto (1-0, 2 to play) having been swept by Milwaukee this past weekend...Following an off day tomorrow, the Orioles wrap up the regular season with three games at Yankee Stadium...The O's are 5.0 games behind the White Sox for the final Wild Card spot with the Rangers (3.0 GB) and Blue Jays (4.0 GB) also in the mix.

- **Shane Baz** did not factor into Monday's decision after allowing three runs, all in the first inning, on five hits and three walks with two strikeouts across 6.2 innings...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Baz became the first Oriole to record a quality start after allowing the first three hitters to score since Chris Tillman on May 8, 2016 vs. Oakland (6.1 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 4 BB, 1 HBP, 7 K).
- Today, the O's are scheduled to play their fourth doubleheader of the season, joining April 30 vs. Houston (1-1), May 24 vs. Detroit (1-1), and July 22 at Boston (1-1)... Baltimore's last doubleheader against Toronto came last season on July 29 at Camden Yards, when the O's swept the Jays.

BATTLING THE BLUE BIRDS: The Orioles have won or split each of the last seven home series with the Blue Jays dating back to 2023, including a 2-2 split in May this year...According to *STATS Perform*, it's the second-longest streak of home series without a series loss against Toronto in team history (since 1954), trailing a 10-series run between 1977-1981.

FOLLOW THE LEADER: **Pete Alonso** leads the AL and is third in MLB with 108 RBI this season while also ranking among AL leaders in home runs (3rd, 40), total bases (3rd, 300), OPS (5th, .869), slugging percentage (5th, .510), extra-base hits (6th, 64), hits (7th, 156), and runs (8th, 94)...Since the All-Star break, his 19 home runs lead the AL and are third most in MLB behind CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (24 HR) and SD's Fernando Tatis Jr. (20 HR).

- He leads the AL in RBI ahead of HOU's Yordan Alvarez (102 RBI)...Alonso led the NL with 131 RBI in 2022 with the Mets and looks to become the first player to lead the AL and the NL in RBI in a season, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Seven Orioles have led the AL in RBI: Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

MORE ON THE POLAR BEAR: Alonso is the ninth Oriole (10th occurrence) with a 40-homer season, joining Anthony Santander (44 HR, 2024), Mark Trumbo (47 HR, 2016), Chris Davis (2x, 47 HR in 2015 & 53 HR in 2013), Nelson Cruz (40 HR, 2014), Rafael Palmeiro (43 HR, 1998), Brady Anderson (50 HR, 1996), Frank Robinson (49 HR, 1966), and Jim Gentile (46 HR, 1961).

- Alonso's 40 home runs are tied with Nelson Cruz (2014) for the third most by an Oriole in their first season with the club behind Frank Robinson (49, 1966) and Mark Trumbo (47, 2016).
- His 108 RBI are the most by an Oriole since Mark Trumbo (108, 2016)...The last with at least 109 RBI was Chris Davis (117, 2015).
- He's the sixth Oriole with 100+ RBI in his first year with the team, along with Miguel Tejada (150, 2004), Frank Robinson (122, 1966), Albert Belle (117, 1999), Nelson Cruz (108, 2014), and Mark Trumbo (108, 2016).
- Alonso hit his 300th career home run on September 15 at New York-NL, a game-tying solo homer in the ninth inning...According to *STATS Perform*, Alonso became the 10th-fastest player to reach 300 career home runs at 1,160 games, trailing Aaron Judge (955 G), Ralph Kiner (1,087 G), Ryan Howard (1,093 G), Juan Gonzalez (1,096), Shohei Ohtani/Alex Rodriguez (both 1,117 G), Giancarlo Stanton (1,119 G), Harmon Killebrew (1,137 G), and Mark McGwire (1,148 G)...He's hit 304 career home runs, the third most in a player's first eight seasons in MLB history behind Ralph Kiner (329) and Albert Pujols (319).
- He has started all 157 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with TB's Junior Caminero, ATL's Matt Olson, and PHI's Bryce Harper...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
- Alonso has played in 573 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (939 G).

MAYO MASHING: Despite seeing his career-best 23-game on-base streak come to an end on Monday, **Coby Mayo** is slashing .270/.335/.557 (47-for-174) with eight doubles, three triples, 12 home runs, and 29 RBI over 54 games since the All-Star break.

- Mayo's .557 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is second highest in the AL (min. 150 AB), trailing teammate **Pete Alonso** (.568).
- Since August 31, he is 12-for-43 (.279) with three doubles and four home runs against right-handed pitching after going 0-for-29 off righties from August 11-30.
- Mayo is batting .315/.384/.713 (45-for-143) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.097) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole behind Gary Roenicke's 18 in 1983.

'PEN PALS: **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 20 games (17.2 IP) since August 6, the longest streak by an Oriole since Zack Britton had a franchise-record-tying 25-game stretch from June 22-August 22, 2016.

- Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Twins (15).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's 571 walks rank second in the AL behind the White Sox (577) and fifth in MLB behind the Cubs (659 BB), Brewers (650 BB), and Dodgers (611 BB).

- According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Birds look to lead the AL in walks for the seventh time in franchise history (since 1954) and for the first time since 1990 (660 BB).
- Baltimore has had 10 different players this season record at least 30 walks, tied for most in MLB with Milwaukee and Minnesota...It is tied for the most by the Orioles in a single season in franchise history (since 1954), along with 1999, 1982, 1973, and 1970.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles have played in an MLB-high-tying 105 games (51-54) decided by three runs or fewer along with the Guardians (57-48) and Royals (44-61)...Their .486 winning percentage in those games ranks 19th in the majors.

- Baltimore is 18-24 in one-run games this year...The team's .429 winning percentage in those situations is 25th in the majors.

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his 18th start (20th appearance) of the season...Signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.
⚡ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List (low back discomfort) on June 8, retroactive to June 5, and transferred to the 60-day IL on July 17...Reinstated from the 60-day IL on August 14.
⚡ Reached 10 years of major-league service time in May.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his eighth win of the season on September 16 at New York-NL after tossing a season-high-tying 6.2 innings (3x, last: 8/25 at STL), allowing one run on five hits and one walk with six strikeouts...Threw 95 pitches, 61 strikes.
⚡ Snapped a career-high-tying, three-start streak of allowing at least three walks (3x, last: 4/24-5/5/23) from August 30-September 11.
⚡ Has earned the win in four of his last five games since August 25, with the lone exception September 5 vs. Boston (L).

FAMILIAR FOE: Bassitt is 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA (12 ER/30.0 IP) over five career starts opposite Toronto dating back to April 23, 2016...In two starts vs. the Blue Jays this season, he is 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP) and one quality start.
⚡ Earned the win in his last start at Toronto on September 11, allowing two runs in 5.0 innings pitched on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with five strikeouts.

U TURN: Over seven starts since returning from the Injured List on August 14, Bassitt is 4-1 with a 3.76 ERA (17 ER/40.2 IP).
⚡ He went 4-4 with a 5.27 ERA (33 ER/56.1 IP) over his first 12 appearances (10 GS) of the season, allowing opponents to slash .307/.383/.447 (70-for-228).

A TALE OF TWO PITCH TYPES: Hitters are slashing .192/.290/.283 (23-for-120) with five doubles, two homers, 11 walks, and 32 strikeouts off Bassitt's breaking balls (curve, sweeper, slider) compared to .337/.399/.482 (86-for-255) with 13 doubles, eight homers, 25 walks, and 39 strikeouts on his fastballs (sinker, cutter, four seamer).
⚡ Recorded a season-high four strikeouts on his curveball in his last start on September 16 at New York-NL...Opponents are 1-for-12 (.083) on the pitch through three September starts with zero extra-base hits.

TO THE LEFT: Bassitt has allowed 21 of his 29 extra-base hits (19 2B, 10 HR) this season to lefties, who are slugging .472 against him compared to a .340 mark for right-handed batters...In 2025, he allowed 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 3 3B, 13 HR) to left-handed batters, more than double his 18 extra-base hits (9 2B, 9 HR) given up to righties.
⚡ However, hasn't allowed an extra-base hit to a lefty in three starts this month, during which left-handed batters are slashing .231/.302/.231 (9-for-39) with four walks and 10 strikeouts.

WEAK CONTACT: Only 16 of Bassitt's 320 batted balls (5.0%) have been barreled this season...The 5.0 percent barrel rate is the second-lowest mark of his career (4.7%, 2015) and ranks in the 89th percentile of MLB.

RUNS (THAT'S WHAT I WANT): Bassitt's 6.49 run support average is the 10th-best mark in MLB (min. 15 GS), trailing leader WSH's Cade Cavalli (8.06)...He's received at least six runs of support in four of his last five starts since August 25, over which he holds a 9.71 run support average.
⚡ Received a season-high 13 runs of support on August 25 at St. Louis, his most since August 6, 2023 at Boston (also 13 RS).

MAKING THE ADJUSTMENT: The first time through the lineup, opponents are batting .320 (47-for-147) with eight doubles, five home runs, 18 walks, and an .880 OPS.
⚡ Those figures drop to .273 (41-for-150) with eight doubles, four home runs, 12 walks, and a .738 OPS the second time through, and .275 (25-for-91) with three doubles, one home run, seven walks, and a .687 OPS the third time around.

WORK HORSE: Bassitt is one of 28 active MLB pitchers to have reached 1,300 career innings, which he did on April 22 at Kansas City... Entering the 2026 campaign, he was one of seven MLB pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons, joining Toronto's José Berrios, Dylan Cease, and Patrick Corbin, Chicago-NL's Kevin Gausman, Miles Mikolas, and SF's Logan Webb.
